

## **Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**

### **Today's Update:**

- **Indian farmers have covered 131.46 lakh ha , up by 0.6% from last year(131.38 lakh ha).**Farmers have covered 2.97 % higher area under chana to 89.28lakh ha against 86.70 lakh ha. Lentils area is down by 7.26 % to 14.49 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 15.62 lakh ha last year. Peas area has been reported at 8.73 lakh ha against 8.50 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 5.01 lakh ha, down by 4.48 % from last year. Moong area is running down by 29.38% to 1.83 lakh ha. Normal area under moong is 10.10lakh ha. Kulthi, Lythyrus and other rabi pulses area too is running down by 0.99,7.87%and 6.84% so far. Only chana and peas area has been reported up.
- **Clearing all gossips over urad import quota running into the market the DGFT has issued notification of increasing import quota from 1.5 lakh MT to 4.0 lakh MT for a year.** Almost 1.5lakh MT has already been imported and 1.5 to 2 lakh MT is expected now in Jan., Feb and Mar-2020.Immediate import is not possible. It would take atleast one month time from registration to striking deal and shipping it into India. However, this decision would impact urad cash market and stockiest may prefer to offload stock now. Cash market has already decreased by Rs300 and it would decrease further by 300-400 per qtl.in coming weeks. At higher level demand for dal is weak right now. Availability of green vegetable is higher. So pressure may continue to urad market. Urad in Mumbai market traded at Rs 7000-7100 and may decrease to Rs 6500-6600.In Chennai market it is being offered at Rs 7500and SQ at Rs8050 per qtl.
- **Central govt has allocated 8.47 lakh MT pulses on subsidized rates to various states.** Under this allocation 3.2lakhMT tur,2 lakh MT urad,1.2 lakh MT chana,1.5 lakh MT mung and 0.57 lakh MT masur have been offered. It may have a cooling impact of cash pulses market.

### **Previous Update:**

- **Chana market recovered on mills fresh buying interest and traded at Rs 4400-4500 in Delhi market.** Uptrend is unlikely to continue as area coverage is increasing and weather remains favorable for the crop. Besides, Nafed has to sell 6 lakh MT in Jan and Feb.It would not allow market to move beyond rs4600-4700. At this level private trades too would offload their stock as new crop would start hitting the market by end Feb.
- **Central govt has allowed procurement agencies to procure 11.20 lakh MT pulses from Oct to Sep (2019-20).**Two agencies Nafed and FCI have been authorized to take on procurement. Besides, some state agencies too would be involved at local level. FCI would procure 30,000 MT moong and 24000 MT uradin Maharashtra. FCI would procure pulses in limited quantity in Karnataka, MP,AP and Gujarat too. Out of total procurement target for moong is 344654 MT, for urad 235550MT and for tur 545573 MT. In it chana has not been included. Karnataka govt. is considering additional bonus on tur procurement this season.
- **New tur arrival in Yadgir started and around 950 bags was reported.** As moisture level is higher in new crop ranging from 14 to 22%,rates quoted for it Rs 5200/5511 per qtl. With opening of weather quality of crop is likely to improve by next week. Tur traded firm in Amravati. Cloudy weather and rains may affect matured crop to some extent. Demand is good and some support is expected at current level. Besides, procurement drive in new year to support tur market. In December price is expected to be in the range of Rs 5100-5700, depending on quality and moisture level in the crop.
- **Tur procurement in Karnataka is likely to start from 1st jan-2020 at MSP of Rs5850 per qtl.** State govt may offer bonus of Rs350 to 425 per qtl. It is still under consideration. If bonus is offered over and above MSP, farmers would get Rs6200 per qtl.In Maharashtra FCI would remain active and would procure around 30,000 MT this season. Govt has fixed tur procurement target at 5,45,573MT.Karnataka govt hasd paid a bonus of rs 425 per qtl last year and procured 2.28 lakh MT.MSP for tur last year was rs5675 per qtl.
- **Chana recovered slightly as area is still lagging and Nafed has yet to decide at which price it would accept chana bids for bulk sale.** Now three months is left and if it sells 9 lakh MT in next three months, supply side would remain at ease. So any spike in chana market is unlikely at this point of time. It may continue to trade in the range of Rs 4400-4650in December under prevailing condition.

- **Moong procurement is on and it remains supportive to moong market. However, millers are unwilling to buy at higher level as they have fears that govt would release stock below MSP in the first quarter of newyear. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6600-6800 per qtl. In south Indian market it traded at Rs 6400-6800 per qtl. Steady tone may prevail in moong market.**

#### **International Market Update:**

- **Peas export from France increased to 25750 MT in Oct-2019. It is higher by 3550 MT from Sep. France had exported 22200 MT in Sept-2019. Export increased despite India being out of global market due to quantity restriction.**
- **Demand for peas improved from China. It has helped peas price to improve further. It would push up import parity in India too. Peas production in Canada declined during last two years. However, This year production is up by 18% from last year to 42 lakh MT. Peas import volume in China is expected to cross 18 lakh MT this season. Cattle feed industry is using pea in bulk volume while in India is used for human consumption.**
- **Turkey import volume for lentils from Canada improved in the month of Oct-2019. It has imported 25211 MT from Canada, 20440 Mt from Kazakhstan and 1627 MT from Russia. Total import by Turkey in Oct was registered at 48783 MT. Total import for Turkey touched at 274,328 MT in this calendar year. It is down by 7% from last year till Oct-2019.**
- **Despite lower export volume for lentils from Canada in Oct overall export volume from Canada increased by 14% to 518,626 MYT during ongoing MY. In Oct Canada exported total 131,325 MT, down from 272,705 MT in Sep. India purchased 32240 MT from Canada in Oct besides other sources. For Nov Indian import volume is likely to increase as prices in domestic market have started increasing.**
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission Canada has exported 25,500 MT lentils during 18th to 24th Nov-2019. With this total export quantity in the season to date reached at 247,900 MT against 140,600 MT last season till Nov-2018. Out of total export No-2 Canada lentils contributed 85% while 15% were of other grades. Farmers have delivered 40,600 MT last week. Season to date deliveries now total 534,400 MT, compared to 504,100 during the same period last season.**
- **Improved export movement helped to continued firm tone this week too despite higher supply from farmers end and higher stock too from last year. till 18th Nov-2019, growers had delivered 32% of all peas available on their farms to the bulk handling system, compared to 29% by the same time last year as per market source.**
- **Canada pea production is likely to be 30 % higher than last year. The latest estimate has pegged it at 47 lakh MT. Even lentil production is likely to be higher by 20 % to 25 lakh MT. Chickpeas production would be up by 15% to 2.63 lakh MT this year Dry beans production has been pegged at 3.56 lakh MT, up by 45 from last year.**
- **Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT, lentil production at 2.47 lakh MT, total chickpeas production has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT. Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.**
- **Dry pea production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year. The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.**
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719 MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.**
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % to 203983 MT in 2019. It was 199628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318**

MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.

- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT. Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
