

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- ***No extension for urad import time line has been given and major loss in Sep due to rains may remain supportive to cash urad market. Govt /procurement agencies would not be able to procure as prices are ruling much higher than MSP of Rs5700 for the season. Even quota for import has not been increased and it is still at 1.5 lakh MT for the whole year. As demand at higher level has decreased, price have decreased almost by Rs 1000 in last two days. However, further downward trend is unlikely as there is a short supply in cash market. Once demand starts improving it may move up again. Right now in Chennai market urad is being traded at Rs 8100-8200. It may move up by Rs500 again.***
- ***Tur market is expected to improve once new imported crop sold out. At least one lakh MT is at various ports and 50,000MT is expected to reach port before 15th Nov-2019. After this no import is possible. Besides, procurement would start from 15th Dec and it would help market to move up again. Tur may touch 5800-6200 in Dec end.***
- ***It seems that India is bound to loose self-sufficiency status in pulses achieved during last two years in 2020. Kharif crops have damaged while weather condition for rabi pulses too is not favorable. If rains continue in Nov-Dec, rabi pulses too be affected. This means our import volume would increase considerably in 2020. Govt has around 20/22 lakh MT pulses, but it would not meet the requirements if rabi pulses fails. Rabi sowing is already delayed by 15 days. It may push pulses price up in coming months.***
- ***Against normal expectation DGFT has extended time line only for 15 days for tur importers. Now tur importers can import till 15th Nov-2019. With this notification slight pressure on tur market was seen and it decreased slightly. However, price would move up again and it would not affect long term price outlook. In this short period fresh import is impossible. However, tur imported after 31st Oct and is at ports would be released. Besides, there is no extension for urad and moong import. It's a good decision. Govt.'s stand is right step to stop import at the time of new crop arrivals. It would help market to move up again.***

Previous Update:

- ***Masur imported from Canada and US from Tuticorin was found mixed with foreign matters. The custom officials from port declined to give clearance on the above ground. After request to Agriculture ministry for clearance by pulses import association it has issued order for clearance with some condition only for this consignment. This relaxation would be applicable on purchase bill till 24, October-2019 or before it. Some condition would be applicable too on it. These consignments have to go through cleaning at warehouse suggested by customs officials. It would be under official surveillance. It would be released after full satisfaction of the official. The cost incurred in this process would be borne by importers.***
- ***Punters and stockiest are active in cash urad market and sellers/importers have restricted selling sensing uptrend to continue due to heavy loss of kharif urad. Higher price may encourage govt. to increase import quota from 1.5 to 2.5 lakh MT soon. There is no seller of urad at ports. If quota is not increased and bulk selling from central pool is not started, urad may move further by Rs 500 per qtl more. Sensing uptrend in urad tur stockiest too have started restricting sale. Tur price too have increased by Rs 800-1000 in last two days. It may move further up by Rs500-700 more.***
- ***Stormy wind accompanied by rains and hailstorm may damage standing pulses crop in Rajasthan, Gujrat and Odisha. It may support pulses cash market if it continues. Fear of heavy rains fall is growing too in south Indian states. Tur urad and moong may move up further while sowing of chana may be delayed by 15 days.***
- ***Myanmar offers Urad FAQ at \$700 and SQ at \$800 per MT. It has moved up by \$30 in last few days. In INR term it comes to Rs 5198 & Rs 5914 per MT. New lemon tur is being offered at \$645 and old at \$600 per MT. Moong Padi Shwewa was quoted at \$975 per MT while Pakaku was offered at \$830 per MT. Anya Shwewa was offered at \$840 per MT. Chana kabuli was offered at \$650 per MT.***

Previous Update:

- **Moong too may continue to trade firm as Procurement by Nafed commences in Tamil Nadu, Telangana & Maharashtra.** It is likely to begin soon in M.P., Rajasthan and Gujarat. It has procured 25.75 MT in Tamil Nadu and 3285MT in Telangana. Nafed sold 470 MT moong in Rajasthan at Rs 6401 per qtl. It was sold in Gujarat at Rs 6285 per qtl. Nafed still has 95989.34 MT moong in its stock. Out of it rabi share is 18281.14 MT. As procurement is on moong may continue to trade firm despite new arrival in Rajasthan is yet to pick up. There is a short supply of quality moong. So stockiest should buy when it comes down by Rs 200-300 on arrival pressure. Poor quality of moong coming into mandis may check one way uptrend in coming weeks. Farmers are selling moong to private trades due to quality issue and set parameters for govt.'s purchase. Overall trend in moong market seems firm until procurements come to an end. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6000-6200.

International Market Update:

- **Canada, Australia and the USA have raised objections against India over ban on pulses import in WTO.** Actually India has restricted pulses import to support domestic price. They have questioned export import policies and higher quantity of procurement at MSP. India consumes 24 MMT pulses a year while production has crossed 25 MMT as per Govt. data. In last two years import decreased from 6 MMT to 1.5 to 2MMT a year. So import restriction is essential to provide better price for farmers. As moong and urad crops have been damaged in kharif season, shortfall can be compensated by increasing import quantity. There is a danger of losing case in WTO.
- **China imported 222739 MT peas in August, up by 144% from July when it was recorded at 91,214 MT** as per General Customs Administration of China. From Jan to Aug-2019 China imported total 10.85 lakh MT pea against 12.67 lakh MT last year till Aug-2018. In August Canada exported 2.18 lakh MT followed by France and UK.
- **Canada pea production is likely to be 30 % higher than last year. The latest estimate has pegged it at 47 lakh MT.** Even lentil production is likely to be higher by 20 % to 25 lakh MT. Chickpeas production would be up by 15% to 2.63 lakh MT this year. Dry beans production has been pegged at 3.56 lakh MT, up by 45 from last year.

Previous Update:

- **Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT, lentil production at 2.47 lakh MT, total chickpeas production has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT.** Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.
- **Pea export from Russia decreased to 28836 MT in June against 56283 MT in May-2019.** Total export during calendar year was registered at 2.04 lakh MT, down by 62% from last year. Turkey purchased 8,571 Pakistan MT, 8,554 MT, followed by India at 3,107 MT in June.
- **As per the latest updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia declined in July to 16632 MT against 25805 MT in June-2019.** It is almost 36% down from June. Total export till July was recorded at 275,049 MT, massively down from 671,642 during the last marketing year. Pakistan, B, desh and UAE purchased 4,474 MT, 4,403 MT & 2,455 MT. respectively in July-2019.
- **Dry pea production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year.** The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719 MT** as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % tp 203983 MT in 2019.** It was 199628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318

MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.

- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.
- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20** while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
