

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Weak demand for urad dal and eased supply side of imported urad with stay order forced domestic stockiest to liquidate stock at higher level. Increased intension to release stock before new crop in Andhra Pradesh starts hitting the markets. Millers in A.P. would prefer to buy local crop expected from Kurnool and East Godaveri regions by the first week of December. New crop arrival is delayed by 10 days due to bad weather condition in the region. Crop condition in Nellore and Guntur region is good and may hit market from the third week of Dec. After this new urad would hit market from Tamil Nadu. So millers in south India are waiting for new arrival and avoiding bulk buying at this point of time .As stock in market is coming down, urad is unlikely to decrease much. At peak arrival season it main extend its loss by Rs 300 to 400 from current level. With easing of new arrival pressure it may bound to recover again. Rabi sowing is already down by 4.5% Against normal area of 8.61 lakh ha for the whole season.
- Out of around 3 lakh MT procurement target from kharif moong Nafed has procured around 45291 MT moong so far. The highest procurement was registered in Rajasthan at 27513 MT. It has procured9875 MT in Telangana and 5477 MT in Karnataka. Various agencies have procured 1503 MT in Maharashtra. It has procured 603.05 MT in Haryana and 275.4 MT in AP. Tamil Nadu contributed only 43.5 MT so far. As arrival remains slow, procurement pace too is slow. Farmers are busy in Rabi crop sowing so arrival is expected to increase in coming weeks. Bad weather condition too is hampering sowing as well as procurement pace.

Previous Update:

- New tur arrival begins in U.P in smaller quantity and was traded at Rs 5500 in local market. Moisture level in the new crop is high. Tur traded under pressure due to lack of demand and growing expectation of release by Nafed. Pressure is expected by the end of Dec as maturity of standing crop has been delayed by 15 days due to rains in growing regions. Steady to slightly weak tone may prevail.
- Rabi pulses sowing area is lagging behind by 19.28 % to 71.25 lakh ha as on 22nd November'19. Chana area was registered at 48.35 against 61.91 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 8.44 against 10.13 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 5.53 against 5.88 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 1.87 against 1.96 and 0.65 against 0.62 lakh ha respectively. Sowing is lagging behind slightly due to unfavorable weather conditions in Nov. so far
- Unseasonal rains in Karnataka and south India may delay harvesting of tur crop by 15teen days. Pressure continues on tur market due to higher volume of import in mid Nov. New crop is hardly one month away. So stockiest too are intending to release stock before mid Dec. So ,any spike in tur market is unlikely. It may recover if demand improves. Nafed still has 8 lakh MT tur in its stock. Crop condition is good as of now. However, if rains continues for next two weeks, it may damage quality of matured crop. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs5600-5700 per qtl.It may come down to Rs5500-5600.
- Pressure on urad market too continues as old stock is being released by private trades. Demand in retail market remains slackened. Recovery is expected once again as arrival is lower by 60 % from kharif crop. Import remains restricted. Rabi sowing has picked up pace now and there is good sowing conditions in urad growing states. Area coverage is expected to be slightly higher due to higher prevailing price. In south Indian market urad SQ is being traded at Rs 8250 & FAQ at Rs 7400. It may decrease by Rs 200-300 more from current level.
- Moong procurement is on and it remains supportive to moong market. However, millers are unwilling to buy at higher level as they have fears that govt would release stock below MSP in the first quarter of new year. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6600-6800 per qtl. In south Indian market it traded at Rs 6400-6800 per qtl. Steady tone may prevail in moong market.
- Masur imported from Canada and US from Tuticorin was found mixed with foreign matters. The custom officials from port declined to give clearance on the above ground. After request to Agriculture ministry for clearance by pulses import association it has issued order for clearance with some condition only for this consignment. This relaxation would be applicable on purchase bill till 24, October-2019 or before it. Some condition would be

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applicable too on it. These consignments have to go through cleaning at warehouse suggested by customs officials. It would be under official surveillance. It would be released after full satisfaction of the official. The cost incurred in this process would be borne by importers.

International Market Update:

- Canada, Australia and the USA have raised objections against India over ban on pulses import in WTO. Actually India has restricted pulses import to support domestic price. They have questioned export import policies and higher quantity of procurement at MSP. India consumes 24 MMT pulses a year while production has crossed 25 MMT as per Govt. data. In last two years import decreased from 6 MMT to 1.5 to 2MMT a year. So import restriction is essential to provide better price for farmers. As moong and urad crops have been damaged in kharif season, shortfall can be compensated by increasing import quantity. There is a danger of losing case in WTO.
- China imported 222739 MT peas in August, up by 144% from July when it was recorded at 91,214 MT as per General Customs Administration of China. From Jan to Aug-2019 China imported total10.85 lakh MT pea against12.67 lakhMT last year till Aug-2018. In August Canada exported 2.18 lakh MT followed by France and UK.
- Canada pea production is likely to be 30 % higher than last year. The lattest estimate has pegged it at 47 lakh MT. Even lentil production is likely to be higher by 20 % to 25 lakh MT. Chickpeas production would be up by 15% to 2.63 lakh MT this year Dry beans production has been pegged at 3.56blakh MT, up by 45 from last year.
- Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT, lentil production at 2.47lakh MT, total chickpeas production has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT. Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.
- Pea export from Russia decreased to 28836MT in June against 56283 MT in May-2019. Total export during calendar year was registered at 2.04 lakh MT, down by 62% from last year. Turkey purchased 8,571 Pakistan MT,8,554 MT, followed by India at 3,107 MT in June.
- As per the latest updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia declined in July to 16632MT against 25805 MT in June-2019. It is almost 36% down from June. Total export till July was recorded at 275,049 MT, massively down from 671,642 during the last marketing year. Pakistan, B,desh and UAE purchased 4,474 MT,4,403 MT & 2,455 MT. respectively in July-2019.
- Dry pea production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison tolast year. The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 cropyear. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT .Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to259,863 MT(till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B,desh brought 8,463 MT in June ,followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased4,991 MT in June.
- Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % tp 203983 MT in 2019.It was 199628 MT in 2018.Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018.All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018.Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019.It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.
- Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT,similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
