

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Indian farmers have covered 105.14 lakh ha area under pulses as on 2nd, Aug-2019 against 113.73 lakh ha last year till date.** It is 7.56% lower than last year. Normal area under kharif pulses is 119.89 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 37.50 lakh ha under tur, 30.27 lakh ha under urad bean, 25.81 lakh ha under moong, 0.18 lakh ha under kulthi and 11.38 lakh ha under other pulses. It is 4.56 % down for tur, 5.38% for urad, 12.3% for moong, 48.57 % for kulthi and 10.84% for other pulses from last year. See sowing table:
- **Good showers of rains and more likely in coming weeks have encouraged farmers to cover their sowing acreage as soon as possible.** Even govt. seems on relaxed state as IMD has forecast normal rainfall in Aug & Sep .It may give confidence to govt to release stock in open market. As good rainfall in producing regions would ensure bumper crop this year too. Nafed still have over 37 lakh MT pulses stock. There is a common view in the market that maximum pulses would not be able to get MSP price in markets in new season and so govt. would have to purchase more. For storage space, it would continue to release pulses stock before new procurement season starts.
- **Sources say that 20,000 MT tur and 30,000 MT urad vessels are in way to India from Myanmar** and is likely to hit Indian port by mid of August. Loading for another 5 to 10 thousand MT is under process and is expected to start from Myanmar by 10 to 12 August. The millers who have imported tur and urad would not be able to sell it directly to any one as there is a stern penalty if it is sold directly in the market without processing. New crop of tur in Burma is in good condition and under prevailing condition good crop is expected. New crop would hit market just ahead of Indian crop.
- **New arrival of early kharif moong is about to start in Karnataka in Gadag market.** The pressure is likely to build from mid Aug. Arrival of two bags was reported today and was traded at Rs7600-7800 per qtl. MSP for kharif moong is Rs7050 per qtl. Sowing is running behind by 6.7 lakh ha to 20.50 lakh ha and it is 7 lakh ha lower from normal average. However, recent rains in Rajasthan, M.P., and Maharashtra have given much needed respite to standing moong crop. Heavy rains, if occur, may damage crop and its quality in coming weeks.
- **Today is the last day of mandi tax holiday in M.P. State govt. has to decide whether to continue it or not.** If it is not extended, it would further affect pulses business in the state.
- **Burma offers urad FAQ at \$535 and SQ at \$675 per MT basis Indian ports. It is down by \$10 from previous day.** New lemon is being offered at \$750 per MT, old at \$670 per MT. It has lost \$10 in last two days. Moong is being offered at \$860 per MT.

Previous Update:

- **Nafed Procured 25965.15 MT moong against approved quantity of 58643 MT during Rabi 2019-20 so far.** Maximum quantity has been procured in AP. It has procured 12429.05 MT against approved quantity of 19235 MT. Odisha has contributed 6086.06 MT, Tamil Nadu-5383.89 MT and Gujarat-2066.15 MT so far against approved quantity of 14210 MT, 16900 and 7093 MT respectively. This shows that rabi moong procurement is only 44.27% of approved quantity.
- **Poor performance at urad procurement front by Nafed too was seen in rabi 2019-20.** Nafed has procured 18240.54 MT urad against approved quantity of 130881 MT. It is only 13.93 % of approved quantity. The highest contributor was AP contributing 12797.05 MT against approval of 70390 MT. Nafed procured 961.8 MT in Telangana & 3379.07 in Tamil Nadu against approved quantity of 963 & 58425 MT respectively as on 24 July-2019. It procured almost 100% in Odisha (1102.62 against 1163 MT).

International Market Update:

- **As per the latest estimate by NASS (US) area under total pulses in US is likely to decline by 15.57 % to 2,121,500 acres in 2019 against 2,512,800 acres in 2018.** All Chickpeas area is expected to decline by 34.91 % to 559,500 this year. Small & large chickpeas area is expected to decline by 43.87 & 31.77 % to 125,000 & 434,500 acres in 2019. Even lentils area is expected to decline by 31.41 % to 535,000 acres. However, dry pea area is expected to increase by 17.65 % to 1,027,000 acres in 2019 in US.
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % to 203,983 MT in 2019.** It was 199,628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79,833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157,262 MT against 39,916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12,156 to 43,318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.

Previous Update:

- **Dry pea production in Canada is likely to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 35.81 MT produced last year.** Higher production estimate would increase total supply by 6 % to 45.15 lakh MT. Due to higher export estimate (by 5 lakh MT to 31 lakh MT) this year may restrict total supply side from 42.46 to 45.15 lakh MT. Domestic consumption has been pegged at 9.15 lakh MT. Despite higher production carryout is expected to decrease from 7.45 to 5 lakh MT. Average price for the year is likely to hover in the range of \$255 to 285 per MT.
- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92 lakh MT last year.** However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.
- **As per the latest update by US dry peas & lentil council mostly standing pulses crops are heading towards maturity stage despite some planting is going on in particular regions.** Crop condition is normal to good. As demand from India is weak so farmers have changed planting decision to some extent this year. Inventory of chickpeas and lentil has increased. As per USDA estimate area under chickpeas and lentils have decreased by 31 & 35 % respectively. Montana lentil crops benefitted from good rains across the state. 52% of lentil plants are in bloom. The lentil crop rated 4% poor, 52% fair, 43% good and 1% excellent.
- **A tentative comparison from last year shows that carryover stocks are high for all peas, lentils, and chick-peas.** Dry pea stocks are up 2% to 204,117 MT, lentils are up 81% at 144,242 MT. Large chickpeas are up 310 percent or 113,851 MT, while small chick-peas are up 256 percent, or 43,318 MT. Total chickpeas are up 294% for a total of 157,396 MT as per NASS report.
- **As per latest data received from Russian Federal Customs Service chickpeas export from Russia decreased by 16% to 25,197 MT in May-2019 in comparison to April when export was registered at 29,858 MT.** Russia has exported total 99,674 MT in this MY against 19,209 MT during the previous calendar year. Pakistan was the major buyers buying 9,797 MT in May, followed by India-6,789 MT and Turkey at 3,766 MT. Demand remains weak as main buyer like India is almost out of the market due to higher availability in domestic market as well as central pool.
- **Russian export of peas posted slight gain in comparison to March-2019.** In April Russia exported 55,930 MT peas, up by 8% to 518,363 MT in March. In current MY Russia has exported total 175,643 MT, down from 380,191 in the same period the last calendar year. Pakistan brought 12,004 MT, followed by India 9,655 MT and Bangladesh at 8,701 MT. Demand is likely to improve in coming months.
- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20 while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT.** Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
