

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **The commerce ministry has asked pulses importers to finish their import by end Oct-2019.** If they fail to do so, their quota allotment would not be valid beyond Oct. In any case date would not be enhanced. Notably, The DGFT had stated that imports should arrive on Indian ports latest by October 31 and the validity period of the allotment will not be enhanced on 11th Sep-2019.
- **Chickpea export increased from 8698.89 MT in Jul to 9083 MT in Aug-2019. Tur export declined from 1283.78 to 951.22 MT in Aug.** Green pea export declined from 821.01 to 5.71 MT while lentils export increased slightly from 868.95 to 885.16 MT during same period. Urad and moong export too declined to 745.86 and 1506.81 MT. Total export of pulses declined by 6.17% to 13215.55 MT in Aug-2019
- **Chana recovered as mills renewed buying and increasing demand for seeds. Recovery in futures** was expected as sellers were unwilling to sell at lower level. Besides, Nafed restricted sale helped market to gain again. Chana in Delhi market traded at Rs 4350-4450 and may move up further by Rs 100 from current level. However, any major spike in chana cash market is unlikely. It may move up to MSP level in the short term.
- **Myanmar quotes for pulses improved today on increasing fear of crop loss due to heavy rains** in growing states. It quoted lenon tur up by \$10 at \$690 per MT basis Indian ports. Even old crop quotes increased by \$20 to \$620 per MT. Urad FAQ too increased by \$35 to \$595 and SQ \$30 to \$745 per MT. Chana (kabuli) stayed steady at \$650 while moong was quoted at \$860 Per MT. Red Rajma was quoted at \$1120 per MT basis Indian ports.
- **This year moong area is almost 9 % lower than last year as per latest sowing updates. Farmers have planted 31.16 lakh ha against 34.25 lakh ha last year.** Crop loss scenario seems rather serious now with current showers of normal to heavy rains in states like Raj, Karnataka, M.P., Mah, Guj and U.P. The major kharif moong growing states are Rajasthan (18.31 lakh ha against 19.02 last year), Maharashtra (3.28 against 4.18 lakh ha last year) Guj (0.93 against 0.63 lakh ha last year), Odisha (1.64 against 1.74 lakh ha last year) Telangana (0.71 against 0.73 lakh ha), MP (3.11 against 4.11 lakh ha). Around one lakh ha is said to be washed out by flooding while 15 % crop in these states are said to be dis-colored due to continuous rains. It may support moong price in coming weeks. Kharif moong production is bound to decline by 1 lakh MT while shortage of quality moong might be felt in Nov-Dec. Arriav is not increasing as expected at this point of time.

Previous Update:

- **The extended phase of monsoon has become a cause of concern for kharif pulses farmers** whose crop are either at maturity stages or at flowering stages in Rajasthan, Gujarat, MP and Maharashtra. Some pulses crops in UP too have been damaged due to recent flooding. Recent rains are disturbing farmers to harvest their matured crops standing in the fields. Farmers in the affected area say if rains continue, it would damage quality of crop, especially moong and urad. It may affect yield too. The rains have caused a delay in the crop arrivals. The Centre's crop projections have factored in the extended rain impact, and the pulses production is likely to be 3 per cent lower at 8.23 lakh tonnes as against 8.59 lakh tonnes.
- **Tur cash market continued to trade under pressure as importers have started releasing** lower quality stock at discounted price. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs 5550-5650 per qtl. down by Rs 100 from last week. Total area coverage under tur is almost same as last year at 45.37 lakh ha. It may end up with 46 lakh ha this year against normal of 43 lakh ha. Crop condition started improving with recent showers of rains in major growing belts despite some losses in Gujarat, Raj and MP. Area loss is likely to be compensated by higher yield in Mah, UP and Gujarat. However, crop condition is poor in Karnataka, the major tur growing states where 11.69 lakh Ha has been covered. Area in Mah crossed 12 lakh ha.
- **Urad and moong crops in Baran, Bundi, Chittorgarh, Dholpur, Jhalawar & Kota in Rajasthan, Mansore, Neemuch, Bhopal and Hoshangabad in MP & Marathwara and 3 districts in central Maharashtra have suffered a lot** due to flooding and continuous rains. In Maharashtra moong and urad crops are at harvesting stages. Total 1.6

to 1.8 lakh ha urad crop in Rajasthan is feared to be washed out. Around 60 to 75 thousand ha moong crop is said to be washed out in Rajasthan.

- **Despite demand of higher import duty on Masur govt has not taken any decision on import duty.** However, govt is aware of higher volume of import and may analyze the overall scenario before taking any decision on imposing higher duty. There is a continuous flow of masur from Canada and Australia and it is affecting price in domestic market.

International Market Update:

- **Pulses & edible beans production in China is expected to decline by 10% this year to 44 lakh MT** due to lower seeded area and unfavorable weather conditions. Lower prevailing price in local market discouraged farmers to reduce area year on year basis. China's annual pulse consumption per-capita is roughly 1.7 kilograms. Pulses demand in China is increasing due to health awareness and rising income.
- **Lentils export from Turkey posted smart gains in July in comparison to June-2019 as per** available statistics from Turkish Statistical Institute. Turkey exported 13,053 lentils in July against 8608 MT in June. Turkey has exported total 142199 MT lentils during the calendar year so far. It is down by 7% from last year till date. Sudan brought 4406 MT, Saudi Arabia -1144 MT and Iraq -999 MT in July-2019.
- **Pea export from Russia decreased to 28836 MT in June against 56283 MT in May-2019.** Total export during calendar year was registered at 2.04 lakh MT, down by 62% from last year. Turkey purchased 8,571 Pakistan MT, 8,554 MT, followed by India at 3,107 MT in June.
- **Chickpea & dry edible bean harvest in US has started and around 12% is said to be complete** now as per NASS updates. It was 6% last week ending 13th Sep-2019. Idaho completes 37% of the crop is now in the bin, versus 65% last year, while Montana has harvested 58%, down from 76% last year and Oregon reports 45% harvested, compared to 75% last year. In North Dakota only 13% harvest is said to be complete against 72% last year till date. In other states it is in initial stages.
- **As per the latest updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia declined in July to 16632 MT against 25805 MT in June-2019.** It is almost 36% down from June. Total export till July was recorded at 275,049 MT, massively down from 671,642 during the last marketing year. Pakistan, B, desh and UAE purchased 4,474 MT, 4,403 MT & 2,455 MT. respectively in July-2019.

Previous Update:

- **Dry peas production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year.** The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when** it was registered at 24719 MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June, followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % to 203983 MT in 2019.** It was 199628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.
- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at

almost 6 lakh MT . Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.

- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20** while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
