

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Indian farmers have covered 140.13 lakh ha , up by 2.42% from last year(136.82 lakh ha).** Farmers have covered 5.64 % higher area under chana to 94.96lakh ha against 89.89 lakh ha. Last year as on 27th Dec-2019. Lentils area is down by 4.53 % to 15.18 lakh ha. Farmers had covered 15.90 lakh ha last year. Peas area has been reported at 9.08 lakh ha against 8.81 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 5.70 lakh ha under urad, down by 2.23 % from last year. Moong area is running down by 16.67% to 2.55 lakh ha. Normal area under moong is 10.10lakh ha. Kulthi, Lythyrus and other rabi pulses area too is running down by 2.67,5.57 %and 6.31% so far. Only chana and peas area has been reported up. Overall rabi area is up so far.
- **Indian importers imported total 2.83 lakh MT pulses in Nov-2019.**out of total yellow peas quantity was 74401.71 MT. Green peas quantity was 6384.57 MT. In Nov India imported 49685.34 MT. Urad import was registered at 43978.87 MT. Tur import was registered at 42195.15 MT in Nov-2019. Moong ,Kidney bean and green peas import was limited.
- **New crop of tur has started trickling in in markets of Karnataka & Maharashtra and pressure is likely to build from the second week of January.** Moisture level in new crop is higher and is expected to decrease from mid –Jan. There is no import at this point of time. Higher arrival may pressurize tur market to a certain extent. However, with procurement drive expected from first week of Jan may support market at lower level. Import license would be issued from April-2020 and it would continue till May. So, crop from Myanmar is expected in June. Quota for tur import for private trade is 4 lakh MT, besides, G2G basis import would continue. So any major spike is unlikely. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs 5400-5450. In Jan market is likely to trade in the range of Rs 5200-5700. Govt has fixed tur procurement target at 545573 MT.

Previous Update:

- **Lentils cash market traded up taking clue from firm international market and 7.26% lower area coverage in local market.** Farmers in India have covered 11.49 lakh ha against 15.62 lakh ha last year so far. With improving demand in domestic market and restricted selling by local stockiest have started pushing up cash market price. It may move further towards MSP level as new crop is still two months away from now. Even importers have started quoting higher price at ports. Govt. has not changed its import policy and import would continue at 30 % (applicable 33%) import duty. As B, desh, Pakistan and Nepal are buying aggressively amid active buying by Indian importers, lentils price in global market is bound to go up. It would lend support domestic market too.
- **Restriction continues on peas import at 1.5 lakh MT and import is possible now only through Kolkata port.** So prices of peas moved up and it supported chana market too. New crop is almost two and a half months away. Import volume is limited. So supply in the rest of the month is possible through central pool. Nafed has plan to sell 6 lakh MT chana during Jan and Feb. Consumption is expected to be 16 lakh MT by Feb end. Even private trades too would prefer to release their stock during the period. It is expected to be around 5 to 6 lakh MT. So total supply would be around 12 lakh MT, excluding reserve stock of 10 lakh MT held in central pool. It would support chana market to some extent in coming weeks. In Delhi market it may trade at Rs 4500-4700. Even futures too trades firm. It would not move beyond MSP as area is bound to cross 105 lakh ha this year as bumper crop seems very much on the card.
- **Chana market recovered on mills fresh buying interest and traded at Rs 4500-4550 in Delhi market.** Uptrend is unlikely to continue as area coverage is increasing and weather remains favorable for the crop. Besides, Nafed has to sell 6 lakh MT in Jan and Feb. It would not allow market to move beyond Rs 4650-4750. At this level private trades too would offload their stock as new crop would start hitting the market by end Feb.
- **Clearing all gossips over urad import quota running into the market the DGFT has issued notification of increasing import quota from 1.5 lakh MT to 4.0 lakh MT for a year.** Almost 1.5 lakh MT has already been imported

and 1.5 to 2 lakh MT is expected now in Jan., Feb and Mar-2020. Immediate import is not possible. It would take at least one month time from registration to striking deal and shipping it into India. However, this decision would impact urad cash market and stockiest may prefer to offload stock now. Cash market has already decreased by Rs300 and it would decrease further by 300-400 per qtl. in coming weeks. At higher level demand for dal is weak right now. Availability of green vegetable is higher. So pressure may continue to urad market. Urad in Mumbai market traded at Rs 7000-7100 and may decrease to Rs 6500-6600. In Chennai market it is being offered at Rs 7500 and SQ at Rs8050 per qtl.

- **Central govt has allocated 8.47 lakh MT pulses on subsidized rates to various states.** Under this allocation 3.2 lakh MT tur, 2 lakh MT urad, 1.2 lakh MT chana, 1.5 lakh MT mung and 0.57 lakh MT masur have been offered. It may have a cooling impact of cash pulses market.

International Market Update:

- **Peas export from France increased to 25750 MT in Oct-2019. It is higher by 3550 MT from Sep.** France had exported 22200 MT in Sept-2019. Export increased despite India being out of global market due to quantity restriction.
- **Demand for peas improved from China. It has helped peas price to improve further.** It would push up import parity in India too. Peas production in Canada declined during last two years. However, This year production is up by 18% from last year to 42 lakh MT. Peas import volume in China is expected to cross 18 lakh MT this season. Cattle feed industry is using pea in bulk volume while in India it is used for human consumption.
- **Turkey import volume for lentils from Canada improved in the month of Oct-2019.** It has imported 25211 MT from Canada, 20440 MT from Kazakhstan and 1627 MT from Russia. Total import by Turkey in Oct was registered at 48783 MT. Total import for Turkey touched at 274,328 MT in this calendar year. It is down by 7% from last year till Oct-2019.
- **Despite lower export volume for lentils from Canada in Oct overall export volume from Canada increased by 14% to 518,626 MT during ongoing MY.** In Oct Canada exported total 131,325 MT, down from 272,705 MT in Sep. India purchased 32240 MT from Canada in Oct besides other sources. For Nov Indian import volume is likely to increase as prices in domestic market have started increasing.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission Canada has exported 25,500 MT lentils during 18th to 24th Nov-2019.** With this total export quantity in the season to date reached at 247,900 MT against 140,600 MT last season till Nov-2018. Out of total export No-2 Canada lentils contributed 85% while 15% were of other grades. Farmers have delivered 40,600 MT last week. Season to date deliveries now total 534,400 MT, compared to 504,100 during the same period last season.
- **Improved export movement helped to continued firm tone this week too despite higher supply from farmers end and higher stock too from last year.** till 18th Nov-2019, growers had delivered 32% of all peas available on their farms to the bulk handling system, compared to 29% by the same time last year as per market source.
- **Canada pea production is likely to be 30 % higher than last year. The latest estimate has pegged it at 47 lakh MT.** Even lentil production is likely to be higher by 20 % to 25 lakh MT. Chickpeas production would be up by 15% to 2.63 lakh MT this year. Dry beans production has been pegged at 3.56 lakh MT, up by 45 from last year.
- **Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT, lentil production at 2.47 lakh MT, total chickpeas production has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT.** Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.
- **Dry pea production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year.** The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 to 4.5 MMT. Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.

- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics. Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June , followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.**
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % to 203983 MT in 2019. It was 199628 MT in 2018. Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.**
- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92 lakh MT last year. However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT . Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.**

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
