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Commodity-wise Domestic, International Prices and Arrivals at Different Centers

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Highlights

Domestic:

- Pulses market noticed range-bound to firm movement.
- Domestic cash markets witnessed thin trading activities on Diwali festivities.
- The cyclonic storm, 'NILOFAR' over westcentral and adjoining southwest Arabian Sea moved northwards, intensified into a severe cyclonic storm and about 1180 km southwest of Naliya (Gujarat). It would intensify further into a very severe cyclonic storm. It would recurve towards northeastwards and cross north Gujarat around Naliya by 31st October morning.
- According to Ministry of Agriculture, rabi pulses 2014-15 coverage is trailing to 3.31 lakh Ha. compared with 3.78 lakh ha. during the corresponding period of last year.
- According to the farm sources, commencement of chana sowing reported in Northern Karnataka.
- Delhi State Food and Supplies Department has imposed the pulses stock limit of 2000 quintals for wholesalers and 50 quintals for retailers. There is, however, no upper limit for imported pulses. There is no upper stock limit for the commission agents who do not retain any consignment of pulses received for a period exceeding 15 days from the date of its receipt.
- Indian farmers may sow higher masoor area on relatively better returns from other crops.
- According to Maharashtra Agriculture Department, following is rabi pulses sowing progress till Oct.22,2014:

- The exemption of stock limit on imported pulses extended till September 30, 2015
- The exemption of Customs Duty on imported pulses extended till December 31st, 2014 for Garbanzos and till March 31st, 2015 for other Pulses.
- According to Ministry of Agriculture, around 102.34 lakh hectare of area has been sown under pulses (Kharif) this year as on October 10, around 6.17% lower than the previous year, when it was 109.08 lakh hectares during the same period.
- For the country as a whole, cumulative rainfall during this year's monsoon has till September 30, 2014 has been 12% below the Long Period Average (LPA). The actual rainfall recorded at 777.5 mm against the 886.9 mm of normal rainfall-IMD.

International Fundamental:

- In Canada, pulses harvesting almost complete.
- The USDA's Commodity Credit Corporation office release purchase tender of 8,240 metric tonnes (MT) of pulses for shipment in December and January.

Lower Pulses Production in Canada & USA During 14-15; Except Record USA Chana :AAFC

In Canada, dry peas production is estimated to decrease by 11% to 3.5 Mt during 2014-15 on lower yields. Saskatchewan is expected to account for 2.0 Mt of the dry pea production, Alberta over 1.4 Mt, with the remainder of the production in Manitoba and British Columbia. Exports are

forecast to increase to 2.8 Mt, with India, China and Bangladesh continuing to be three markets. Green dry peas prices are expected to maintain a premium of C\$75/t over yellow dry peas, which are above the historical average, but well below the C\$165/t premium green peas had over yellow peas last year. The lentil production is estimated to fall by 19% to below 1.8 Mt. The Large green production is forecast to fall from last year to over 0.4 Mt, while red lentil production is expected to be unchanged at 1.2 Mt. Production of the other remaining lentil types is expected to fall to just over 0.1 Mt. Large green lentil prices are forecast to maintain a premium over red lentil prices, compared to a C\$30/t discount to red types in 2013-14. The chana production is estimated to decrease by 20% to 141 kt in 2014-15, largely due to lower yields. The carry-out stocks are expected to fall but remain burdensome.

In USA, area seeded under dry peas for 2014-15 is forecast by the USDA to rise by 8% from 2013-14 on high area in Montana and North Dakota. Meanwhile, AAFC also increase USA dry peas production forecast by 8% to 0.78 Mt. The area seeded under lentils for 2014-15 is forecast by the USDA at 0.3 mln acres, down 12% from 2013-14 due to lower area seeded in Montana. Meanwhile, AAFC also estimate decline of lentil production by 19% in to 0.2 Mt in 2013-14. The chickpea area seeded is estimated by the USDA at a record 0.22 mln acres, up 4% from 2013-14. This is largely due to higher area seeded in the state of Montana. Meanwhile, AAFC forecast slightly higher 0.16 Mt production than last year.

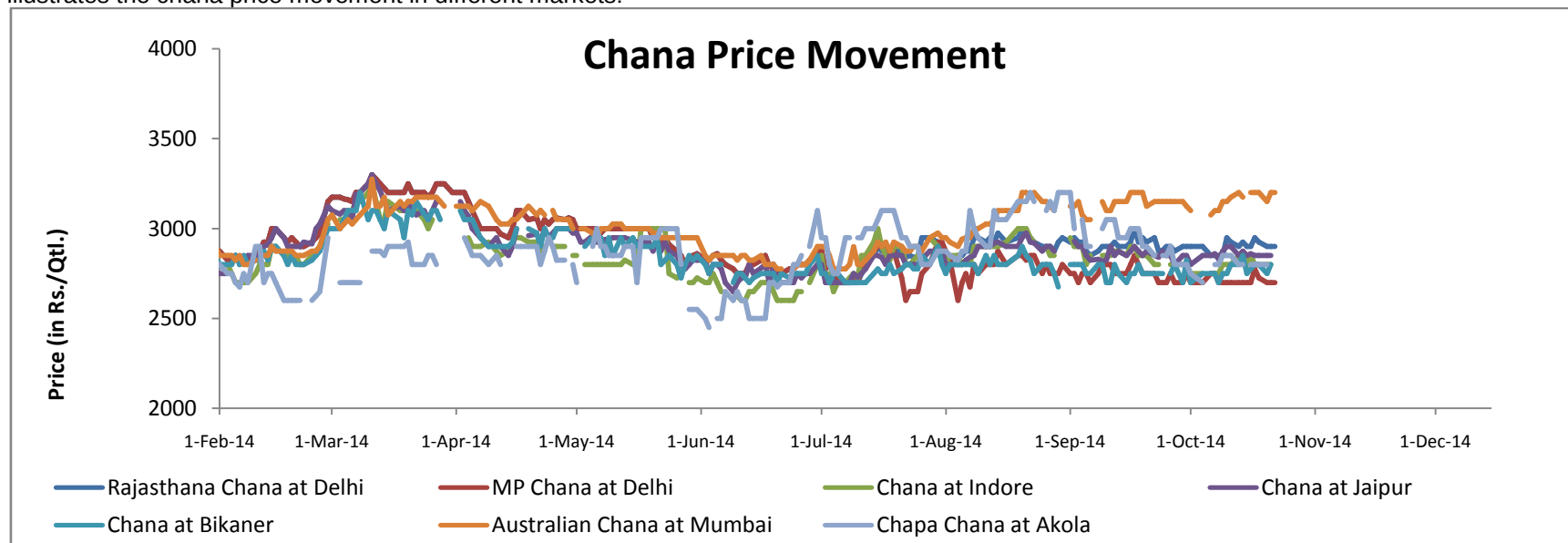

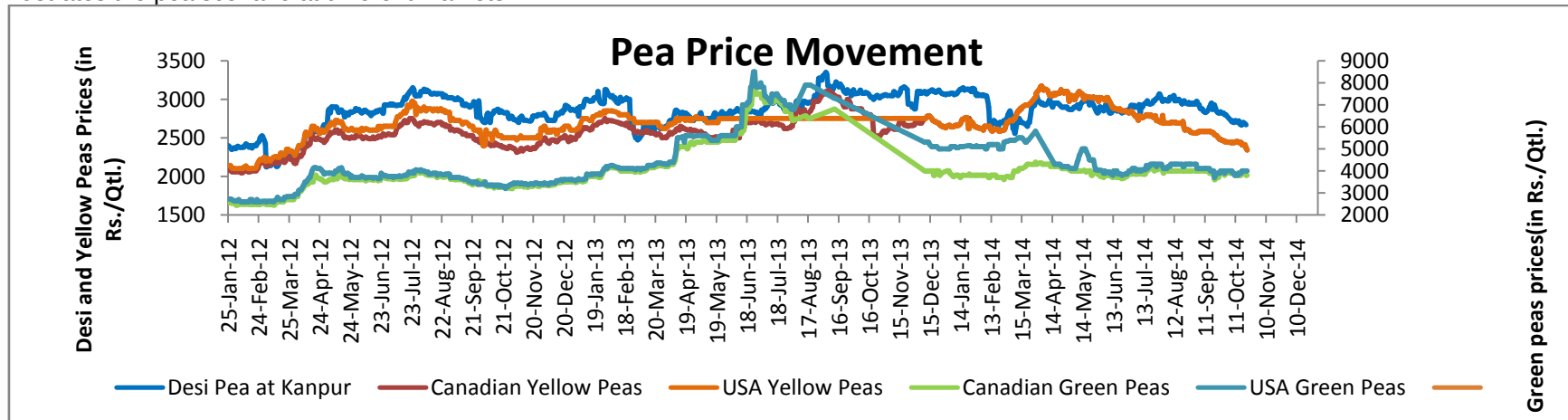

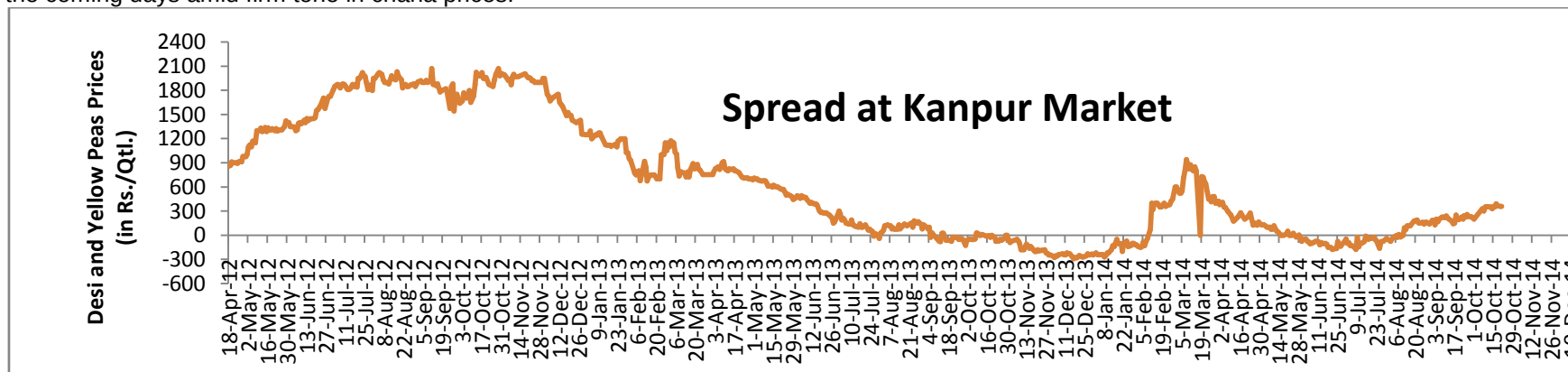

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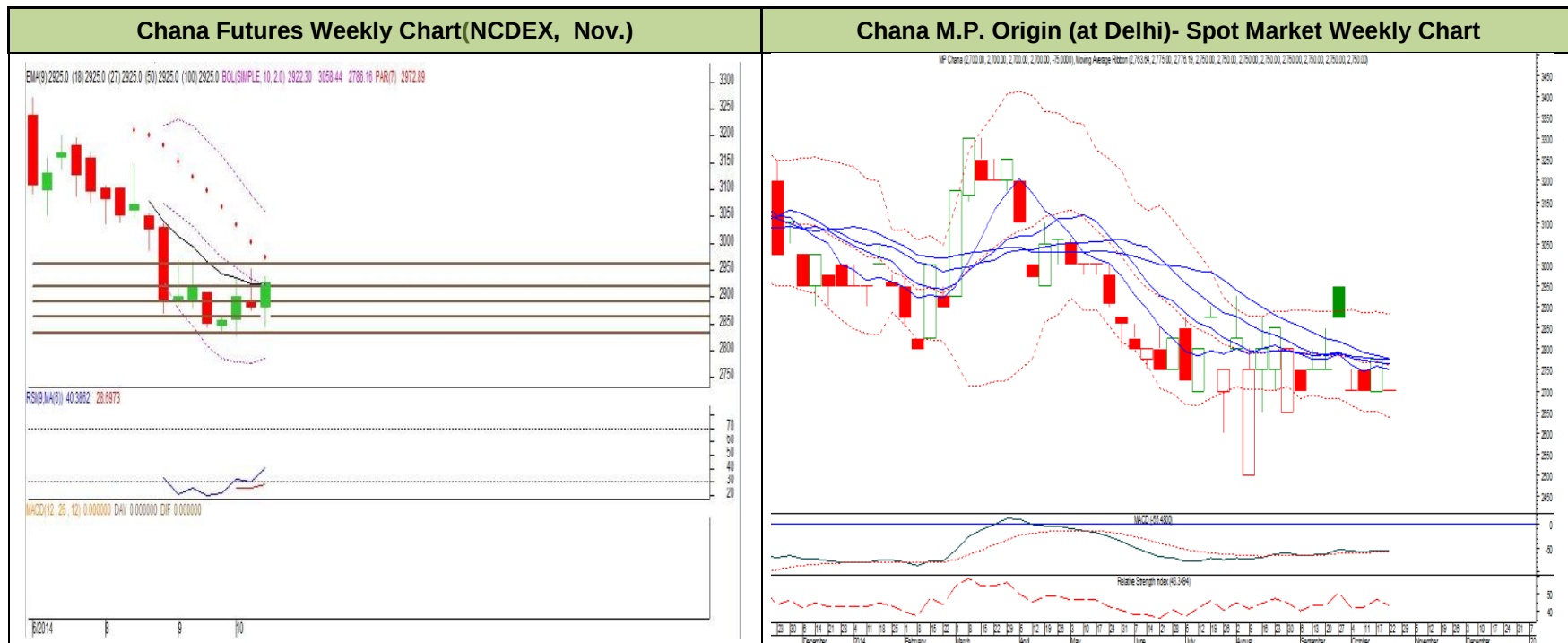

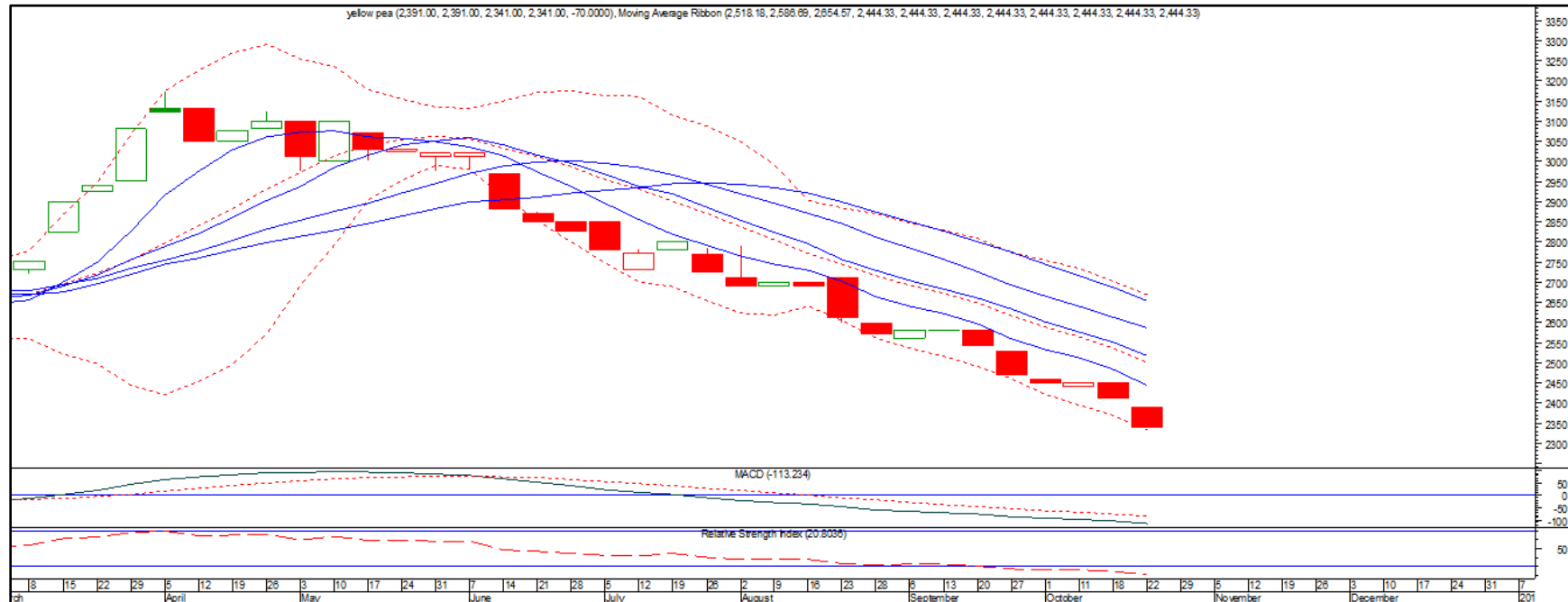

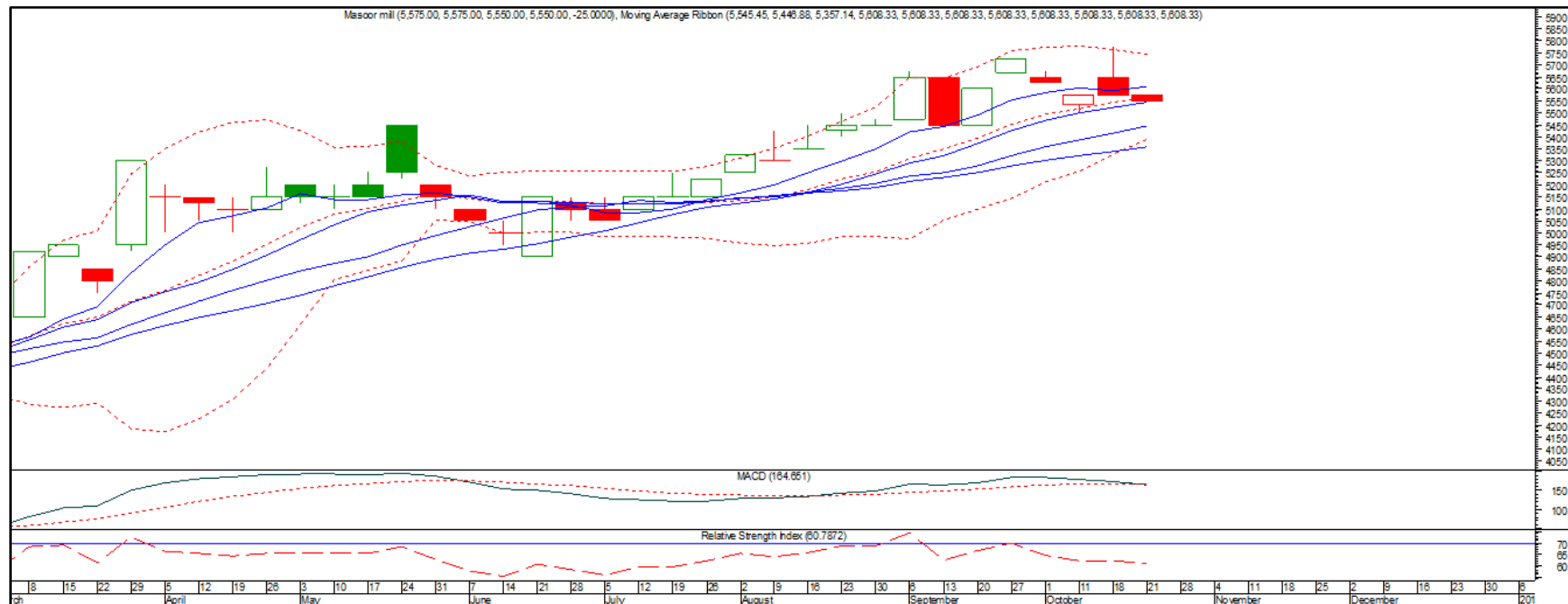

Tur (at Gulbarga) Spot Market Weekly Chart



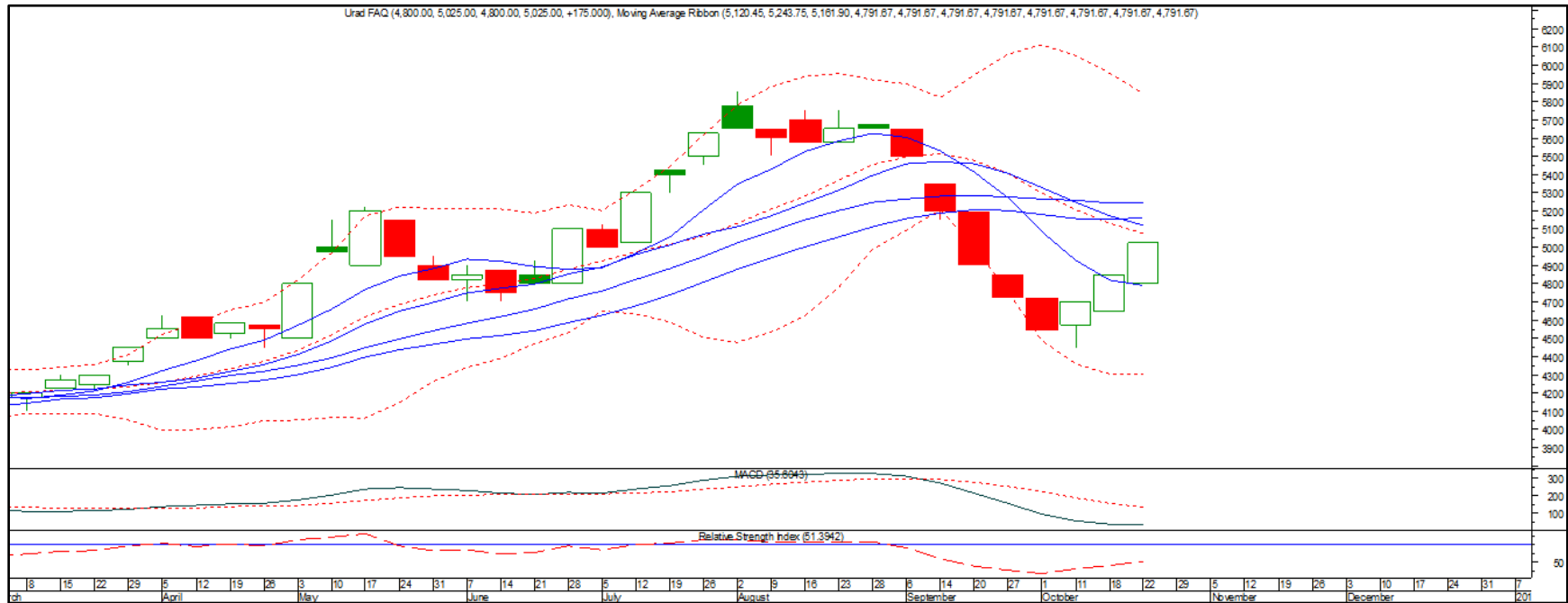

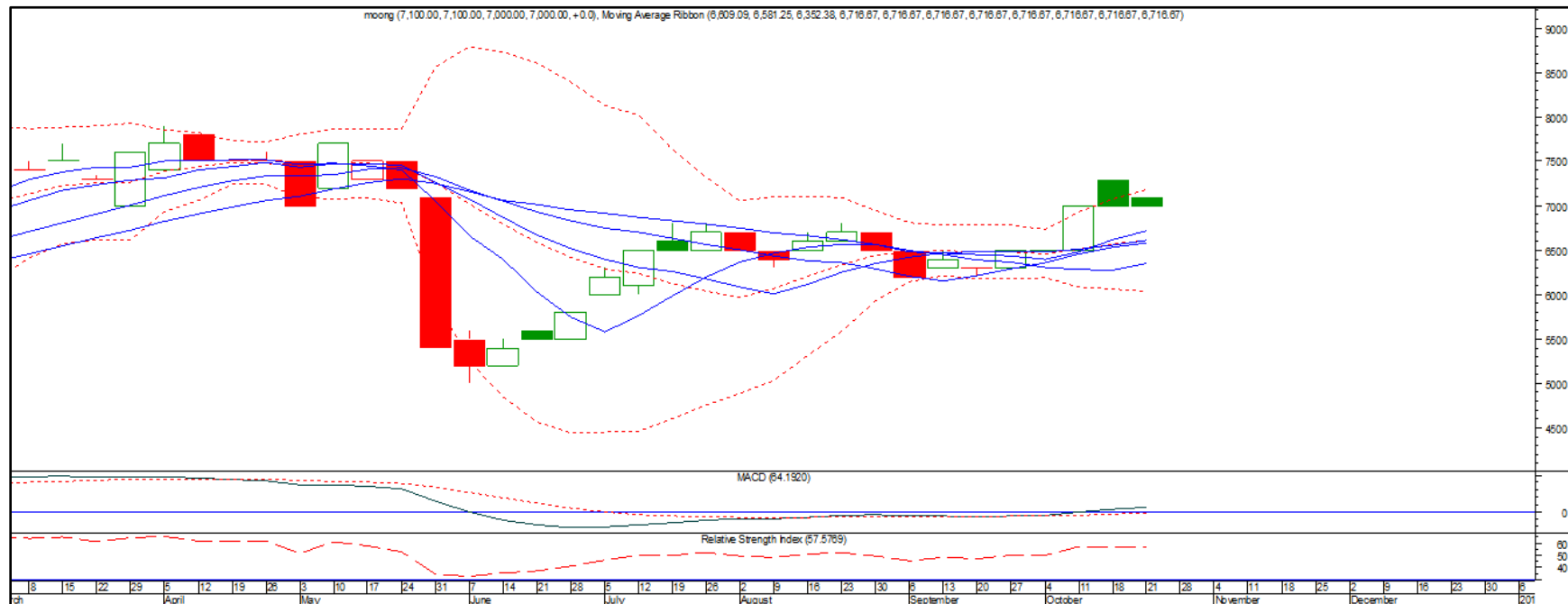

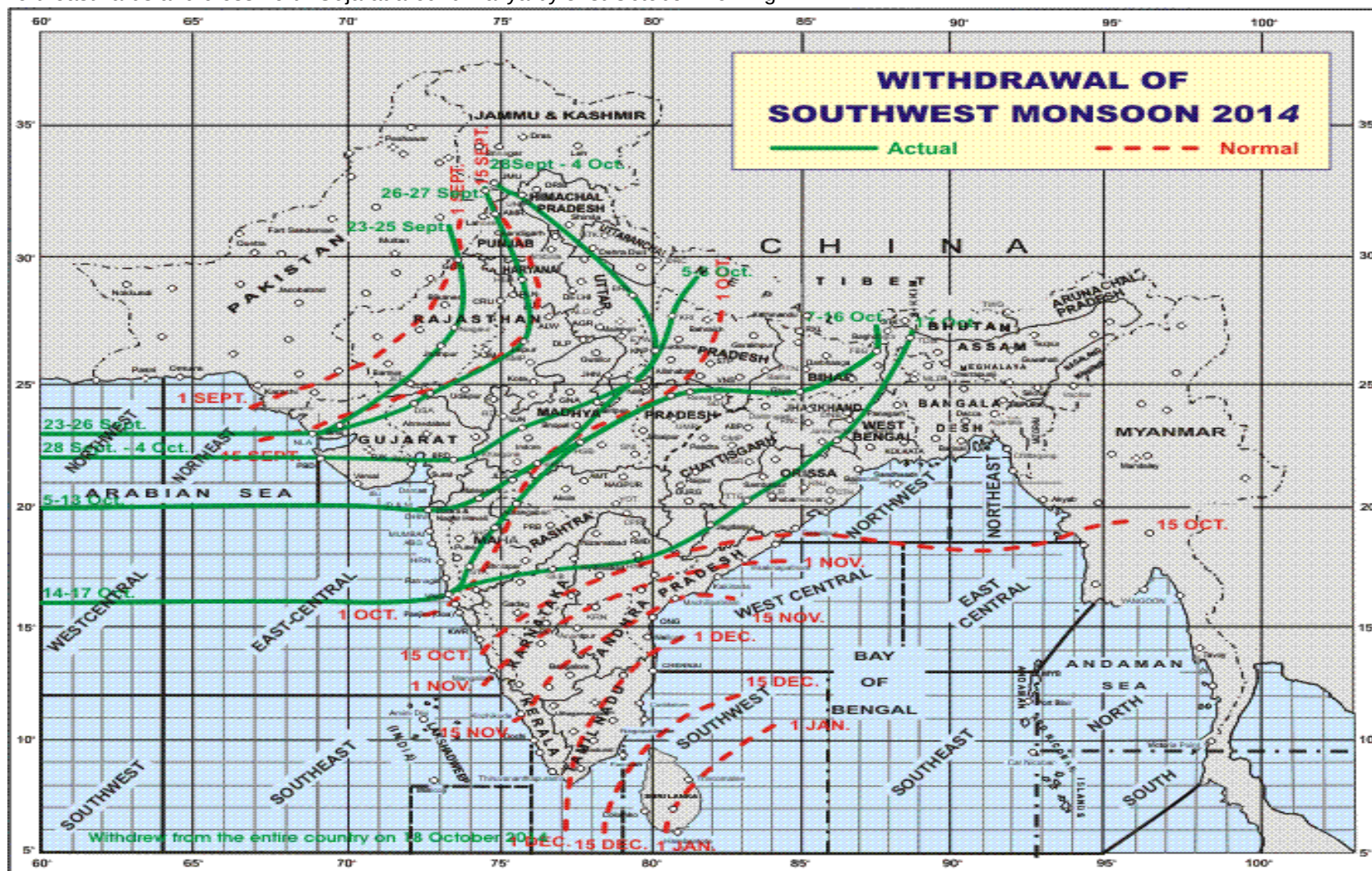

Monsoon 2014

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- The cyclonic storm, 'NILOFAR' over westcentral and adjoining southwest Arabian Sea moved northwards, intensified into a severe cyclonic storm and about 1180 km southwest of Naliya (Gujarat). It would intensify further into a very severe cyclonic storm. It would recurve towards northeastwards and cross north Gujarat around Naliya by 31st October morning.

- ✓ For the country as a whole, the rainfall for the season (June-September) was 88% of its long period average (LPA).
- ✓ Seasonal rainfall was 79% of its LPA over Northwest India, 90% of its LPA over Central India, 93% of its LPA over south Peninsula and 88% of its LPA over Northeast (NE) India.
- ✓ Out of the total 36 meteorological subdivisions, 23 subdivisions constituting 67% of the total area of the country received normal season rainfall and 12 subdivisions (30% of the total area of the country) received deficient season rainfall. One subdivision (South Interior Karnataka) constituting 3% of the total area of the country received excess rainfall.

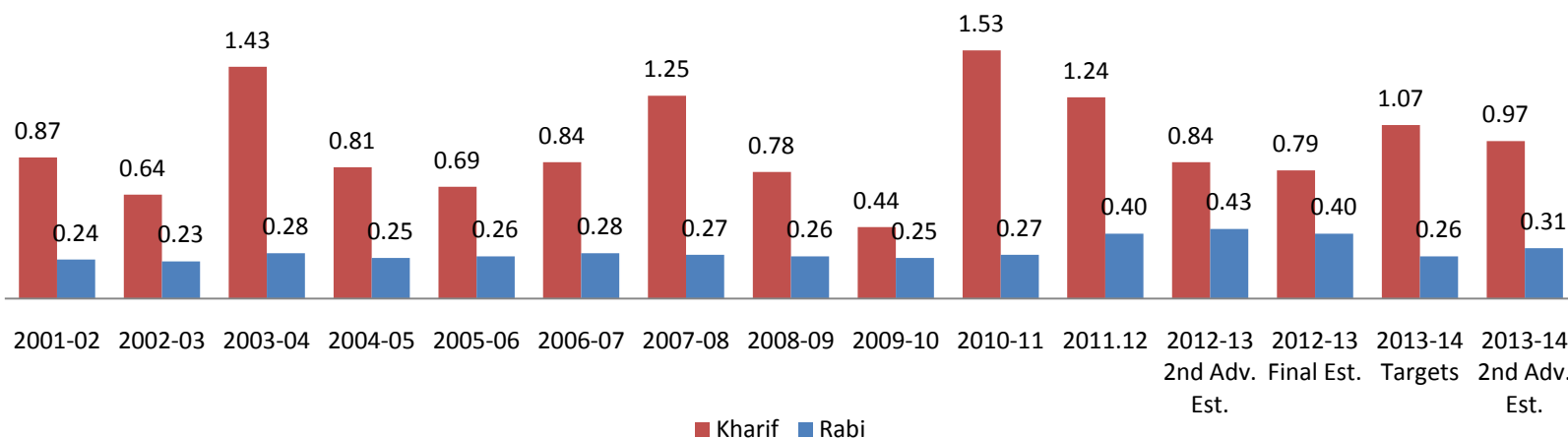
Gram in Rabi (Production in million Tonnes)



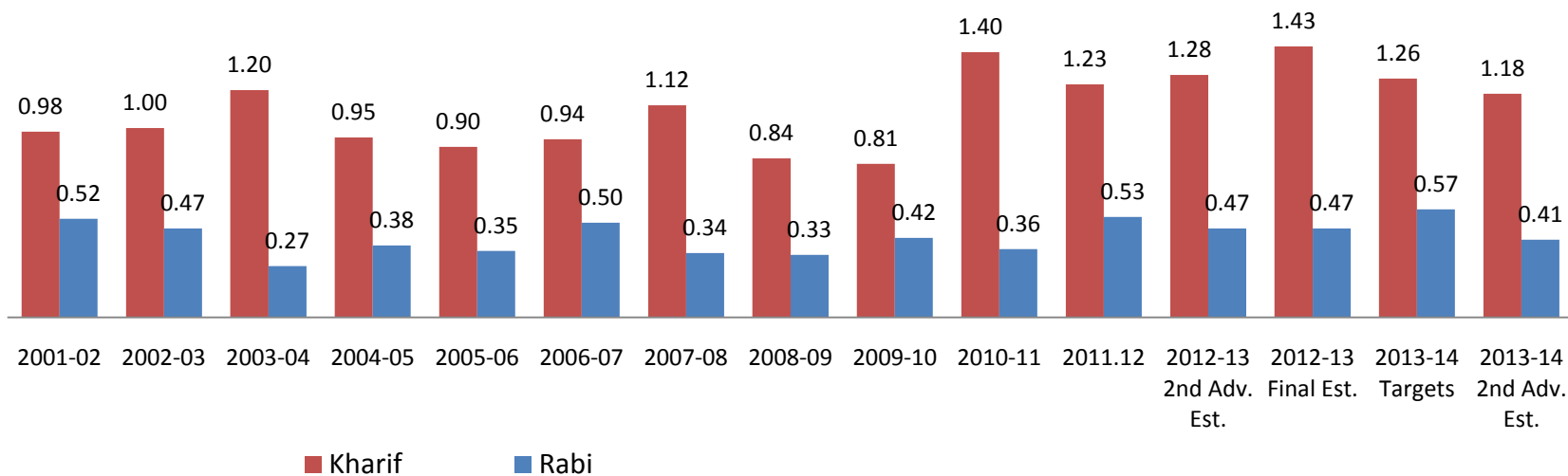

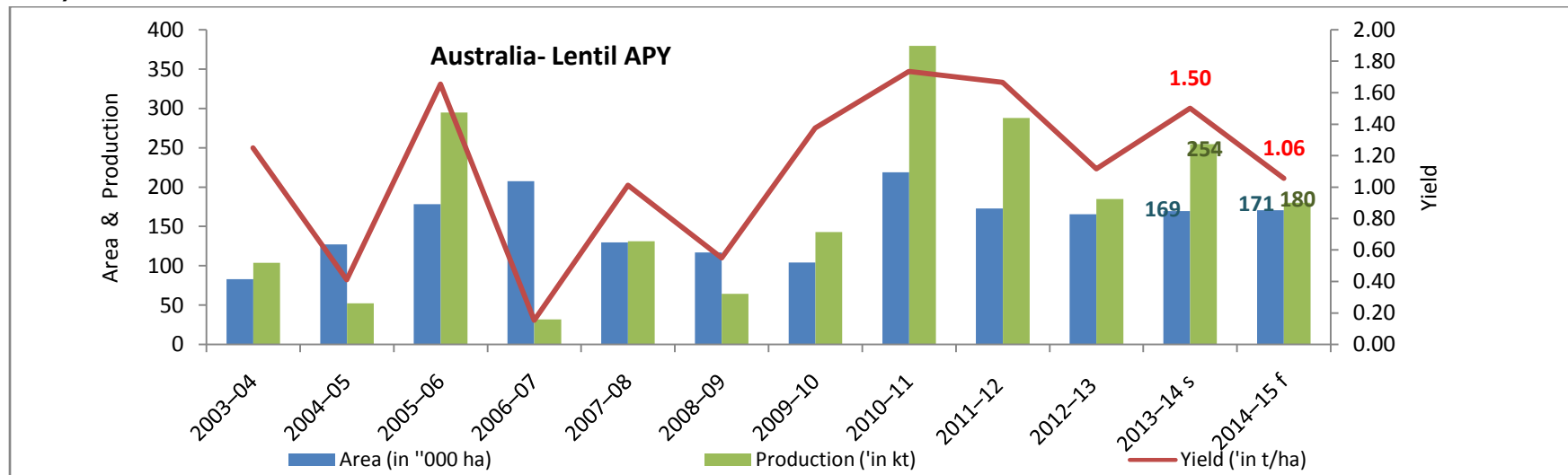
a) Field Pea



b) Chickpea



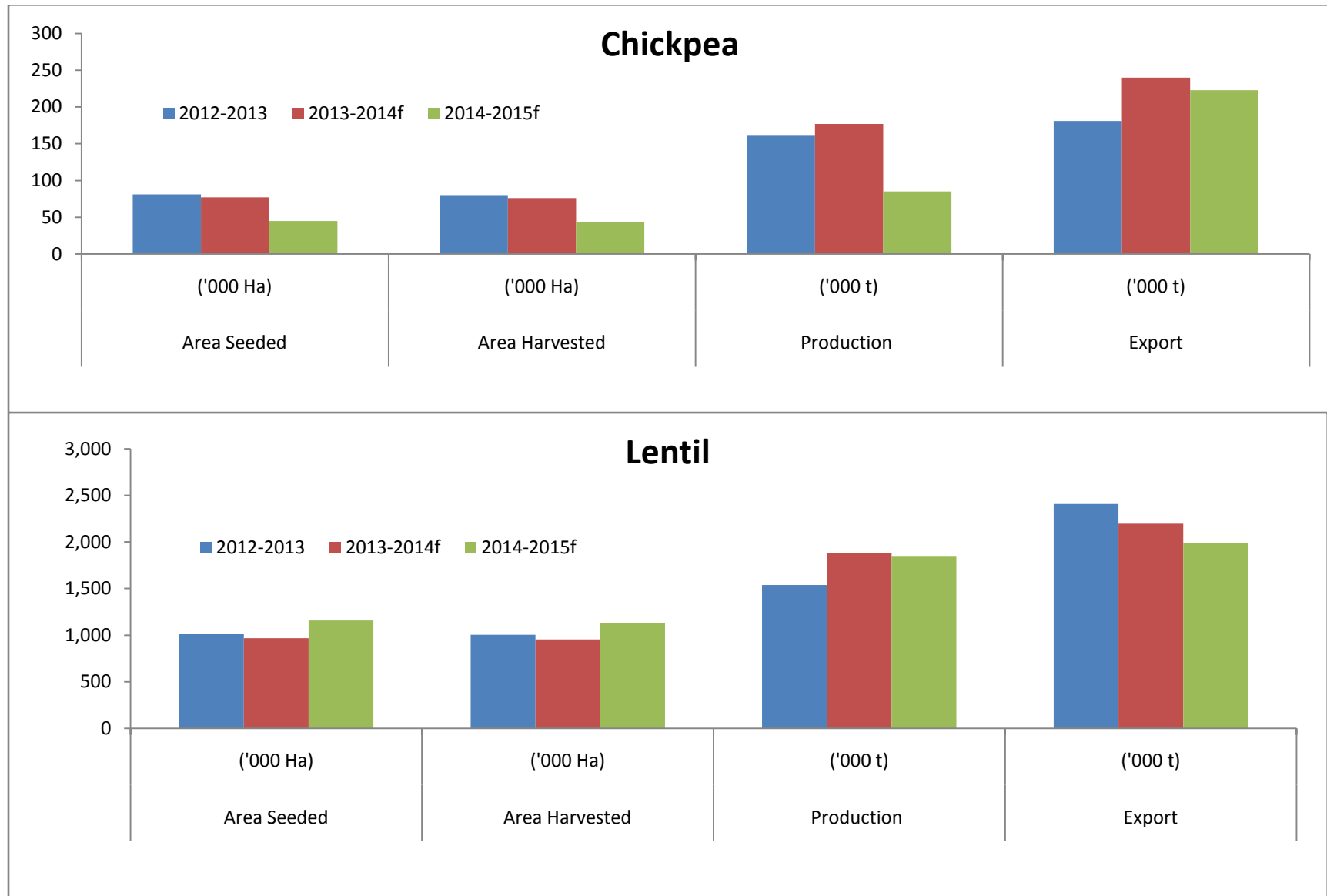

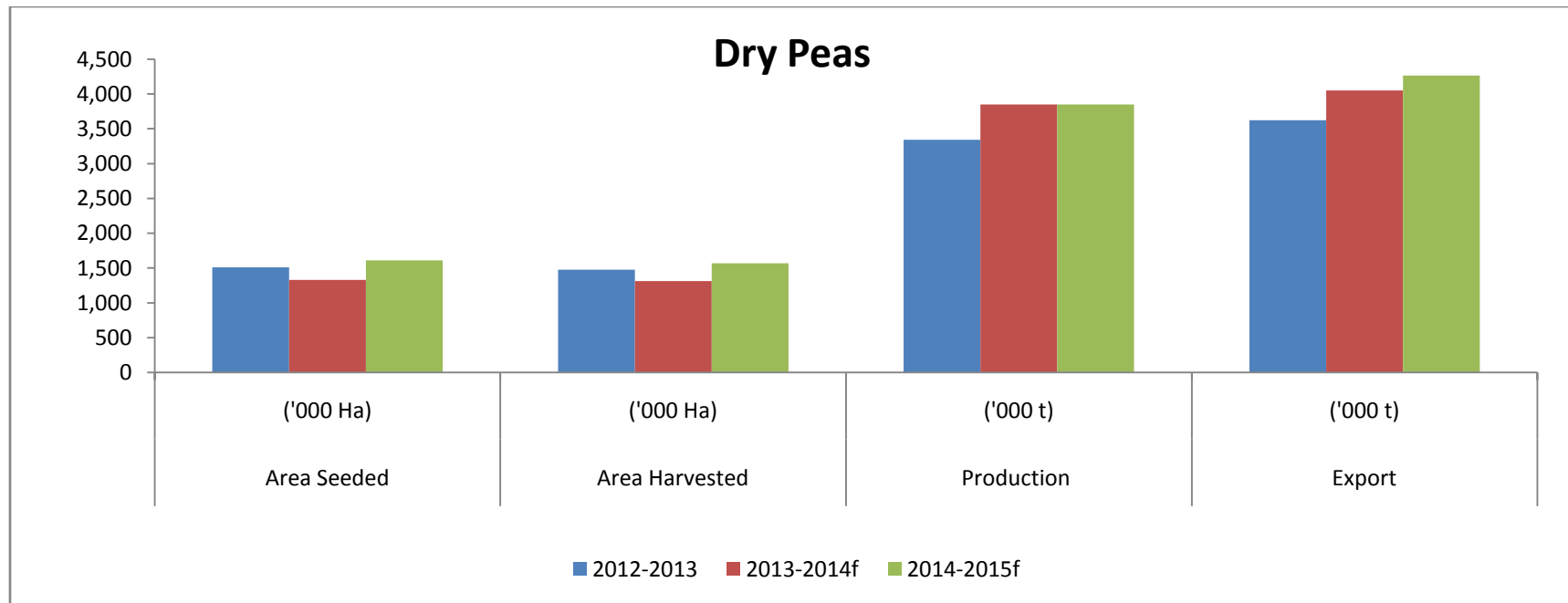
