- Subsidies to Mini Pulses Mill**-Ministry of Food Processing Industries has provided subsidy to various Food Processing Industries including Mini Pulses Mills in the country including Uttar Pradesh under the Scheme of Technology Upgradation/ Establishment/ Modernization of Food Processing Industries (TUS). Ministry extends financial assistance in the form of grant-in-aid to entrepreneurs @ 25% of the cost of Plant & Machinery and Technical Civil Works subject to a maximum of Rs. 50 lakhs in general areas or 33.33% subject to a maximum of Rs. 75 lakhs in difficult areas. The committed/spillover liabilities of 11th Plan is being considered during 12th Plan under the scheme. Now, the said scheme has been subsumed in the National Mission on Food Processing(NMFP) implemented through State/UT Governments during 12th Plan i.e. w.e.f. 1.4.2012. Under the Mission, State Governments are empowered to receive the applications, sanction and release the grants-in-aid to the eligible beneficiaries. Mission also provides flexibility to States / UTs in the selection of beneficiaries and location of projects etc. for the development of food processing sectors.

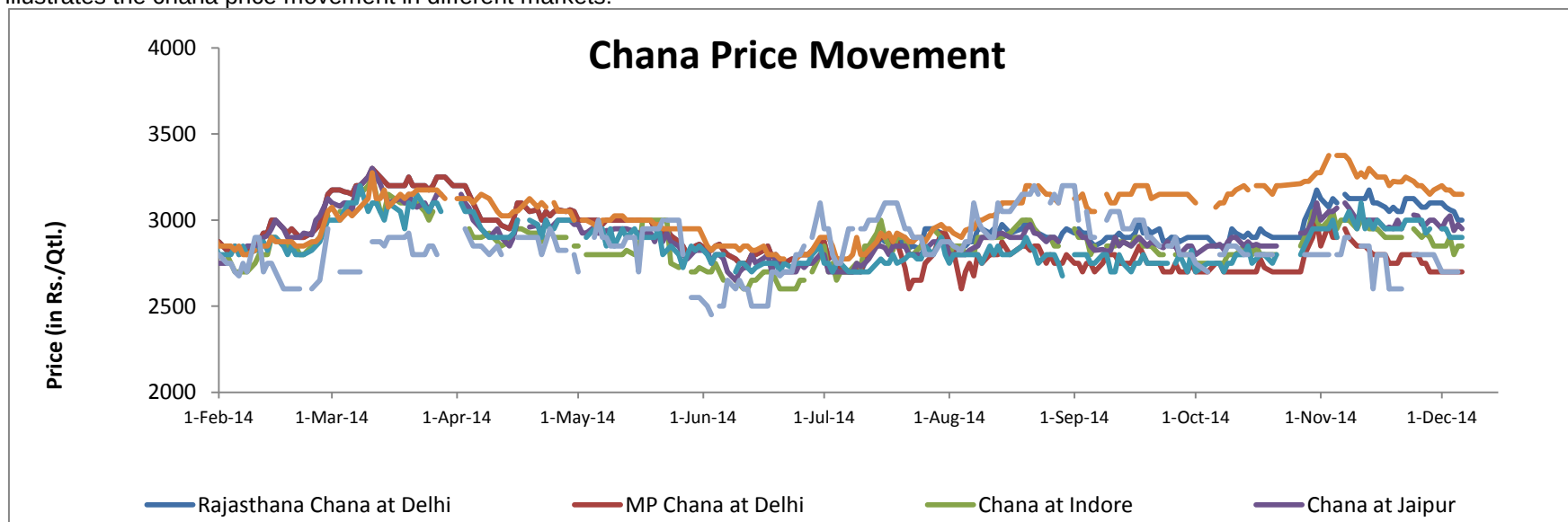

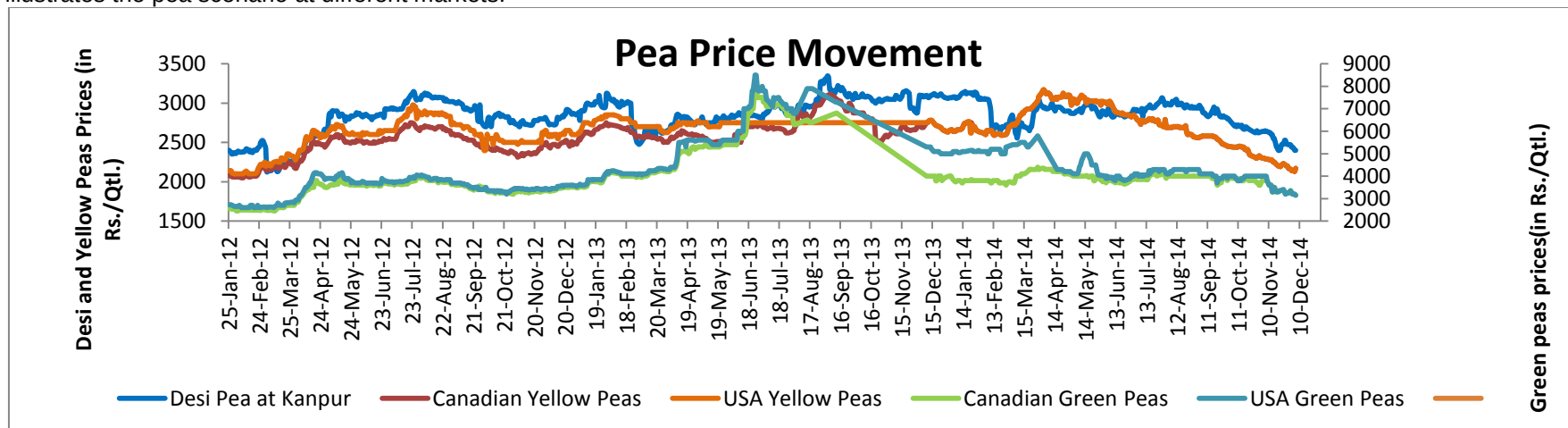

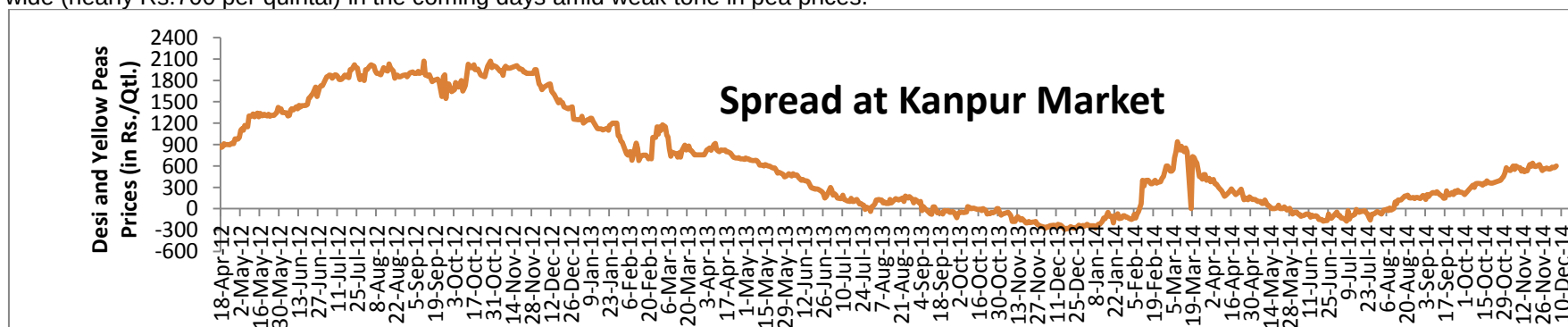

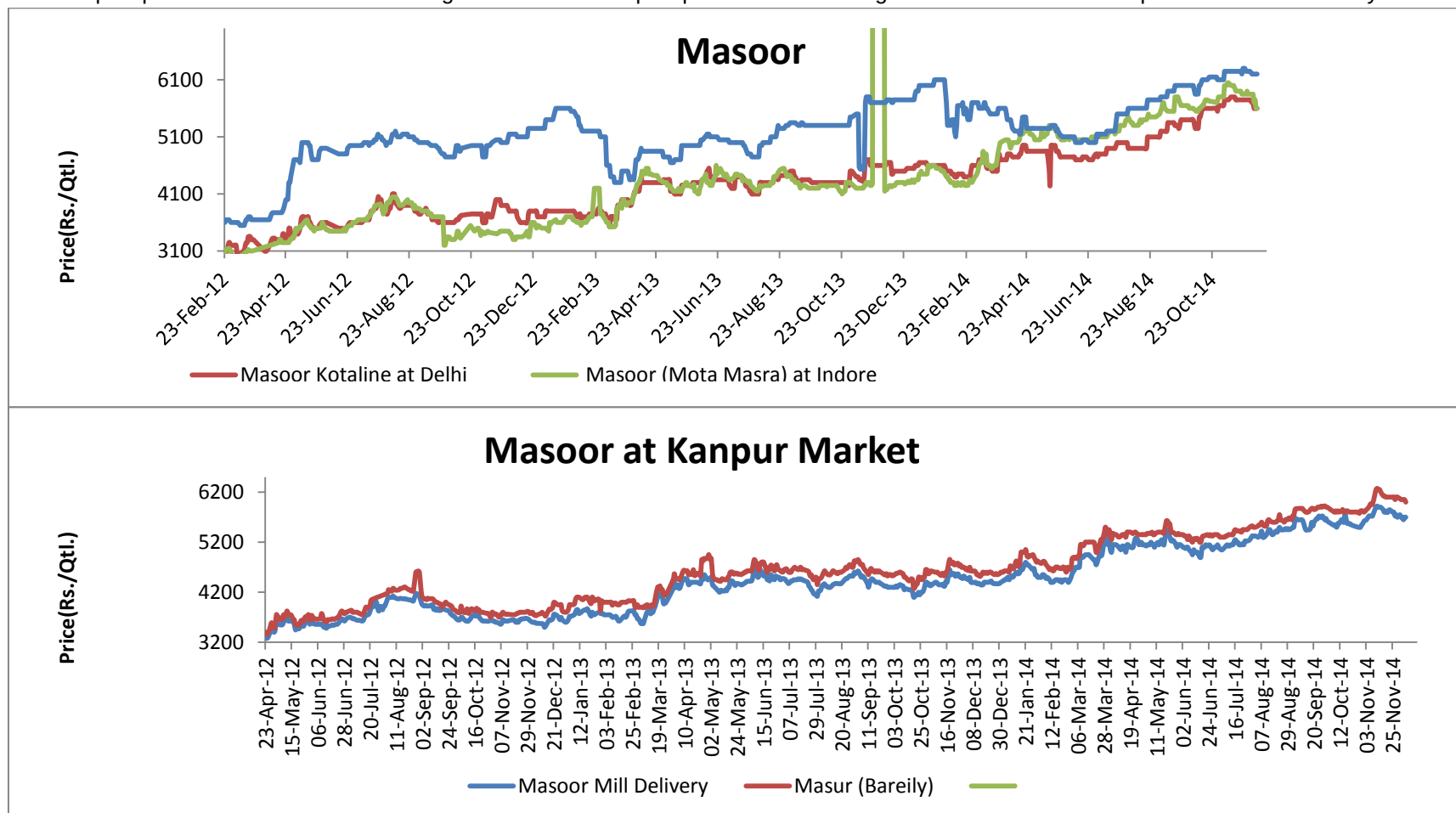

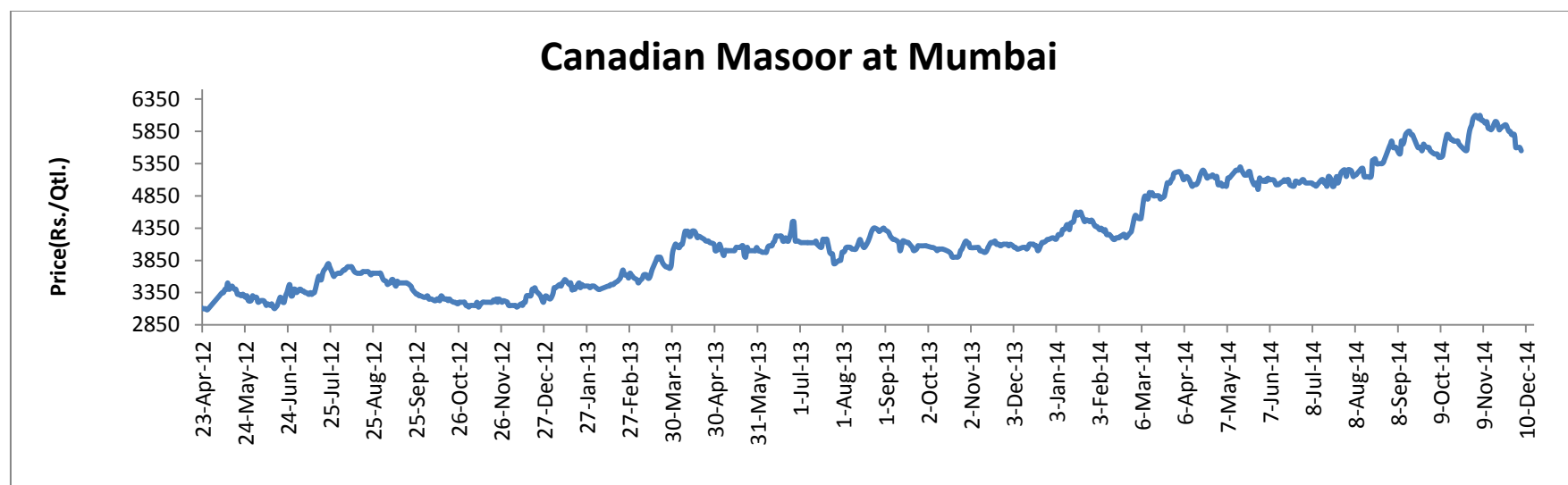

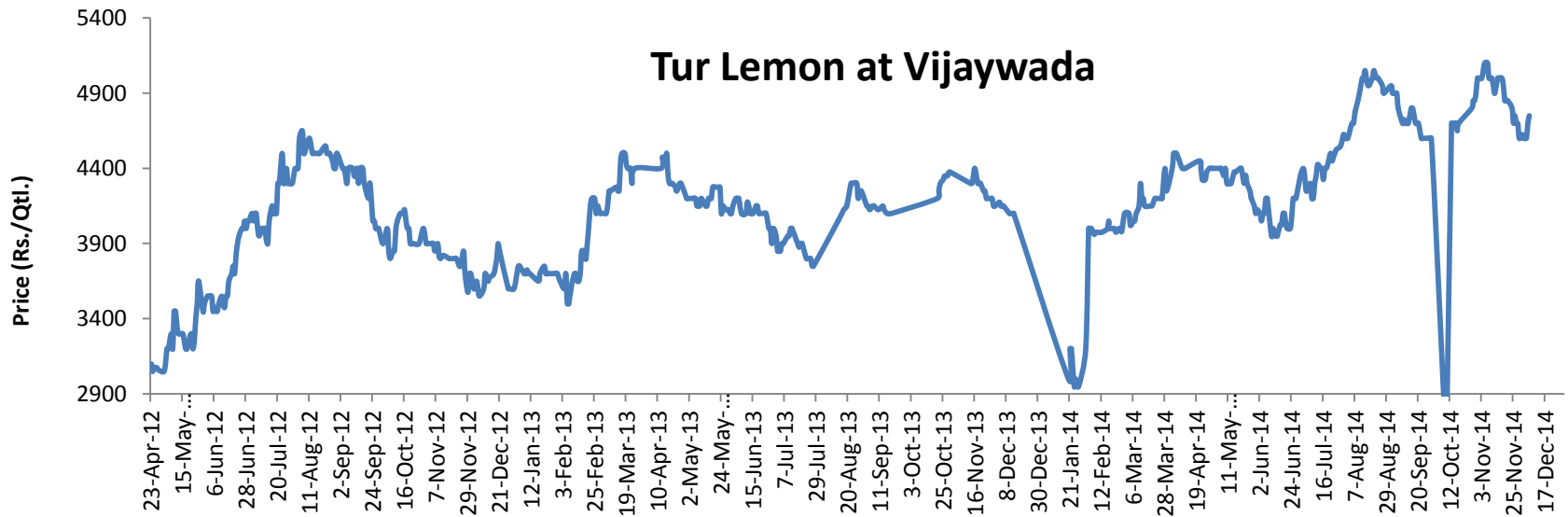

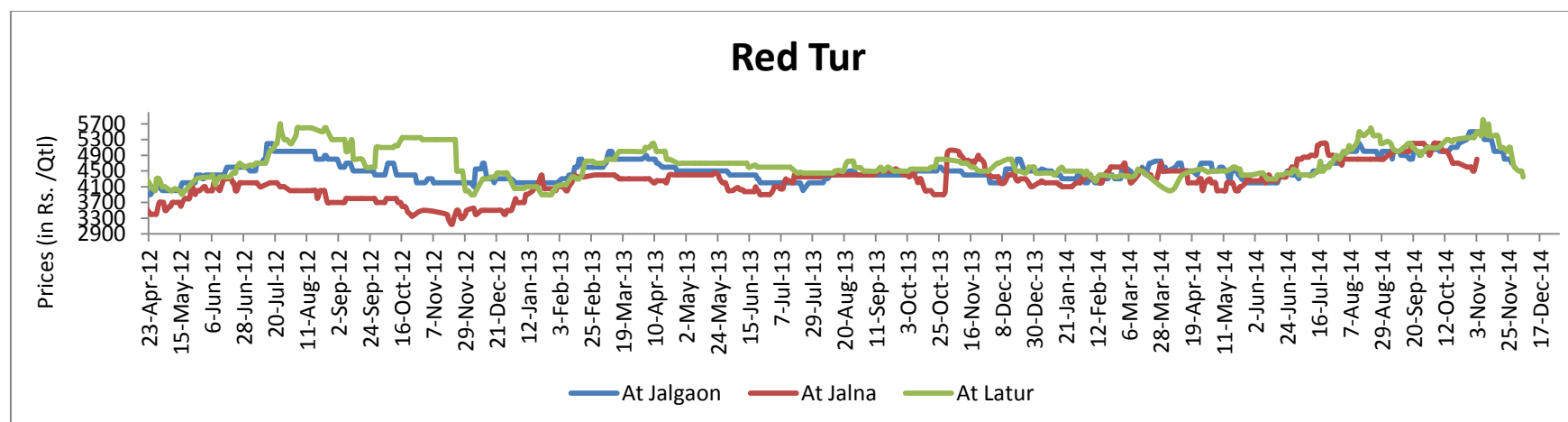


Burmese Lemon Tur

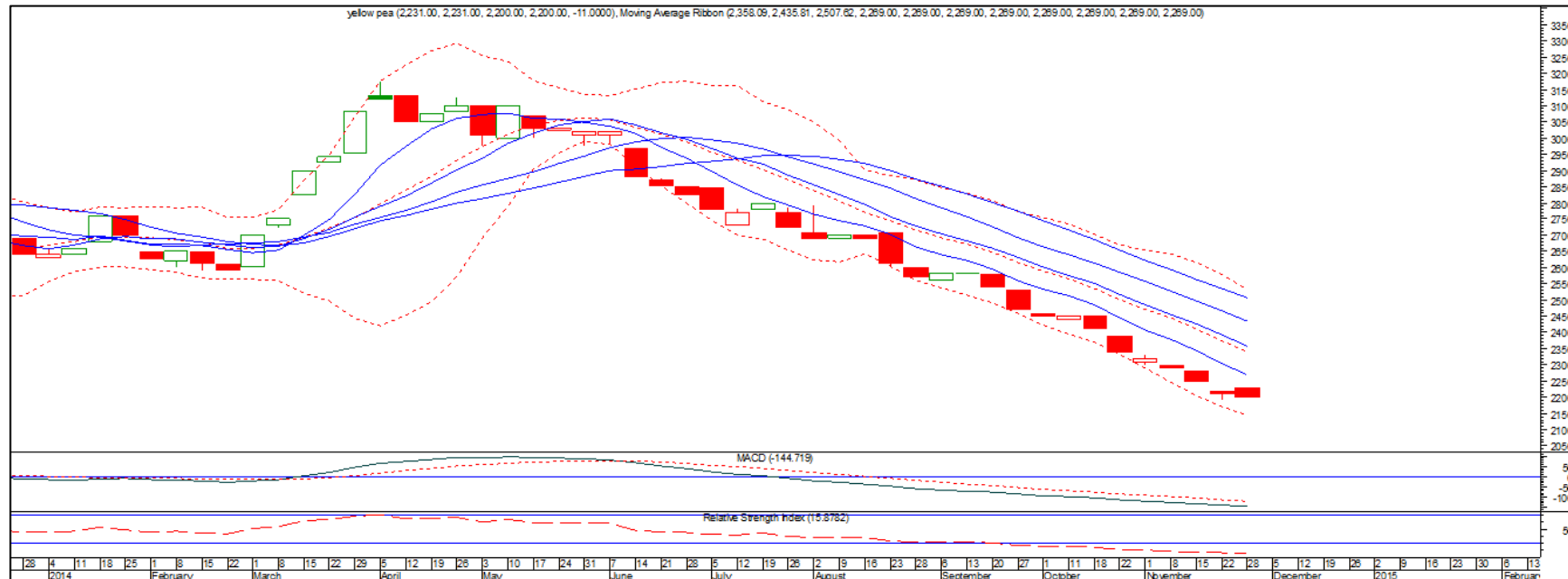

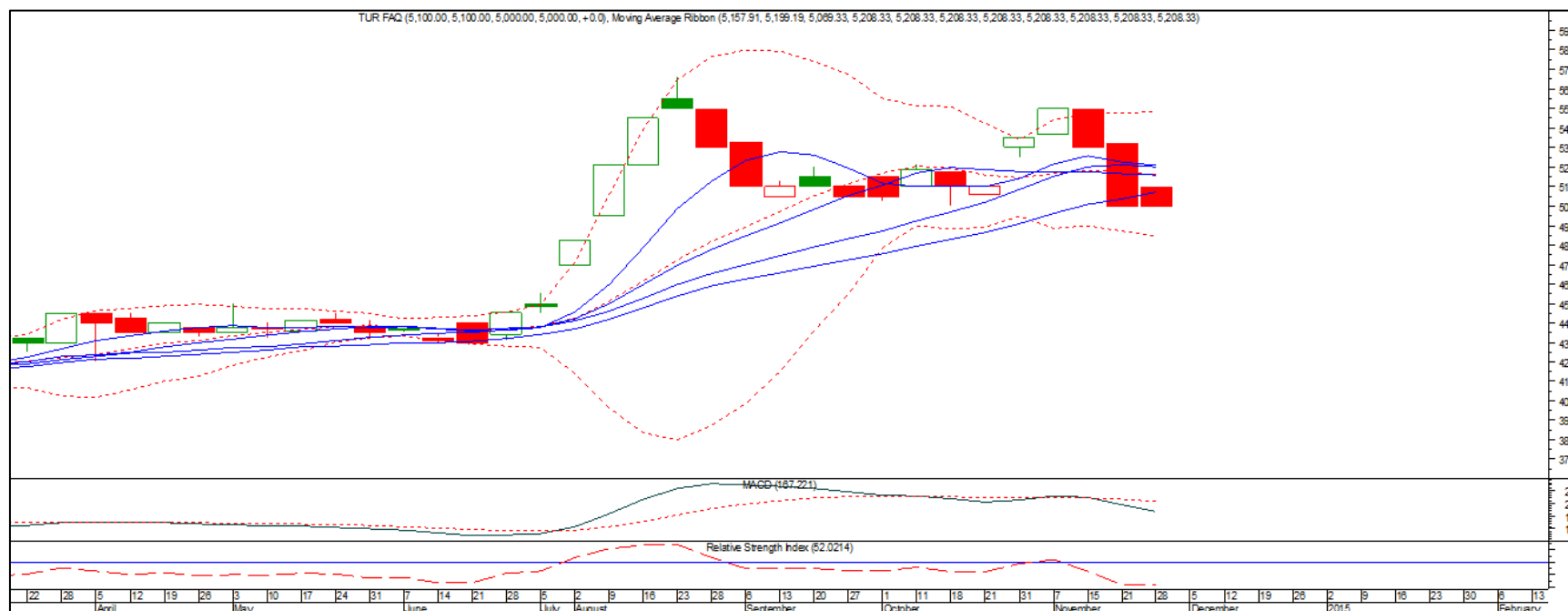

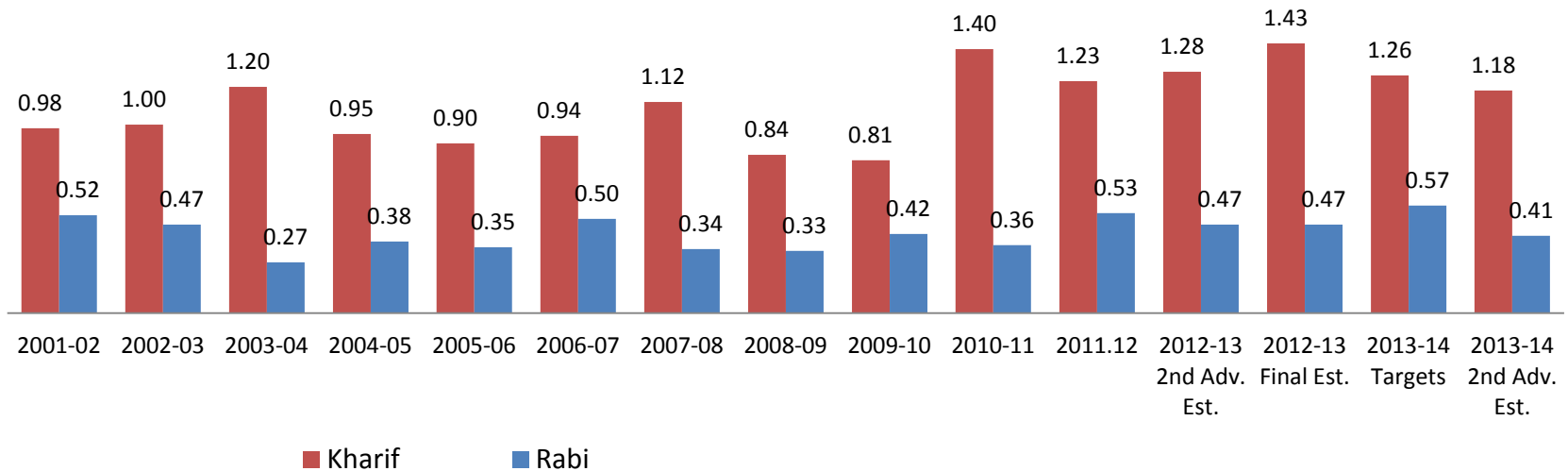




Moong (Production In Million Tonnes)
