

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- ***In major markets of Rajasthan Moong's fresh demand are normal whereas arrivals are decreasing. Unseasonal rain affecting the sowing time of Rabi Moong. Approx. 70% stock is already consumed in Bihar, U.P, M.P and Jharkhand and farmer already cleared their stock at high levels. So, According to Agriwatch expectations Moong prices may go up by Rs.300 to Rs.500 from current level. Already Moong price in Rajasthan is trading above the MSP.***
- ***Due to unseasonal rain harvesting activities are affected in major production like Karnataka and some parts of Maharashtra which is going to affect the arrival in local market. Weather it's not going to affect the quality if it's open in next 2 days. Procurement has started at MSP in Karnataka and Gujrat. 5.45 Lakh MT procurement target has fixed by Govt. Production is expected over 37 lakh MT due to good quality of crop. Nafed has 3209.26 MT tur in stock asides reserve stock. Import would not be allowed till 30 March 2020.***
- ***It is expected that tur prices is slightly up from current level in coming weeks. Nafed procured 447.30 MT tur in Telangana till 10th Jan-2019 at MSP at MSP of Rs.5800. Prevailing price in market is ruling. As arrival got affected due to recent rains, prices are likely to rule at current level. Demand remains weak as pressure from new crop is expected from last week of Jan-2020.***
- ***Bad weather condition may affect standing pulses crop and if it continues, damage for tur would increase. However, it is good for chana, urad and moong crops that are in vegetative stages. Next 10 days are very crucial for standing crops. Market stayed steady to slightly weak as demand support remains invisible for all pulses.***

Previous Update:

- ***Chana market could not sustain its higher level due to higher availability of stock with Nafed and private trades. Besides, area is unexpectedly higher this year and may cross 105 lakh ha. New crop is expected to hit market after mid Feb. So, supply of old crop is increasing while buyers are buying based of immediate needs. Nafed too would prefer to lighten burden of old stock,at least 6 lakh MT in next two months. Weather is favorable right now for standing crop.In normal condition production of chana may cross 95 lakh MT. Carryout is higher. So supply side seems at ease. From long time perspective weather condition in Jan and Feb would be crucial. If weather turns rough chana price may recover. Otherwise it would continue to rule in the range of Rs4300 to Rs 4500 in Delhi market. If Nafed starts accepting bids below 4100-4200, it would pressurize chana market further.***
- ***Indian farmers have covered 146.22 lakh ha , up by 2.42% from last year(142.22 lakh ha). Farmers have covered 5.72 % higher area under chana to 98.52lakh ha against 93.19 lakh ha. Last year as on 3rd Jan -2020. Lentils area is down by 4.33 % to 15.46 lakh ha. Farmers had covered 16.33 lakh ha last year. Peas area has been reported at 9.27 lakh ha against 9.08 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 6.42 lakh ha under urad, up by 4.22 % from last year. Moong area is running down by 9.32% to 3.31 lakh ha. Normal area under moong is 10.10lakh ha. Kulthi, Lythyrus and other rabi pulses area too is running down by 4.23, 2.27 and 5.07% so far. Only chana, urad and peas area has been reported up. Overall rabi area is up by 2.81% so far.***
- ***DGFT has issued circular no-38-2015-2020 regarding peas HS code (07131000) and removed it. Now it has been classified in three categories. For yellow peas new HS code is 07131010,for green peas it is -07131020 and for other peas it is 07131090.Now import would be possible under above code.***
- ***Demand for masur and masur dal has improved in recent weeks. Stockiest have restricted sale. It is lending support to cash masur market. Import pace remains slow and is not up to the normal expectation. At sowing front area coverage is 4.53% lower to 15.18 lakh ha so far. As it is last phase of sowing, any recovery is unlikely. Selling by stockiest is rather slow so price may move further up by Rs 200 from current level. Right now it is ruling above MSP and may cross Rs5000 soon. Gap between demand and supply is increasing. Imported masur in Mumbai is being traded at rs 4900-5000 while in Kanpur market it is being quoted at Rs5150-5200.In Katni region of MP it is being traded at Rs 5200.There is an expectation in the market that price may cross Rs5400 soon if demand continues at current level. At this level selling is expected by end Jan -Feb. Overall outlook remains firm.***

- **With changed status from the free to restricted category and hefty levy imposed on peas its import has halted completely now.** The commerce ministry issued a separate harmonized system (HS code) for all peas (including yellow, green dun and kaspa) and changed its status in the third week of Dec. It has affected importers badly whose consignment is on port or in way to India. Now import deals are not taking place. The fixed quota of 1.5 lakh MT has already been completed. Actually govt is trying to increase consumption of chana as it is abundantly available in domestic market. Importers have requested govt to allow green peas import as prices of green peas have increased to Rs 8500-8800 per qtl from 5600 per qtl a week ago. Against the quota of 1.5 lakh MT over 5.5 lakh MT has been imported so far. Under prevailing condition govt. is unlikely to allow green peas import. New crop in local market started hitting mandis now.
- **Central govt has allocated 8.47 lakh MT pulses on subsidized rates to various states.** Under this allocation 3.2 lakh MT tur, 2 lakh MT urad, 1.2 lakh MT chana, 1.5 lakh MT mung and 0.57 lakh MT masur have been offered. It may have a cooling impact of cash pulses market.

International Market Update:

- **Commerce ministry of Myanmar has changed exim policy.** All importers and exporters have to get registered till 31st Dec-2019. With this new changes importers and exporters would get new 9 digit digital taxation identification no from 5th Jan-2020. Without new registration no import and export would not be possible. It may delay shipment to some extent.
- **Peas export from France increased to 25750 MT in Oct-2019.** It is higher by 3550 MT from Sep. France had exported 22200 MT in Sep-2019. Export increased despite India being out of global market due to quantity restriction.
- **Demand for peas improved from China. It has helped peas price to improve further.** It would push up import parity in India too. Peas production in Canada declined during last two years. However, This year production is up by 18% from last year to 42 lakh MT. Peas import volume in China is expected to cross 18 lakh MT this season. Cattle feed industry is using pea in bulk volume while in India it is used for human consumption.
- **Turkey import volume for lentils from Canada improved in the month of Oct-2019.** It has imported 25211 MT from Canada, 20440 MT from Kazakhstan and 1627 MT from Russia. Total import by Turkey in Oct was registered at 48783 MT. Total import for Turkey touched at 274,328 MT in this calendar year. It is down by 7% from last year till Oct-2019.
- **Despite lower export volume for lentils from Canada in Oct overall export volume from Canada increased by 14% to 518,626 MT during ongoing MY.** In Oct Canada exported total 131,325 MT, down from 272,705 MT in Sep. India purchased 32240 MT from Canada in Oct besides other sources. For Nov Indian import volume is likely to increase as prices in domestic market have started increasing.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission Canada has exported 25,500 MT lentils during 18th to 24th Nov-2019.** With this total export quantity in the season to date reached at 247,900 MT against 140,600 MT last season till Nov-2018. Out of total export No-2 Canada lentils contributed 85% while 15% were of other grades. Farmers have delivered 40,600 MT last week. Season to date deliveries now total 534,400 MT, compared to 504,100 during the same period last season.
- **Improved export movement helped to continue firm tone this week too despite higher supply from farmers end and higher stock too from last year.** till 18th Nov-2019, growers had delivered 32% of all peas available on their farms to the bulk handling system, compared to 29% by the same time last year as per market source.
- **Canada pea production is likely to be 30 % higher than last year.** The latest estimate has pegged it at 47 lakh MT. Even lentil production is likely to be higher by 20 % to 25 lakh MT. Chickpeas production would be up by 15% to 2.63 lakh MT this year. Dry beans production has been pegged at 3.56 lakh MT, up by 45% from last year.
- **Dry peas production has been pegged at 856163 MT, lentil production at 2.47 lakh MT, total chickpeas production has been pegged at 1.79 lakh MT.** Total pulses production has been pegged at 12.82 lakh MT this year against 15 lakh MT last year. Due to rains generated issues yield has been down this year for all pulses in US.

- **Dry pea production in Canada is expected to increase by 20 % to 43 lakh MT in comparison to last year.** The reason is attributed to higher area coverage in 2019-20 crop year. The major growing state is Saskatchewan accounting 50 % in total production. Alberta is 2nd major growing state accounting 45% of total production. As carry in stock is lower supply side is expected to increase by only 55 tp 4.5 MMT .Export may decrease to 31 lakh MT. Top buyers might be China, Bangladesh and the US. Carry in stock would increase. Average price is expected to be similar as 2018-19.
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased by 10 % to 27251 MT in June against May when it was registered at 24719MT as per Australia Bureau of Statistics.** Thus total export in current MY reached to 259,863 MT (till June) against 646,411 MT in corresponding period last year. B, desh brought 8,463 MT in June ,followed by Pakistan at 8,064 MT. UAE purchased 4,991 MT in June.
- **Dry pea stock in US is likely to increase by 0.02 % tp 203983 MT in 2019. It was 199628 MT in 2018.** Even lentils stock is expected to be higher by 81% to 144,425 MT in 2019 against 79833 MT in 2018. All chickpeas stock is 294% higher to 157262 MT against 39916 MT in 2018. Out of total small chickpeas stock increase from 12156 to 43318 MT in 2019. It is higher by 256% from last year. Large chickpeas stock is expected to increase by 310% to 113,943 MT in 2019.
- **Lentils production in Canada is likely to increase by 5.16 % to 22 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20.92 lakh MT last year.** However, total supply would decrease by 3.14 % to 28.95 lakh MT due to higher domestic use pegged at almost 6 lakh MT . Carryout would decrease from 7 to 5 lakh MT in 2019-.20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh MT, similar as last year. Average yearly lentil price is expected to hover in the range of \$430 to 460 per MT.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
