

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Heavy rains and flooding in recent weeks in parts of North Karnataka have impacted moong** harvesting activities Gadag, Dharwad, Belgaum and Bagalkot. In some region quality of moong too has suffered and it has turned natural green to black. Area under moong this year is lower by 10.04% to 29.10 lakh ha against 32.34 lakh ha last year till date. In Karnataka area under moong was 38 % lower this year to 2.53 lakh ha. Even in Rajasthan and Maharashtra kharif moong area is lower by 3.61 and 18.25% this year. It may lend support to cash moong market in coming weeks. Farmers have demanded to start procurement early as they don't have holding capacity. The crop looks good in Vidarbha region and arrival is expected from 10th Sep. Good quality moong in this region may trade at Rs 6500. Steady to firm tone may prevail in moong market in coming weeks.

Previous Update:

- **M.P. govt. may decide to reduce mandi tax from 1.5 to 1% on all farm produces.** It had already cut mandi tax by 50 basis points to 1.5% in October. A senior official with the state government said that markets have to pay 0.2 % as surcharge over the tax. State govt. expects trades community to pass on the benefits to farmers. The govt has already rolled back mandi tax on pulses procured from other states for milling purpose in the beginning of August. Before this roll back mills in M.P. had to pay additional 2.2% as mandi tax.
- **India imported total 238995.36 MT pulses in July against 163899.83 MT in June-2019.** It is up by 45.81 % from last month. Chickpeas import in July increased from 22105.65 to 36275.21 MT. Even tur import increased from 11598.9 to 29556.5 MT during same month. Green pea import too increased from 7792.69 to 16179.8 MT. Lentil import too increased from 51102.96 to 78570.91 MT. Urad and moong import too increased from 1582.34 to 9099.37 MT and 3497.26 to 11710.49 MT. However, yellow pea import decreased from 57214.31 to 46579.47 MT during same month. Kidney bean import too increased from 9005.72 to 1113.61 MT. Import flow is likely to increase in August too. Tur and lentils import would increase. See table.
- **Lentil prices traded weak in the past week due to continuous imports. As per market sources** vessel (Medi Astoria) is likely to arrive at Mundra port either today or tomorrow with 28620.15 tonnes of lentil. Mill quality lentil at Kanpur fell to Rs 4410 per quintal from Rs 4450 per quintal. As per govt.'s fourth advance estimate released on 19th August-2019 govt. has estimated 1.56 MMT production in 2018-19 compared to final estimate of 1.62 MMT for 2017-18. As per traders view, this estimate is at higher side.
- **Chana market could not sustain its upward momentum and decreased by Rs 50 to Rs 4425** in Delhi market taking clue from weak futures. Demand remain restricted despite festive season. Market is well aware of Nafed stock. Cash market should improve once again and may trade at Rs 4400-4600 in Delhi market in coming weeks. Weak demand, liquidity issue and Nafed stock remain restrictive to cash chana market. Even futures remains un-supportive to cash market.
- **Tur market is likely to move up slightly due to recent loss of standing crop in Karnataka, Maharashtra and MP.** However, recent rains are considered too be beneficial to standing crop in upper land. As area is expected to be higher than last year, recent loss would be compensated by higher area and good rainfall in other growing regions. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs 5850-5950 per qtl. It may move up by Rs 100-150 more from current level.
- **Even urad may trade up by Rs 100-200 from current level as stockiest have resorted** to retain stock sensing recent crop loss and lower availability in global market amid restricted import flow. In Chennai market urad moved up by Rs 100 to Rs 4700 and may touch 4800-4900 by the end of this week. At this level selling by private trades might be seen. Crop condition in UP, Rajasthan, MP and Gujarat in Upper land is very good.
- **New early kharif urad crop from MP is expected to hit market by mid sep.** Crop condition is good so far. However, heavy rains, if continue, may damage urad crop in MP. As far as old stock in private hands is concerned, it is not enough to fulfil market demand despite 1.5 lakh MT import option till 31st Oct-2019. However, Nafed still has 3.32 lakh MT stock. Out of total 3.14 lakh MT is old stock. It may restrict urad market to move one way up. If rains

damage standing crop, it may move up by Rs250 to 300 from current level. New urad from Gujarat and Maharashtra too would hit market from second week of Sep. However, late sowing heavy rains may impact yield. Quality of imported urad is not good. So quality urad may move up in coming weeks. Urad from Chandausi line is expected in Nov.

International Market Update:

- **Dry peas production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT** in comparison to last year. The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- **Lentil quotes from Canada as well as Australia have eased in the past week due to ample supplies.** Canadian lentil container and vessel are being quoted at Rs 4100 per quintal and Rs 3900 per quintal respectively, higher compared to previous week. Whereas Australian lentil container is being quoted at Rs 4200 per quintal.
- **Due to rough weather condition and disease in Canada & parts of US chickpeas growing belts concern** s have started surfacing its head regarding yield potential. Market experts have expressed concern over chickpeas yield in Canada. Fear has been expressed over quality too. Chickpeas crops are suffering from ascochyta blight. It reduces yield and hampers quality too. If it is not contained in its early stages, yield loss might be 60 to 70 percent this year.
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May** when it was registered at 24719MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. India brought 8,463 MT in June, followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- **As per the latest estimate by NASS (US) area under total pulses in US is likely to decline by 15.57 % to 2,121,500 acres** in 2019 against 2,512,800 acres in 2018. All Chickpeas area is expected to decline by 34.91 % to 559,500 this year. Small & large chickpeas area is expected to decline by 43.87 & 31.77 % to 125,000 & 434,500 acres in 2019. Even lentils area is expected to decline by 31.41 % to 535,000 acres. However, dry pea area is expected to increase by 17.65 % to 1,027,000 acres in 2019 in US.
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % to 203983 MT in 2019.** It was 199628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.

Previous Update:

- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.
- **A tentative comparison from last year shows that carryover stocks are high for all peas, lentils, and chick-peas.** Dry pea stocks are up 2% to 204,117 MT, lentils are up 81% at 144,242 MT. Large chickpeas are up 310 percent or 113,851 MT, while small chick-peas are up 256 percent, or 43,318 MT. Total chickpeas are up 294% for a total of 157,396 MT as per NASS report.
- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20** while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
