**Domestic Market Fundamentals:**

- **Chana traded weak during the review months and pressure continued to build up from increasing arrivals in MP and Rajasthan.** However, hike in import tariff from 40% to 60 % at Feb end has helped market to recover once again. Actually, higher duty would restrict import at a negligible level even in the second half of the year and restrict declining prices to a great extent. Agriwatch expects market to stabilize near current level. Private buyers are buying with their immediate demands at hand. Stake holders should buy on dip.
- **Farmers have restricted selling having hope that govt 's agencies would be active to procure chana.** However, it remains to be seen how much quantity is brought by agencies on MSP, as Chana is the largest crop in pulses segment, produced in India. Private buyers would prefer to wait for impact of duty hike. Chana production estimate by govt. has been revised up from the target of 9.75 MMT to 11.1 MMT for 2017-18 in the 2nd adv estimate, released on 27th Feb-2018. For 2016-17 final chana production estimate has been pegged at 9.38 MMT.
- **As expected last week demand for Tur dal decreased and stockists resorted to release old stock at higher level.** Besides, procurement pace got slowed down last week, Its impact was seen on cash market price. Tur prices in various markets decreased by around Rs200 per qtl. It is being traded at Rs 3900 to Rs 4300 per qtl in various market. As demand is weak, market is expected to stay steady this week. Ongoing procurement drive may restrict market to move down further. Overall tone remains firm in the medium term.
- **The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved** the regularisation and extension of Government Guarantee provided to lender bank for providing credit limit to National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India (NAFED) Rs 19,000 crore from earlier Rs 9,500 crore for undertaking procurement operation of pulses and oilseeds under Price Support Scheme (PSS). These Government Guarantees are valid for a period of five years, till 2021-22.
- **Govt. has revised Tur production estimate slightly up from 3.99 MMT to 4.02 MMT in second adv.** estimate releasd on 27.02.2018 against set target of 4.25 MMT for 2017-18. Govt has released final production fig for last year at 4.87 MMT.
- **Urad kharif and rabi production estimate has been pegged higher at 3.23 MMT against production target of 2.6 MMT in the second adv estimate released on 27th Feb-2018.** For 2016-17 final production fig for rabi and kharif has been pegged at 2.84 MMT. Kharif Urad production has been pegged at 2.6 MMT against target of 1.85 MMT while rabi production has been pegged at 0.63 MMT against target of 0.75 MMT. Urad could not sustain its firmness due to weak demand and active selling by private stockists at higher level. Besides, state agencies remain active to sell old stock taking advantage of higher prices. So steady to weak tone may prevail in cash Urad market in March too.
- **As expected moong market traded lower despite govt's attempts to arrest declining prices through increasing bank limit for Nafed,** provision in budget to ensure 1.5 times production cost for farmers. Higher rabi crop size in Odisha and huge inventory continue to pressurize moong cash market. Acreage in Odisha has increased from 5.17 to 5.86 lakh ha this year. At national level area under rabi Moong increased from 7.34 to 8.31 lakh ha this year. Out of total Odisha contributed 5.86 lakh ha. Rabi production is expected to increase from 5.50 lakh tonne to around 7 lakh tonne. This would further ease supply in coming weeks. Higher old stock and selling from central pool stock too remain restrictive for price.
- **Current improvement in Masur is due to demand from West Bengal.** It is expected would come down again. So it is advisable to buy after correction. Crop condition is good and crop from Bihar would hit market from next week. Pressure on lentil market continues as new crop is at hand. Export is not feasible as exporting countries offer it at cheaper price. import would be restricted due to 30 % duty. Market would move up April onward. Govt would procure on MSP in Uttar Pradesh and MP.
- **Peas market traded slightly firm. Range bound movement is expected this week.** Desi pea in Kanpur market is being traded at Rs2941-2950 peer qtl. Canadian pea is being offered at Rs 2951-61(duty included in it) Russian pea is being offered at Rs Rs2975. Steady to firm tone may prevail this week.
- **Final Rabi pulses sowing area, except Moong, is awaited now.** Sowing of Moong would continue in Bihar and UP till 15th March. Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 5.29 % to 169.10 lakh ha as on 9th Feb-2018. Chana area was registered at 107.63 against 99.54 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 17.36 against 17.30 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 11.92 against 11.97 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 9.44 against 9.94 & 8.31 against 7.34 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 6.28 against 6.53 lakh ha. Sowing is almost over except Urad & Moong so far.



## International:

- **India has increased import duty on Chickpeas from 40 to 60 % now and it will affect Canadian & Australian pulses markets more.** Any possibility of import has diminished completely now. Canadian minister of infrastructure and communities, Amarjeet Sohi had said talks were on to resolve the pulses import duty issue with India. The Centre had imposed a 30 per cent import duty on Masur (chana) and 40 % on Chana(now 60 % End Feb-2018) in December and 50 per cent on yellow peas in November. Besides, govt. would buy oilseeds and pulses at pre-set prices till 2021-22 with waiver of 1 per cent government guarantee fee. All these developments are not in favor of overseas Pulses exporters.
- **CEO of Myanmar Pulses Beans and Sesame Seeds Merchants Association (MPBSMA) San U Myat Soe has given hint that Indian and Burmesse Govt.'s official are still engaged in sorting out issue related to pulses purchase from Mayanmar.** Price modalities are being set. Myanmar govt is eager to sell pulses to India at locally prevailing price while Indian govt wants to fix pulses price below market prevailing price. Market is awaiting decision. The price negotiations were revived again this month, seven months since Indian slammed an import quota on pulses and beans from Myanmar last August. Notably, India had announced a 200,000-tonne import quota on Myanmar pigeon peas and 300,000-tonne import quota on Myanmar mung beans in August last year.
- **Lentil price has come down from \$500 to \$475-80 per tonne. Major buyers like India are not going to enter the market for any bulk purchasing.** So, buying interest of other countries would not fill the gap. So price is likely to stabilize at current level.
- **Chickpeas production estimate for the US has been increased from 2.50 lakh tonne (2016) to 3.15 lakh tonne in 2017** despite lower area coverage of 6.23 lakh acres. US farmers had covered 3.31 lakh acres in 2016. However, Chickpeas stock on 1st Dec-2017 was recorded at 72000 tonne, lower from 65000 tonne from Dec-2016. Small Chickpeas stock was recorded at 45750 tonne against 32600 tonne last year. Its a tentative fig. Combined stock is higher by around 20,000 tonne from 2016.
- **Lower demand from major importing countries lentil and peas area has declined in Canada this year.** Lower export volume from Canada also hints at weak demand and it is likely to continue in 2018 too. Farmers in Canada had covered around 10 million acres in 2016, which was around 40 lakh acres higher than 2013-14 crop year. This year total area declined to 85 lakh acres. Under lentil crop around 44 lakh acres has been covered while pea area was reported at 41 lakh acres. Despite lower area coverage in 2017 it is second largest area coverage. So supply side is unlikely to be tight this year.
- **Undertone in global chickpeas market remains subdued due to higher supply in exporting countries** and lower demand from India. Global Chickpeas production is bound to increase from 115 to 125 lakh tonne due to higher area coverage in India. Global Chickpeas production of Kabuli Chana) too would increase from 20 to 28 lakh tonne this year. Besides global trade would decline as major buyers like India is out of the market right now.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 47.85 % to 10.45 lakhtonne in 2017-18** from record 2004 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1069 to 1144 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Production of Yellow pea continues to increase in Nebraska.** In 2017/18, 70,000 acres of yellow peas were planted in the state, up from 10,000 acres five years ago.
- **Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year.** Yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production, would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year.** Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production, would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Field peas production too, is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **Imposition of 50% import duty on all peas, has started impacting export volume from Canada,** According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT (2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18. Lower export volume



would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas prices are hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada. Outlook: Cash market is likely to steady to weak for Chana, Masur, Moong & pea while steady to slightly firm for Tur, Urad.

**Urad Kharif-Rabi** combined production is bound to increase slightly from 23.9 to 24.97 lakh ton in crop year 2017-18. Production increase is due to higher area coverage. Import would remain restricted at 1.5 lakh tonne, applicable till March-2018. Over 1.1 lakh ton Urad import has already been reported. Govt may review quantity restriction in March-2017. Consumption is likely to increase by 2 lakh ton due to cheaper availability in domestic market. Carryout would increase due to higher total supply and higher production. It will increase from 8.77 lakh ton to 9.74 lakh ton. Supply side will remain at comfortable level.

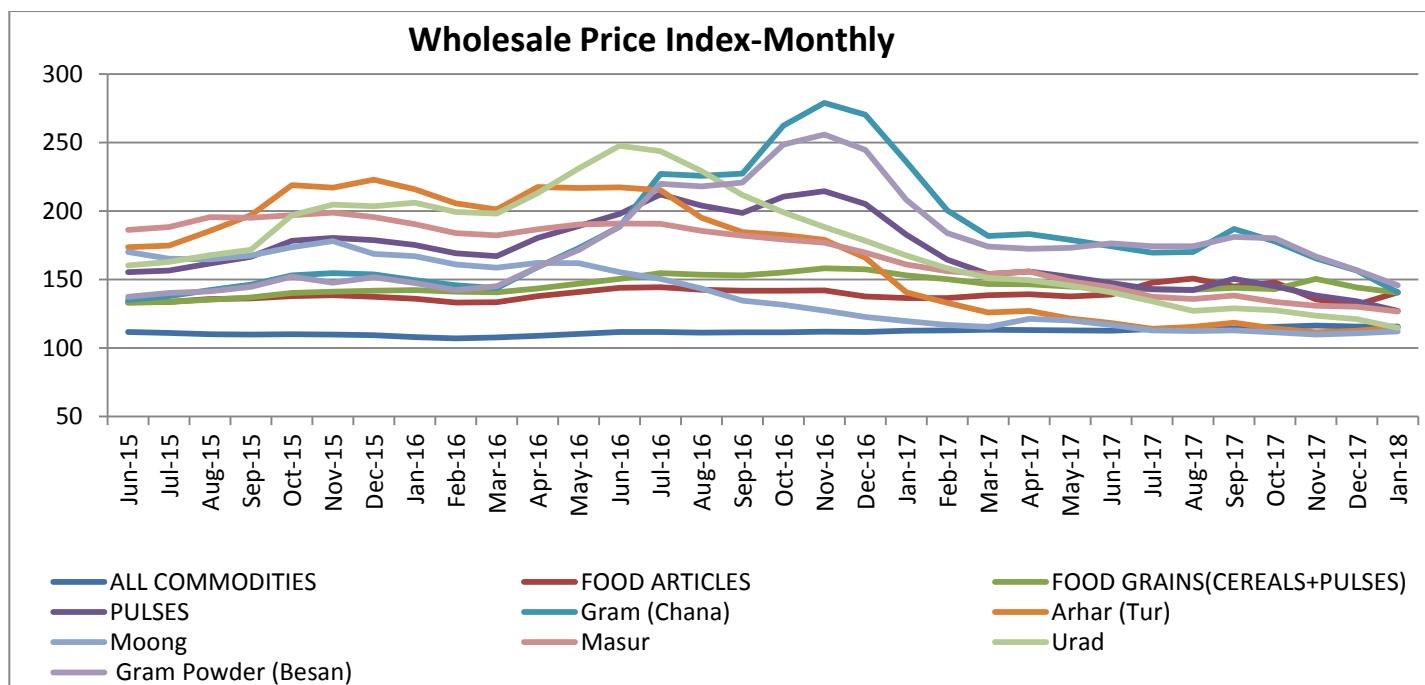
**Moong Kharif-Rabi** production is expected to decrease from 20.3 lakh ton to 19.25 lakh ton in 2017-18. Import would remain at 1.5 lakh ton as fixed by govt. Total supply would increase to 29.65 lakh ton due to higher carryout stock. Govt may review import quantity restriction, March-2018 onward. Over 1.25 lakh ton Moong has been imported so far. Consumption would increase slightly from 18.8 to 20.5 lakh ton. The season 2017-18 would end with higher carryout stock(9.15 lakh ton). Supply side will remain at comfortable level.

**Tur production** is expected to decline to 30.26 lakh ton in 2017-18 from record production of 39.18 lakh ton last year. Decrease in production is due to over 22/24 % decline in area planted this year. Total supply is expected to decline to 42.72 lakh ton due to lower crop size. Consumption is expected to increase from 37 to 38.25 lakh ton due higher availability at competitive price. Ending stock would decline from 10.67 to 4.68 lakh ton. Supply side is comfortable. Import restriction continues and fixed at 2 lakh ton.

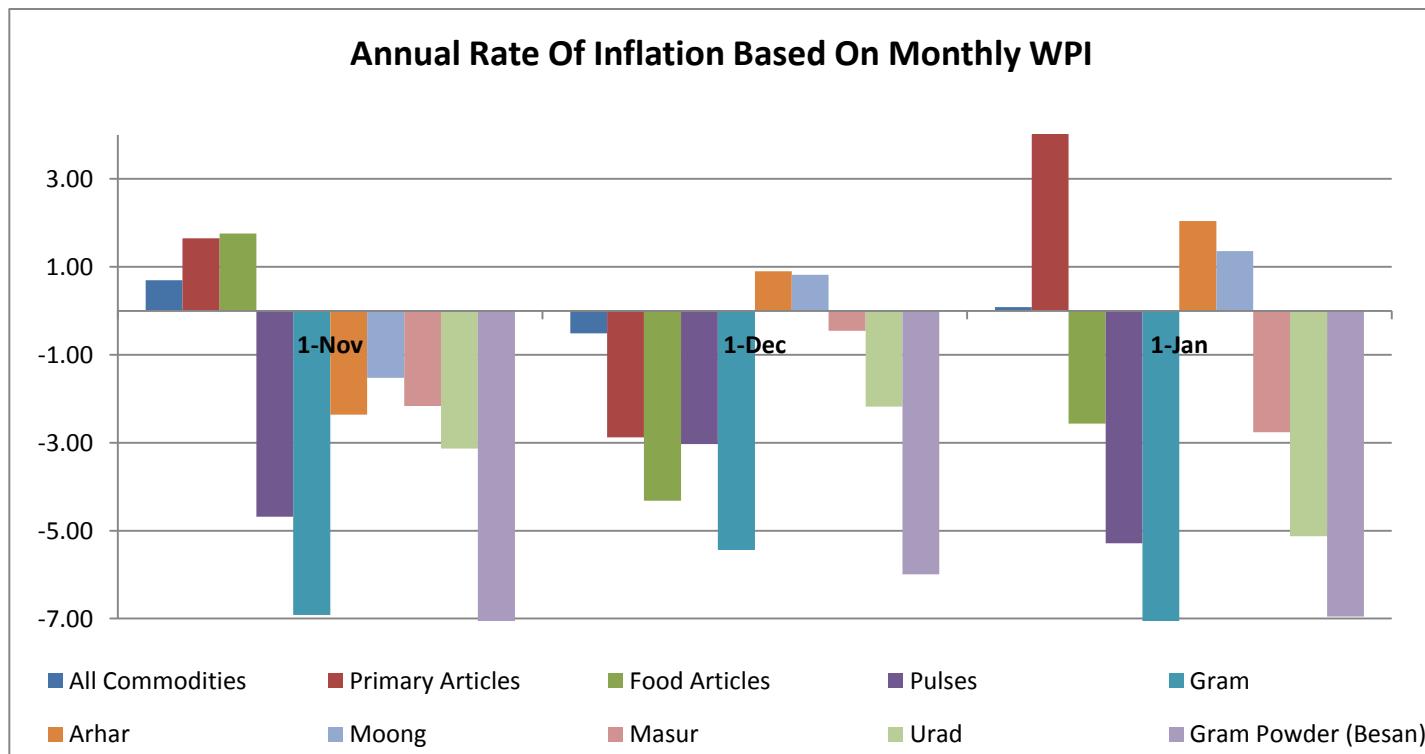
**Chana production** estimate has been revised down from 95.56 lakh ton to 94.54 lakh tonne for MY 2018-19 as per Agriwatch 2<sup>nd</sup> adv estimate due to crop loss in Maharashtra and yield loss in MP and Rajasthan. As season would start with hefty carryout of 11.91 lakh ton Chana, total supply would increase from 101.91 to 108.45 lakh ton. As supply side is higher, import might decrease from hefty 9.8 lakh ton to 2 lakh ton. Consumption is likely to increase from 90 to 91 lakh ton. The season would end with 15.45 lakh ton carry out. So, pressure on Chana market may continue without govt.'s interference.

**Lentil** production is expected to increase from 10.40 to 11.68 lakh ton this year due to higher area coverage. Higher carry out and higher production would increase total supply to 23.63 lakh ton. Import is expected to remain steady at 7/8 lakh ton. Availability is higher. The season may end with 3.63 lakh ton carry out. Supply side would remain at comfortable level.

### Chana (Chickpeas /Bengal Gram):

#### Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:

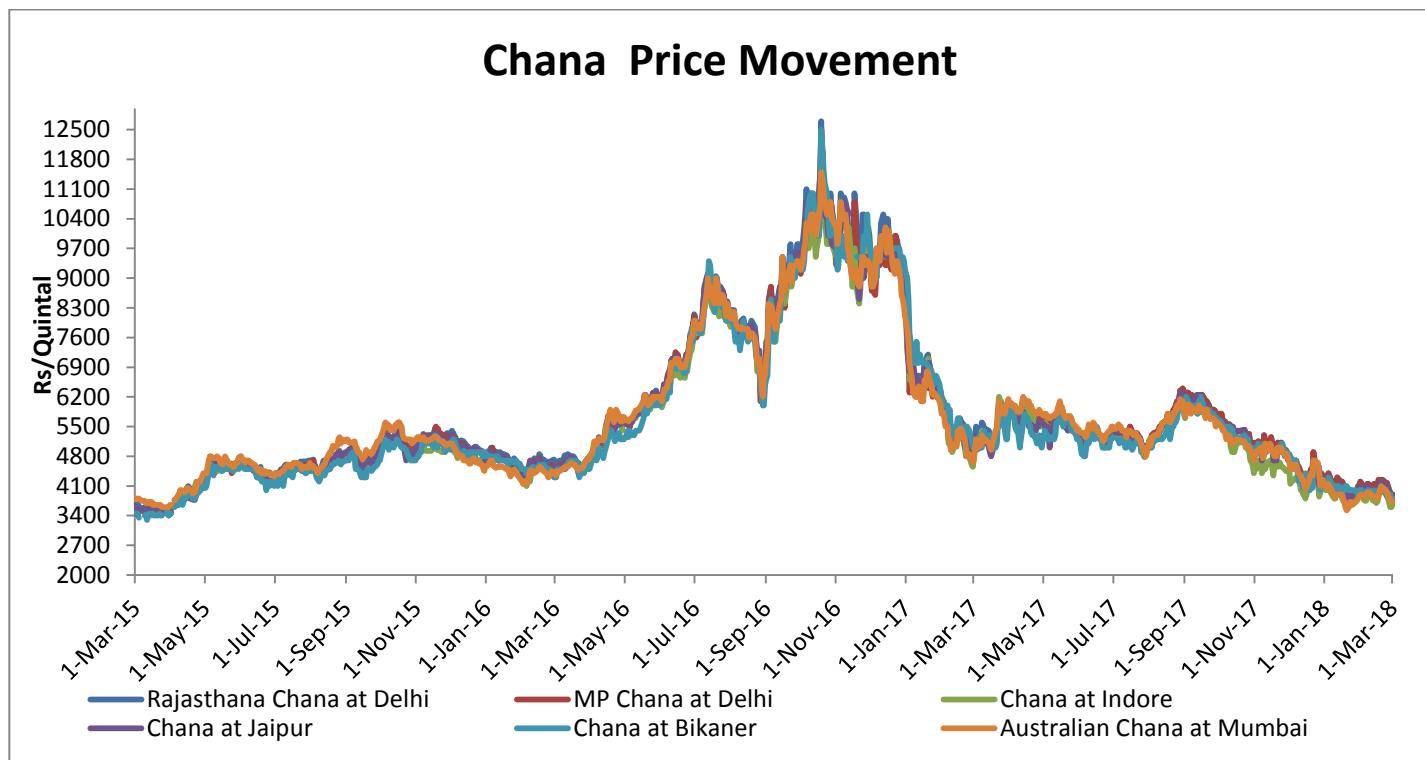
##### Market Recap:

*Chana cash market could not sustain its uptrend despite import duty hike from 40 to 60 % last week .It would impact market when arrival pressure would start decreasing .Higher duty has ensured complete halt for Chana import. However, crop size is higher, it would not allow market to move up immediately. It is obvious that duty hike would restrict market to fall further. So buying on dip seems good. Cash market would move up slowly in coming weeks. Besides, Nafed got credit limit from 9500 crore to 19,000 crore to procure pulses and oilseeds.. This means higher procurement by state agencies. It would continue till 2021-22. So any major dip from current level is unlikely. It should stabilize near current level.*

##### Price Dynamics:

*In Feb-2017, all India average price was down by 0.57 % to Rs 4009 per qtl..Average price in Jan was 4032 per qtl. Prices are likely to stay steady in March due to:*

- Higher import duty(60%)
- Active private buying at lower level.
- Extended credit for Nafed from 9500 to 19000 crore and
- Higher usage due to lower price for gram flour industries.

**Market Outlook for March-2018**

Chana prices are likely to witness steady to slightly weak tone on increasing arrivals. Higher duty 60 % on import would continue to restrict import and its impact might be seen when arrival would start declining. Besides, govt. intends to support cash market by implementing various measures. Stake holders should start buying on dip.

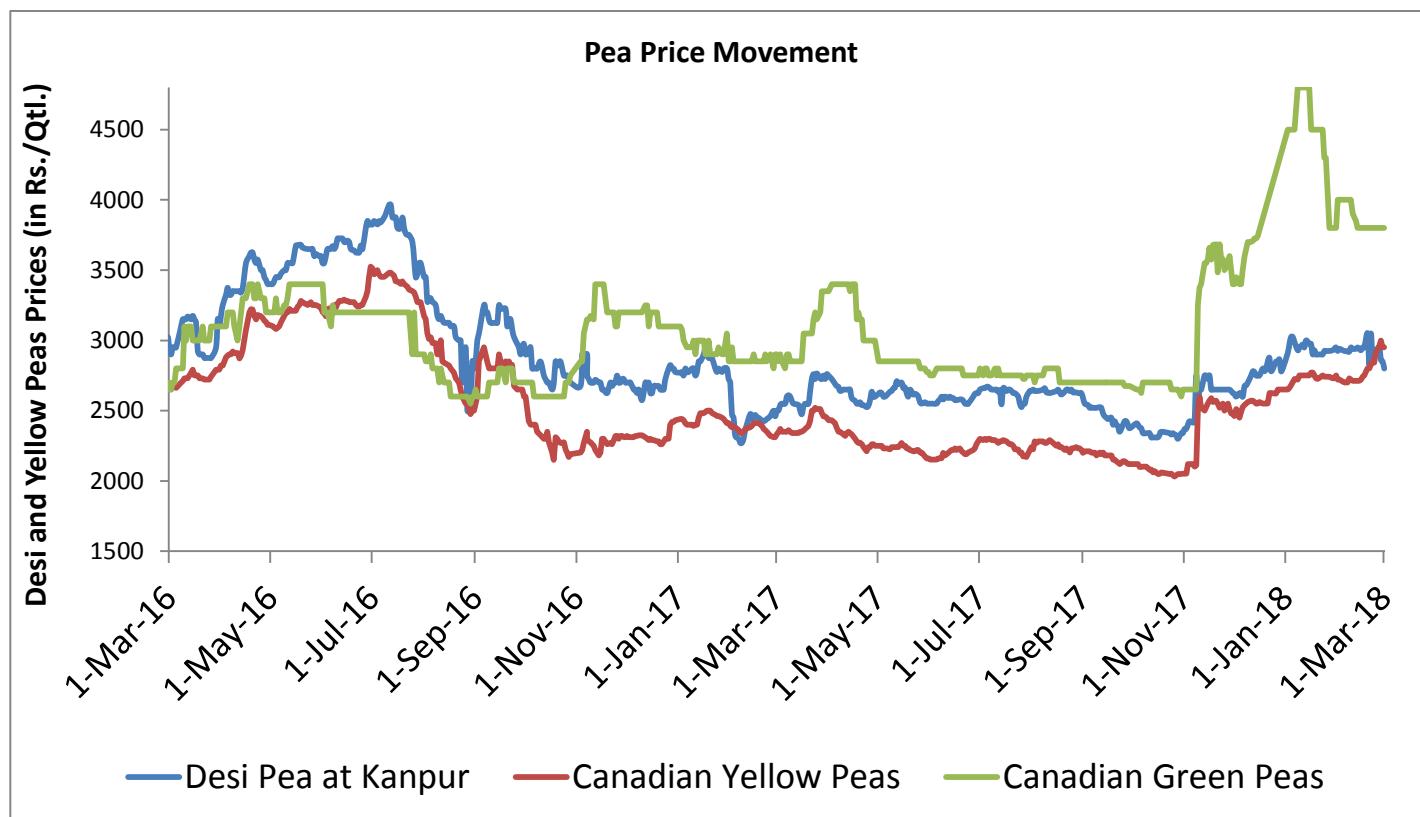
**Field Pea (Matar /Dry Pea):****Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:****Market Recap:**

Imposition of 50 % duty on all peas has restricted import flow to a considerable extent Peas market traded slightly up during the week under review. However, weak chana may pressurize pea market this week .As supply side is ample with commencement of new crop, slight downward correction might be seen in cash market in the near term. Pea may trade steady to slightly weak taking cue from Chana. Right now, 50 % duty is applicable on all peas. The average price decreased by 0.75 % to Rs 2924 per qtl. in Kanpur market, Canadian pea increased by 2.31 to Rs 2786. It may trade range bound in the near term. Import flow is expected to come to a halt in the first quarter.

**Price Dynamics:**

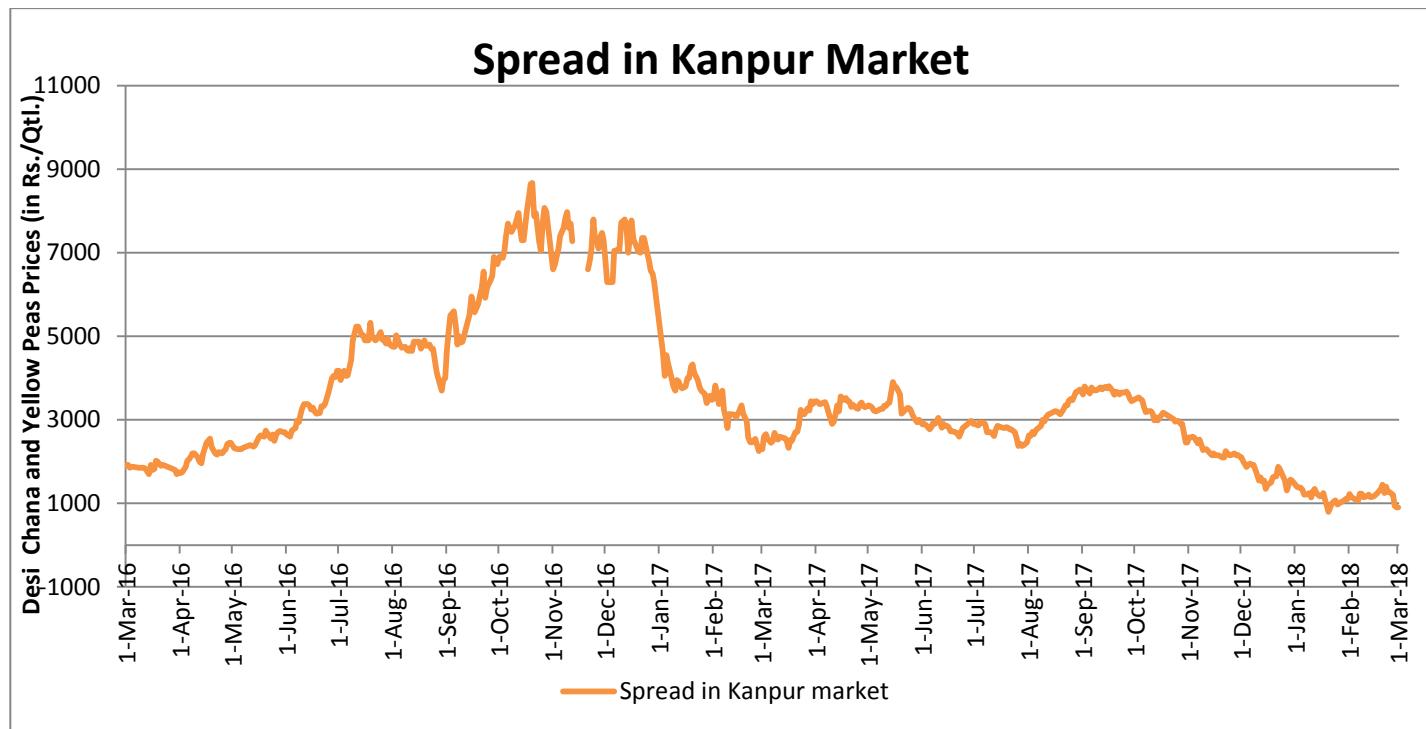
In Feb-2017., yellow pea all India average prices traded up by 0.99% to Rs 2855 per qtl. Steady to slightly weak movement is expected in March due to:-

- Higher stock & new arrivals
- Steady area coverage & cheaper availability of other pulses
- Decreasing Chana price &
- Restricted buying.



**Spread With Chana:**

(Back to Content)



The spread between Chana and Pea at Kanpur market has decreased considerably by around 25 mainly because of decreased Chana price from Jan to Feb-2018. As pressure would continue, spread is expected to remain between Rs 1000 to Rs 1200 per quintal in March on relative movement in Chana prices.

**Seasonality Index** depicts that pea prices are likely to notice range bound movement in March-2018.

**Market Outlook For March:** Prices of Pea are likely to trade steady to slightly weak due to subdued demand at current level and weak chana price. Besides, new crop starts hitting domestic markets. Stock is ample. Ample old stock and expected good crop size would prevent market from unexpected upward movement in the near term. Gov. may consider revision in duty (currently 50 %) after new crop. It might be in next financial year, starting from April-2018. Steady to weak tone may prevail. Stake holders should buy on dip.

**Masoor (Lentils/ Masoor):**

**Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:**

**Market Recap:**

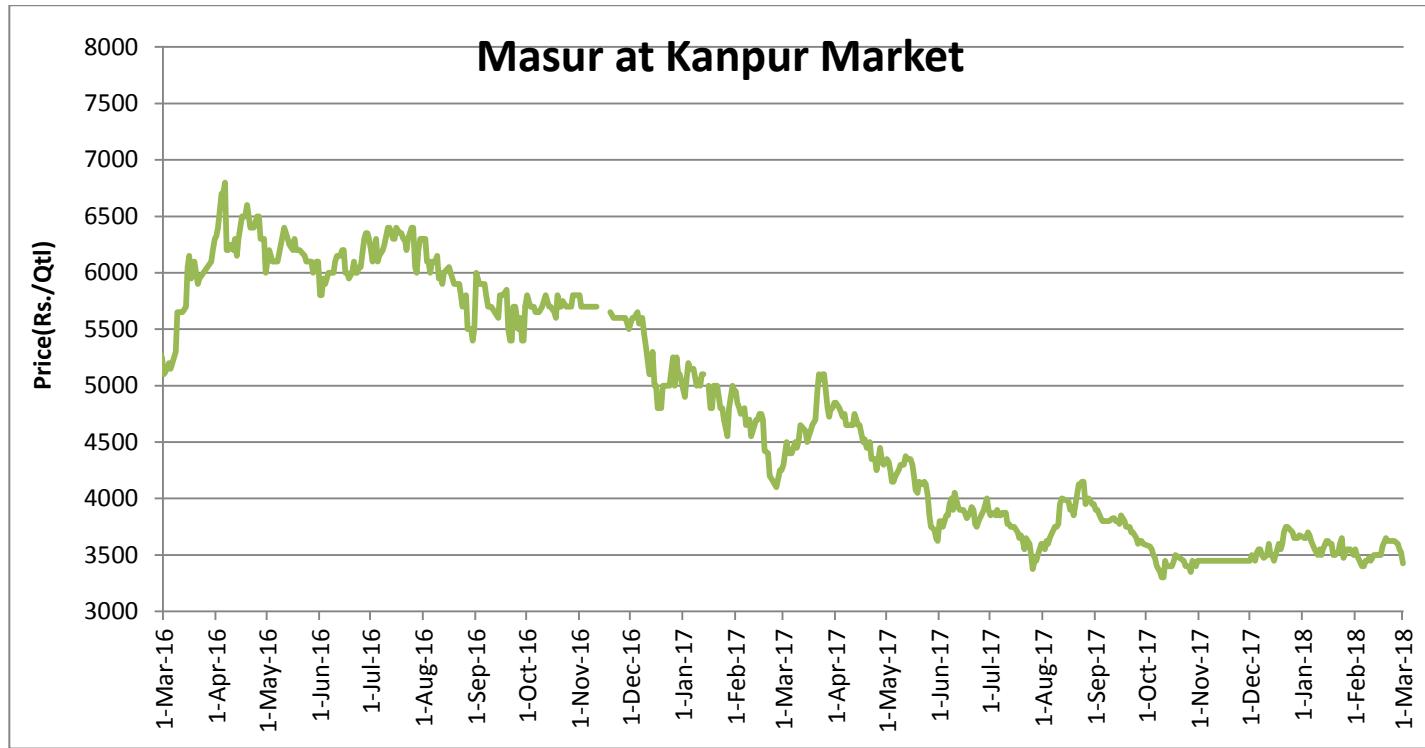
Kanpur market traded weak in Feb on new arrivals and good crop condition so far. Despite imposition of duty market continued to rule under pressure. Recovery is unlikely as new crop is at hand now. Area under Lentils is bound to increase this year as overall sowing trend is higher by 0.55 % to 17.34 lakh ha so far. Procurement drive may support market to a certain extent. Australian Red whole Lentils (nipper Type) is being offered at \$505 for tonne for March delivery. Nugget type is being offered at \$495 per ton for same month. Weak tone may prevail in March.

**Price Dynamics:**

In Feb-2018, average price in key market Kanpur was down by 1.28 % to Rs 3526 per qtl MoM basis. Prices are likely to stay steady in March. Weakness is due to:

- Lower forward quotes (\$495/500) Australia/Canada-\$455/65.

- Higher area/good crop condition so far.
- Weak demand



**Seasonality Index** depicts range bound to slightly weak movement in March-2018.

#### Market Outlook for Feb:

Kanpur market opened with a firm note in the first half and could not sustain at higher level due to new arrival and weak buying. Crop condition is good. More dip is unlikely as buyers from West Bengal are expected to be active in weeks ahead. Besides, procurement drive would start in MP and Uttar Pradesh. It may support market at lower level. Imposition of 30% import duty would continue to restrict import. Buyers should take positions after correction. Area under Lentils is bound to increase this year as overall sowing trend is higher by 0.35 % at 17.36 lakh ha so far. Overall sentiments remain firm in the medium term. Stakeholders should buy on dip.

Average prices of Masur decreased by around 1.28% to Rs 3526 per qtl in Feb-2018. Demand factor and likely new arrival is weighing on to the market as availability of other pulses is higher at attractive price. Besides, selling through auction continues. Steady tone may continue. Market may dip Rs100 more from current level.

#### Price Dynamics:

Weak demand for dal and new crop being at hand may lead to continued pressure on Masur in March . It would trade weak due to:

- Higher crop size/area
- Higher Old stock
- Weak demand &
- Limited buying approach by state agencies on MSP

**Tur (Toor/ Arhar/Red Gram/Pigeon Pea/Aware):**

**Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:**

As expected last week demand for Tur dal decreased and stockists resorted to release old stock at higher level. Besides, procurement pace got slowed down last week, its impact was seen on cash market price. Tur prices in various markets decreased by around Rs200 per qtl. It is being traded at Rs 3900 to Rs 4300 per qtl in various market. As demand is weak, market is expected to stay steady this week. On going procurement drive may restrict market to move down further. Myanmar offers old Tur at \$355-65 per tonne while new Tur is being offered at \$400-410 per tonne, still much lower than prevailing price in India which converts to \$640-645 per tonne. Stake holders should buy on dip.

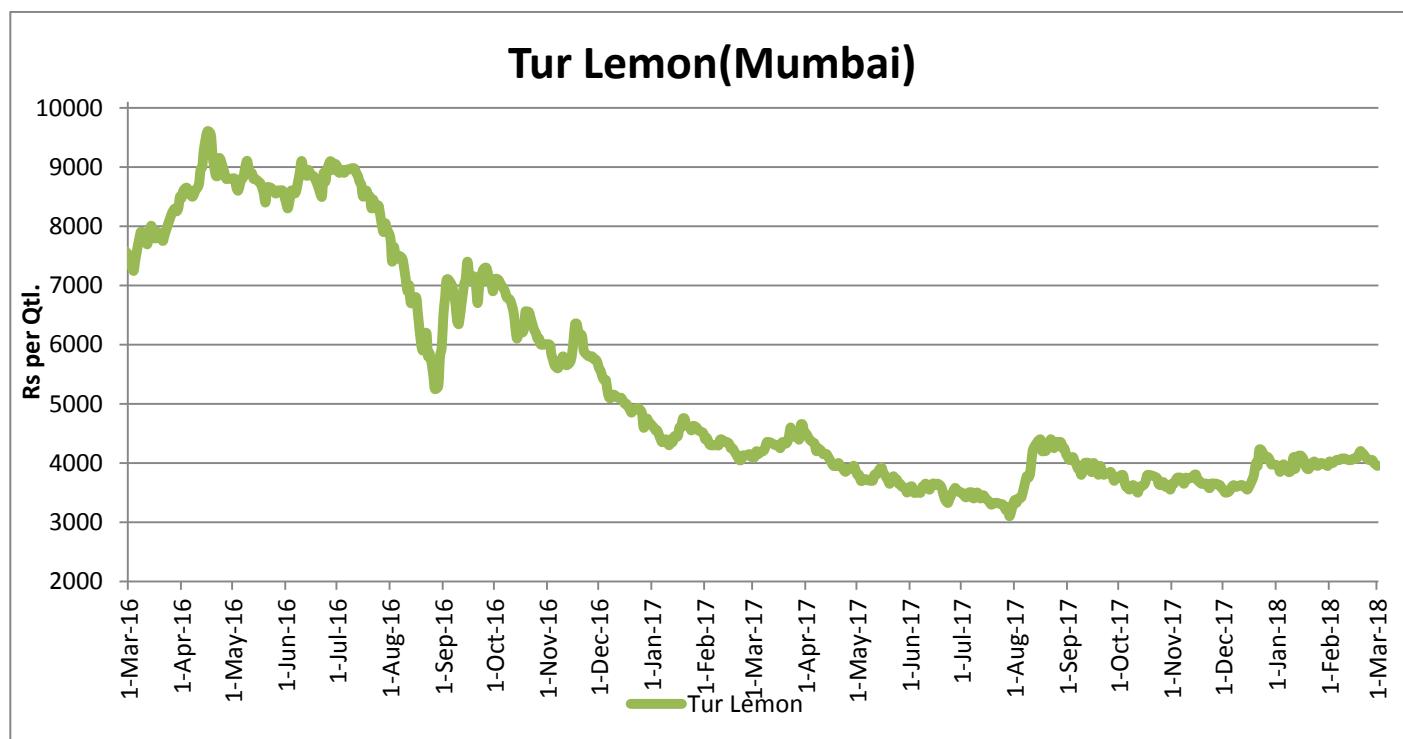
**Market Recap:**

Average price of Tur decreased 2.80 % from 4400 to Rs 4180 per qtl. in Feb-2018 in Gulberga market. Price may decrease slightly in March too to a certain extent. Stake holders should buy on dip as market is expected to recover as fundamental remains firm. Procurement drive and private buying interest would prevent market from falling below a certain level. Normal trade is expected after April. Imported Tur price in Mumbai decreased from Rs 4400 to 4183 per qtl. in Feb-2018. Steady to slightly weak tone may prevail in March.

**Price Dynamics:**

In March-2018, average price in Mumbai market was down by around 2.45% to Rs 4041 per qtl. from Rs 4200 in Jan due to

- Higher arrival
- Selling from central pool stock(old crop)
- Steady retail demand for dal at current level
- Cheaper availability of other pulses & restricted procurement drive.



**Seasonality Index-** depicts steady to slightly weak movement in this month. Average price decreased by 1.0 % MoM basis to Rs 3983.



**Production-** According to the Agriwatch estimate, Kharif Tur MY 2017-18 production is estimated at around 30 Lakh tonne against 39.19 lakh tonne in 2016-17. New crop starts now .Tur area ended with 42 lakh ha as per Agriwatch estimate.

**Govt. has revised Tur production estimate** slightly up from 3.99 MMT to 4.02 MMT in second adv. estimate release on 27.02.2018 against set target of 4.25 MMT for 2017-18. Govt has released final production fig for last year at 4.87 MMT.

### Market Outlook for March:

Tur prices are likely to trade steady to slightly weak in March-2018. However, stake holders should start buying on dip. Market may move up April Onward once again.

#### Urad (Black Matpe/Black Gram)

#### Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:

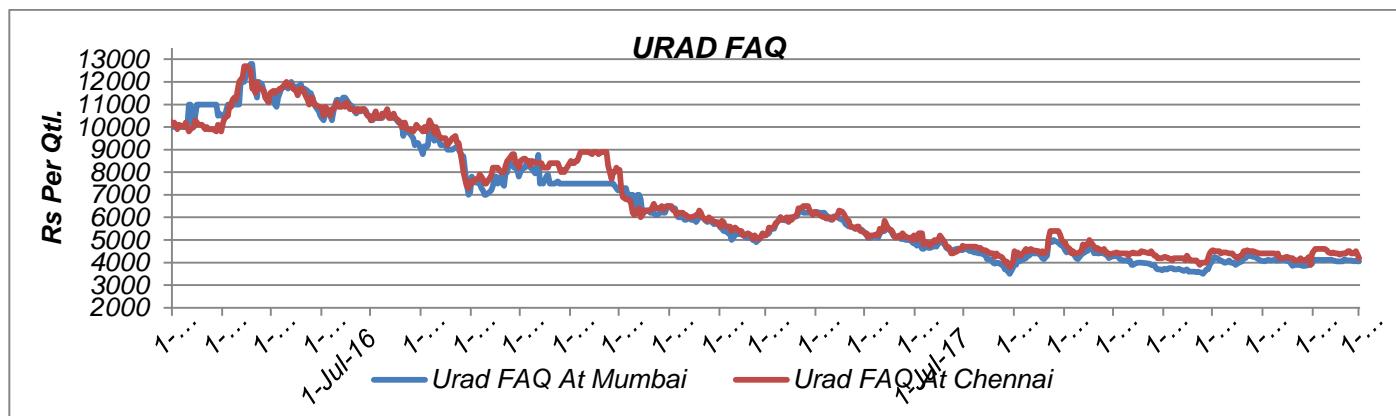
##### Market Recap:

Urad traded slightly down on higher supply. It is being traded at Rs 4200 to Rs 4050 per qtl in Chennai market. Steady tone may prevail with ongoing procurement drive. Government's procurement drive at MSP (Rs.5400, including bonus of Rs.200) remains supportive to cash Urad market. However, overall condition is that of very high surplus. New arrivals from Rabi crop and selling through auction by central pool may restrict any upward momentum in the short term. It is likely to trade in the range of Rs.4200 to Rs.4600 per quintal in the open market in coming weeks, depending on quality. Urad FAQ Chennai is being traded at Rs 4200 to 4250 per quintal while in Mumbai it traded at Rs.4000-4050 per quintal. There is no export opportunity for Indian Urad at prevailing prices as Myanmar offers FAQ Urad at \$465 and SQ at \$590 per tonne.

##### Price Dynamics:

In Feb, average prices in key markets including Mumbai/were down by 3.01 % percent from 4000 to Rs 4200 per qtl. In Chennai it is being traded at Rs 4250-4300. Prices may stay steady to weak due to

- New arrival from Rabi and weak demand after Holi
- Higher crop size
- Ample old stock
- Lower forward quotes and restricted buying in domestic market.



**Seasonality Index** depicts steady to weak movement in the near term to medium term.

##### Production:

According to the Agriwatch preliminary estimates, Kharif Urad MY 2017-18 production is estimated at 24.97 lakh tonne against 23.97 lakh tonne 2015-16. See supply and demand side. Crop condition is good.

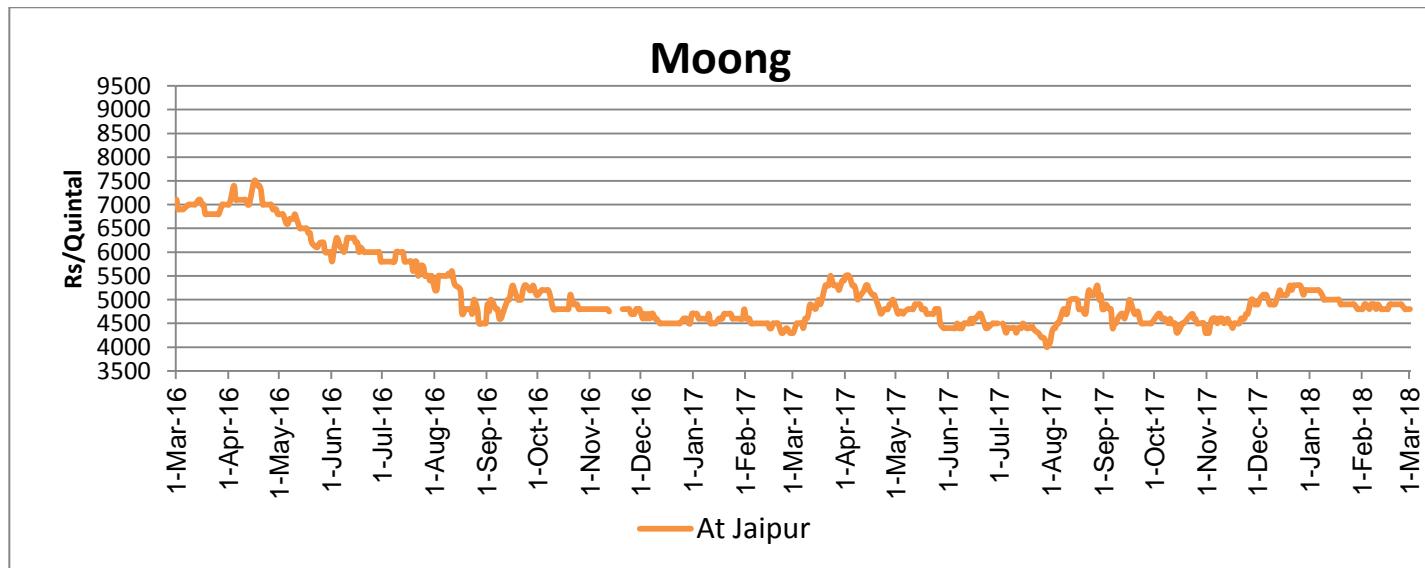
### Market Recap:

Moong market traded steady to slightly weak at Rs 4800 in Jaipur market. As arrival has decreased, more dip is unlikely from current level. New crop is 3-4 months away from now, so steady tone may prevail. It is likely to trade in the range of Rs 4700-5000 per qtl. in Jaipur market. Dal demand is likely to improve as availability of vegetables starts decreasing with increasing temperature. However, selling by Nafed and Markfed would restrict market from moving beyond a certain level. Markfed has issued tender for sale of 1.93 lakh tonne Moong in MP. It would continue to balance supply side and would continue to affect market sentiments in the weeks ahead.

### Price Dynamics:

Moong at Jaipur showed steady to weak movement and traded in the range of Rs 4700 to Rs 4900 per quintal, lower by Rs 100 from February. Market may trade steady to slightly weak ahead of Odisha crop. Average price in Feb moved down by 1.24 % to Rs 4800 per qtl. in Jaipur market. Burma offers Moong At \$695-700 per tonne. Prices may stay steady to weak due to

- Stockiest selling at higher level market
- Selling from central pool stock
- No export parity/Burma offers Moong at lower rate
- Higher carryout/New arrivals



**Seasonality Index** depicts steady to slightly weak movement in March.

**Production-** According to the Agriwatch preliminary estimates, Kharif and rabi Moong 2017-18 production is estimated at 19.25 Lakh tonne. It was 20.13 in 2016-17.

Moong production for kharif season has been pegged at 1.42 MMt against the set target of 1.65 MMt for 2017-18 in 2nd adv estimate. Final kharif moong production for rabi has been pegged at 0.32 against target of 0.65 MMt. Total moong production has been pegged at 1.74 MMt against target of 2.3 MMt. Final moong production for last year has been pegged at 2.16 MMt.

### Market Outlook for March:

Range bound movement with weak bias is expected in March too.
