

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Improvement in tur crop condition and weak demand remains unsupportive for tur market.** Pressure is likely to build up by the end of this month. So any jump from current level is unlikely until procurement starts. Govt.'s agencies are gearing up for procurement and it may start from Jan-2020. As quantity of procurement has been fixed at 5,45,573 MT, it may support cash market to some extent. Import through private channel is not allowed at this point of time, so recovery is expected next month. In Gulberga market tur may continue to trade at Rs5350-5450. Prices are lower as moisture level in new crop is higher at this point of time.
- **As per market sources Jaipur high court has extended the date of hearing of pulses import from 16th to 19th Dec-2019.** It hints that clearing of urad at ports would depend on DGFT. It may support urad market to some extent in cash market. Millers have restricted buying at higher level and demand remains sluggish. As imported quantity volume is lower, it would not go to impact price much. Price movement would depend on demand from retailers and millers. Govt.'s authority is still undecided over additional import quota
- **Indian farmers have covered 119.16 lakh ha area under pulses against 120.91 lakh ha last year as on 13 Dec-2019.** Normal area under rabi pulses is 146 lakh ha. Area under gram is up by 0.16 % to 80.63 lakh ha against 80.50 lakh ha last year. Lentils area was recorded at 13.75 lakh ha against 14.8 lakh ha last year till date. Normal area under lentils is 14.19 lakh ha. However, peas area is up by 6.41 % to 8.30 lakh ha against 7.80 lakh ha last year. Normal area under peas is 9.45 lakh ha. Area under urad is up by 1.89 % to 4.32 lakh ha against 4.24 lakh ha. Normal area under urad is 8.61 lakh ha. Moong area was registered at 1.44 lakh ha as on 13 th Dec-2019. Normal area under rabi moong is 10.10 lakh ha.
- **Procurement agencies have procured 96,731.36 MT moong in various states so far.** Procurement in Haryana has ended now at 1065.9 MT. It is on in states like Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Rajasthan and AP. The highest contributor is Rajasthan where 80,281.23 MT moong has been procured. Telangana and Karnataka have contributed 5874 MT each so far. Procurement in Maharashtra was recorded at 2843.72 lakh MT. AP has contributed only 741.85 MT so far.
- **Govt has fixed pulses procurement target during Oct-Sep-2019-20 at 1125777 MT.** Out of total moong target has been fixed at 344654 MT, urad at 235550 MT and tur at 545573 MT. Nafed and other agencies have procured 82006.69 MT moong so far. The highest contributor is Rajasthan where 66151.17 MT moong has been procured. Second and the third highest contributors are Kar and Telangana where 5874 MT has been procured so far. As arrival remains slow, procurement pace too is slower.

Previous Update:

- **Chana recovered slightly as area is still lagging and Nafed has yet to decide at which price it would accept chana bids for bulk sale.** Now three months is left and if it sells 9 lakh MT in next three months, supply side would remain at ease. So any spike in chana market is unlikely at this point of time. It may continue to trade in the range of Rs 4400-4650 in December under prevailing condition.
- **Urad cash market lends support due to non-clearance of imported stock at ports like Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai.** Stockiest too restricted selling. Demand is normal. Prices may move further up if Nafed delays release of urad from central pool stock. Nafed has around 2 lakh MT stock and may restrict uptrend by releasing it. Kharif crop size is lower by 30 to 35%. However, rabi sowing is on right track. Quota of import might be increased if prices continue to move up.
- **Moong procurement is on and it remains supportive to moong market.** However, millers are unwilling to buy at higher level as they have fears that govt would release stock below MSP in the first quarter of new year. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6600-6800 per qtl. In south Indian market it traded at Rs 6400-6800 per qtl. Steady tone may prevail in moong market.

International Market Update:

- **Turkey import volume for lentils from Canada improved in the month of Oct-2019.** It has imported 25211 MT from Canada, 20440 Mt from Kazakhstan and 1627 MT from Russia. Total import by Turkey in Oct was registered at 48783 MT. Total import for Turkey touched at 274,328 MT in this calendar year. It is down by 7% from last year till Oct-2019.
- **Despite lower export volume for lentils from Canada in Oct overall export volume from Canada** increased by 14% to 518,626 MYT during ongoing MY. In Oct Canada exported total 131,325 MT, down from 272,705 MT in Sep. India purchased 32240 MT from Canada in Oct besides other sources. For Nov Indian import volume is likely to increase as prices in domestic market have started increasing.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission Canada has exported 25,500 MT lentils during 18th to 24th Nov-2019.** With this total export quantity in the season to date reached at 247,900 MT against 140,600 MT last season till Nov-2018. Out of total export No-2 Canada lentils contributed 85% while 15% were of other grades. Farmers have delivered 40,600 MT last week. Season to date deliveries now total 534,400 MT, compared to 504,100 during the same period last season.
- **Improved export movement helped to continued firm tone this week too despite higher supply** from farmers end and higher stock too from last year. till 18th Nov-2019, growers had delivered 32% of all peas available on their farms to the bulk handling system, compared to 29% by the same time last year as per market source.
- **Canada pea production is likely to be 30 % higher than last year. The latest estimate** has pegged it at 47 lakh MT. Even lentil production is likely to be higher by 20 % to 25 lakh MT. Chickpeas production would be up by 15% to 2.63 lakh MT this year. Dry beans production has been pegged at 3.56 lakh MT, up by 45 from last year.
- **Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT, lentil production at 2.47 lakh MT, total chickpeas production** has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT. Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.
- **As per the latest updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia** declined in July to 16632 MT against 25805 MT in June-2019. It is almost 36% down from June. Total export till July was recorded at 275,049 MT, massively down from 671,642 during the last marketing year. Pakistan, B, desh and UAE purchased 4,474 MT, 4,403 MT & 2,455 MT. respectively in July-2019.
- **Dry pea production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year.** The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when** it was registered at 24719 MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June, followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % to 203983 MT in 2019.** It was 199628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.
- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
