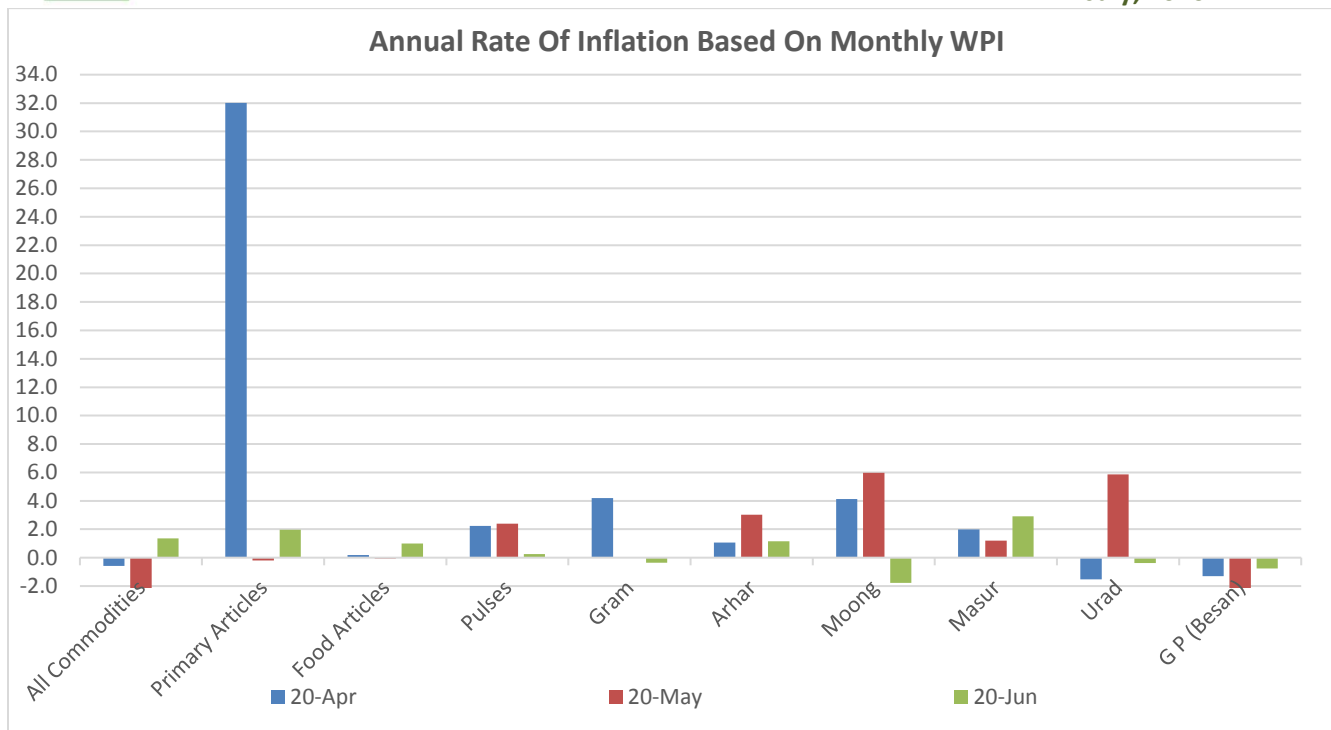
Highlights-Domestic Market:

- Kharif Pulses area coverage has increased by 25.73 % to 99.71 lakh ha. in the ongoing season** so far. It was 79.30 lakh ha last year as on 24th July-2020..The reason behind higher area coverage is mainly attributed to good monsoon rains and an encouraging MSP. Higher MSP for kharif pulses, good rains and smooth procurement drive have encouraged farmers to grow more pulses this season. As weather is favorable, kharif area is bound to increase by 10 to 15% this year. Farmers have covered 36.80 against 28.10 lakh ha under tur, 30.14 against 25.51 lakh ha under urad, 25.96 against 19.45 lakh ha under moong and 6.76 against 6.20 lakh ha under other pulses. See details at page no -14.
- Slashed import duty on masur from 30 to 10 percent in June and revised time frame for import** up to 31st of August-2020 have started impacting market sentiments in local physical markets now. Import volume from Canada and Australia has started increasing at various ports of India now. Importers can import at least 3 lakh MT masur in July and August taking advantage of lower duty. Import volume from US would be limited as duty applicable on US masur is 30 % after deduction of 20 points. If higher volume of import on reduced duty affect domestic market price more than common expectation, govt. would prefer to discontinue it after August. If prices rule near current level (unlikely),govt may extend lower duty structure beyond Aug. Under prevailing condition masur market is bound to decrease by Rs 400 from current level.
- With increasing area under tur amid favourable planting conditions, tur cash market could not move up** as expected last week. Demand is yet to pick up despite the beginning of festive season. Around 50,000 MT tur is expected to hit Indian ports from Myanmar by the end of this month. It too would help to cap any attempts of uncertain rise. Under prevailing condition cash market may either trade steady or slightly weak this week. Tur is being traded at Rs 5750-5950 per qtl. in Gulberga market. In other South Indian markets, it is being traded at Rs 5100-5450 per qtl. Indian farmers have covered 36.8 lakh ha against 28.1 lakh ha last year so far. It is higher by 31% from last year and 83% of normal. Normal area of tur is 44.29 lakh ha.
- Cash urad market traded steady to slightly weak after some improvement last week. Supply increased** at higher levels in the domestic market while increasing possibility of higher import in July and August have affected the inner tone negatively in the market. Govt. has fixed import quota of urad at 4 lakh MT for 2020-21 and import time line has been decreased from Mar-2021 to Aug-2020 now. So higher volume in next two months is expected. Apart from this, increasing kharif urad area may also drag down prices in coming weeks. Stockists are also expected to offload stocks in July and Aug as the new crop should hit the markets by end August. So overall, sentiments remain weak in July-Aug. Demand is normal and south Indian millers are waiting for bulk import. Urad price may decrease at least by Rs 200 in coming weeks. Farmers have covered 30.14 lakh ha area so far under kharif urad against 25.51 lakh ha last year till 24th July -2020.It is running higher by 18 % so far. Normal area under kharif urad is 35.53 lakh ha.
- Increasing kharif moong area, higher arrival from summer crop and selling intention of Nafed ,FCI and stockists** before new crop starts hitting the market by end Aug have weakened inner tone in the market. Moong is hitting various markets from MP, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Ranchi region. Weak demand, arrival of light quality moong may drag down moong price by a further Rs200 to 300. Apart from this, kharif moong area is bound to increase and it may cross 33 lakh ha against normal of 30.49 lakh ha. Under normal conditions, Agriwatch expects 14.25 to 14.50 lakh MT kharif production as per preliminary estimates.Farmers have covered 25.96 lakh ha against 19.45 lakh ha last year till date. It is higher by 33.5% from last year. Normal moong kharif area is 30.49 lakh ha.
- Chana cash market did not recover as expected last week despite the beginning of festive season.** Demand for besan is almost 50% lower as hotels, small shops, railways stations are only partially open. Besides, bumper production, higher stock(over 3MMT) in central pool and free distribution of 1kg chana per family per month till November would not help to push up cash chana market in the near to medium term. Dal mills are selling dal at discounted price as fundamental remains weak. Chana traded at Rs 4150-4200 in Delhi market. It may decrease by Rs150 more.Procurement under price support scheme has already reached 21.43 lakh MT against a target of 22.5 lakh MT. Overall tone seems weak now with commencement of auction by Nafed early than normal schedule. It may continue to cap uptrend in Chana cash market.
- Peas market continues to trade steady to slightly weak.Traders are selling peas at Rs 5550 in Kolkatta** while yellow peas in Mumbai are being traded at Rs 5400 per qtl.Demand at higher level is weak as chana dal and chana are available at lower price.Govt .is not going to relax import quota beyond 1.5 lakh MT as availability of other pulses is ample and govt is eager to encourage pulses consumption at all costs.

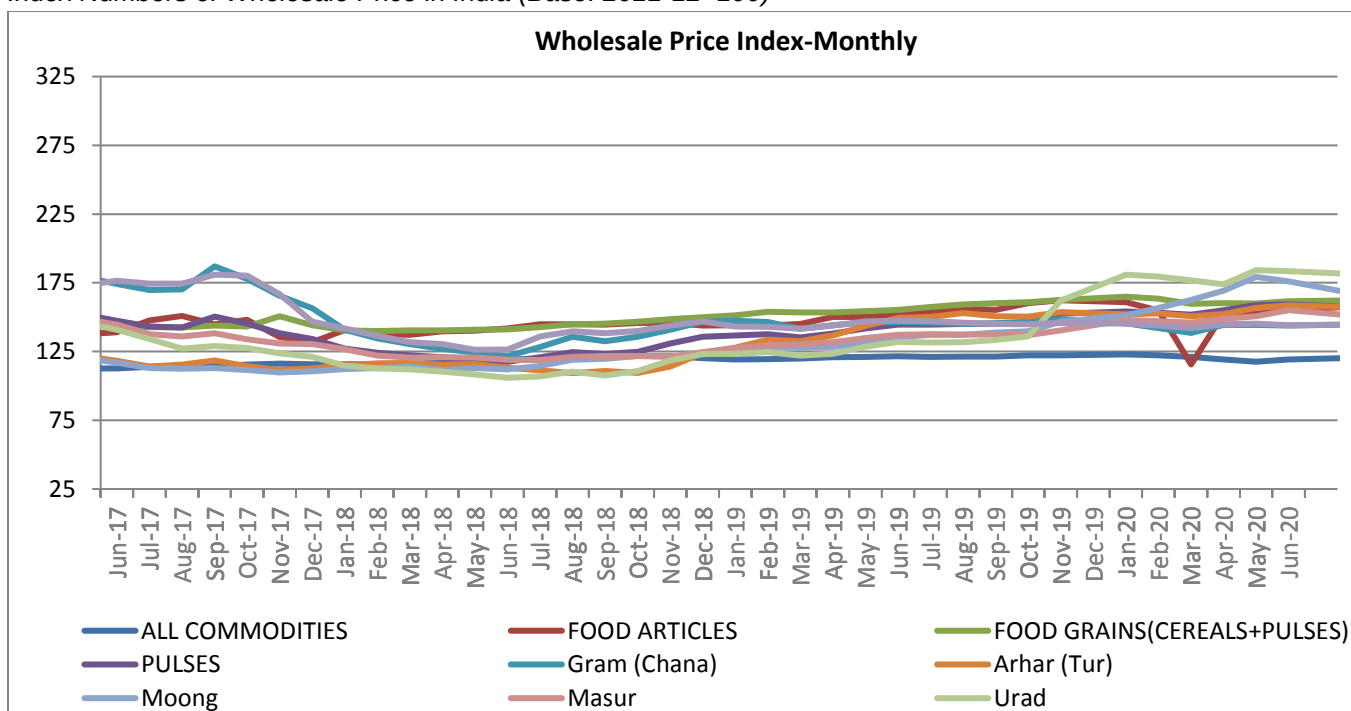
International Market Update:

- **For 2020-21, Canadian lentil seeded area rose by 12% to 1.7 Mha, due to good forecasted returns** compared to other crops. By province, Saskatchewan accounts for 90% of the lentil area, with the remainder seeded in Alberta and Manitoba. Production is forecast to increase to 2.48 Mt, with supply lower due to smaller carry-in stocks. Exports are forecast to be lower at 2.1 Mt. Carry-out stocks are forecast to rise to nearly 0.2 Mt. The average price for all grades and types is forecast to rise from 2019-20, with higher prices from large green and red types. There is an expectation that import demand in the Indian subcontinent will continue to be similar to higher in 2020-21.
- **Chickpea markets maintained its firm tone during the past week, helped by reports on the seeded area in Argentina** being down substantially this year. Shortages of large caliber product is expected to remain an issue until the first half of 2021 because of lower availability of supplies from Mexico and India. This has added some support to medium caliber markets, which are also looking a reduction in total area in Canada and the United States. The USDA and Statistics Canada pegging combined area at 602,000 acres, down from 843,000 last year and the record 1.3 million sown in 2018.
- **As per latest report by Canada stats MY 2019-20 may end up with 3 lakh MT masur stock.** Sowing in new season i.e 2020-21 is almost over and under prevailing condition 21.5 lakh MT production is expected. If we assume 50,000 MT import in new season, it hints that total availability would be around 25 lakh MT. New crop is expected to hit market in Sep. As India has slashed duty by 20 % to 10%, Exporters in Canada have increased quotes accordingly. So, Indian importers are unlikely to benefit through imports. Emerging situation is not favorable for import and Indian importers would not be able to import much masur till August. New quotes in Canada is \$660 per MT. Higher price has eroded benefit of duty slash in India.
- **Lentils area in Canada is expected to decline slightly from 1530 thousand ha to 1501 thousand ha** in 2020-21. the decline is nominal so production size is estimated to be similar as seen in 2019-20. Canada had produced 21.67 lakh Mt lentils in 2019-20. the fig for 2020-21 has been pegged at 21.50 lakh MT. Yield is expected to be similar at 1.46 tonne per ha. though import and export may decline in 2020-21 from 85 to 50 and from 2200 to 2000 thousand MT respectively. Price is expected to hover in the range of \$500-530 per MT.
- **Dry peas export from Canada is expected to increase from 32.70 lakh MT to 36.50 lakh MT** in 2019-20 and it may decrease to 34.00 lakh MT in 2020-21. For 2020-21, it is preliminary estimate as crop sowing has just ended in mid June-2020. China, India and Bangladesh have been top buyers of dry peas in 2019-20 Imports were up from 62 to 72 thousand tons in 2019-20. It may decrease to 60 thousand MT in 2020-21.
- **Dry peas production in Canada increased from 35.81 lakh MT in 2018-19 to 42.37 lakh MT** in 2019-20. Based on preliminary area and yield estimate production in 2020-21 may increase slightly from 42.37 to 42.75 lakh MT. Seeded area in 2020-21 is 1732 thousand ha in 2020-21 against 1753 thousand ha in 2019-20. The yield of dry peas is expected to increase this year from 2.48 to 2.51 tonne per ha in 2020-21.
- **Lentils stock in Australia is decreasing fast as bulk shipment to Bangladesh has continued and there is news of a three months forward deal being heard.** Old crop of lentils would no longer be available by the beginning of the new season. Forward quotes have been heard at \$700-800 per MT, but limited quantities being available limits the deal size. Bangladesh has been buying 20,000 MT red small lentils per month. It may continue for the next three months. Australia exported 80,000 MT lentils in March and big volume export continued in April and May too. So old stock is depleting fast. As prices are moving up, area under lentils may increase by 10% this year. New lentils quotes are \$650-700.
- **Australia is going to plant biggest chickpeas crop in comparison to last three years.** Planting continues in Queensland and NSW. As moisture level in the field is good, farmers are increasing area under chickpeas. As top level soil moisture is lower, farmers are using wheat land for chickpeas planting. Forward delivery for October onward has been heard at \$ 630 per MT. New chickpeas crop may attract higher value. Value of new crop may be affected by any further hiccups caused by COVID-19. It may pressurize Chickpeas price.
- **As per latest update by NASS, dry pea acreage may be down by 12-13% this year in US** peas producing regions. Farmers may plant 971,000 acres against 11,03,000 acres last year. Intended plantings are down from a year ago in Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, and South Dakota. However, area in Washington may increase by 19% this year.
- **Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to weak.**

Pulses WPI increased by 4 points from 158.8 in May to 159.2 in June-2020

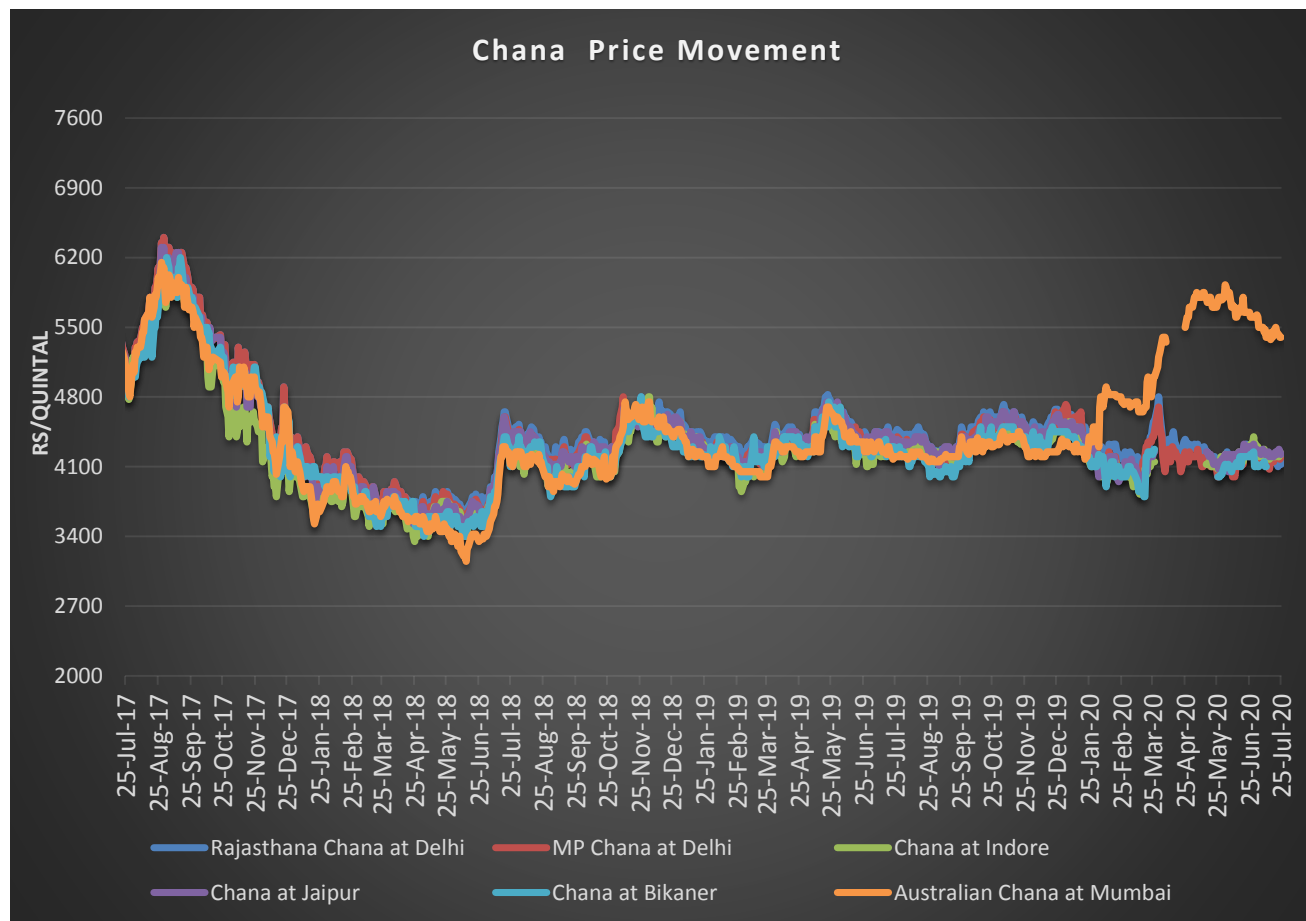
Pulses-Wise Scenario:

Chana

Current Scenario:

Chana cash market could not maintain its firm momentum taking clue from weak futures and commencement of sale by Nafed..Auction continues in MP, Raj and Mah.procurement is almost over now.Nafed has procured around 21.43 lakh MT chana so far..In Delhi, Chana is being traded at Rs 4100-4150 and may move down by Rs 50-100 from current levels. Demand for chana is expected to improve from end July and it may help market to recover to a certain extent. Prices may move up beyond MSP level if import from LDC countries remains restricted and Nafed stops selling in Aug. Nafed has ample old stock and there is a possibility of over 2.25 MMT procurement from new crop too. As of now around 21.43lakh MT chana has been procured. Overall sentiments seems weak for chana cash market this week too.In Delhi It may trade at Rs 4000-4100.

All India average price for Chana decreased by 1.1 percent from Rs 4150 to 4110 per qtl.during review week. Even Australian Chana (imported) price decreased by 1.11% from Rs 5500 to Rs5460 per 100kg due to higher availability of desi chana in domestic market. Following graph illustrates chana price movement in different markets:



Market Outlook: Weak tone might prevail in chana cash market this week too due to commencement of selling by Nafed and weak demand from mills amid higher import from LDC countries despite festive season being round the corner. Futures remain un-supportive too. Apart from this free distribution of pulses is affecting market sentiments. Distribution of 1 k.g. dal per family/ per ration card would continue to affect direct demand from cash market till Nov.

Peas (Matar):
Market Recap:

No major change was seen in peas markets like Kanpur, MH, Kolkatta and Indore as maximum trade remain suspended due to disruption in major markets due to covid-19. Demand is weak at higher level. No import is taking place right now as import limit of 1.5 lakh MT has already been exhausted. With changed status from the free to restricted category and hefty

levy imposed on peas, its import would remain almost nil in coming months too. The commerce ministry issued a separate harmonized system(HS code) for all peas (including yellow, green dun and kaspia) and changed its status in the third week of Dec. Now import deals are not taking place given these changes aimed at increasing consumption of chana which is abundantly available in domestic market. Under prevailing condition govt. is unlikely to allow green peas import. So price of yellow peas will also stay steady to slightly weak at current levels.

Peas in Kanpur market traded up at Rs.5300-5350 due to halted arrival in domestic market. Stockists too are unwilling to release old stock because of the bumper chana production this year. It has impacted price of peas in Kanpur market to some extent. As demand at higher level is down, prices may rule range bound. As supply side of green peas is tight, it would continue to trade steady to slightly firm. Demand for green pea is normal.

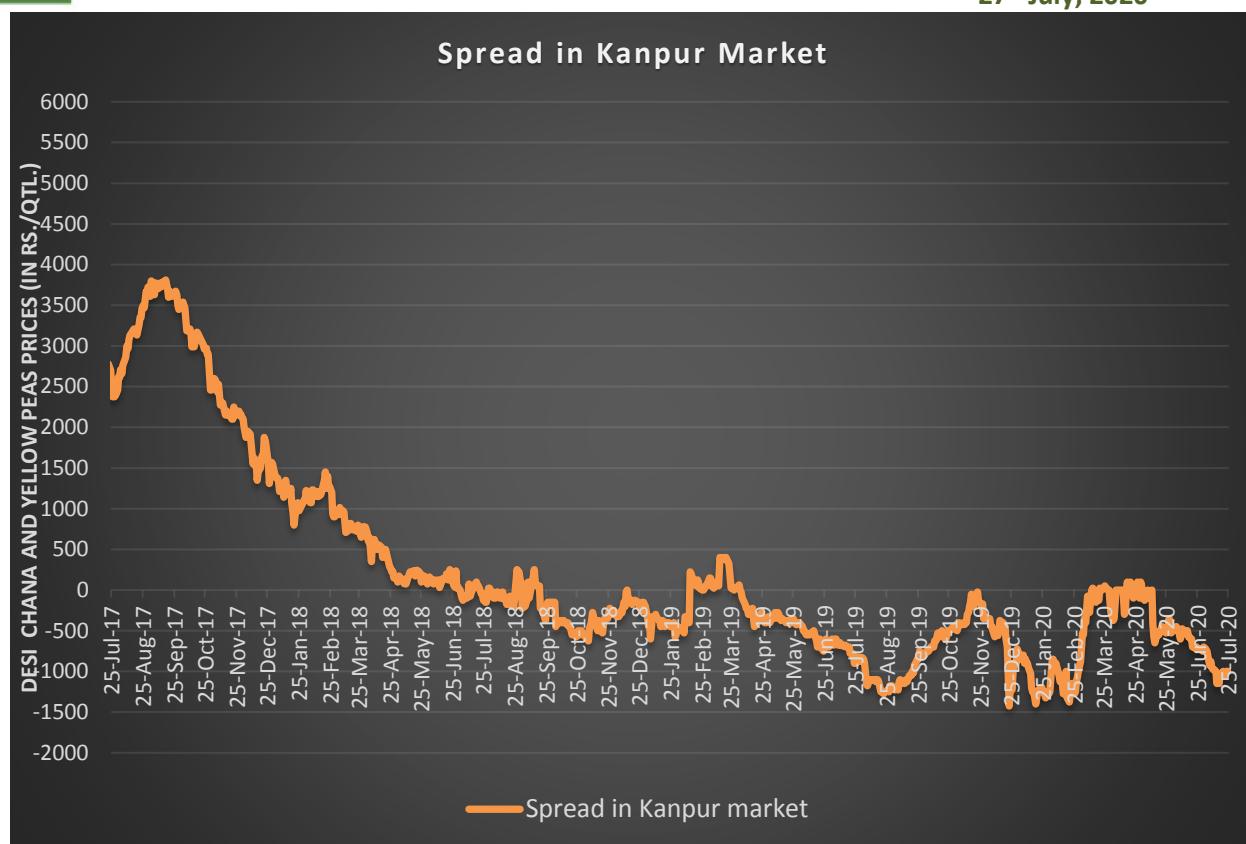


Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

Peas market traded up due to lower arrival from stock in domestic market and restricted chana selling by stockists and Nafed. Kanpur market traded up at Rs 5300-5350 per qtl. Any major spike is unlikely in Aug. Overall, all India average price was up by 2.25% to Rs 5350-5400 per qtl. In Mumbai market, there was no quote for yellow peas as stock was exhausted. Demand and supply side is balanced right now.

Spread With Chana:

Spread between Chana and Peas, at Kanpur market remained in negative zone. Gap has increased from Rs 1100 to Rs 1125 due to decreased chana price. Spread is expected to remain in the negative zone in Aug too on relative movement in Chana prices. Overall outlook seems steady this week too.

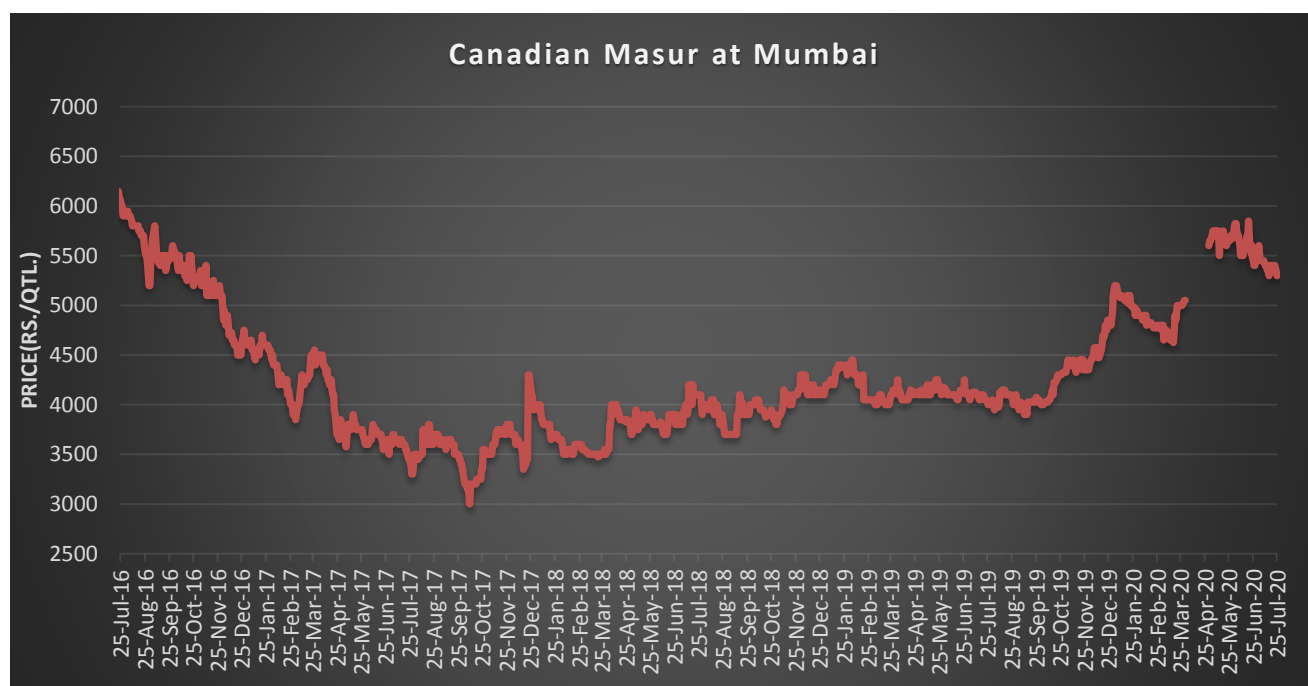
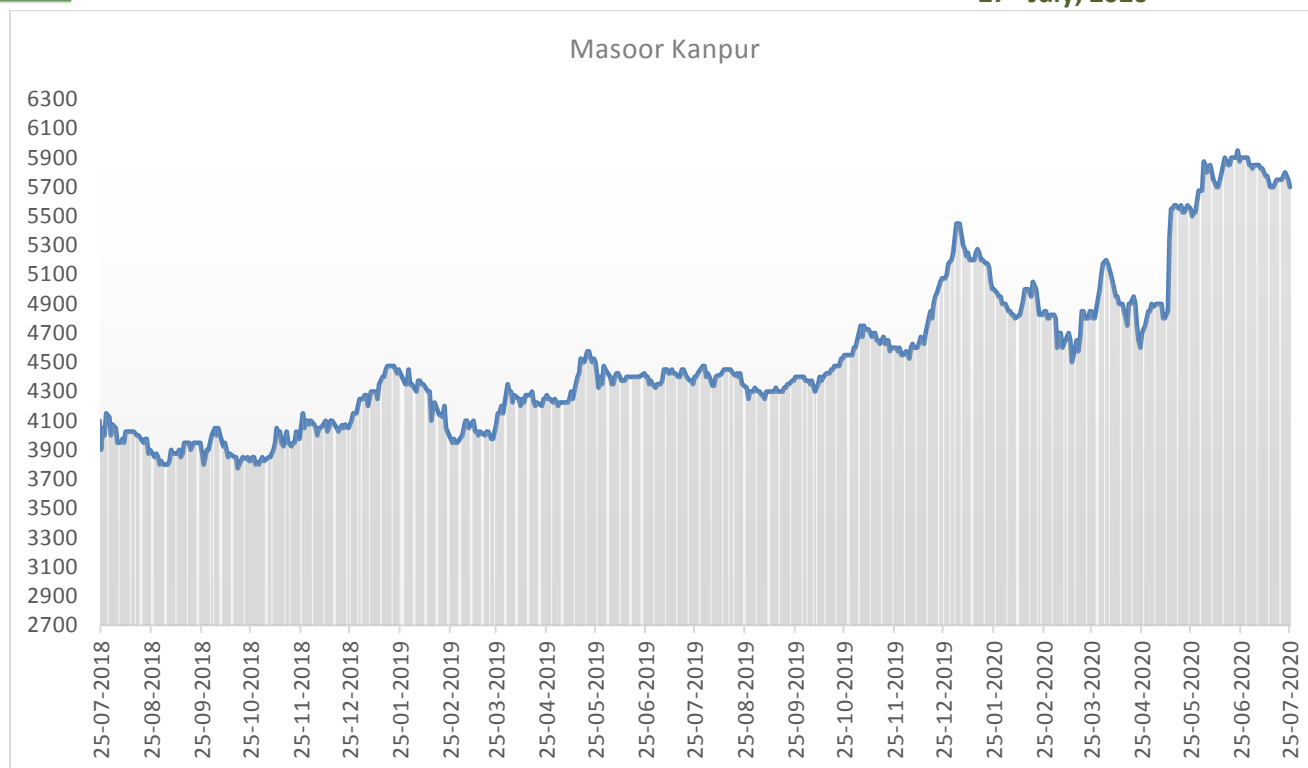
Lentils (Masoor):

Market Recap:

As prices are ruling higher than MSP in cash market, procurement agencies could not procure masur even 5000 MT against set target of 1.21 lakh MT. Nafed and other agencies have been able to procure only 3200 MT so far. Import pace is likely to increase now, so pressure might be felt on masur market in coming weeks. Around 3 lakh MT masur is expected in July-Aug. Production this year has been pegged at 12.73 lakh MT.

Current Scenario:

In the 4th week of July-2020, average price in key market of Kanpur was down by 1.0% to Rs 5690-5700 per qtl. Prices are likely to trade steady to slightly weak in the 1st week of Aug as three vessels having 1.5 lakh MT lentils are expected by end July and Aug.



Market Outlook: Prices are likely to stay steady to slightly weak due to higher supply prospects in coming weeks. Sluggish demand from mills and good pace of offloading by stockists remains unsupportive to cash market in the medium term. Nafed may start selling old crop too. It has 21,000 MT old stock. Import is likely to continue ahead of festive season. Overall tone in masur market remains weak in the short term.

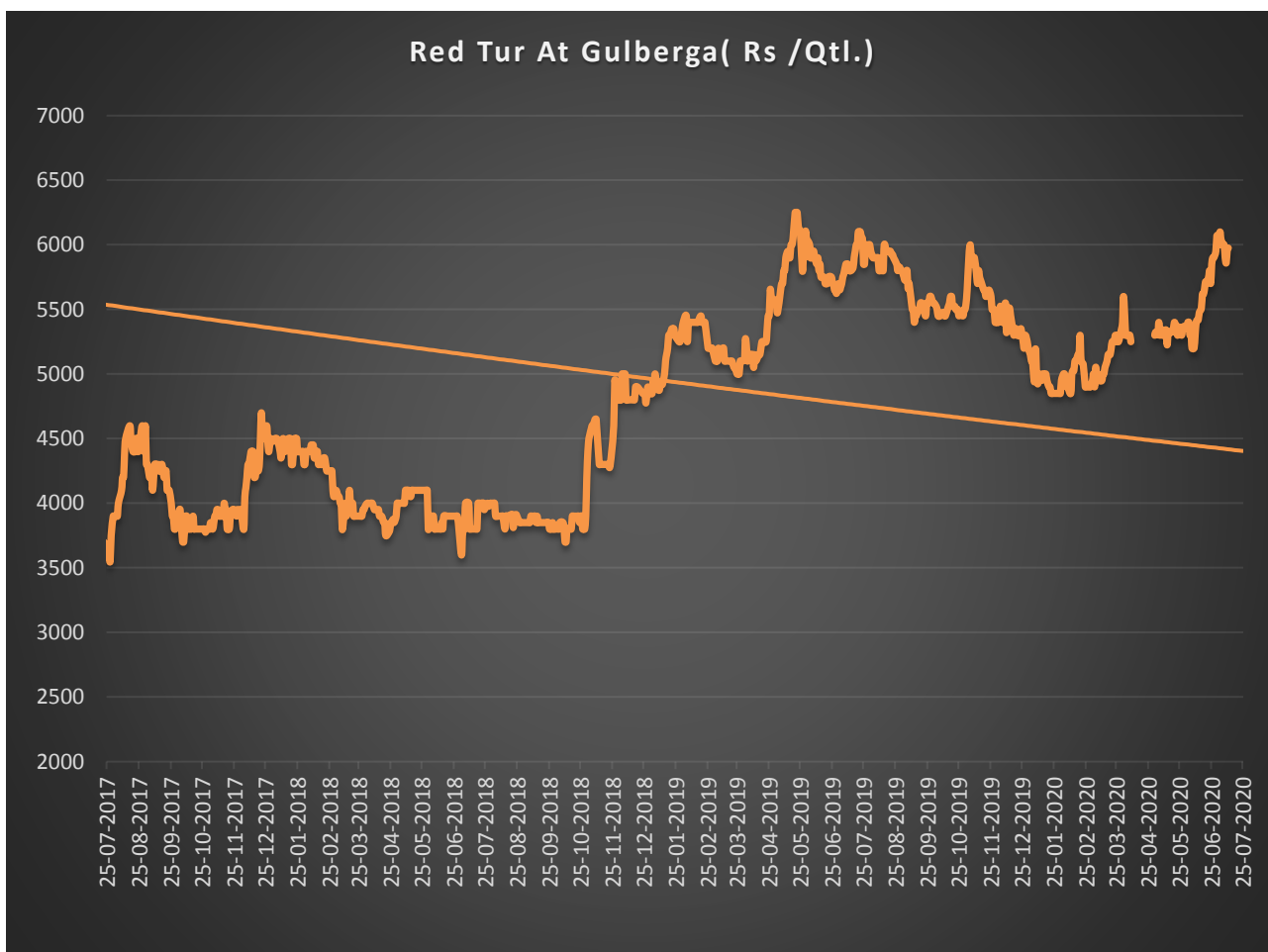
Pigeon Pea (Tur/Toor):

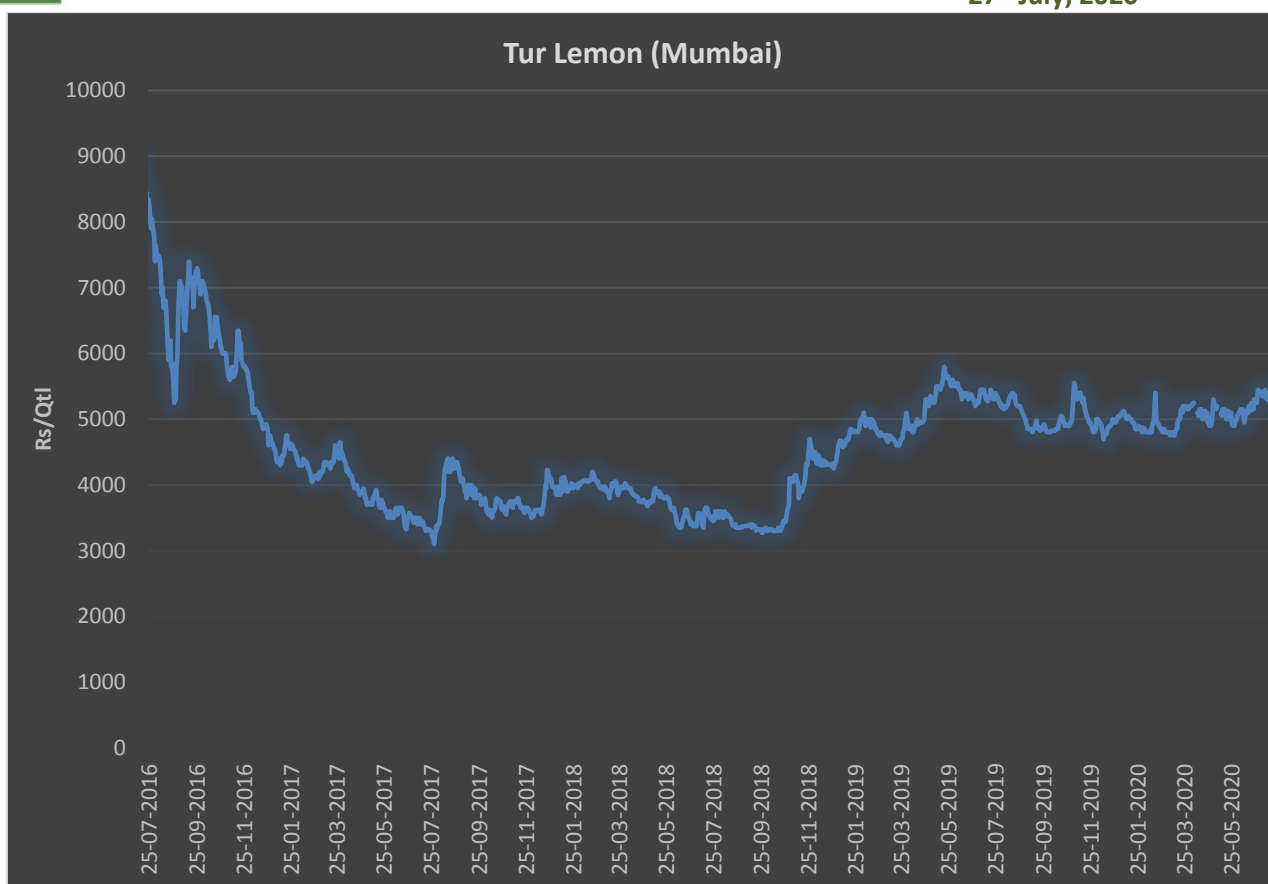
Market Recap:

Tur cash market could not sustain its firm momentum and it decreased by Rs 100 due to weak demand from mills and expectation of higher flow of import in coming months. Increasing area and good weather condition is hinting towards better crop size this year. Overall, area may increase by 10 % from last year to 48 lakh ha this year. Arrival in Latur market was reported at 1800-2000 bags while it was higher in Gulberga. As prices are under pressure now,, stockists are willing to sell tur at prevailing price . Tur price may move further down by Rs100- from current levels. Right now in Gulberga market it is trading at Rs 5750-5850.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

Tur procurement target has been fixed at 545,573 MT, lower than last year owing to lower kharif crop size. As a nodal agencies, Nafed and FCI have procured tur this year, supported by some state agencies too. As of now around 5.44 lakhMT has been procured. Crop size is expected to be around 39 lakh MT with prevailing good weather condition. Cash market is expected to trade in the range of Rs 5500-6000 during the rest week of Aug. Steady to slightly weak movement may prevail. Import license has not been g8iven to importers/millers as of now.





Market Outlook:

In the 4th week of Jul-2020, average price in Gulberga market was down by Rs 100 to Rs 5700-5800, due to halted procurement from new crop and restricted buying by private trades. Apart from this increasing kharif area too are un- supportive to cash market. Import volume are likely to increase in Aug. Tur price is likely to trade down despite lower arrivals in markets. Favourable weather and increasing area are affecting market sentiments.

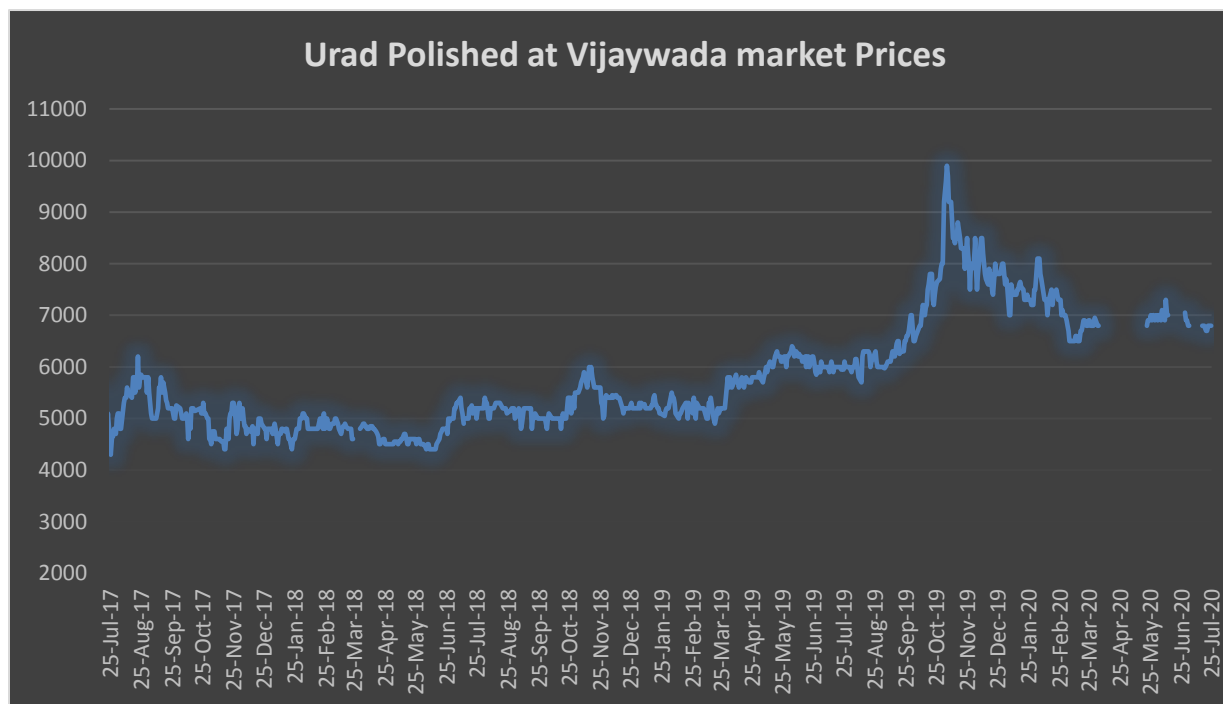
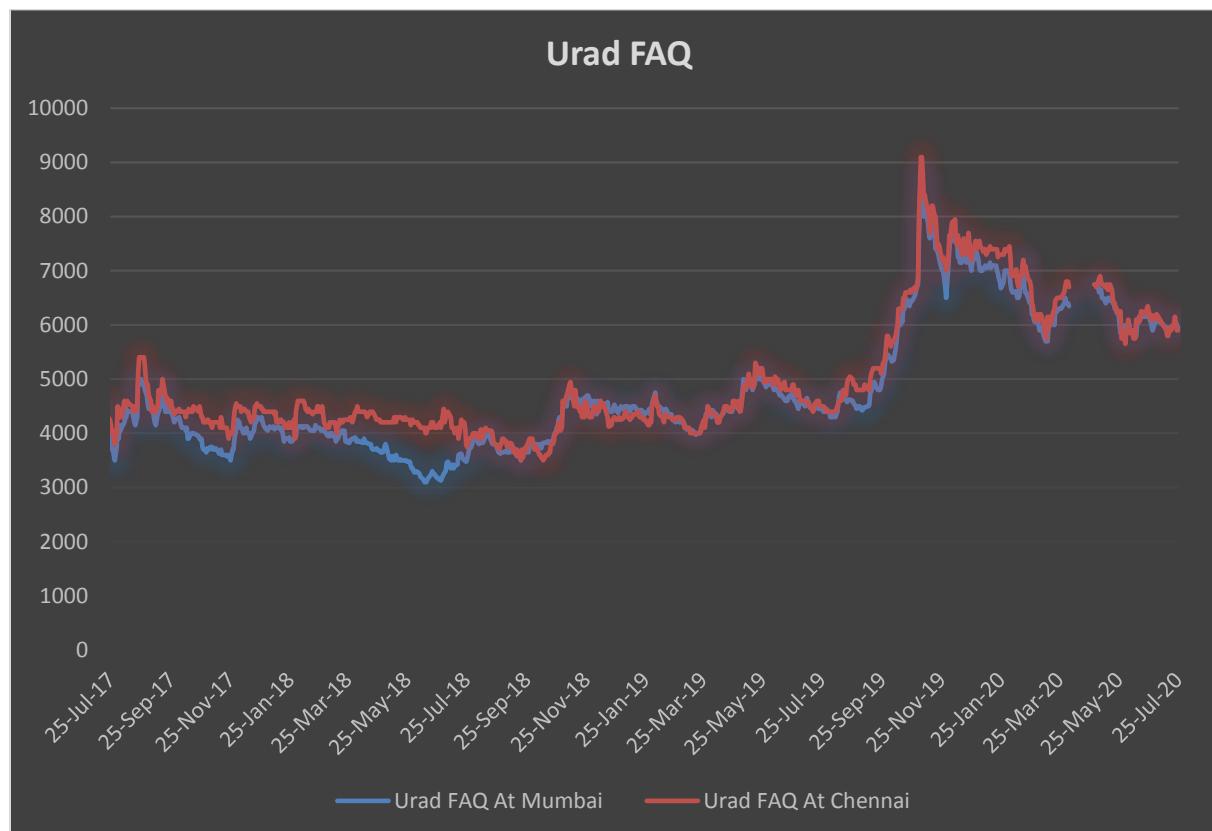
Black Matpe (Urad):

The DGFT has decreased the time line for 4 lakh MT urad import quota from 31st March-2021 to 31 August-2020. As time frame for import has been reduced, the DGFT is expected to issue licenses soon. When the licenses are issued, it would impact the market sentiments and cash market could trade down by Rs200 to 300 from current levels. Besides, new kharif crop would be available from Aug amid increasing kharif area. So pressure seems building on urad price. Demand remains depressed at higher level.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

Nafed has started intervening in the market with govt.'s consent as it has around 1.74 lakh MT old stock. Import would increase supply into the market and price is bound to decrease in coming days. Even kharif area is expected to increase by 10% this year due to higher MSP. Sowing has already begun and kharif area is running higher by 33 % right now. Early start of monsoon rains are beneficial for kharif sowing and early arrival is expected this year.

Market Outlook: Urad Prices are likely to show steady to weak momentum.

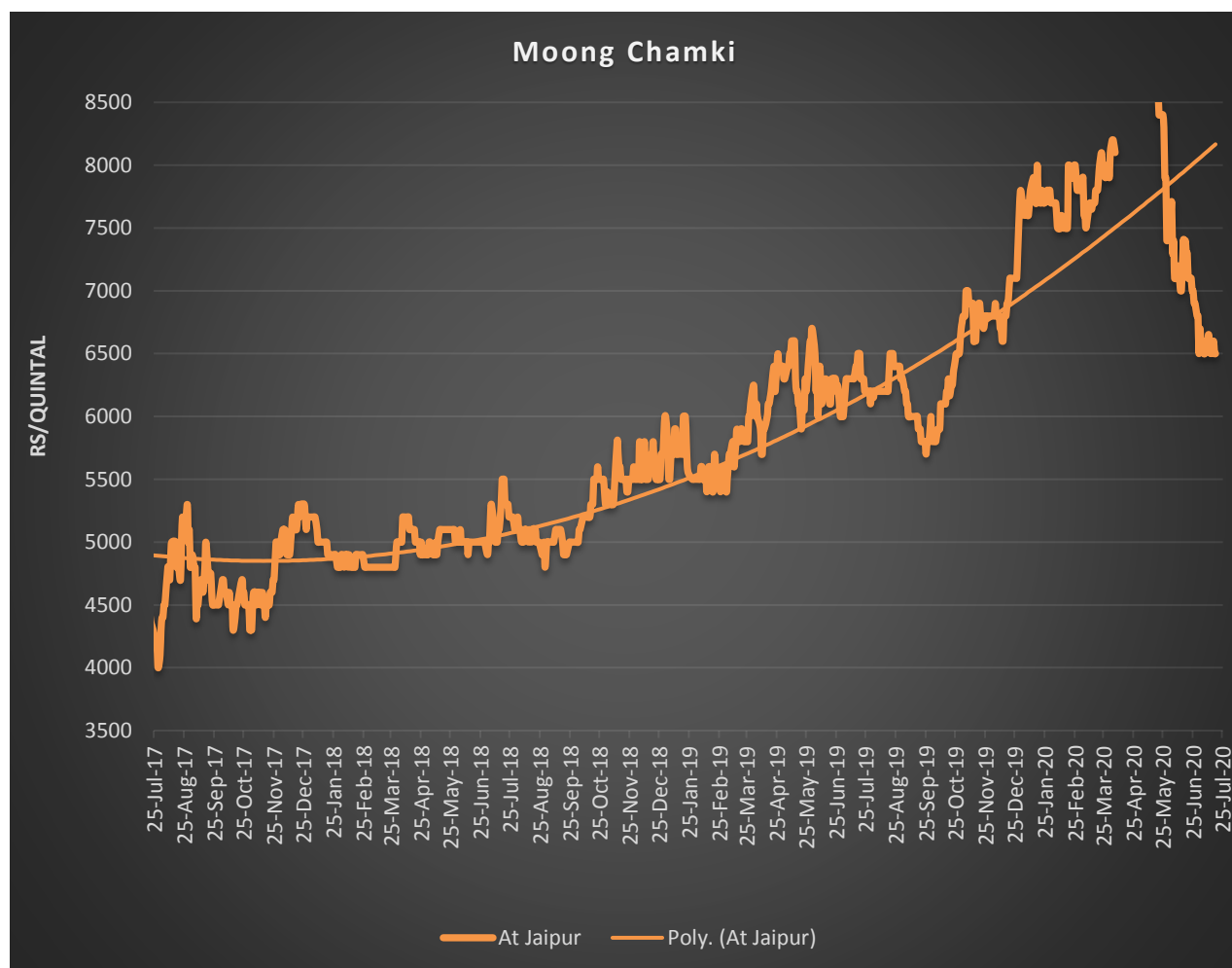


Green Gram (Moong):

Market Recap:

Increasing kharif area, higher arrival from summer crop and selling intention of Nafed, FCI and stockists before new crop starts hitting the market by end Aug have weakened inner tone in the market. Moong is hitting various markets from MP, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Ranchi region. Weak demand, arrival of light quality moong may drag down moong price by a further Rs200 to 300. Apart from this, kharif moong area is bound to increase and it may cross 33 lakh ha against normal of 30.49 lakh ha. Before this maximum area was covered in 2016-17 whenover 35 lakh ha was sown. Weather conditions are favourable with good rainfall and higher MSP are encouraging farmers to grow more moong this kharif season. Under normal conditions, Agriwatch expects 14.25 to 14.50 lakh MT kharif production as per preliminary estimates.

Farmers have covered 25.96 lakh ha against 19.45 lakh ha last year till date. It is higher by 33.5% from last year. Normal moong kharif area is 30.49 lakh ha. Kharif area is expected to increase this year to 33-34 lakh ha. as there has been good rainfall in the growing regions amid higher MSP. Since the proposed MSP of moong is higher at Rs 7196 for 2020-21 against Rs 7050 for ongoing season, it would encourage farmers to cover more area under kharif moong.



Market Outlook: Moong prices are likely to trade steady to slightly weak in the near term.
