

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Some reputed firms have alleged that prices of lentils in Indian market are ruling around 3800 to 4000 per qtl while its price in supplying countries like Australia and Canada are hovering at lower levels. So import volume is continuously increasing in Indian market. Sensing dumping like condition some firms have requested either to increase import duty on lentil or impose quantity restriction as soon as possible. The matter pertaining to increase in duty pertains to department of revenue while action on curbing of import may be taken by DGFT. It would be interesting to see the next move by the concerned authority in this regard.
- Increasing fear of urad crop loss in India due to rains and recent flooding. Gauging the crop loss importers have started striking new deals for urad in Myanmar. Quotes in Myanmar too increased from\$525 to \$535 for FAQ and from \$660 to \$670-75 for SQ in last two days. Due to loss availability of urad in MP is likely to be lower. As per latest update this year urad production in Myanmar has been pegged at 3.5 lakh MT. Out of this around 2.25 lakh MT has been exported tillAug-2019. Myanmar is exporting 50 to 60 thousand MT urad per month. Under current situation urad price may move up further by 300-400 per qtl.

Previous Update:

- As per trade Sources, India has imported 54535.91 MT of yellow pea at an average CiF of \$257.92 per tonnes during the month of August-2019. Of the total quantity around 31511 tonnes has been purchased from Russia and the remaining quantity from Canada, Ukraine and Lithuania.
- Despite some improvements seen in futures chana market is unlikely to sustain at higher level.. Demand from bulk users has improved taking clue from firm futures. Once Nafed starts selling chana in bulk volume it would come down again. Market is well aware of ample availability of chana in central pool as well as in private hands. If we keep aside reserve stock of 1278453 MT, still there is a availability of 1232136MT with Nafed for sale. In Delhi market chana is being traded at Rs 4350-4350. If demand improves and Nafed decides not to sell stock, it may move to 4400-4500 maximum. Liquidity crunch too is restricting normal trade. So it is better to sell Chana at every hike of Rs75-100..
- Rains in Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan have delayed arrivals of moong. If it continues quality of crop may suffer. In anticipation of emerging quality loss mills have started buying old crop and it supported cash market by Rs 100-150 per qtl. It may move up further by Rs 200. Mills are buying moong in U.P and it is being traded at Rs 5600-5700 per qtl now. Quality moong in this region is being traded at Rs 6000. Stake holders should release old stock at increased level.
- Tur market continued to trade under pressure as demand from bulk users remains subdued against ample supply from private trades and imported stock. Despite some crop loss by flooding in Gujarat, M.P. and Rajasthan crop in other states are in normal condition. Besides, Nafed has around 8 lakh MT stock. It would keep market under pressure in coming weeks. New crop would hit market in December. So there is ample stock for for three months consumption. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at RS5650-5700. It may further decrease by Rs 100-150 from current level.
- Moong crop in Merta, Shekhawati, Chhoti Khatu and Jayal line of Rajasthan is in excellent condition and is expected to hit market by third week of Sep. Higher price during sowing season encouraged farmers to grow more moong this year. However, old moong price would rule higher until moong from Rajasthan hits the market. There is report of some loss in Kishanganj line. Overall, crop size is larger in Rajasthan.
- In Maharashtra moong crop in Akola and Khamgaon line is in very good condition. Summer crop in UP, Bihar, Jharkhand and MP was lower in size. So moong price increased from normal expected level. Now stockiest have resorted to release light quality stock at Rs 5500-5700. Mills are buying moong at this level. It is good time for traders and stockiest to start offloading moong now.



International Market Update:

- Pea export from Russia decreased to 28836MT in June against 56283 MT in May-2019. Total export during calender year was registered at 2.04 lakh MT, down by 62% from last year. Turkey purchased 8,571 Pakistan MT,8,554 MT, followed by India at 3,107 MT in June.
- As per the latest updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia declined in July to 16632MT against 25805 MT in June-2019. It is almost 36% down from June. Total export till July was recorded at 275,049 MT, massively down from 671,642 during the last marketing year. Pakistan, B,desh and UAE purchased 4,474 MT,4,403 MT & 2,455 MT. respectively in July-2019.
- Chickpeas crop condition is not as satisfactory as local farmers estimate in US and Canada. There are reports of infestation (ascochyta blight and other diseases) in the crop due to wet weather conditions. Farmers of Western Canada and the northern United States are reporting infestation in standing crops.CDC Orion varieties are more affected than other varieties. If it continues to increase, production in both countries may decline by 10 to 15% from farmer's expectation. Quality of the crop too may be downgraded.
- Poor domestic and export demand continued to weigh on global chickpea market this week. Given the supply situation and carry in from 2018-19 buyers are in no hurry to buy. They are active to fulfill their immediate needs. They are not buying for medium or long term basis. As havesting is delayed by 10 to 15 days, it is difficult to move stock into export market in lesser time. India may pose a challenge as chickpeas market is decreasing and Govt.'s agency like Nafed has excess stock to offload.
- Dry peas harvest in Canada and US has got momentum despite slower pace of commencement .It is still running behind of 5 years average. Harvesting of 52% US dry is over now against 70% last year till date. With current harvested area around 4.92 lakh MT peas from new crop would be available for sale this week. It was 5.26 lakh MT last year at this point of time. The 5 years average is 5.98 lakh MT. Against it Canadian farmers have been able to harvest only 12 % dry pea so far due to bad weather condition in growing regions. In Canada only 4.92 lakh MT new peas is available against 16.6 lakh MT last year till date.

Previous Update:

- Dry peas production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison tolast year. The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 cropyear. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT(till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June , followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % tp 203983 MT in 2019.It was 199628 MT in 2018.Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018.All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018.Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019.It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.
- Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.
- Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20 while production is expected to fall from 3.11to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower



imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
