

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Lentil prices were firm in the past week. Lentil mill quality in Kanpur market increased from Rs 4340 per quintal to Rs 4415 per quintal. Rainfall during the period (01.06.2019-07.08.2019) is below LPA by 5%. Lower rainfall has supported lentil prices as low soil moisture may impact yields in upcoming Rabi season. However good stock position of lentil in India is likely to keep prices steady in upcoming months. Canadian lentil container and vessel are being quoted at Rs 4150 per quintal and Rs 3950 per quintal respectively, higher compared to previous week. Whereas Australian lentil container is being quoted at Rs 4250 per quintal. Australia as well as Canada has ample supplies available and can easily provide export quotes below prevailing prices in India.
- Moong cash market traded steady amid commencement of new arrival from Karnataka. Moisture level is higher in new crop. Arrivalis likely to increase in second fortnight of August and by then quality is expected to improve. Heavy rains in Karnataka M.P. & Rajasthan may affect quality of moong passing through maturity stages. The picture will be clear in next 10days. If rains continues it may affect crop size too amid quality. Coverage area is still lower. If standing crop suffers from rains and flooding, prices of moong may move up from current level. Nafed has only 1.45 lakh MT moong in its stock. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6200 per qtl. it may move upto Rs 6500-6600 once again.

Previous Update:

- Indian farmers have covered 115.39 lakh ha area under pulses as on 9th, Aug-2019 against 121.39 lakh ha last year till date. It is 4.94% lower than last year. Normal area under kharif pulses is 119.89 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 40.12 lakh ha under tur, 32.58 lakh ha under urad bean, 28.12 lakh ha under moong,0.19 lakh ha under kulthi and 14.38 lakh ha under other pulses. It is 1.40 % down for tur, 5.62% for urad, 11.04% for moong,47.22 % for kulthi and 1.20% up for other pulses from last year. See table at page no.3
- New early kharif urad crop from MP is expected to hit market by mid sep.Crop condition is good so far .However, heavy rains, if continue, may damage urad crop in MP.As far as old stock in private hands is concerned, it is not enough to fulfil market demand despite 1.5 lakh MT import option till 31st oct-2019.However,Nafed still has 3.32 lakh MT stock. Out of total 3.14 lakh MT is old stock. It may restrict urad market to move one way up. If rains damage standing cro ,it may move up by Rs250 to 300 from current level. New urad from Gujarat and Maharashtra too would hit market from second week of Sep. However, late sowing heavy rains may impact yield. Quality of imported urad is not good .So quality urad may move up in coming weeks. Urad from Chandausi line is expected in Nov.
- Import flow of pulses from Myanmar and Africa during last one week at Indian ports, many vessels on way to Indian ports and weak demand in domestic market at this point of time has pressurized pulses cash market by 5 to 10 % in four-five days. As supply from imported pulses and from kharif crop is expected to increase by the end of this month, prices of pulses is expected to remain under pressure during festive season. Normally, pulses demand increases during festive season. However, govt, allowed 4 lakh MT tur import, 1.5 lakh MT moong and urad each. Besides lentil is being imported at faster pace. Good rainfall in kharif growing belts too is ensuring better kharif pulses production prospects. So, prices of pulses would remain stable at peak demand season.
- Decreased arrival of chana in Delhi helped market to recover slightly by Rs 50 to Rs 4400. As demand has not been up to the mark against supply, any spike is unlikely. Private trades may prefer to lighten their stock at Rs4500 analyzing hefty stock of chana with Nafed. Demand in domestic market is still poor. Almost all pulses are reeling under pressure right now. Good rainfall has increased better kharif prospects. So, any jump in cash pulses market is unlikely in the near term.
- Sources say that 20,000 MT tur and 30,000 MT urad vessels are in way to India from Myanmar and is likely to hit Indian port by mid of August. Loading for another 5 to 10 thousand MT is under process and is expected to start from Myanmar by 10to 12 August. The millers who have imported tur and urad would not be able to sell it directly to any one as there is a stern penalty if it is sold directly in the market without processing. New crop of tur in Burma



is in good condition and under prevailing condition good crop is expected. New crop would hit market just ahead of Indian crop.

International Market Update:

- Due to rough weather condition and disease in Canada & parts of US chickpeas growing belts concern s have started surfacing its head regarding yield potential. Market experts have expressed concern over chickpeas yield in Canada. Fear haves been expressed over quality too. Chickpeas cropis suffering from aschochyta blight. It reduce yield and hamper quality too. If it is not contained inits early stages, yield loss might be 60 to 70 percent this year.
- Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT(till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June , followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- As per latest update, Australia has exported 73.23 thousand tonnes of lentil in June'19 higher by around 166% percent compared to previous month. The top buyers were Bangladesh, India and Pakistan with 56.11 thousand tonnes, 10.24 thousand tonnes and 3.78 thousand tonnes respectively.
- As per the latest estimate by NASS (US) area under total pulses in US is likely to decline by 15.57 % to 2,121,500 acres in 2019 against 2,512,800 acres in 2018. All Chickpeas area is expected to decline by 34.91 % to 559,500 this year. Small & large chickpeas area is expected to decline by 43.87 & 31.77 % to 125,000 & 434,500 acres in 2019. Even lentils area is expected to decline by 31.41 % to 535,000 acres. However, dry pea area is expected to increase by 17.65 % to 1,027,000 acres in 2019 in US.
- Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % tp 203983 MT in 2019.It was 199628 MT in 2018.Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018.All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018.Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019.It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.

Previous Update:

- Dry pea production in Canada is likely to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 35.81 MT produced last year. Higher production estimate would increase total supply by 6 % to 45.15 lakh MT. Due to higher export estimate(by 5 lakh MT to 31lakh MT) this year may restrict total supply side from 42.46 to 45.15 lakh MT Domestic consumption has been pegged at 9.15 lakh MT. Despite higher production carryout is expected to decrease from 7.45 to 5 lakh MT. Average price for the year is likely to hover in the range of \$255 to 285 per MT.
- Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.
- As per the latest update by US dry peas & lentil council mostly standing pulses crops are heading towards maturity stage despite some planting is going on in particular regions. Crop condition is normal to good. As demand from India is weak so farmers have changed planting decision to some extent this year. Inventory of chickpeas and lentil has increased. As per USDA estimate area under chickpeas and lentils have decreased by 31 & 35 % respectively. Montana lentil crops benefitted from good rains across the state. 52% of lentil plants are in bloom. The lentil crop rated 4% poor, 52% fair, 43% good and 1% excellent.
- A tentative comparison from last year shows that carryover stocks are high for all peas, lentils, and chick- peas. Dry pea stocks are up 2% to 204,117 MT, lentils are up 81% at 144,242 MT. Large chickpeas are up 310 percent or 113,851 MT, while small chick- peas are up 256 percent, or 43,318 MT. Total chickpeas are up 294% for a total of 157,396 MTas per NASS report.
- Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20 while production is expected to fall from 3.11to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower



imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
