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Commodity-wise Domestic, International Prices and Arrivals at Different Centers

Highlights-Domestic Market:

- **Kharif pulses sowing has entered in the last phase now. Indian farmers have covered 137.86 lakh ha so far against 131.76 lakh ha last year as on 11th Sep-2020. It is almost 4.6 % higher than last year and around 107% of normal (128.89 lakh ha) till date. Tur area is up by 6.41 % to 48.11 lakh ha. Urad area too is higher by 1.03 % to 38.27 lakh ha so far against 37.88 lakh ha last year. Normal area is 35.53lakh ha. Indian farmers have showed more interest in moong farming and they have shown 35.66 lakh ha so far against 30.71 lakh ha last year. It is higher by 16.12 % from last year and higher by 16.96 % of normal as on 11th Sep-2020.Kulthi sowing is down by 23 % at 0.33 lakh ha so far .Farmers have covered 15.49 lakh ha area under other pulses against 17.53 lakh ha last year.See details on page no-15-16.**
- **Agriculture Minister Narendra Singh Tomar has introduced 'The Farmers' Produce Trade And Commerce (Promotion And Facilitation) Bill' and 'The Farmers (Empowerment and Protection) Agreement on Price Assurance and Farm Services Bill in Lok Sabha on Monday. Apart from this 'The Essential Commodities (Amendment) Bill' to replace the ordinances promulgated by the government earlier too has been introduced. It would help farmers to get a remunerative price for their crops and private investments and technology too. It would also enable farmers to have a barrier free trade for agriculture produces. The minister also assured that MSP would stay. It is a welcome step.**
- **Tur Stock at ports is lower than normal for Aug and Sep as import license has not been issued as yet. Tur import is taking place only on a G to G basis and is of Mozambique origin. India imported around 5212Mt in Aug while from April to Aug total 50500 Mt tur has been imported. Market is waiting for issuance of import licenses for 4 lakh Mt tur, allocated for the ongoing season.As new crop is around 2 months away and import volume is lower, tur cash market may continue to trade firm. Demand is likely to improve due to ongoing festive season. Apart from renewed demand, arrivals in major markets are decreasing now amid restricted sales by Nafed and private trade. It may push up tur market this week by Rs100-150. Tur is being traded at Rs6300-6400 in Gulberga market.**
- **Nafed has started accepting bids for chana around Rs5050 to Rs5191.It may have cooling impact on chana price. Nafed has ample stock to control price and it may adopt such a selling strategy that may stabilize market at current levels (5000-5350). Besides, Stockists, sensing uptrend in coming weeks, may also slow down their release. Actually, there is an artificial short supply in the market and intention is to push market beyond 5400-5500. As Nafed has started accepting bids, market should stabilize now. Agriwatch expects regular release from Nafed at these levels. Overall, the short term sentiment remains firm as demand is improving. Nafed still is in the driver's seat and can control supply and prices in the coming weeks to ensure farmers get MSP levels and continue growing chana. Nafed has around 2.2 MMT new chana stock. Sowing would start from end Oct. Import volume may increase from LDC countries as it is duty free.**
- **Prices of moong are mostly steady though pressure might begin, as arrivals from new kharif season have started in Karnataka and MH. Besides, higher area coverage and good crop condition so far would not allow market to move up from current level. Arrival from MP is expected now, followed by Telangana and Gujarat. There is no parity for import as moong price is ruling lower than Myanmar right now. Expecting a huge crop from Rajasthan, stockists are preferring to dispose their stocks so overall trend seems weak in the medium term.In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs6500-6600, may decrease to 6000-6200 by the end of this week.**
- **Despite some recovery in urad cash market uptrend is unlikely to continue as new arrivals have started hitting the market now and is expected to increase by the end of this month. No major area loss has been reported so far except some quality losses in pockets of M.P, MH and Gujarat due to heavy rains. Govt. has stopped urad import with commencement of new arrivals. Delay in arrival, restricted import for limited period (during arrival season) may cap urad price slipping below MSP this year (Rs6000 per qtl.).Pipeline is almost vacant. So, stockists/millers would be active once quality crop starts hitting the market. Urad FAQ is being traded at Rs 6400 in Mumbai and at Rs6500 in Chennai. Urad Market is expected to trade in the range of Rs 6200-6600 in coming weeks. Quotes for FAQ urad moved down by \$5 to \$755 per MT while SQ stay steady at \$870 per MT basis Indian port.**
- **Masur cash market traded steady to slightly firm due to restructured duty (from 10 to 30 % again),applicable from Sep-2020. India imported around 1.67 lakhMT masur in July and volume is expected to increase to 2 to 2.25 lakh MT in August. So any spike is unlikely in Sep.The reason behind higher import was reduced duty (10 instead of 30 %) till August. Prices may increase again once the imports have been consumed in various domestic markets.Right now imported masur is**

being traded at Rs 5300-5350 at Mumbai. Masur and masur dal demand is normal while supply side in overseas market is increasing with commencement of harvesting in Canada and USA.


International Market Update:

- **Private participants are expecting higher lentils crop in Canada and the United States this year against last year.** However, govt.'s estimate has not been revised as yet. They expect lower crop size this year against last year in Australia. Abares too has not revised crop estimate as yet. Private participants/experts expect 497,000 metric tonnes production this year against 543,000 metric tonnes last year in Australia. The USDA expects this year's harvest to reach 295,000 MT, compared to 244,000 last year. Statistics Canada will release its second production estimate soon. But, farmers are reporting higher average yields to Saskatchewan.
- **For 2020-21, Canadian lentil seeded area rose by 11.96 % to 1.72 Mha, due to good forecasted returns compared to other crops.** It was 1.53Mha in 2019-20. By province, Saskatchewan accounts for 90% of the lentil area, with the remainder seeded in Alberta and Manitoba. Production is forecast to increase to 2.47 MMT (2.16MMT last year), with supply lower due to smaller carry-in stocks. Exports are forecast to be lower at 2.1 MMT. Carry-out stocks are forecast to rise to nearly 0.175 MMT. The average price for all grades and types are forecast to rise from 2019-20, with higher prices from large green and red types. It may rule in the range of \$500-530 per metric tonne throughout the year. There is an expectation that import demand in the Indian subcontinent will continue to be similar or slightly higher in 2020-21. The data has been taken from the latest update from Agriculture & Agri food Canada.
- **For 2020-21, the area seeded under chickpeas in Canada fell by 23.89% from 159 thousand ha in 2019-20 to 121 thousand ha** due to the lower farm gate prices received in the previous year. Saskatchewan accounts for most of the chickpea area, with the remainder in Alberta. Production is forecast by AAFC at 200 Kt, down 20.63% from the previous year, due to lower seeded area despite higher expected yields. Supply is forecast to rise to 410Kt. Exports are forecast to rise from 105 to 125Kt and carry-out stocks are forecast to fall from 160 to 150Kt in 2020-21. The average price is forecast to fall marginally due to a larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution. It may hover in the range of \$455 to \$485 per tonne.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is likely to increase by 3.5 lakh MT to 6 lakh MT in 2020-21,** The new crop would hit market in End Oct. As demand from India is weak, sentiments remain weak in Sep too. As chickpeas attracts 60% import duty, import volume is negligible from Australia. However, from other African countries, import continues on zero duty. India has imported 2.38 lakh MT from Zambia, Mozambique, Tanzania and Malawi.
- **As per latest updates by NASS, dry pea acreage may be down by 12-13% this year in US peas producing regions.** Farmers may plant 971,000 acres against 11,03,000 acres last year. Intended plantings are down from a year ago in Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, and South Dakota. However, area in Washington may increase by 19% this year.
- **Chickpeas area in the US is likely to decrease by 32% from last year.** Small chickpea acreage shows a decline of only 5%, while large chickpea acreage is expected to decrease by 41%. It is really a big surprise this year.
- **Stock position of urad in Myanmar is said to be around 2.75 to 3 lakh MT.** New crop is expected to hit market in mid-March-2021. By then Myanmar may export around 1 lakh MT under quota system before the new crop hits the market and retain 50,000 MT for domestic consumption. If India extends the time line for import, prices in Myanmar may move up by \$100 per MT from current level. Myanmar is offering urad FAQ and SQ at \$720 and \$825 per MT respectively right now and the price movements will depend on the Indian import time line. India govt may open import after assessing the kharif crop size and any losses of the crop that is, heading towards maturity and harvesting of which should commence in Sep.



Index Numbers of Wholesale Price in India (Base: 2011-12=100)



Pulses-Wise Scenario:
Chana

Current Scenario: Nafed has started accepting bids in the range of Rs5050 to 5190 in various states. It has weakened firm sentiments right now. As Nafed has ample stock it would continue to release stock to ensure proper supply in the market. So, any spike is unlikely in the near future. There is good demand of chana dal in the market and prices are likely to rule near 4900-5300 in various market. As sowing starts from mid-Oct, govt. would prefer to see chana at current level, so that area under chana could be maintained at last year's level during sowing time. Chana is being traded at Rs 5100-5200 in Delhi market. It may sustain at this level. As Nafed has started accepting bids above MSP level, private trade too would continue to release stock in parts. Import would be limited even from LDC countries, as availability is said to be lower(1.75 lakh Mt) in least developed countries. India imported around 27,000 MT in July from LDC countries while from April to July around 2.38 lakh MT has been imported. The fig is expected to be 25,000 Mt in Aug too. Import data for Aug is awaited. Under prevailing condition chana market is expected to move range bound. In Delhi It may trade at Rs 5000-5300 in Sep.

All India average price for Chana decreased by 1.59 % percent to 4982 per qtl. during review week. Even Australian Chana (imported) price decreased by 0.071% to Rs 5466 per 100kg due to increased supply through Nafed in domestic market. Following graph illustrates chana price movement in different markets:



Market Outlook: Slight downward correction is expected in cash chana market in coming days despite improvement in price. Nafed's current selling strategy would enhance supply and may cap one way firm momentum in domestic market. Indian importers have imported around 2.38 lakh MT chana during April to July 2020 from LDC without tax. Demand for besan mills and hotel industry has started increasing now. However, distribution of 1 k.g. dal per family/ per ration card would continue to affect direct demand from cash market till Nov. It would cap any unexpected spike in chana cash market.



Peas (Matar):
Market Recap:

Availability of peas at ports is poor and arrival in domestic market is decreasing fast. The stockists who have stock, are unwilling to sell it at lower price. However, consumption too is weak as prices are higher in domestic market. Govt. would not allow import as other pulses are available easily at affordable price. Even The DGFT has not allowed port authority to release stock lying at ports. The stock is said to be 1.25 lakhMt, as it exceeds quota limit of 1.5 lakhMt per year. Demand is weak as prices are Rs1500 per qtl. higher than chana. So, prices may rule steady in domestic market. Peas in Kanpur market also traded up at Rs 6600-6800 due to halted arrivals in domestic market, lower availability at ports and almost no import during last four months. Stockists too are unwilling to release old stock because of lower production this year. It may continue to lend support to peas in Kanpur market. Demand for green pea is normal.


At global level, Canada is unable to export peas in bulk volume as major buyer like India is out of the market. Demand from other consuming countries too is weak due to disturbed market activities everywhere. B, desh and Nepal may buy higher quantity in Oct-Nov due to lower price in global market and sell it in India illegally as and when they get chance as peas price in India is higher.



Current Market Dynamics & Outlook: Peas market traded firm due to decreasing availability in domestic market, at ports and firming chana price. Kanpur market traded up by Rs200 to Rs 6600-6800 per qtl. Any major spike is unlikely now. Tight supply side is expected until peas enters in India through B, desh and Nepal illegally. Overall, all India average price was up by 4.50% to Rs 6600-6800 per qtl. In Mumbai market, there was no quote for yellow peas as stock was exhausted. Canadian yellow pea in Kolkata1 is being traded at Rs 710-7200.

Spread With Chana:

Spread between Chana and Peas, at Kanpur market remained in negative zone. Gap has decreased slightly from Rs 1275to Rs 1200 due to increased pea price. Spread is expected to remain in the negative zone in Sep too on relative movement in Chana prices. Overall outlook seems steady to slightly firm this week too.



MarketOutlook: Firm tone may prevail.

Lentils (Masoor):
Market Recap:

Importers imported higher quantity (around 4.25 lakh Mt) of masur during July and Aug, taking advantage of lower import duty. Now 80% imported consignment is lying on ports as demand in domestic market is weak at this point of time. So, prices could not increase in the market despite enhanced duty from 10% to 30% from 1st Sep-2020. Demand for daal too is weak. Masur was quoted at Rs 5350-5500 in Kolkata while in Mumbai it was traded at 5300-5350. Price of Australian containers was quoted at Rs 5450.

Price of Masur in Australia and Canada may increase again as demand from Asian countries is expected to increase. Apart from this lentils production in Australia may decrease by 7%. It may push up price. If demand increases in India, Importers can strike some deals at higher duty too. If illegal trade remains restricted from Nepal and Bangladesh, import may continue even at 30% duty in Oct-Nov too.


Current Scenario:

Stock at ports has started increasing now. At Mumbai ports importers are selling masur at Rs 5300-5350. Nafed may start releasing stock to keep price under check. It has around 21,000 MT old stock while stock is only 4500Mt. Any spike in masur market is unlikely. Demand is weak, so price may decrease slightly this week.

Market Outlook: Prices may trade down due to higher supply prospects from imported stock in the near to medium term. Sluggish demand from mills and commencement of offloading by stockists remains unsupportive to cash market right now. Overall tone in masur market remains weak in Sep.


Market Recap:


Stocks at ports are said to be lower at this point of time. Import licenses have not been issued to importers yet, so millers are buying tur from local markets. Arrivals in local market are decreasing. so market is moving up slowly. Relaxation

from lock down in various states has increased demand for dal and millers have increased buying. Tur was quoted at R6000-6150 in Mumbai market. It is being traded at Rs 6300-6450 in Gulberga market. Overall sentiment seems firm. Importers are active in Myanmar, so it hints that govt may issue licenses soon, by end Sep. Under prevailing condition tur price may move further up by Rs150-200- from current levels.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

The production share of tur in total kharif pulses production is 34.5 % and farmers have covered around 109 % (48.11 lakh ha) area of normal (45.53 lakh ha). Planting is almost over and area may end at 48.25 lakh ha. Higher offtake from mills and improved demand for tur dal amid lower pace of import have helped market to trade up by Rs 150-250 in various markets. Apart from renewed demand, arrivals in major markets are decreasing now amid restricted sales by Nafed and private trade. It would continue to support tur cash market this week too. Demand for tur dal may increase further in the coming weeks due to festive season despite good planting and crop condition so far. As import licenses are yet to be issued, volume of imports from allocated quota of 4 lakh MT is expected to be lower in Sep, even if licences are issued in the second half of the month.





In the second week of Sep-2020, average price in Gulberga market was up by Rs 100 to Rs 6350-6500 due to slower pace of import, improvement in demand for dal and improved buying by private traders. However, increasing kharif area and likely selling by Nafed may cap upward momentum in coming weeks. Import volumes (G to G basis) are likely to increase in Aug-Sep, while import licenses could be issued soon for private millers. Tur price is likely to trade firm in Sep.

Black Matpe (Urad):


Despite some recovery in urad cash market uptrend is unlikely to continue as new crop has started hitting the market from the second week of Sep. No major loss has been reported so far except some pockets of M.P, MH and Gujarat. Higher rainfall would not affect size but quality of the crop. Import flow of urad remained slow in August as margin for import is decreasing with declining prices in the domestic market and prospects of good kharif crop this year. Import time line has not been extended and it may cap market coming down below MSP. Quotes for FAQ urad moved down by \$5 to \$760 per MT while SQ stay steady at \$870 per MT basis Indian port. Prices in domestic market moved up slightly to Rs 6450 for FAQ and Rs 7000 for SQ at week end because of non-extension for import time line. If demand improves and new arrival is delayed, prices would increase against normal expectation. Arrival pressure from kharif crop is expected from third week of Sep.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:


The production share of urad in total kharif pulses production is 27.5 % and farmers have covered around 107.5 % (38.27 lakh ha) area of normal so far. Normal area of urad is 35.53 lakh ha. Planting is almost over now. Area in M.P., MH & Kar has increased while it is down in Raj,U.p. & Telangana. However, overall area is higher so far. Due to heavy rains around 10000 ha area is said to be inundated. However it would not affect the final size of the crop. Overall, planted area is higher by 35,000 ha from last year.

Market Outlook: Urad Prices are likely to show steady to slightly weak momentum.


Urad Polished at Vijaywada



Green Gram (Moong):
Market Recap:

Prices are mostly steady and pressure might begin, as arrivals from new kharif season has started from Karnataka and MH. Besides, higher area coverage and good crop condition so far would not allow market to move up from current level. Arrival from MP is expected now, followed by Telangana and Gujarat. Arrival from summer crop is over now. If demand improves, slight recovery might be seen this week. There is no parity for import as moong price is ruling lower than Myanmar right now. Expected huge crop size in Rajasthan, stockists prefer to sell now So, overall trend seems weak in the medium term despite minor loss in Karnataka (2500 ha) and Telangana (650 ha) by flooding.

Arrival from new kharif crop has started increasing and pressure would build up by the end of this month. As demand is weak, prices may decrease by Rs200-300 from current level. Crop condition is good while some quality issues have been reported from those areas where heavy rains occurred during harvesting time. However, loss is minor when we consider higher area this year. Kharif production is expected to be in the range of 14.50-15.50 lakh Mt this year. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6600-6700, may come down to Rs 6200-6300 by end Sep.



Market Outlook: Moong prices are likely to trade steady to slightly weak in the near term.
