

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- ***Tur market traded under pressure with commencement of new arrivals in UP and MP and higher import flow during Oct to 15th Nov-2019. Besides, 65,000 MT has been imported through G2G basis out of 1.75 lakh MT. The rest will continue to come at regular intervals. Crop conditions in various states have improved and there is ample stock (7.5 to 8 lakh MT) in central pool. So, market is unlikely to move up until procurement starts. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs 5400-5450. It may come down by Rs 200 more from current level. Moisture content is high in new arrival. Recent rains may delay harvesting by a couple of weeks.***
- ***As prices of Urad are ruling much above MSP (Rs5700), Nafed is unable to procure urad at various centers. As of now only 7.15 MT has been procured at MSP. Out of total procured quantity Tamil Nadu has contributed 6.85 MT so far while in Maharashtra Markfed has been able to procure only 3 qtl. Procurement quantity would remain at lower level as prices in open market is higher. Private trades are active. Govt may try to compensate crop loss in kharif season by instructing Nafed to offload 1lakh MT crop in cash market. Even QR can be enhanced to cool down price.***
- ***Nafed may start chana selling in bulk volume and it may affect chana cash market in coming weeks. It has planned to sell 9.83 lakh MT in Dec and Jan. As quantity is higher so, bid acceptance level has potential to drive cash market up and down. If it accepts bid around Rs4400, cash market may improve, otherwise it will decrease. As offered quantity is higher, any uptrend is unlikely in chana cash market.***

Previous Update:

- ***Rabi pulses sowing area is lagging behind by 10.01 % to 89.23 lakh ha as on 29th November'19. Chana area was registered at 61.59 against 68.40 lakh ha last year till date. It is lower by 9.95% so far. Masur area was registered at 10.29 against 11.88 lakh ha, down by 13.38%. Peas area was recorded at 6.38 against 6.68 lakh ha, down by 4.40 %. However, urad and moong area was recorded at 2.70 against 2.38 and 0.79 against 0.78 lakh ha respectively. Sowing is lagging behind slightly due to unfavorable weather conditions in Nov. so far. As weather has opened up now, sowing pace is likely to increase in coming weeks.***
- ***Govt agencies have procured 49369.72 MT moong on MSP till 26th Nov-2019. Out of total procurement Rajasthan has contributed 35242.63 MT, Telangana-5875MT, Karnataka-5515 MT, Maharashtra -1695 MT, Haryana-670 Tt, AP-326 MT, AP-326MT and Tamil Nadu -46 MT. Procurement pace has improved with opening of weather in various states.***
- ***Weak demand for urad dal and eased supply side of imported urad with stay order forced domestic stockiest to liquidate stock at higher level. Increased intension to release stock before new crop in Andhra Pradesh starts hitting the markets. Millers in A.P. would prefer to buy local crop expected from Kurnool and East Godavari regions by the first week of December. New crop arrival is delayed by 10 days due to bad weather condition in the region. Crop condition in Nellore and Guntur region is good and may hit market from the third week of Dec. After this new urad would hit market from Tamil Nadu. So millers in south India are waiting for new arrival and avoiding bulk buying at this point of time. As stock in market is coming down, urad is unlikely to decrease much. At peak arrival season it may extend its loss by Rs 300 to 400 from current level. With easing of new arrival pressure it may bound to recover again. Rabi sowing is already down by 4.5% against normal area of 8.61 lakh ha for the whole season.***
- ***Moong procurement is on and it remains supportive to moong market. However, millers are unwilling to buy at higher level as they have fears that govt would release stock below MSP in the first quarter of new year. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6600-6800 per qtl. In south Indian market it traded at Rs 6400-6800 per qtl. Steady tone may prevail in moong market.***
- ***Masur imported from Canada and US from Tuticorin was found mixed with foreign matters. The custom officials from port declined to give clearance on the above ground. After request to Agriculture ministry for clearance by pulses import association it has issued order for clearance with some condition only for this consignment. This relaxation would be applicable on purchase bill till 24, October-2019 or before it. Some condition would be***

applicable too on it. These consignments have to go through cleaning at warehouse suggested by customs officials. It would be under official surveillance. It would be released after full satisfaction of the official. The cost incurred in this process would be borne by importers.

International Market Update:

- ***As per Canadian Grain Commission Canada has exported 25,500 MT lentils during 18th to 24th Nov-2019. With this total export quantity in the season to date reached at 247,900 MT against 140,600 MT last season till Nov-2018. Out of total export No-2 Canada lentils contributed 85% while 15% were of other grades. Farmers have delivered 40,600 MT last week. Season to date deliveries now total 534,400 MT, compared to 504,100 during the same period last season.***
- ***Improved export movement helped to continued firm tone this week too despite higher supply from farmers end and higher stock too from last year. till 18th Nov-2019, growers had delivered 32% of all peas available on their farms to the bulk handling system, compared to 29% by the same time last year as per market source.***
- ***There was no major movement in global chickpeas market and it stayed almost steady last week. Harvesting of chickpeas is almost complete now. Farmers in Saskatchewan managed to harvest 93% of the crop. The rest crop is said to be of green seeds. Farmers are engaged to seek potential buyers for feed products. If remaining stockiest not harvested soon, it may reduce crop size from 2.6 to 2.46 lakh MT. The large portion of it may be directed to feed industry.***
- ***Canada pea production is likely to be 30 % higher than last year. The latest estimate has pegged it at 47 lakh MT. Even lentil production is likely to be higher by 20 % to 25 lakh MT. Chickpeas production would be up by 15% to 2.63 lakh MT this year. Dry beans production has been pegged at 3.56 lakh MT, up by 45 from last year.***
- ***Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT, lentil production at 2.47 lakh MT, total chickpeas production has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT. Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.***
- ***As per the latest updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia declined in July to 16632 MT against 25805 MT in June-2019. It is almost 36% down from June. Total export till July was recorded at 275,049 MT, massively down from 671,642 during the last marketing year. Pakistan, B, desh and UAE purchased 4,474 MT, 4,403 MT & 2,455 MT. respectively in July-2019.***
- ***Dry pea production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year. The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.***
- ***Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719 MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.***
- ***Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % to 203983 MT in 2019. It was 199628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.***
- ***Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.***

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
