

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**Today's Update:**

- ***The govt. has changed the import duty structure on Lentil from 11% to nil for Canada and Australia while for the USA it has been reduced to 11%.it would be valid now till 30th Sep-2022.*** Apart from this, the import of Moong has been placed from free to restricted list now from the immediate effect. Restricting Moong import is said to be a good decision and it may help local market to improve. NAFED has plenty of Moong stock and it was unable to sell it at market price. Import was pressurizing the cash market and the lower price could have discouraged farmers to maintain area during kharif season. Reduction in duty on Masur was expected as the price was not coming down in spite of the commencement of new arrivals in M.P.in limited quantity and higher area coverage this year.

Previous Update:.

- ***With renewed buying interest by mills in the North Indian markets Chana and Tur recovered by INR 50 to 100.Chana traded at INR 5075 to 5100 in Delhi market. It traded up by INR 50 in Madhya Pradesh to 4975-5000. New arrival in Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh has already commenced. Quality of new Chana in Barhsi market is normal to good. But grain size is smaller in comparison to last year. It may affect the final size of the crop in Barhsi region. Despite some improvement in price Chana may trade low once the arrival starts increasing. Arrival pressure is expected by the end of this month. Ample availability of old crop would not allow market to move up until and unless crop gets damaged in any one of major growing states.***
- ***Tur market recovered slightly on mills renewed buying interest in Delhi market. Maharashtra line Tur traded up by INR 6375-6400 while in Mumbai Lemon Tur traded at INR 6125-6150.The upward trend is unlikely to continue as availability of old stock is ample and Stuckists would continue to release old stock. Apart from it, import flow is likely to continue from Myanmar, Mozambique and Tanzania. Arusha and Matwara Tur in Mumbai is being sold at INR 5200-5250 per quintal. Desi Tur in Gulbarga market is being traded at INR 6200-6500.As demand is not good right now in the Central and South Indian markets, the overall sentiment remains weak.***
- ***As on 4th Feb-2022, All India Rabi pulses area was up marginally by 1.30 % to 168.27 lakh ha as good recovery was seen during the last few weeks for Lythyrus & Urad. Farmers have covered 114.95 lakh ha under Chana so far, up by 4.14 % from same time last year. Lentil area continues to recover and currently stands up by 4.73 % to 17.71 lakh ha against 16.91 lakh ha same time last year. Urad acreage has also recovered during the week and stood at 8.17 lakh ha, which is still lower by 1.92 % compared to 8.33 lakh ha same time previous year. Till Jan, the rabi Urad acreage was lagging that of previous year by 7.34 %. Moong acreage continues to lag the previous year's tally by 27.84 % to 4.77 lakh ha. Field pea acreage was down by 2.12 % from previous year, at 10.14 lakh ha. This is also an improvement from previous week's lag of 2.17 %. Overall acreages for Urad and Field Pea are likely to remain lower than previous year as sowing may continue only for 10-15 more days from now. Rabi Moong acreage is likely to recover to some extent as the sowing duration is longer as it includes summer sowing too..Farmers have covered 5.13 lakh ha against 7.03 lakh ha.***
- ***Chana cash market continued to reel under pressure in the Central and North Indian markets taking cue from higher area coverage this year. Farmers have sown 114.95 lakh ha as on 4th Feb-2022. New arrivals are expected soon in major markets of Maharashtra and South Indian states. Crop condition is good so far and***

pressure might be seen by the end of this month. As the availability is higher of old crop, pressure on price may continue and it may slip by Rs 200-400 from the current level.

- **Production size is expected to be around 105-108 lakh MT this year, higher by 8-10 LMT from last year. Import is also coming from the LDC countries and the stockists/NAFED too are releasing stock to vacate the space for the new crop.** Demand is normal. However, supply in the coming weeks is bound to increase. So, under the normal condition AgriWatch expects price to decrease by Rs 200-400, until the procurement starts for the central pool. The stake holders should wait at least for two-three weeks to get dry Chana. The impact of higher production prospects, ample availability of old stock, cheaper import are already visible on Chana market. Rajasthan and M.P. Chana in Delhi market has decreased by 2 % to Rs 4950 this week while in South Indian markets it declined by Rs100 to 5200. It declined in Jalgaon by Rs 100 to Rs 4700. The price may come down to 4600 to 4800, depending on quality by the beginning of March.
- **The pea cash market could not sustain its firm momentum and declined considerably just ahead of the new local crop. It declined by 6.15% to Rs 6100 in Kanpur market, 1.92% to Rs 5100 in Dabra market and 3.70% to Rs 7800 in Delhi market.** Prices of yellow peas are still higher as it is old imported stock. Prices of pea may move further down by 200-300 as stockists are willing to release stock before the new crop hits in the market. Farmers have covered 10.14 lakh ha this year so far, down by 2.11% from last year. They have shifted some peas area to other crops like Mustard, Wheat and Lentils in Uttar Pradesh, Assam and Bihar. As import of pea remains restricted, global price would not affect price movement much. Availability in global market would increase as Canada has increased production forecast for 2022-23 to 3.80 MMT from 2.25 MMT for 2021-22.
- **Urad cash market continued to trade under pressure despite 4.28 % lower Rabi area coverage so far and the eased supply side in domestic market.** The reasons behind it are mainly attributed to good availability in Myanmar (expected crop size at 6.5 lakh MT), extended import timeline by India till June-2022 from the previous deadline of March-2022. Arrival from the South Indian states is expected to start from the end Feb. The new crop from Myanmar too would hit India in March. So, the traders, stockists and mills are very cautious to go for bulk buying. All these factors are pushing price down. The price gap between the imported & local crops are contracting and price may settle and stable after a decline by 100-200 more. Demand is yet to pick up. This year the local production has been pegged at 22.91 lakh MT against 24.19 lakh MT last year. The import volume may increase to over 5.25 lakh MT against 3.20 last year during Aug to Jul (MY). The overall tone seems steady to slightly weak. Supply side would continue to ease.
- **Govt. would procure Chana & Masur at 5230 and 5500 per qtl from Rabi crop 2022-23. The CACP has already recommended to fix Rabi MSP and now the govt. has accepted it. Govt may face challenges to procure Masur this year as prices are ruling 1600-1700 above than MSP in the market.** Masur and Chana area has increased this year and good production size is expected under the normal weather condition. Weather conditions in Jan, Feb and Mar are crucial. Masur may continue to trade firm as the new crop is one and a half month away from now while the shipment pace is rather slow despite good availability around 1.95 lakh MT (including new and old) at various Indian ports. Masur in Mumbai and Kanpur markets is being traded at 7250 and 7700. It may move up further.
- **NAFED may procure around 8 lakh MT Tur this year.** Out of total, 2.71 lakh MT would be procured in Maharashtra while 2.5 lakh MT in Karnataka. The rest would be procured in other states. Right now, prices of Tur in various markets are ruling below MSP.

International Market Update:

- **Field Pea market in Canada trades rangebound and may trade firm as supply side seems weak against prospective demand.** Demand from China feed market is almost nil due to the higher prevailing prices, demand might emerge for human consumption and fractionation industry. Apart from it, food processors and packers of US may start rebuilding stock for winter season. It may lend support to pea market despite availability in the global market is likely to increase from 2022-23 crop.
- **Pulses exporter communities of Myanmar have urged the Indian Government to increase annual import quota for Tur and Urad by 100%.** Notably, Government of India had signed a memorandum of understanding with Myanmar to import 2.5 lakh MT urad and 1 lakh MT Tur on annual basis for 5 years FY 2026 through private channel. Now they have requested the volume to be doubled. The request regarding the doubling the annual quota has been communicated to Nidhi Khare, Additional Secretary, Department of Consumer Affairs. The Myanmar exporter's association fears that if the quotas are not increased to 500,000 tonne for urad and 200,000 tonne for tur by the Government of India, farmers may switch to other crops, that may lead to rise in prices of both the commodities in the local market.
- **Speaking on the Myanmar/India Urad status in the OATA Myanmar Panel Discussion, Mr. Hitesh Jain, Country Head, AGT Foods & Ingredients INC.,** hinted towards ample availability this year in Myanmar, based on higher production estimate there. According to Mr. Jain, production of Urad has been on the rise in Myanmar from 2019-20 and continued to increase till 2022. It increased to 6.3 lakh MT in 2020-21 from 5.5 lakh MT in 2019-20. This year it may increase to 6.8 lakh MT. Urad production in India is likely to decline 23.4 lakh MT in 2020-21 to 20.5 lakh MT in 2021-22. So, India would remain a major buyer for Urad from Myanmar. Taking advantage of G2G deal for 2.5 lakh MT import annually for the next 5 years, it may increase supply in India as the production prospect seems very good. Arrivals from the new crop is expected soon. As Production size in India is low this year, prices are unlikely to decline much from the current level. If Rabi crop in India suffers much due to weather aberration, prices of Urad may increase in the domestic market. Total global availability might be at 2019-20 level of 27.3 lakh MT in 2022.
- **The OATA Myanmar Panel Discussion on Tur and Urad gave some useful information regarding production, demand and price outlook for both the commodities on 07th Jan-2022.** As per Anant Chhajed, General Manager, Swiss Singapore overseas P(LTD), Myanmar, Tur opening stock continued to decline from 80,000 MT in 2020 to 70,000 MT in 2021. It declined further to 10,000 MT in 2022 in Myanmar. According to Anant Chhajed Production in Myanmar is expected to increase more than double to 2.5 lakh MT in 2022 from 1.1 lakh MT in 2021. Tur production in Myanmar in 2020 was registered at 1.75 lakh MT. At export front Myanmar had exported 1.85 lakh MT tur in 2020. It decreased to 1.70 lakh MT in 2021. However, this year export may increase to 2 lakh MT. At carryout stock front the season 2021 ended with 10,000 MT. It shows that supply side would remain tight in Myanmar this year too as India would remain a big buyer in 2022 too. Its impact on Indian Tur Price would be felt soon. Indian crop size too is below expectation if we see the latest new arrival pace in Karnataka & Maharashtra.
- **As per the latest data released by Australian Bureau of Statistics, Australia has exported 43,902 MT Lentils in Nov-2021, down by 11.02% from Oct, when 49,341 MT was exported.** Australia had exported 34,200 MT in Nov-2020. The major buyers were Bangladesh, Sri Lanka & India buying 15,720, 8,573 and 6,674 MT respectively. Notably, Australia has harvested a bumper crop this year.
- **As per the latest release by the Canadian Grain Commission, lentil export from Canada has decreased drastically to 49,00 MT only in Nov-2021 under licenced facility.** Notably, Canada had exported 1,14,100 MT

in Oct, while in Nov-2020 it had exported 64,200 MT. Container and labour issues amid the higher global price and buyers unwillingness to buy at higher cost restricted the volume to a great extent. Canada has exported total 3,23,400 MT in the ongoing MY against 4,78,000 MT last year same time. It is 32 % lower than what was exported same time in 2020-21.

- **Turkey Government extends zero import duty on Lentils through out the year to control the spiraling prices of dal and food inflation.** It is an unexpected move for the global market. Notably, Turkey imposes import duty on grains/food items ranging 19.3 to 130%, depending on the supply demand side of a commodity. If there is no extension on 1st Jan-2023, it would be come to formal level.
- **Agriculture Canada has revised down Field Pea production estimate by 10.65% to 22.58 lakh MT for 2021-22 in Dec against Nov-2021.** It was 25.27 lakh MT in Nov-2021. If we compare last year's production, it is down by 50.85%. Pea production in Canada in MY 2020-21 was 45.94 lakh MT. This means the availability of pea in 2022 would be 50 % low and it would keep the price up at the current level. Prices of Peas would continue to rule near \$580-600 throughout 2022. As import is not taking place for India due to restrictions, the price may be stable at the current level. As production has decreased, export volume from Canada too would decline by 8% to 21 lakh MT from Nov estimate and 41.34% from the actual of last year. If the Indian govt. allows import (unlikely), prices of other pulses, especially Chana may decrease further. Consumers in India have already moved to Chana as availability in the domestic market is higher and it is cheaper.
- **As per the latest update released by Agriculture & Agri Food Canada, Production estimate of Lentil for 2021-22 has been revised down by 10.88% to 16.06 lakh MT from Nov estimate of 18.02.** If we consider it from 2020-21 production, it is down by 44 %. Canada had produced 28.68 lakh MT last year. Total supply has come down by 9.24 % due to this latest revision. It has decreased to 20.72 from 22.83 lakh MT in Nov-2021. If we compare it from last year total supply has decreased by 35.04 %, when total supply was 31.90 lakh MT. At export front too availability has decreased by 10.52 % to 17 lakh MT, it was 19 lakh MT in Nov while 23.46 lakh MT in 2020-21. It hints that prices of Canadian Masur may move up again, if Australian suppliers restrict their sale at the current prevailing prices, sensing the decreasing availability in the global market throughout the first half of 2022.
- **The harvesting of pulses winter crop in Australia is running smoothly and is helping in meeting the strong demand in the global market despite the low availability of containers.** As per the latest updates by Pulses Australia, the prospect for export from Australia is very good because of low production in Canada this year. The production estimates for the Australian pulses has been published. As per the latest estimates Australian would harvest 8.44 lakh MT Chickpeas in 2021-22 (Abares estimate) while Pulses Australia sees it at 8.70 lakh MT. The 10 years production average is 7.89 lakh MT. Chickpeas availability in the global market would increase and it may ensure stability in price in the global market.
