

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- ***Tur coming into various markets is said to be of poor quality and it is affecting tur cash price despite slower pace of arrivals. As quality is poor, trade in Maharashtra and Karnataka markets is taking place at lower level. Arrival in Latur market has decreased to 150 bags only. Stock in private hands is coming down. Besides, demand for tur dal is sluggish and Nafed too is planning to sell it as new crop is only two months away. Market participants are of the view that declining stock may push up tur price to a certain extent before new arrival. As crop condition is good, production size may increase further. Import flow continues and it would continue to restrict tur price. In near to medium term tur may trade 5400-5800 in Gulberga market. Myanmar is quoting lemon tur at \$635 right now . So any spike in tur market is unlikely.***
- ***Recent loss and strong demand for stocking purpose amid sellers unwillingness to sell have lent support to cash urad market. Virtually, sellers have disappeared from market and farmers too have restricted selling. Besides, import flow is lower. So there is a short supply like situation in the market and it is pushing up cash market continuously. The largest producing state like MP have lost 15-20% crop while 30% quality of crop is of inferior quality. Arrival is 90 % lower than last year. Even in other states like Raj, U.P & MH quality of crop is average. All these factors have lent massive support to cash urad market. If stockiest/farmers continue to restrict sale, urad may move up further by Rs300-400. However, at current level stockiest may prefer to release stock by end Oct as around 75-80 thousand MT urad is expected to hit Indian ports by the end of this month, if govt. allows additional 1 to 1.5 lakh MT, as has been demanded by dal mills associations/traders, it may decrease, otherwise it may move further up by Rs300-400.***
- ***Chana continued to improve in cash market taking clue from firm futures and improved offtake. Seed demand, restricted sale by Nafed and private trades, unwillingness to sell at current level remain supportive to cash chana market. Delhi chana was traded at Rs 4400-4450. It may cross MSP soon if current demand continues. However, market is unlikely to move up beyond MSP as there is sufficient stock in central pool.***
- ***FCI is going to auction its 22 MT tur in Telangana (Adilabad & Mehboobnagar) and Raichur in Karnataka. Bids has been invited. As quantity is lower it would not impact local market.***
- ***High level officials of DGFT met with the representative of pulses trades and importers yesterday and requested officials to ease import curbs and allow additional one lakh MT urad import due to recent loss of kharif urad. Trade bodies requested to extend the deadline for import of pulses for next two months till 31st Dec. However, officials would send suggestions and requests to concerned ministry. No immediate action has been taken. DGFT would take decision after finding green signal from ministry and it will take time. Extension in deadline for tur import is necessary as 4 lakh MT import is not possible till Oct end.***

Previous Update:

- ***This year moong area is almost 9 % lower than last year as per latest sowing updates. Farmers have planted 31.16 lakh ha against 34.25 lakh ha last year. Crop loss scenario seems rather serious now with current showers of normal to heavy rains in states like Raj, Karnataka, M.P., Mah, Guj and U.P. The major kharif moong growing states are Rajasthan (18.31 lakh ha against 19.02 last year), Maharashtra (3.28 against 4.18 lakh ha last year) Guj (0.93 against 0.63 lakh ha last year), Odisha (1.64 against 1.74 lakh ha last year) Telangana (0.71 against 0.73 lakh ha), MP (3.11 against 4.11 lakh ha). Around one lakh ha is said to be washed out by flooding while 15 % crop in these states are said to be dis-colored due to continuous rains. It may support moong price in coming weeks. Kharif moong production is bound to decline by 1 lakh MT while shortage of quality moong might be felt in Nov – Dec. Arrivals are not increasing as expected at this point of time.***
- ***Despite demand of higher import duty on Masur govt has not taken any decision on import duty. However, govt is aware of higher volume of import and may analyze the overall scenario before taking any decision on imposing***

higher duty. There is a continuous flow of masur from Canada and Australia and it is affecting price in domestic market.

International Market Update:

- ***This year production of green lentils has not been upto the mark. There is a shortage of quality crop in comparison to last year. Prices of no1 and no.2 have been moving up and uptrend is likely to continue. Last year Canada had harvested 28% no -1 lentils,45% no-2 and 22% no-3 and extra -3.This year percentage of no -1 lentils is 16%, No-3 is 55% and the rest is others. As no -1 is lower than expectation, prices may rule firm in coming weeks too.***
- ***As per the latest report from dry pea & lentils council harvesting activities of pulses in US is coming to an end now.Dry pea harvesting is over in 98% area while it is 90 % for lentils. Small Chickpeas harvest is over in 80% while it is 77% for large chickpeas. Total pulses harvesting on an average comes to 93% so far..***
- ***Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT,lentil production at 2.47lakh MT, total chickpeas production has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT. Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.***
- ***Lentils export from Turkey posted smart gains in July in comparison to June-2019 as per available statistics from Turkish Statistical Institute. Turkey exported 13,053 lentils in July against 8608 MT in June.Turkey has exported total142199 MT lentils during the calendar year so far.It is down by 7% from last year till date. Sudan brought 4406 MT, Saudi Arabia -1144MT and Iraq -999 MT in July-2019.***
- ***Pea export from Russia decreased to 28836MT in June against 56283 MT in May-2019.Total export during calendar year was registered at 2.04 lakh MT, down by 62% from last year. Turkey purchased 8,571 Pakistan MT,8,554 MT, followed by India at 3,107 MT in June.***
- ***As per the latest updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia declined in July to 16632MT against 25805 MT in June-2019. It is almost 36% down from June. Total export till July was recorded at 275,049 MT, massively down from 671,642 during the last marketing year. Pakistan, B,desh and UAE purchased 4,474 MT,4,403 MT & 2,455 MT. respectively in July-2019.***

Previous Update:

- ***Dry peas production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year. The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 cropyear. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT .Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US.Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.***
- ***Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to259,863 MT(till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year.B,desh brought 8,463 MT in June .followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased4,991 MT in June.***
- ***Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % tp 203983 MT in 2019.It was 199628 MT in 2018.Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018.All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018.Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019.It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.***
- ***Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT . Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT,similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.***

- *Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20 while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.*

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
