

Pulses Monthly Research Report: June-2020

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Domestic Market Fundamentals:

- **Govt. of India is pleased to promulgate an ordinance namely, the farmers' produce trade and commerce ordinance, 2020** under clause (1) of article 123 of the constitution of India to facilitate interstate and intra state trade in farmers produce. The feature of this ordinance are as follows: any trader having a PAN under ITA 1961 or such other documents notified by central govt, may trade in any scheduled farmer's produce specified in the state APMC ACT, with a farmer or another traders in a trade area, farmers produce organization and agri cooperative society automatically qualify to trade in trade area.
- **Pulses industries in India, importers and farmers are not happy with new import tariff for masur.** Actually, stake holders are opposing the timing for slashed duty. The DGFT has slashed import duty on masur by 20 % to 10% now while 30% would be applicable on American masur. Importers can take advantage of slashed duty till 31st August. Actually it should have been extended till the beginning of sowing. Domestic millers and importers would not be able take advantage of this duty as Canada has increased masur price from \$500 to \$600. At this level, millers would not prefer to import. It would drag down masur price below MSP level once vessels (in way to Indian ports) hit the Indian ports. This means multinational companies would take advantage of this revised duty structure
- **Despite better pace of procurement chana cash market could not get much support and stayed steady.** In mostly markets chana is ruling below MSP. MSP of chana is 4875 while it is being traded at Rs 4100-4400.. As the new season started with hefty carry in (18.22 lakh MT). With bumper production of 106.22 lakh MT total availability increased from 115.5 in 2019-20 to 126.9 in 2020-21. Despite higher estimated consumption of 99.5 in 2020-21, carry out increased from 18.22 to 25.44 lakh MT in 2020-21. Massive carry in, ample old stock (10-12 lakh MT) with Nafed and 13 lakh MT procurement from new crop so far and it may cross 2.0MMT soon. It would not allow market to find support above Rs 4400-4500 in June –July.
- **Moong arrival in Harda market was seen decreasing. Farmers continued to bring moong uncleaned** and thus they received lower than expected price in markets. Superior quality moong was traded at Rs 6500 to 6771 per qtl. As pressure is likely to continue, prices may decrease further by Rs 200 from current level. Kharif moong sowing is likely to start from 20th June in MP, Rajasthan while in other states it may commence by the end of this month. Better crop size in summer crop and good prospects in kharif would not allow moong market to move beyond MSP level. Demand too has weakened at higher level.
- **No major changes were seen in rabi urad final crop size. Weather condition remained favorable** throughout the growing season. No infestation was reported to any states. So area and yield remained unchanged even at the final stage of crop harvesting. Production remained fixed at 6.72 lakh MT while total (kharif rabi) production size was recorded at 19.39 lakh MT. The new season is expected to start with 4.44 lakh MT carry in while preliminary estimate for 2020-21 is 24.86 lakh MT. Higher crop size and increased import quota at 4 lakh MT would cap urad prices in coming months. Supply size would increase and prices may come down to MSP level.
- **The DGFT has decreased the time line for 4 lakh MT urad import quota from 31st March-2021 to 31 August-2020.** As time frame for import has been reduced, The DGFT would issue license soon (June). It would impact the market sentiments and cash market would trade down by Rs 200 to 300 from current level. Notably, import of back log is yet to hit Indian ports. The time line for back log import for ongoing MY has been extended till 31st May-2020. Besides, new kharif crop would be available from Aug. So pressure seems building on urad price..
- **Tur cash market improved due to fresh demand from mills and slower pace of arrivals.** Supply from Karnataka, MH continues for other states. In Latur market it traded Rs 200 up and may continue to trade firm in coming weeks. Arrival in Latur market was reported at 1000-1200 bags while it was higher in Gulberga. As prices are ruling lower, stockiest are unwilling to sell tur at lower price right now. Tur price may move further up by Rs 200-300 from current level. Right now in Gulberga market it is being traded at Rs 5300-5400. Import is due in this month and quantity is higher. So any spike is unlikely in June.
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- **Peas market traded steady despite negligible import and lower stock in domestic market.** Bumper chana crop are restricting upward momentum.. So any firm momentum is unlikely. Green peas would continue to trade firm as stock in pipe line is almost nil.

International Market Update:

- **Exporters and bulk buyers of field peas are now active in western Canada.** As export continues with good pace, carryout stock may decrease to lower level. Govt. agency have estimated 41.80 lakh acres area under peas. Experts say that supply side may be tight even if yield remains at normal level. Lower carryin and higher demand from China would keep peas price well supported throughout the year. Domestic demand of peas too is increasing in Canada.
- **Australia is going to plant biggest chickpeas crop in comparison to last three years.** Planting continues in Queensland and NSW. As moisture level in the field is good, farmers are increasing area under chickpeas. As top level soil moisture is lower, farmers are using wheat land for chickpeas planting. Forward delivery for October onward has been heard at \$ 630 per MT. New chickpeas crop may attract higher value. Value of new crop may be affected by any further hiccups caused by COVID-19. It may pressurize Chickpeas price.
- **Lentils stock in Australia is decreasing fast as bulk shipment to B, desh continues with next three months forward deal was heard.** Old crop of lentils would not be available by the beginning of the new season. Forward quotes have been heard at \$700-800 per MT, but limited quantity limits the deal too. B, desh has been buying 20,000 MT red small lentils per month. It may continue next three months. Australia exported 80,000 MT lentils in March and big volume export continues in April and May too. So old stock is depleting fast. As prices are moving up, area under lentils may increase by 10% this year. New lentils quotes are \$650-700.
- **Moong harvesting is on in Australia .It is almost two third over in Queensland and northern NSW .** Quality of moong is said to be good. Mungbean values have steadied at \$1500/t for No. 1 grade, \$1400/t for manufacturing and \$1300/t for processing as per Central grain Asia report. Quantity of grade -1 moong is higher. China is the biggest buyer of Australian moong. Some buying interest from India too has been seen. Indian millers can also buy moong from Australia if they get license. The central Queensland mung bean harvest is well advanced, and will finish next month.
- **As per agri food Canada area seeded under lentils in Canada is expected to remain unchanged** at 1.53 Mh, due to higher expected returns relative to other crops. With higher yields, production is forecast to rise marginally to 2.2 Mt but supply is expected to decrease to 2.6 Mt due to a fall in carry-in stocks. Exports are forecast to be lower at 2.0 Mt. Carry-out stocks are expected to decrease which will be supportive for prices. The average price for all grades is forecast to rise from 2019-20. The USDA March Prospective Planting report showed that US area seeded to lentils is expected to decrease marginally from last year to 0.47 million acres. Area seeded is expected to fall in North Dakota but rise in Montana.
- **As per latest update by NASS ,dry pea acreage may be down by 12-13% this year in US** peas producing regions. Farmers may plant total 971,000 acres against 11,03,000 acres last year. Intended plantings are down from a year ago in Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, and South Dakota. However, area in Washington may increase by 19% this year.
- **As per latest update by NASS lentil area may be down by 2-3% this year in US.** Farmers may plant total 474,000 acres in crop year 2020., down 2 percent from 2019. Lower area coverage is expected in Idaho, North Dakota, and Washington from last year, while planting intentions are above last year in Montana (7% increase).
- **Chickpeas area in the US is likely to decrease by 32% from last year. Small chickpea acreage shows** a decline of only 5%, while large chickpea acreage is expected to decrease by 41% .It is really a big surprise this year.
- **As per the latest Australian Bureau of Statistics Chickpeas export volume from Australia** increased in Jan-2020 in comparison to Dec-2019. In January -2020, Australia exported 56,502 MT, up 2% from 55,296 the previous month. Bangladesh purchased 36,801 MT. Pakistan was the second most important importer taking 13,073 MT, followed by United Arab Emirates at 3,939 MT..

- Production of peas in Canada has been pegged at 42.37 lakh MT in 2019-20 & production forecast for 2020-21 is slightly higher at 43lakh MT. During the period import would decrease from 70 to 60 thousand MT while export too would decrease from 34 lakh MT to 33 lakh MT in 2020-21. Domestic use would increase slightly from 8.33 to 8.60 lakh MT during the same period. Average price is likely to hinge in the range of \$245-275 per MT, same range as was seen in 2019-20.**

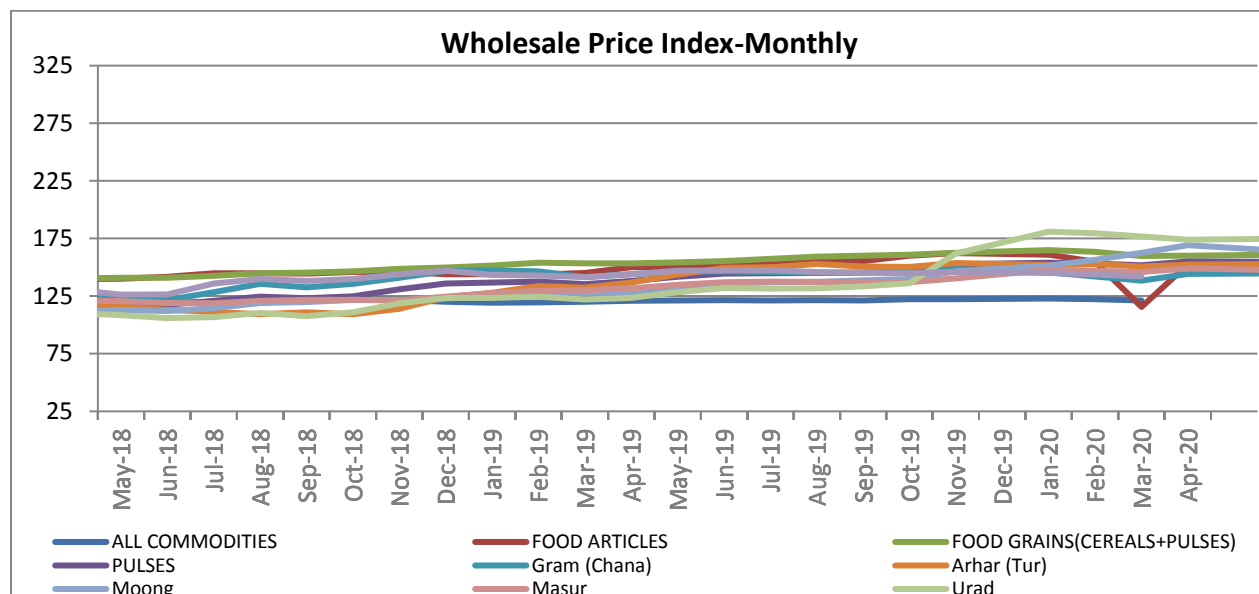

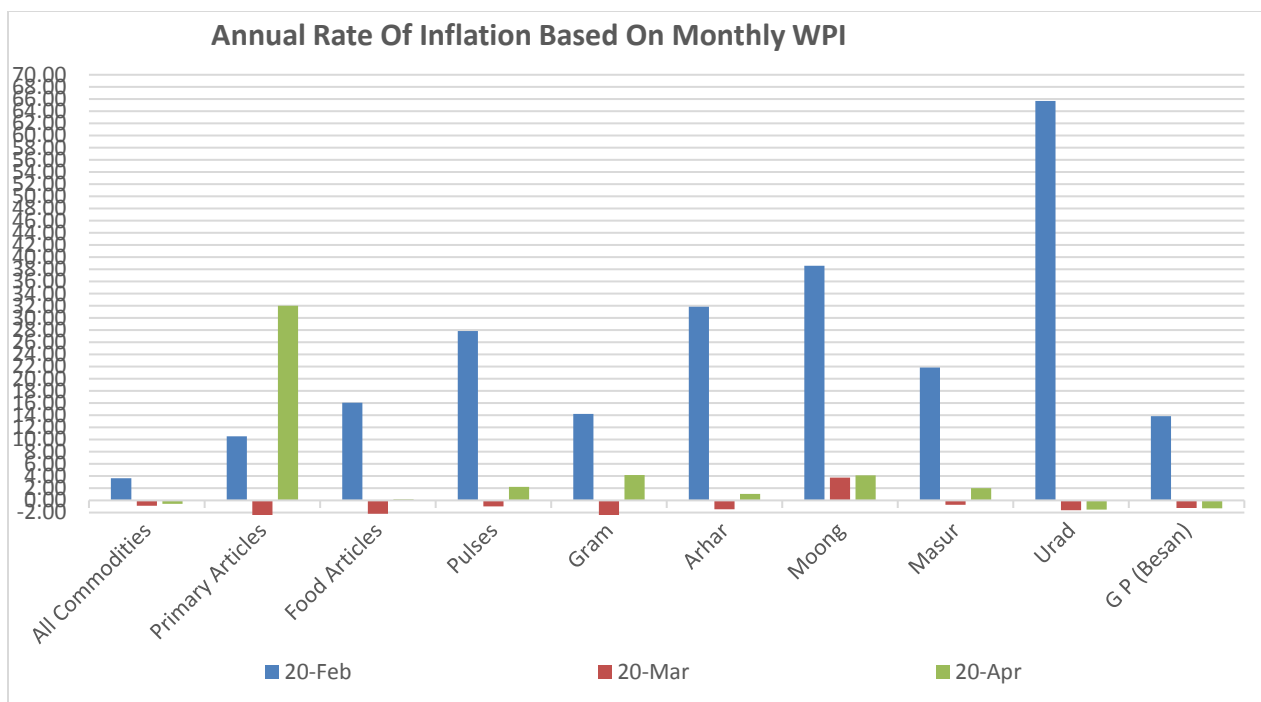

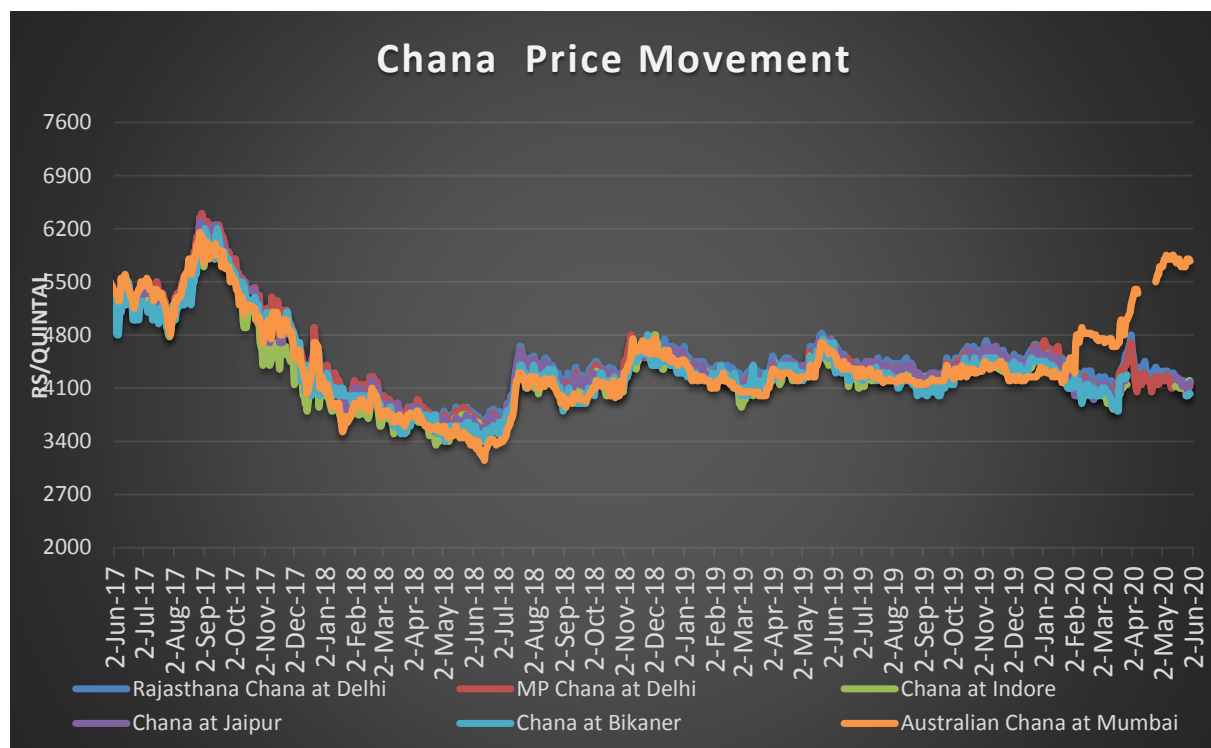
Chana (Chickpeas /Bengal Gram):

Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:

Market Recap:

Chana cash market traded up taking clue from firm futures and increasing possibility of higher procurement 11 lakh MT) in MP. Procurement timing might be extended to 30th June due to disturbance caused by lock down. In Delhi Chana is being traded at Rs 4000-4100 and may move up by Rs 100-200 from current level. Demand for chana is expected to improve June onward and it may help market to push up towards Rs4500. Prices may move up beyond this level if import from LDC countries remains restricted. Nafed has ample old stock and there is a possibility of over 2 MMT procurement from new crop too. It would not allow market to have any unexpected spike in the near to medium term..

All India average price for Chana increased by 2.11percent from Rs 4098 to 4201 per qtl. during review week. Even Australian Chana (imported) price increased to Rs 5600 per 100kg due to lower availability of imported chana in domestic market. Following graph illustrates the chana price movement in different markets:



Price Dynamics: Prices are likely to stay steady to slightly weak in June due to

- Bumper production and weak demand
- Availability of higher stock old) with Nafed and private hands
- Stockiest/millers are avoiding bulk buying at this point of time due to uncertainty over demand.
- Weak futures
- Weak international market and
- Free distribution of pulses to ration card holders for three months up to June, may be increased to July too

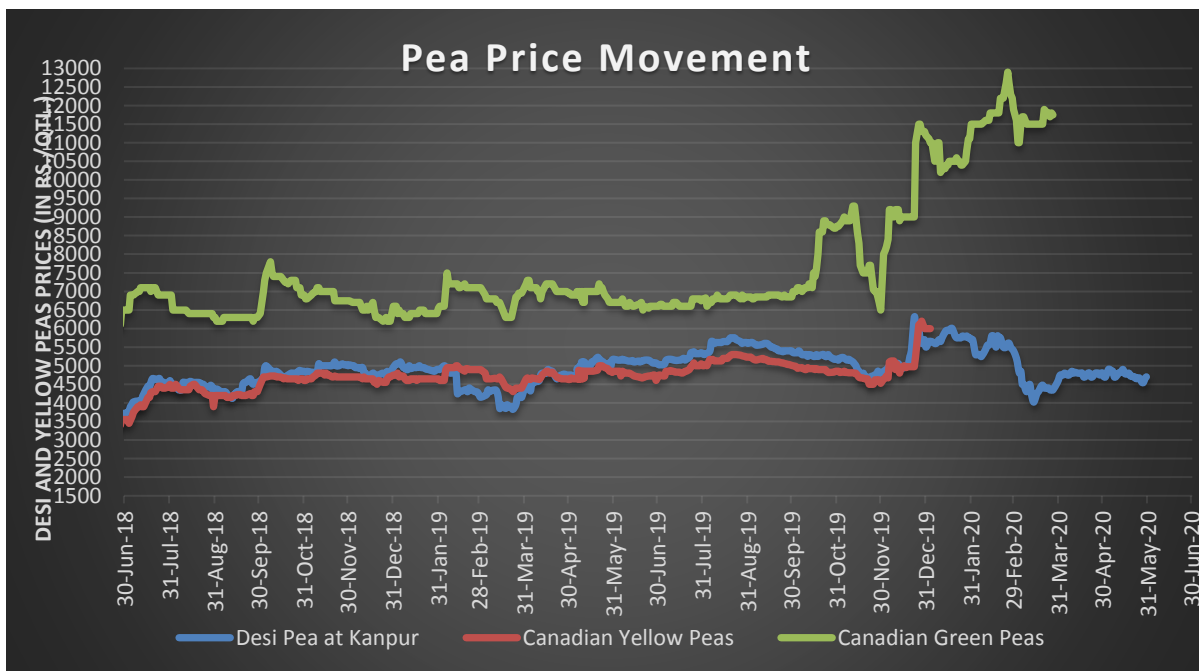

Field Pea (Matar/Dry Pea):

Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:

No major change was seen in peas market as maximum trade remain suspended due to disruption in major market due to covid-19. However, in some markets it traded up due to supply disturbance. With changed status from the free to restricted category and hefty levy imposed on peas, its import remains almost halted. The commerce ministry issued a separate harmonized system (HS code) for all peas (including yellow, green and kaspa) and changed its status in the third week of Dec. It has affected importers badly. Now import deals are not taking place. The fixed quota of 1.5 lakh MT has already been completed. Actually govt is trying to increase consumption of chana as it is abundantly available in domestic market. Importers have requested govt to allow green peas import as prices of green peas ruling higher at Rs-11,800 per qtl. Against the quota of 1.5 lakh MT over 5.78 lakh MT has been imported so far. Under prevailing condition govt. is unlikely to allow green peas import. New crop in local market started hitting mandis now. So price of yellow peas may move down from current level. With new arrival in domestic market supply side seems at ease.

Pea in Kanpur market traded firm at Rs.4650-4700 due to halted arrival in domestic market. Stockiest too are unwilling to release old stock despite bumper chana production prospects. It has impacted price of peas in Kanpur market too despite exhausting stock of imported peas in Mumbai. As chana price has declined, pea too may not be able to move up. Availability of chana would increase. And it would cap peas price too. Green peas have started hitting the local market but in limited quantity. As supply side is tight, it would continue to trade up.



Market Recap:

Arrival from local market started decreasing now in various markets. As demand at current price is weak, yellow pea would continue to trade steady to slightly weak in June. There is no demand for mixing in chana for besan. Chana is abundantly available right now. It would remain price restricting factor in coming months for peas too.

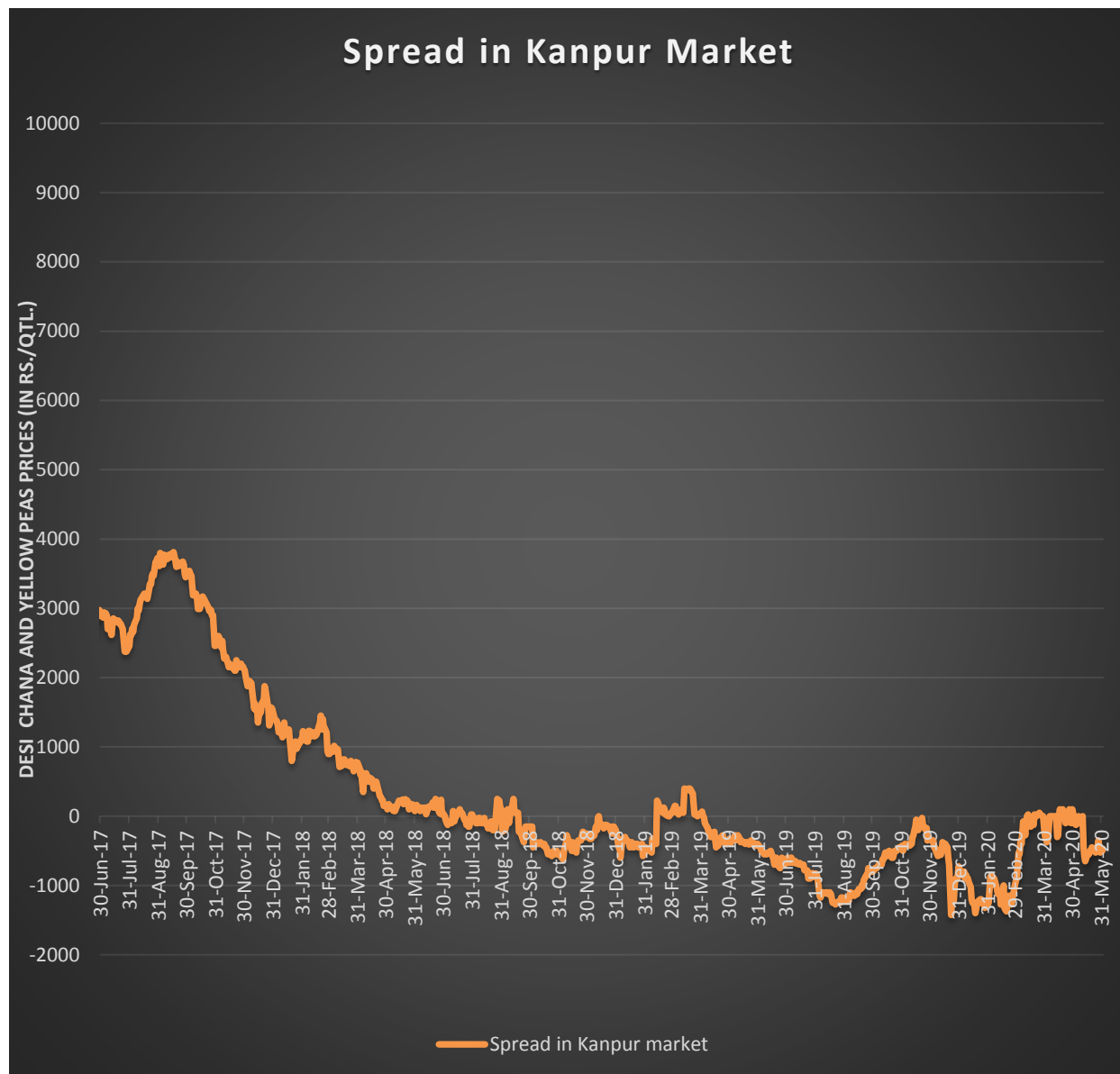
Price Dynamics: Pea market is expected to trade steady to slightly weak in June due to:-

- Weak demand despite decreased arrival from local markets
- Cheaper availability of chana in domestic market.



- No demand for besan as chana availability is higher in domestic market
- Cheaper availability of other pulses and free distribution of pulses by govt. to ration card holders

Spread With Chana:



Gap has decreased from Rs 50 to Rs 450 in last one month, based on monthly average of the price. Spread is expected to remain at same level in June on relative movement in Chana prices. Overall outlook seems steady to weak this month.

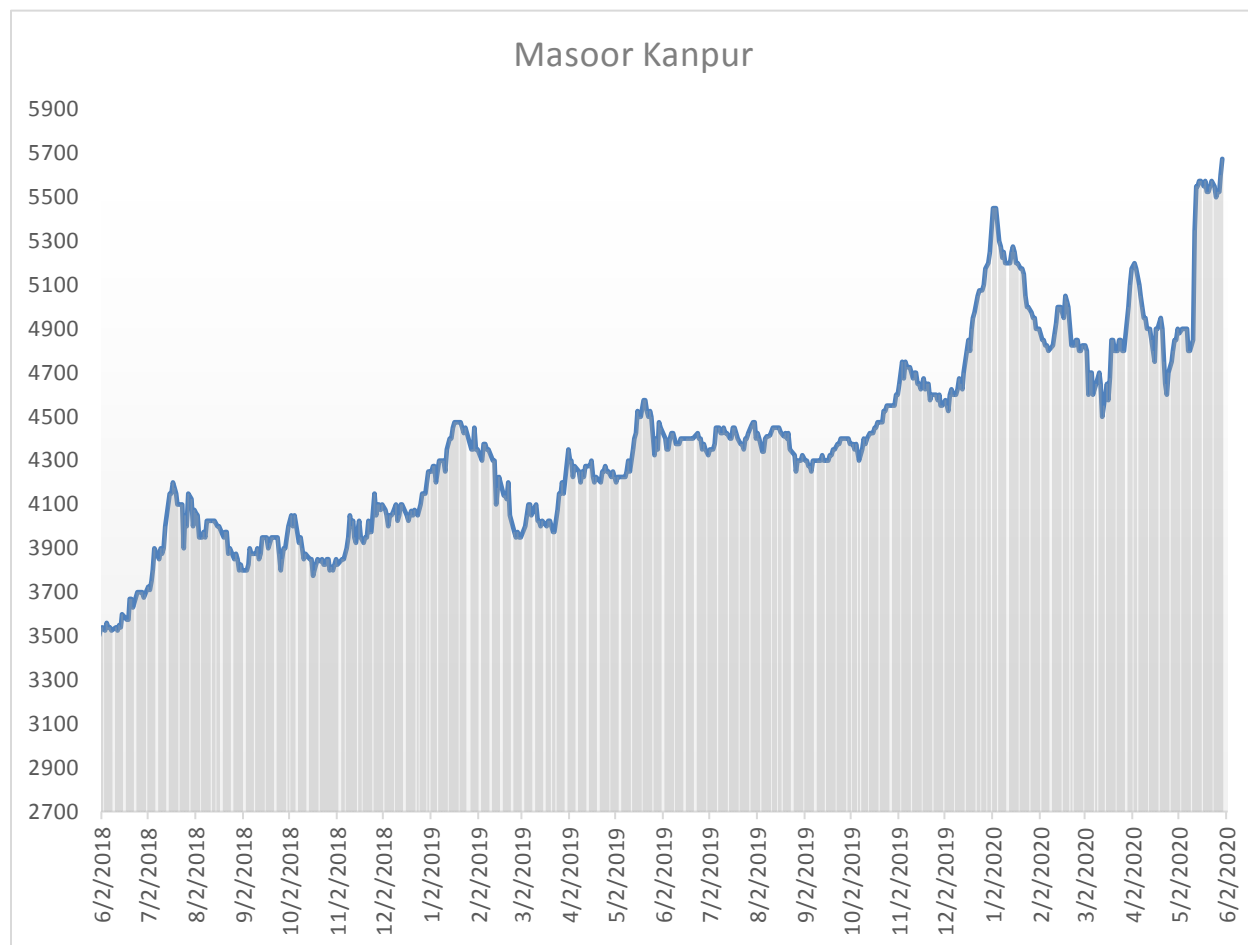

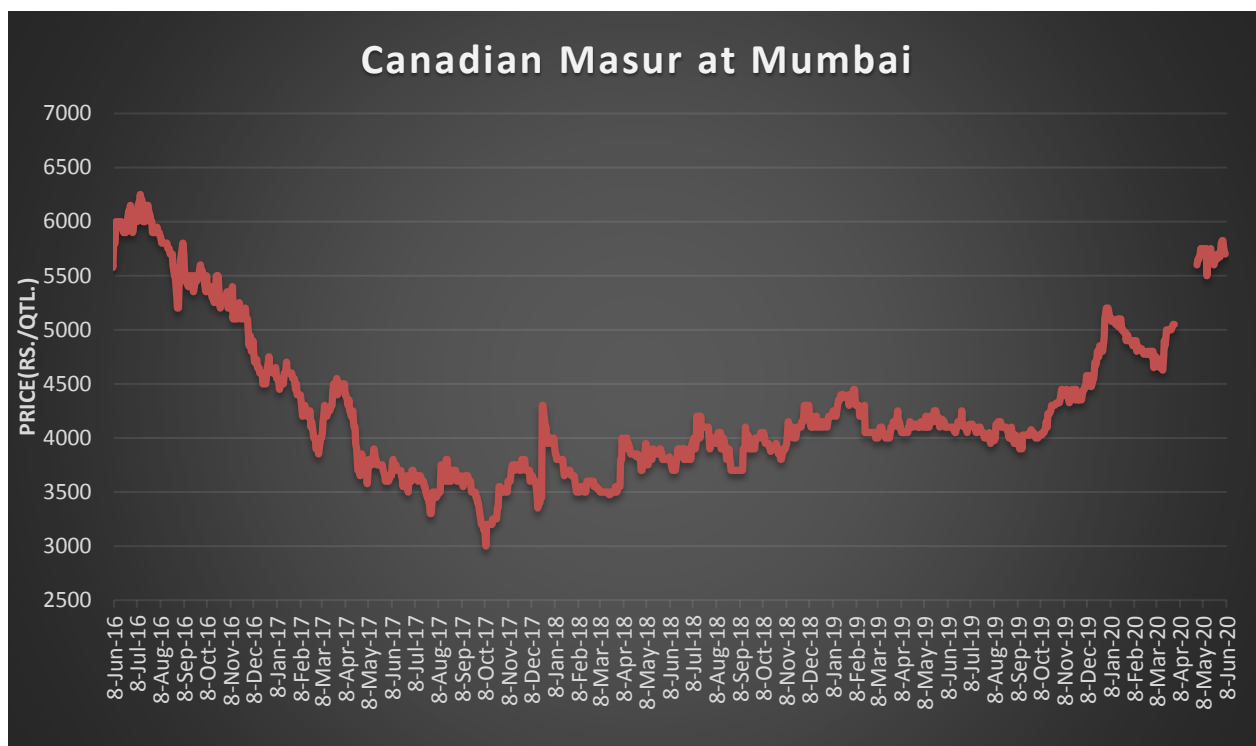
Market Outlook For June: Steady to slightly weak movement is expected.

Masoor (Lentils):

In a latest development govt. has slashed import duty on masur from effective 30 % to 10 % till 31st August-2020 to cool down prices in domestic market. It has encouraged masur price in Australia and Canada. Canada Crimson price increased from \$600 to \$675 per MT while Australian nipper increased from \$680 to \$715 per MT. Australian Nugget increased from \$620 to \$680 per MT. Market considers duty reduction was unnecessary at this point of time. International market is already up by \$75 per MT. It would not help domestic market much.

Stock at port is lower than normal expectation and this month two vessels are expected. As exporting countries have increased price with changed duty structure in India, import flow is unlikely to **increase unexpectedly**. Under prevailing condition masur cash market may improve stay steady. As prices are ruling higher than MSP, so govt.s agencies would not be able to procure 1.21 lakh MT, set target for the year. As of now, only 1403.23 MT has been procured. Old stock with Nafed is around 21,000 MT.

Price Trend In Cash Market:

**Price Dynamics:**

In May-2020s, average price in key market Kanpur was up by 185 % from Rs 5625 to Rs 5700 per qtl. MoM basis. Prices are likely to trade steady in June-2020 .

Steady movement is expected due to:

- *Balanced supply and demand side amid decreasing new arrival*
- *Lower availability of stock with Nafed*
- *Lower volume of imported stock despite downward revision of duty till 31st Aug-2020.*
- *Weak demand in retail market due to free distribution of dal by central govt for three months to June, may be extended one month.*

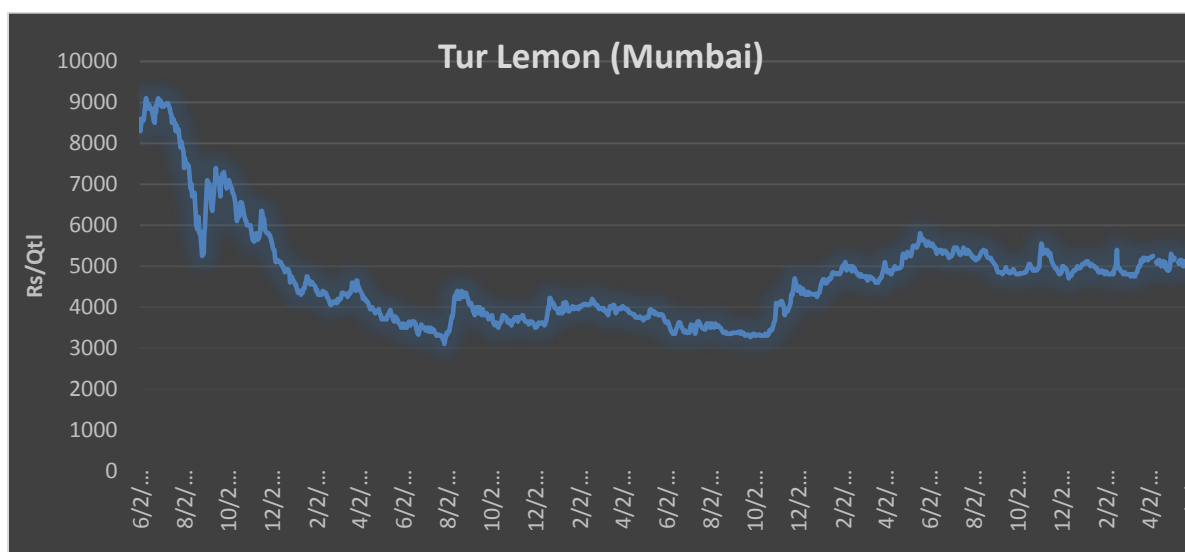
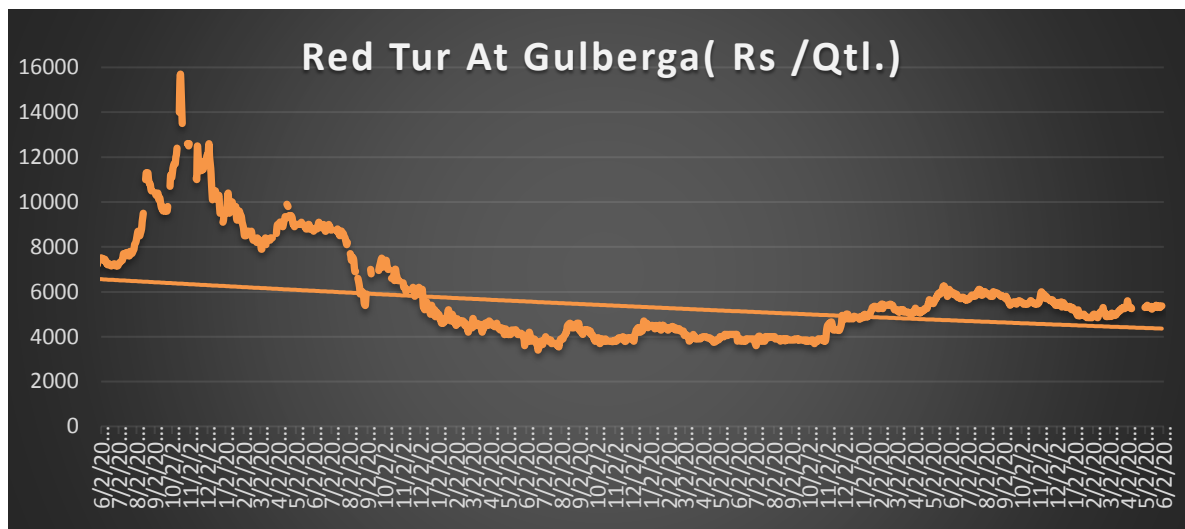

Tur (Toor/Arhar/Red Gram/Pigeon Pea/Aware):**Fundamental Analysis and Outlook:**

Tur cash market improved due to fresh demand from mills and slower pace of arrivals. Supply from Karnataka, MH continues for other states. In Latur market it traded Rs 200 up and may continue to trade firm in coming weeks. Arrival in Latur market was reported at 1000-1200 bags while it was higher in Gulberga. As prices are ruling lower, stockiest are unwilling to sell tur at lower price right now. Tur price may move further up by Rs 200-300 from current level. Right now in Gulberga market it is being traded at Rs 5300-5400. Import is due in this month and quantity is higher. So any spike is unlikely in June.

Market Recap:

Tur procurement target has been fixed at 545573MT. As of now (10th June-2020) 5.20 lakh MT tur has been purchased. With new purchase and old stock with Nafed combined is around 5.51 lakh MT. As a nodal agencies Nafed and FCI would procure tur this year, supported by some state agencies too. FCI is procuring tur in Karnataka. Procurement target has been decreased this year due to lower kharif crop size, so that supply in open market would be lower. Crop size may cross 37lakh MT. Import quota has been fixed at 4lakh MT for 2020-21. Back log of last year has been imported till 31st May-2020. Cash market is expected to trade in the range of Rs 5200-5500 during June-2020..



Price Dynamics:

In May-2020, average price in Gulberga market was up by 2.50% from 5200 to Rs 5250-5350 per qtl. due to procurement drive and fresh demand from mills amid lower pace of import. Tur price in June is likely to improve due to

- Improved pace of procurement
- Slower import pace despite duty slash
- Exporting countries increased price to match duty slash.



- Below normal crop(average of 3 years is 40 lakh MT)

Seasonality Index-depicts steady to slightly firm movement.

Market Outlook for June:

Fundamental remains supportive for Tur cash market in the near term.

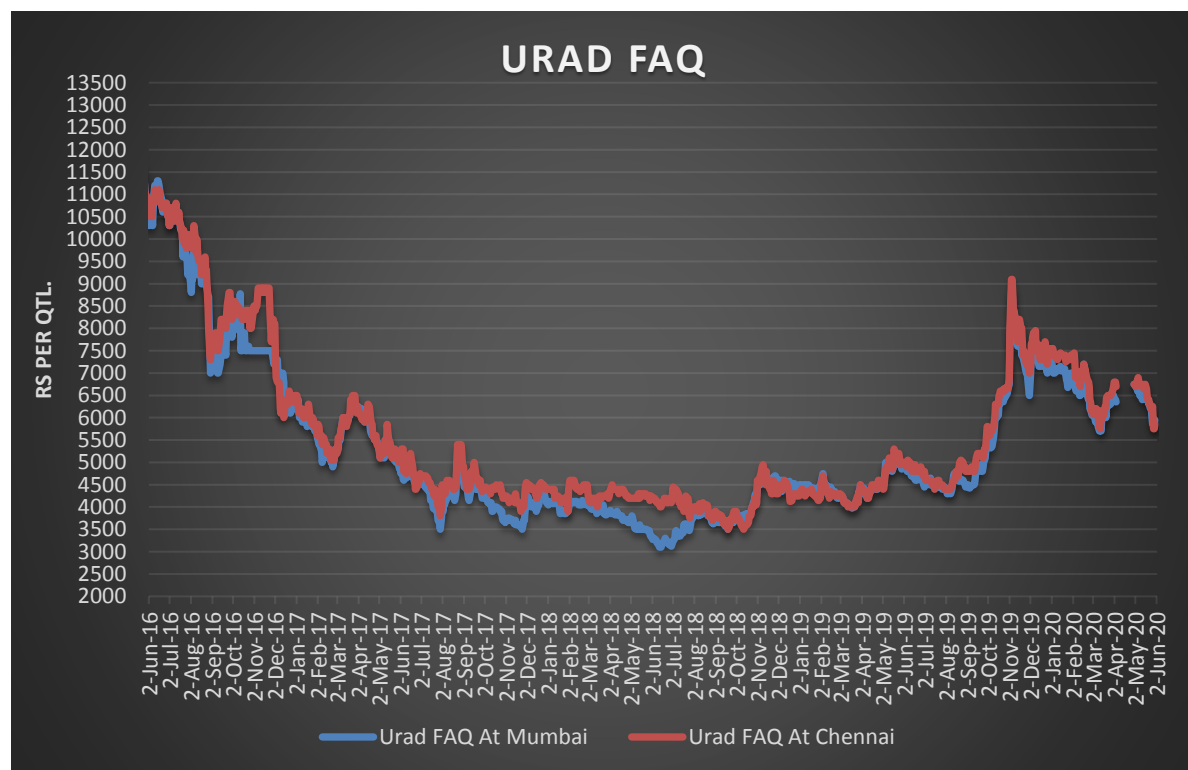

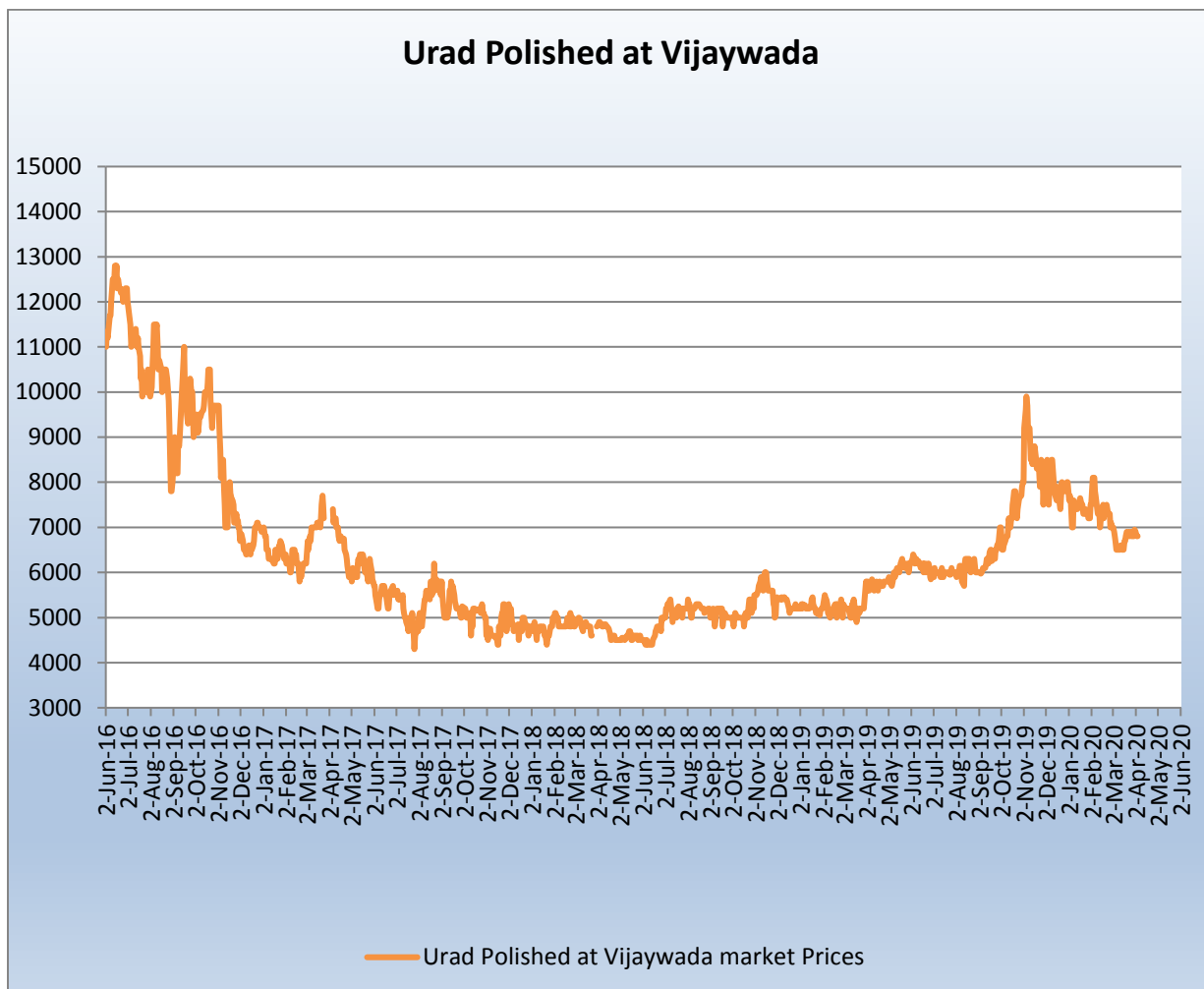

Market Recap:

The DGFT has decreased the time line for 4 lakh MT urad import quota from 31st March-2021 to 31August-2020. As time frame for import has been reduced, The DGFT would issue license soon(June).It woud impact the market sentiments and cash market would trade down by Rs200 to 300 from current level. Notably, import of back log is yet to hit Indian ports.The time line for back log import for ongoing MY has been extended till 31st May-2020.Besides,new kharif crop would be available from Aug.So pressure seems building on urad price.

Even supply side would be adequate in coming weeks. Urad in Mumbai market traded at Rs 6500-6650 and may decrease to Rs 6300-6100.In Chennai market it is being offered at Rs 6600-6700 and SQ at Rs7200-7400 per qtl. Overall trend remains weak.





Seasonality Index depicts range steady to slightly weak tone in the near to medium term.

Price Dynamics:

In May, average prices in key markets including Mumbai/was up by 2.5 % percent from 6450 per qtl. to 6750 in May. In Chennai it was up by 6.5% to 7300. Prices may stay steady to slightly weak in June due to

- Higher import quota(4.0lakh MT) and commencement new arrival from Rabi crop
- Selling of old stock from central pool
- Weak demand at higher level
- Good crop condition so far and
- Cheaper availability of other pulses.

Market Outlook for June : Prices are likely to trade steady to slightly weak .

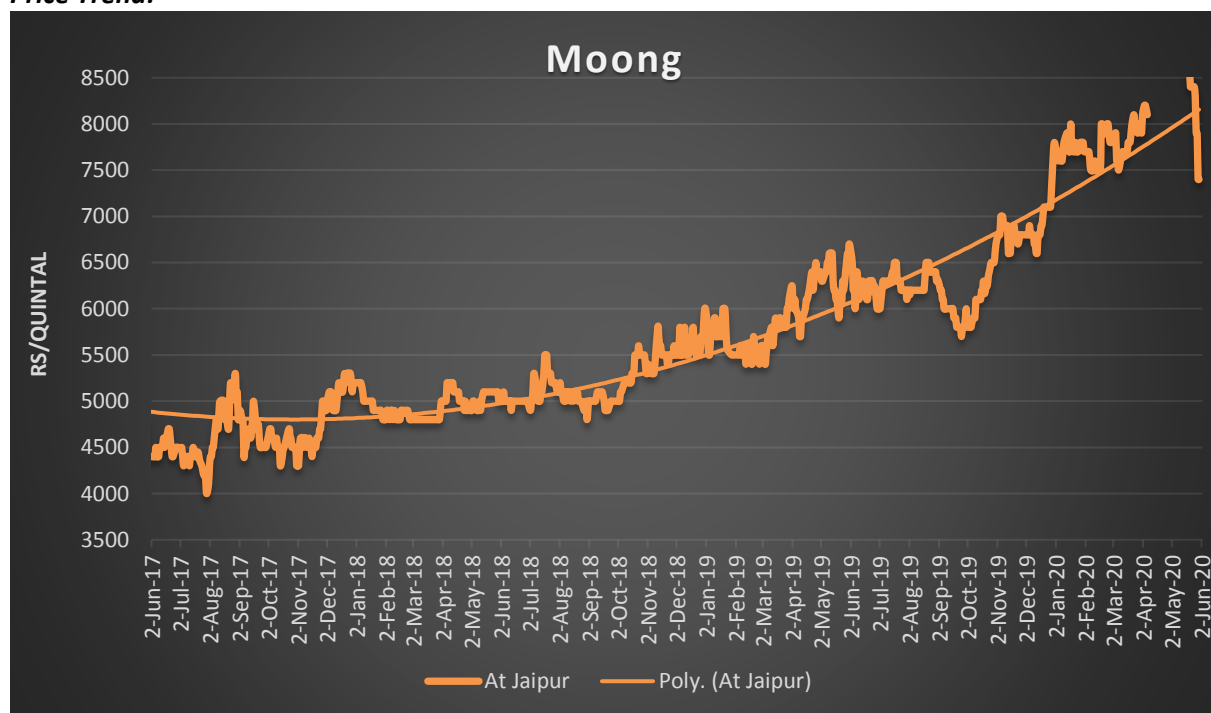
Market Recap:

Moong arrival in Harda market was seen decreasing. Farmers continued to bring moong uncleaned and thus they received lower than expected price in markets. Superior quality moong was traded at Rs 6500 to 6771 per qtl. As pressure is likely to continue, prices may decrease further by Rs200 from current level. Kharif moong sowing is likely to start from 20th June in MP, Rajasthan while in other states it may commence by the end of this month. Better crop size in summer crop and good prospects in kharif would not allow moong market to move beyond MSP level. Demand too has weakened at higher level.

Price Dynamics:

Arrival of new summer moong in Khirkiya and adjoining regions begins. Quality of moong is very good and total arrival in these regions was reported at 2000 bags and may increase to 5000 bags in next one week. The new moong was traded at Rs 8500-8600 per qtl. With increasing arrival, prices are expected to decrease further by Rs300-400 from current level. Quality is good while moisture level is higher right now. Millers are active at this price. Apart from this new arrival in Saurashtra district begins and from UP and Bihar it is expected from 15th of May. So, moong price is bound to decrease from current level. With relaxation in lock down, supply side may ease in coming weeks.

Price Trend:



Market is expected to trade weak in June due to:

- Likely arrival in markets from Jayer (between rabi and kharif season) crop
- Quality of new crop is good and abundantly available in Rajasthan, UP, MP and Bihar
- Old stock in central pool
- Increased availability of moong in global market and



- Weak demand due to free distribution of pulses by central and state govt till June(Around 5.5 lakh MT pulses are likely to be distributed among people throughout country).

Seasonality Index depicts weak movement in the near term.

Market Outlook for June: Steady to slightly weak movement is expected.
