

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Indian farmers have covered 130.05 lakh ha area under pulses as on 06th, Sep-2019** against 132.63 lakh ha last year till date. It is 1.95 % lower than last year. Normal area under kharif pulses is 119.89 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 44.95 lakh ha under tur, 37.95 lakh ha under urad bean, 30.48 lakh ha under moong, 0.45 lakh ha under kulthi and 16.65 lakh ha under other pulses. It is 0.42 % up for tur, 1.74 % down for urad, 9.63 % down for moong, 8.96 % for kulthi and 7.67 % up for other pulses from last year.
- **As on 5th Sep total stock holding in Nafed custody was 3485315.15 MT. The highest quantity is of chana** (over 2MMT). Out of total old crop(2018) is over 12 lakh MT while new crop(2019) is around 7.75 lakh MT. In case of moong total stock(rabi and kharif) is 1.31 lakh MT including rabi -kharif 2017 too. Out of this only 5570 MT is from 2017. In case of urad total stock with Nafed is 2.88 lakh MT. Out of total 18908MT is from 2017 crop, 2.57 lakh MT is from 2018 crop and 12540MT is from rabi 2019 crop. In case of tur total stock is 8.54 lakh MT. The major portion is from 2017 crop(5.78 lakh MT) while 2.75 lakh MT is from 2018 crop. In case of masur total stock is 2.05 lakh MT. Out of total 1.49 lakh MT is from 2018 crop while 56000 MT is from 2019 crop. So stock of pulses is enough to tackle domestic demand. Nafed would continue to offload stock and it would restrict uptrend in the market.
- **New moong arrival from Nimar region of Madhya Pradesh started. Arrival was reported at 11 bags.** It was traded at Rs 6011 per qtl. Total arrival was reported at 35 bags. But due to higher moisture content, it could not be sold. Arrival is expected to increase with opening of weather. Quality of new moong is said to be good.
- **Nafed has started offering chana in Mah, U.P. & M.P. It has offered 5400 MT in Mah, 1831.47 MT in U.P. & 20815.96 MT in M.P.** It has passed tender for 420 MT in Khandwa at Rs 3981. In other states like Raj, Guj & MH, bids were not passed due to lower price. As market is already reeling under pressure, acceptance of lower bid may pressurize cash market further. Buyers are unwilling to buy in bulk quantity as sentiments turned weak.
- **Nafed has offered 2752.51MT moong and 40653.93 MT urad in Odisha, Guj and M.P for moong & Odisha, Guj, U.P. & MP for urad.** Out of total moong offered through tender around 1471 MT has been passed at around Rs 6000 plus. The accepted bids break up is Gharsanea -500 MT, Jodhpur -200MT and Nagore -771 MT. It has passed urad bids in Baran at Rs 4101(2017 crop)
- **Procurement agencies including Nafed had procured over 27 lakh MT chana in rabi season 2018.** Out of total procured quantity Nafed has sold around 10 Lakh MT chana till August-2019. It has maintained reserve stock of 12.78 lakh MT. Thus for auction it has now 12.32 lakh MT available and auction is likely to continue in coming weeks. As bids are being passed around Rs 4000, availability would be easier and it may depress chana price further. Demand is weak. Bulk buyers are unwilling to buy as market sentiments remain weak.

Previous Update:

- **Moong crop in Merta, Shekhawati, Chhoti Khatu and Jayal line of Rajasthan is in excellent condition** and is expected to hit market by third week of Sep. Higher price during sowing season encouraged farmers to grow more moong this year. However, old moong price would rule higher until moong from Rajasthan hits the market. There is report of some loss in Kishanganj line. Overall, crop size is larger in Rajasthan.
- **In Maharashtra moong crop in Akola and Khamgaon line is in very good condition.** Summer crop in UP, Bihar, Jharkhand and MP was lower in size. So moong price increased from normal expected level. Now stockiest have resorted to release light quality stock at Rs 5500-5700. Mills are buying moong at this level. It is good time for traders and stockiest to start offloading moong now.
- **New early kharif urad crop from MP is expected to hit market by mid Sep.** Crop condition is good so far. However, heavy rains, if continue, may damage urad crop in MP. As far as old stock in private hands is concerned, it is not enough to fulfil market demand despite 1.5 lakh MT import option till 31st Oct-2019. However, Nafed still has 3.32 lakh MT stock. Out of total 3.14 lakh MT is old stock. It may restrict urad market to move one way up. If rains damage standing crop, it may move up by Rs 250 to 300 from current level. New urad from Gujarat and Maharashtra too would hit market from second week of Sep. However, late sowing heavy rains may impact yield. Quality of

imported urad is not good .So quality urad may move up in coming weeks. Urad from Chandausi line is expected in Nov.

International Market Update:

- **Chickpeas crop condition is not as satisfactory as local farmers estimate in US and Canada.** There are reports of infestation (ascochyta blight and other diseases) in the crop due to wet weather conditions. Farmers of Western Canada and the northern United States are reporting infestation in standing crops. CDC Orion varieties are more affected than other varieties. If it continues to increase, production in both countries may decline by 10 to 15% from farmer's expectation. Quality of the crop too may be downgraded.
- **Poor domestic and export demand continued to weigh on global chickpea market this week.** Given the supply situation and carry in from 2018-19 buyers are in no hurry to buy. They are active to fulfill their immediate needs. They are not buying for medium or long term basis. As harvesting is delayed by 10 to 15 days, it is difficult to move stock into export market in lesser time. India may pose a challenge as chickpeas market is decreasing and Govt.'s agency like Nafed has excess stock to offload.
- **Dry peas harvest in Canada and US has got momentum despite slower pace of commencement .**It is still running behind of 5 years average. Harvesting of 52% US dry is over now against 70% last year till date. With current harvested area around 4.92 lakh MT peas from new crop would be available for sale this week. It was 5.26 lakh MT last year at this point of time. The 5 years average is 5.98 lakh MT. Against it Canadian farmers have been able to harvest only 12 % dry pea so far due to bad weather condition in growing regions.. In Canada only 4.92 lakh MT new peas is available against 16.6 lakh MT last year till date.

Previous Update:

- **Dry peas production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year.** The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT .Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719MT** as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June , followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % tp 203983 MT in 2019. It was 199628 MT in 2018.** Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.
- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT . Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.
- **A tentative comparison from last year shows that carryover stocks are high for all peas, lentils, and chick- peas.** Dry pea stocks are up 2% to 204,117 MT, lentils are up 81% at 144,242 MT. Large chickpeas are up 310 percent or 113,851 MT, while small chick- peas are up 256 percent, or 43,318 MT. Total chickpeas are up 294% for a total of 157,396 MT as per NASS report.
- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20** while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower

imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
