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Commodity-wise Domestic, International Prices and Arrivals at Different Centers***Highlights-Domestic Market:***

- **Good demand for daal and active buying by millers have continued to push up chana prices** in domestic markets. Arrivals of chana in all major markets are decreasing day by day while demand for seed too remains supportive. Apart from mills, stockists too are active buyers even at these higher prices. Nafed is selling limited quantities and has accepted bids in the range of Rs5350-5960 in various states.. It may push the prices up in the coming weeks. New crop is 4 months away and there is no import parity due to high duty (60%). Here in Delhi chana prices moved to Rs 5450 despite 30-35 motors arriving. Agriwatch expects a downward correction of Rs100 at this level. Stake holders should book profit at this level and wait for correction. At Rs 5250-5350, they can buy it again. Markets in M.P. are closed and if it continues, supply side would be tight again. So, overall inner tone seems firm right now.
- **Govt. has increased MSP for chana from Rs 4875 to Rs 5100 and masur from Rs 4800 to 5100 for MY 2020-21.** Higher MSP should encourage farmers to cover more area under chana and masur in the rabi season, that starts in Oct. MSP for other rabi crops too has been increased.
- **Masur market traded steady to slightly weak during the review week, due to the revision of import duty** again from 30 to 10 % for 52 days till 31st Oct-2020. Demand for daal is weak too. Around 4 lakh MT was imported in July and Aug-2020 at the lower duty which increased availability of masur in domestic market. Import volume would be higher in Sep-Oct too, so prices are unlikely to move up beyond a certain level (Rs5300-5650). Stock at ports is said to be around 4.5 lakh MT. Despite higher import, prices are not likely to decrease below Rs5000 as sowing should start from mid Oct. Besides, govt has increased MSP for masur from Rs4800 to Rs5100 for MY 2020-21. So range bound movement is expected in cash market this week.
- **Active buying by millers and improved demand for daal in cash market pushed up tur price by Rs 300-350 to 7000-7250 per qtl.** during the week under review. Lemon tur stock at ports like Chennai, Mumbai and Kolkata are depleting fast. Importers have increased quotes by 200 to Rs7000. Import volume remains limited due to non-issuance of import licenses. Arrivals in local markets too are negligible. So, stockists have increased its price by Rs 300-350 in last three – four days. Old lemon tur too are being quoted at Rs 7000-7200 per qtl. Arrival has decreased in Jalgaon, Akola and Amravati line. Local tur in Gulberga too moved up to Rs 7200-7300 and it may move up further by Rs200 to 300 under prevailing market fundamentals. New crop is still two and a half month away from now. As prices are increasing Nafed may decide to sell tur crop to cool down price. It has over 3.5 lakh Mt tur stock. Nafed has not taken a decision over tur sale.
- **Taking a call on unexpectedly firm cash market and delayed arrivals from new crop govt. has allowed 1.5 lakh Mt urad** import from immediate effect. However, it will take atleast 15 days time to hit Indian ports. With opening of weather arrival is expected to increase. Apart from this demand for daal at higher level got disrupted. So, a downward correction is expected in urad cash market. Crop condition is average to normal and no major area loss has been reported so far except some quality loss in pockets of Satna, Nagour, Marathwara, Vidarbha and Jalgaon due to heavy rains. Total 30,000-35,000 ha is said to be destroyed. However, the loss is likely to be compensated by good crop condition and better yield in other regions. Delay in arrival, restricted import (1.5 lakh Mt) for limited period (during arrival season) may cap urad price slipping below MSP this year (Rs6000 per qtl.). Pipeline is almost vacant. So, stockists/millers would be active once quality crop starts hitting the market. Urad FAQ is being traded at Rs 7550 in Mumbai and at Rs7650-7700 in Chennai. Quotes for FAQ urad moved up by \$45 to \$900 per MT while SQ moved up by \$35 to \$1010 per MT basis Indian port during the week.
- **Firmness in other pulses like tur, urad and chana has lent support to moong cash market too despite** increasing arrivals in major states like MH, Raj, M.P. and Gujarat. Even farmers have restricted sales sensing strong inner tone in cash pulses market. Demand at higher level is weak and prices are unlikely to sustain at higher level. Procurement agencies are gearing up for procurement in major states like Raj, MH and Gujarat. It has already commenced in Karnataka. Arrival from MP too has started and is expected to begin in Telangana and Odisha soon. There is no parity for import as moong price is ruling lower than Myanmar right now. Expecting a huge crop from Rajasthan, stockists may prefer to dispose their old stocks so overall trend seems weak in the medium term. In Jaipur market moong is being traded near MSP at Rs 7200. MSP for the new season is Rs7196.
- **Stock of peas at ports is depleting fast and arrivals in local markets too have decreased to a negligible level.** Stockists who have stock, are unwilling to sell it sensing shortage of peas in domestic markets. Import is not taking place and the govt. is not in favor of allowing import above 1.5 lakh MT. As prices are lower in global market, Bangladesh and Nepal are

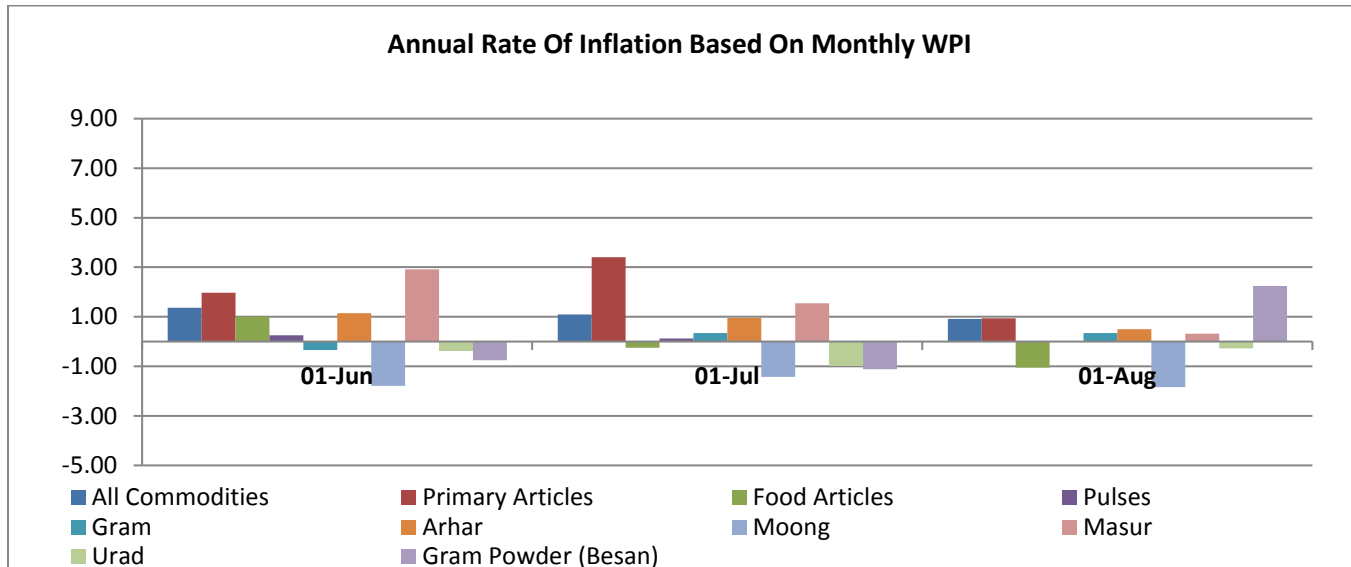
buying more matar as arbitrage opportunity is there with India. Demand is weak as other pulses are available comparatively at cheaper price. Matar in Kanpur market is being traded at Rs6600-6650 per qtl. At port it has already crossed Rs7800.

International Market Update:

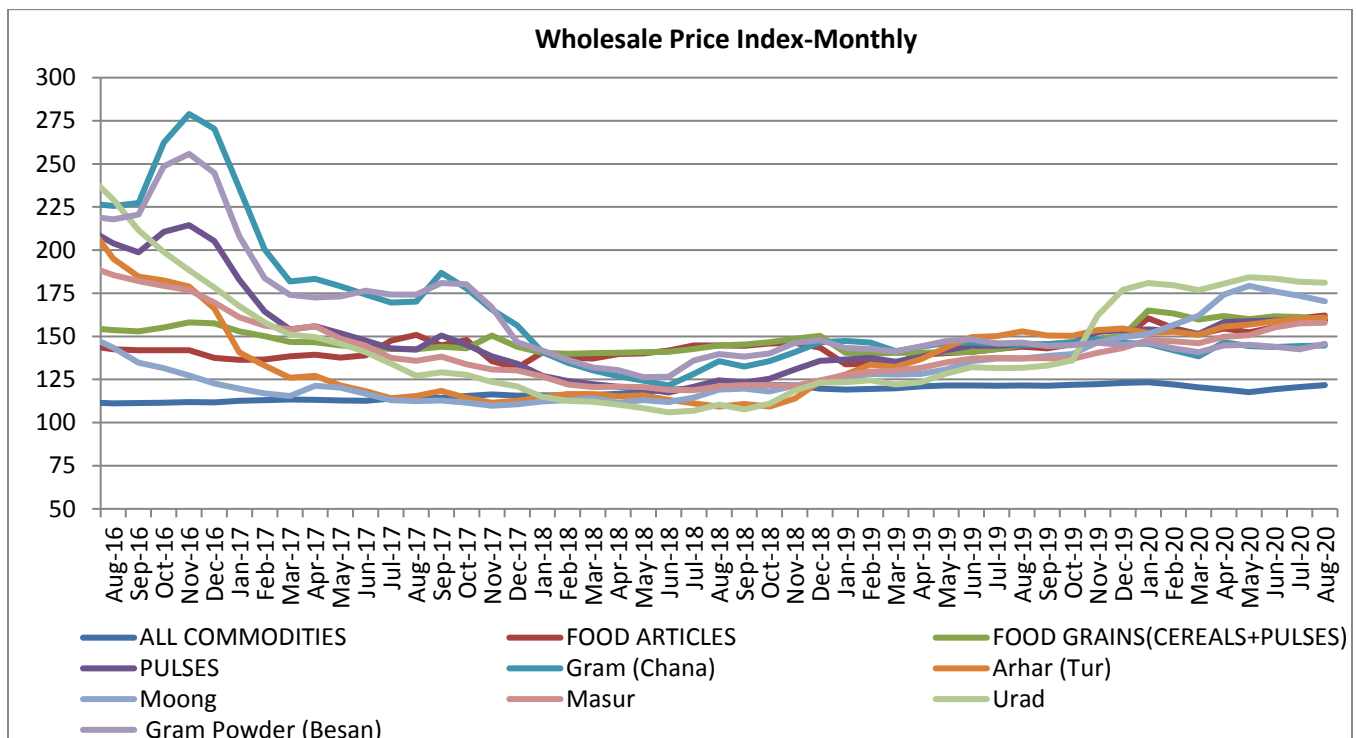
- **Global lentil markets continued to trade firm and firm tone may continue on demand from countries such as India, Sri Lanka and the United Arab Emirates.** Higher demand from these countries has fueled expectations among importers and exporters that prices are likely to maintain an upward trend through the balance of the marketing year. Comments during the online lentil sessions of the week's virtual Global Pulse Confederation lentil sessions suggest farmers in several countries had become disillusioned with prices over the past year, with many setting price targets at which they would be willing to sell remaining new and old crop product on their farms.
- **As per Turkish Statistical Institute (TURKSTAT), Turkey imported 40,774 metric tons (MT) lentils in July-2020** against 89,693 MT in June-2020. Despite lower volume of import in July total imports so far increased to 408,932 MT during the ongoing calendar year. The biggest exporter during the month was Canada, supplying 36,674 MT. Syria was the second most important export origin shipping 2,000 MT, followed by United States at 1,049 MT.
- **Field pea market traded firm last week taking clue from good opening season export movement.** As per Canadian Grain Commission, exporters in Canada loaded 630,900 metric tons (MT) of peas for bulk export in September, up from 102,400 in August and 508,900 the same month last year.
- **Private participants are expecting a larger lentils crop in Canada and the United States this year against last year.** However, official estimates have not been revised, as yet. They expect a smaller crop this year in Australia. Abares has not revised its crop estimate as yet. Private participants/experts expect 497,000 metric tonnes production this year against 543,000 metric tonnes last year in Australia. The USDA expects this year's harvest to reach 295,000 MT, compared to 244,000 last year. Statistics Canada will release its second production estimate soon. But, farmers are reporting higher average yields in Saskatchewan.
- **For 2020-21, Canadian lentil seeded area rose by 11.96 % to 1.72 Mha, due to good forecasted returns** compared to other crops. It was 1.53Mha in 2019-20. By province, Saskatchewan accounts for 90% of the lentil area, with the remainder seeded in Alberta and Manitoba. Production is forecast to increase to 2.47 MMT (2.16MMT last year), with supply lower due to smaller carry-in stocks. Exports are forecast to be lower at 2.1 MMT. Carry-out stocks are forecast to rise to nearly 0.175 MMT. The average price for all grades and types are forecast to rise from 2019-20, with higher prices from large green and red types. It may rule in the range of \$500-530 per metric tonne throughout the year. There is an expectation that import demand in the Indian subcontinent will continue to be similar or slightly higher in 2020-21 according to the latest update from Agriculture & Agri food Canada.
- **For 2020-21, the area seeded under chickpeas in Canada fell by 23.89% from 159 thousand ha in 2019-20 to 121 thousand ha** due to the lower farm gate prices received in the previous year. Saskatchewan accounts for most of the chickpea area, with the remainder in Alberta. Production is forecast by AAFC at 200 Kt, down 20.63% from the previous year, due to lower seeded area despite higher expected yields. Supply is forecast to rise to 410Kt. Exports are forecast to rise from 105 to 125Kt and carry-out stocks are forecast to fall from 160 to 150Kt in 2020-21. The average price is forecast to fall marginally due to a larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution. It may hover in the range of \$455 to \$485 per tonne.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is likely to increase by 3.5 lakh MT to 6 lakh MT in 2020-21, The new crop would hit market in End Oct.** As demand from India is weak, sentiments remain weak in Sep too. As chickpeas attracts 60% import duty, import volume is negligible from Australia. However, from other African countries, import continues on zero duty. India has imported 2.38 lakh MT from Zambia, Mozambique, Tanzania and Malawi.
- **As per latest updates by NASS, dry pea acreage may be down by 12-13% this year in US** peas producing regions. Farmers may plant 971,000 acres against 1,103,000 acres last year. Intended plantings are down from a year ago in Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, and South Dakota. However, area in Washington may increase by 19% this year.

- **Chickpeas area in the US is likely to decrease by 32% from last year. Small chickpea acreage shows a decline of only 5%, while large chickpea acreage is expected to decrease by 41%. It is really a big surprise this year.**
- **Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm as stockists restricted selling sensing uptrend to continue in cash market.

Index Numbers of Wholesale Price in India (Base: 2011-12=100)



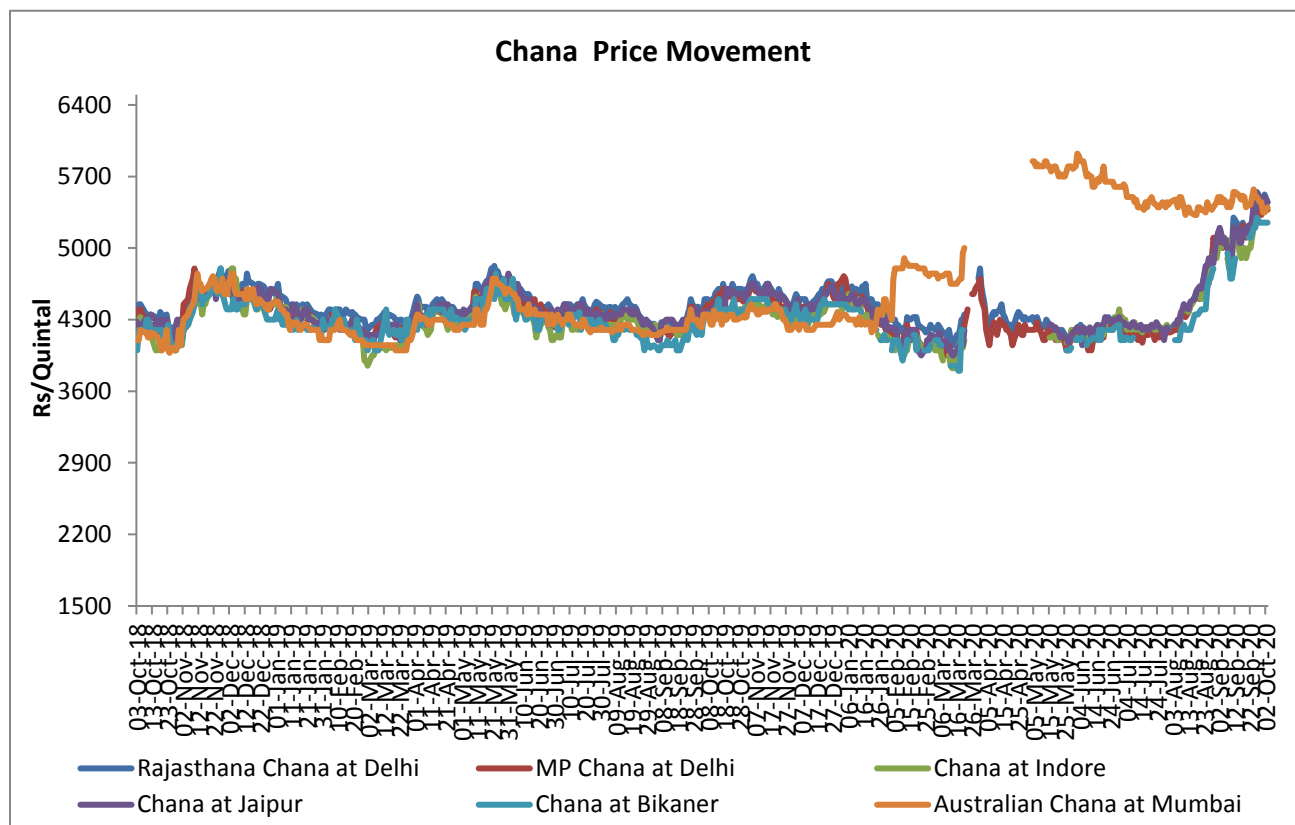

Chana

Current Scenario:Chana cash market continued to trade firm during the week under review.Nafed restricted sale below Rs 5400 and accepted bids in the range of Rs5400-5960 in various states. Arrivals are decreasing in major markets of Raj,MH and M.P. Apart from it demand for daal has improved while buying of chana too increased for seed purpose.It may continue to support cash market at current level.Chana traded Rs5400 to 5500 in Delhi market.If demand continue to improve and farmers' buying increases for seed purpose, market may move up by Rs 200 to 300. At this point Nafed plays a crucial role by decreasing or increasing supply in the market to regulate chana price. As sowing starts from mid-Oct, govt. would prefer to see chana acreages maintained at current level by ensuring prices are attractive. Import would be limited even from African countries,as availability is said to be lower (1.75 lakh Mt).India imported around 3212.82 MT in Aug against 27,000 MT in Jul-2020 from these countries while from April to Aug around 2.42 lakh MT has been imported.Under prevailing condition chana market is expected to trade steady to slightly firm. In Delhi It may trade at Rs 5300-5700 in Oct.

All India average price for Chana increased by 2.80 % percent to 5394 per qtl.during review week. However, Australian Chana (imported) price decreased by 1.58 % to Rs 5400 per 100kg due to increased supply through Nafed in domestic market. Following graph illustrates chana price movement in different markets:



Market Outlook: Slight downward correction is expected in cash chana market this week. Nafed's current selling strategy would determine price trend in coming weeks. As Nafed is accepting higher bids, prices are expected to move up by Rs200-300 from current level..Indian importers have imported around 2.42 lakh MT chana during April to Aug 2020.Demand for besan mills and hotel industry has started increasing now. However, distribution of 1 k.g. dal per family/ per ration card would continue to affect direct demand from cash market till Nov.It would cap any unexpected spike in chana cash market.Overall outlook remains firm.

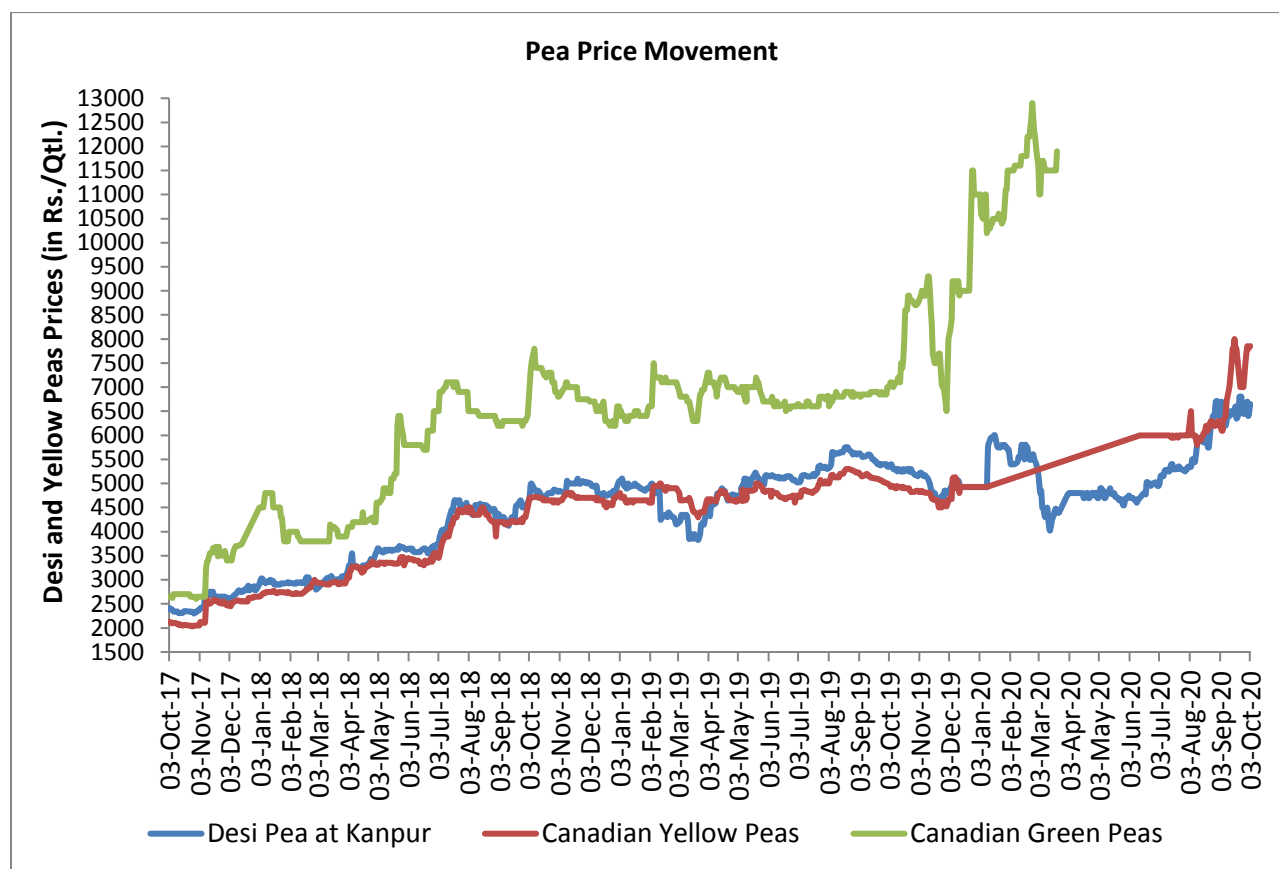

Peas (Matar):
Market Recap:

Availability of peas at ports is very poor and arrival in domestic market is decreasing fast. The stockists who have stock, are unwilling to sell it at current prices. However, consumption too is weak as prices are higher in domestic market. Govt. would not allow import as other pulses are available easily at affordable prices. DGFT has in fact, not allowed port authority to release stock lying at ports. The stock is said to be 1.25 lakh Mt, as it exceeds quota limit of 1.5 lakh Mt per year. Demand is weak as prices are Rs7800 per qtl. at port, reasonably higher than chana. So, range bound movement might be seen in domestic market. Peas in Kanpur market also traded up at Rs 6600-6700 due to halted arrivals in domestic market, lower availability at ports and almost no import during last five months. Stockists too are unwilling to release old stock because of lower production this year. It may continue to lend support to peas in Kanpur market at current level.

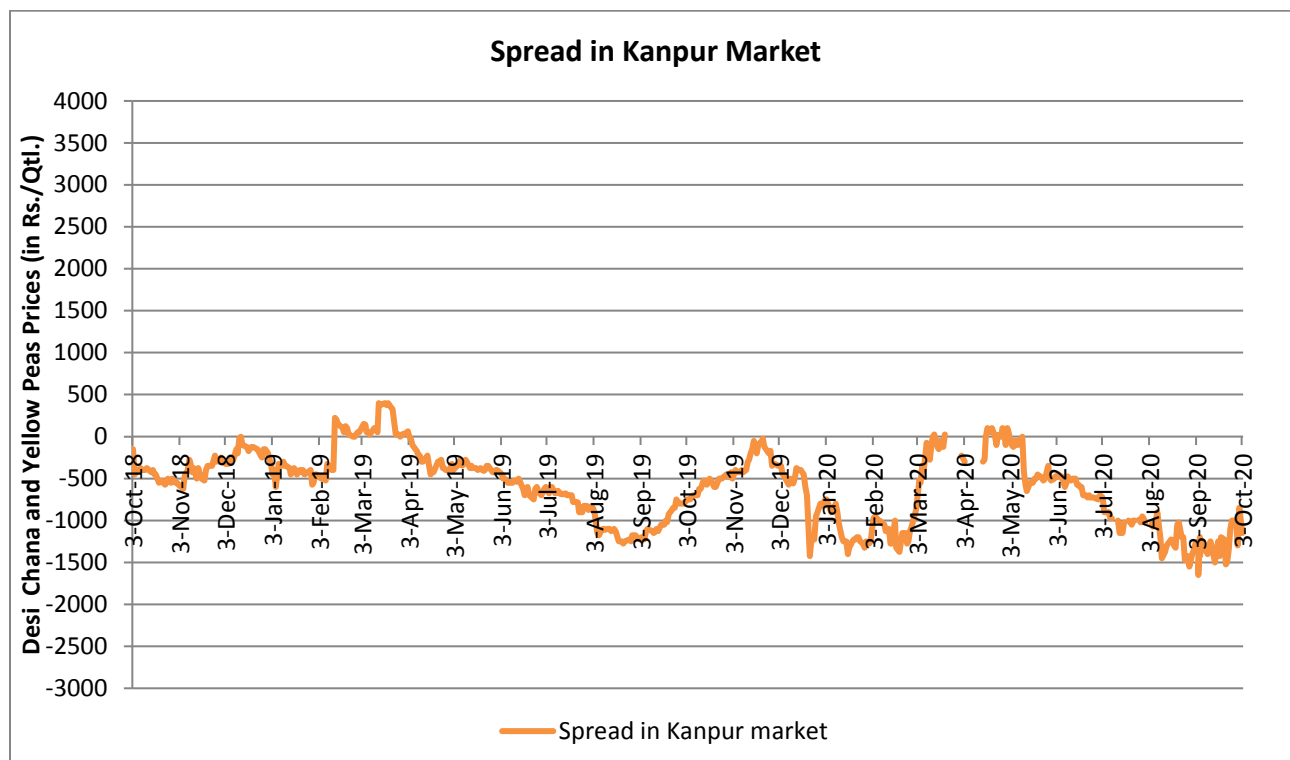
At the global level, Canada is exporting higher volume of peas as current buyers like EU, Pak, Sri-Lanka and Bangladesh have increased buying, taking advantage of lower price in global market.. Bangladesh and Nepal may buy higher quantity in Oct-Nov due to lower prices in the global market and sell it in India as there is good arbitrage opportunity for them.



Current Market Dynamics & Outlook: Peas market traded up due to tight supply side in the cash market. Availability in domestic market is decreasing while stockists are unwilling to sell sensing tight supply side. Kanpur market traded up by Rs100 to Rs 6700-6750 per qtl. Any major spike is unlikely now. Tight supply side is expected unless peas enters in India through Bangladesh and Nepal. Overall, all India average price was up by 0.50% to Rs 6700 per qtl. In Mumbai market, there was no quote for yellow peas as stock was exhausted. Canadian yellow pea in Kolkata is being traded at Rs 6900-7000.

Spread With Chana:

Spread between Chana and Peas, at Kanpur market remained in negative zone. Gap has decreased slightly from Rs 1000 to Rs 850 due to increased chana price. Spread is expected to remain in the negative zone in Oct too on relative movement in Chana prices. Overall outlook seems steady to slightly firm this week too.



MarketOutlook: Steady to slightly firm tone may prevail.

Lentils (Masoor):

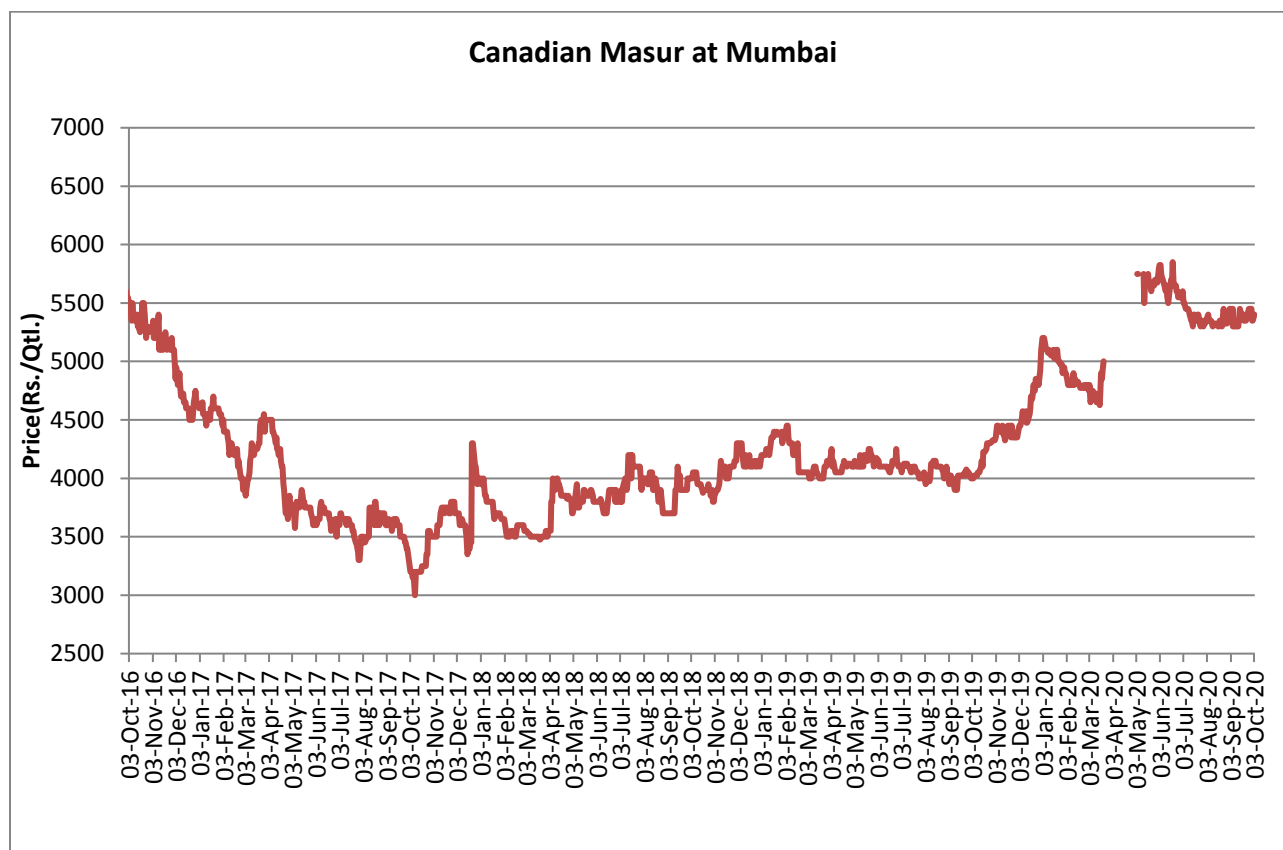
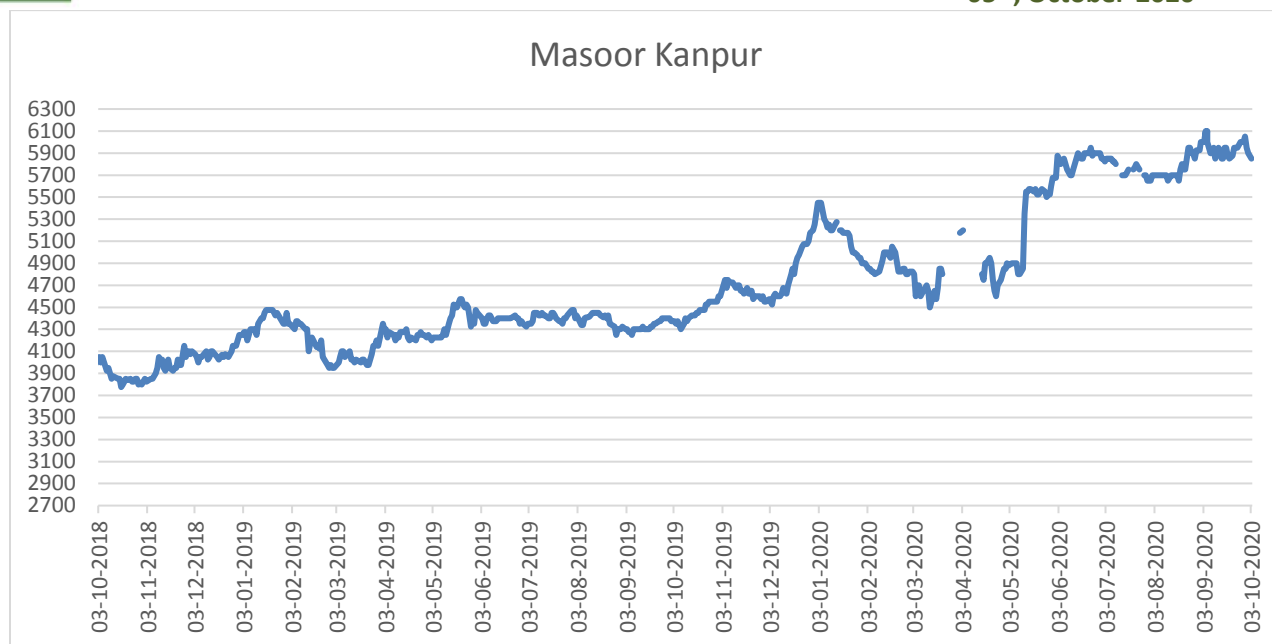
Market Recap:

Importers imported higher quantity (over 2.07 lakh Mt) of masur during Aug, taking advantage of the 10% import duty. Now 80% imported consignment is lying at ports as demand in domestic market is weak at this point of time. Total import from Apr to Aug reached at 5.19 lakh Mt So, prices did not increase in the market despite government raising duty from 10% to 30% from 1st Sep-2020. Now again import duty has been reduced from 30 to 10 % till 31st Oct-2020. It may mean higher import volume in Oct too. So supply would increase and price may trade in the limited range. Demand for daal too is weak. Masur was quoted at Rs 5450-5500 in Kolkata while in Mumbai it was traded at 5350-5400. Price of Australian containers was quoted at Rs 5400.

Price of Masur in Australia and Canada may increase again as demand from Asian countries is expected to increase. Apart from this lentils production in Australia may decrease by 7%. It may push up price. If demand increases in India, Importers can strike bulk deals at reduced duty again. Supply side is at comfortable level right now. Sowing is about to start in India.

Current Scenario:

Stock at ports has started increasing now. At Mumbai ports importers are selling masur at Rs 5550-5400. Nafed may start releasing stock to keep price under check. It has around 21,000 MT old stock while new stock is only 4500Mt. Any spike in masur market is unlikely. Demand is weak, so price may trade in limited range this week too.



Market Outlook: Prices may trade range bound due to higher supply prospects from imported stock in the near to medium term. Sluggish demand from mills and commencement of offloading by stockists remains unsupportive to cash market right now. Overall tone in masur market remains weak in Oct too.

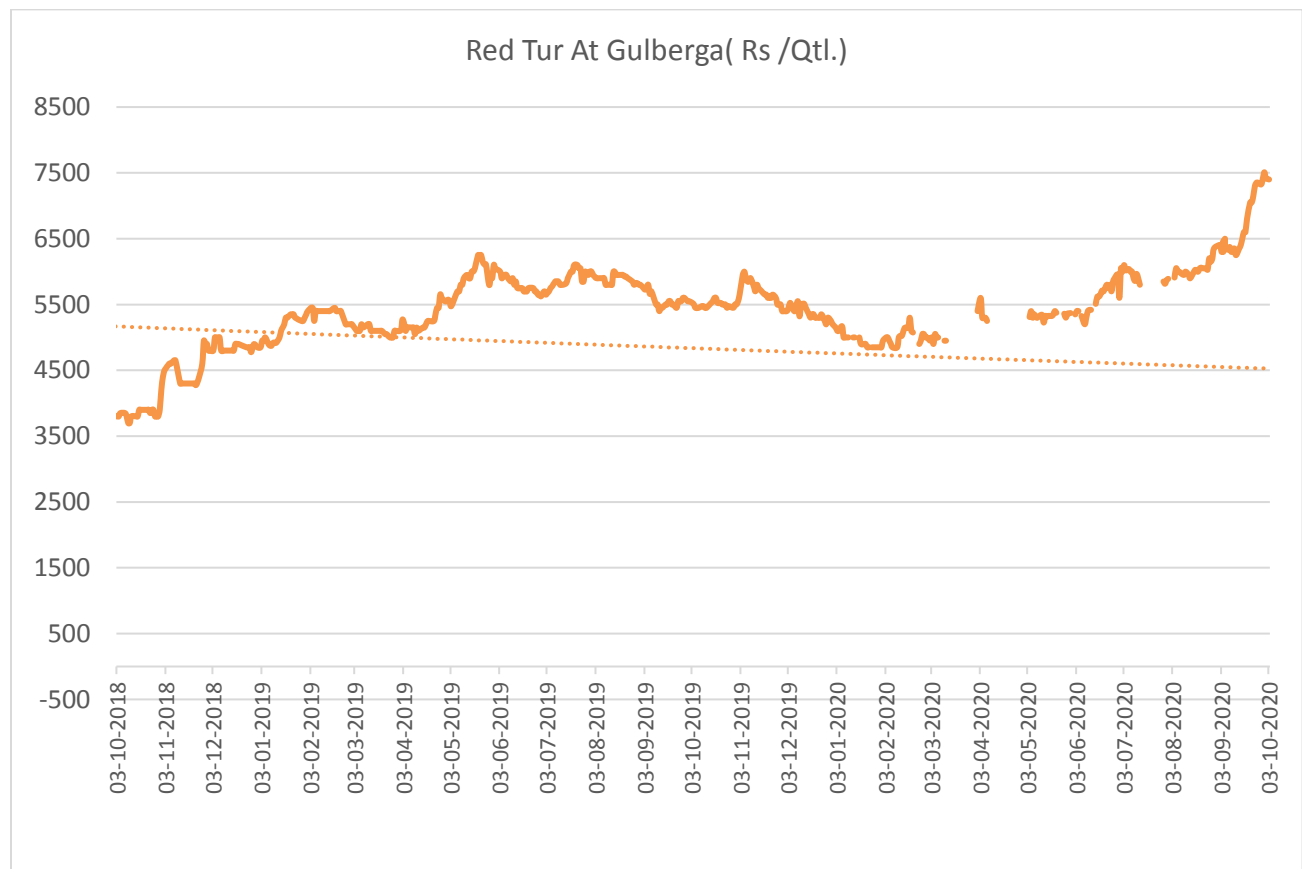
Pigeon Pea (Tur/Toor):

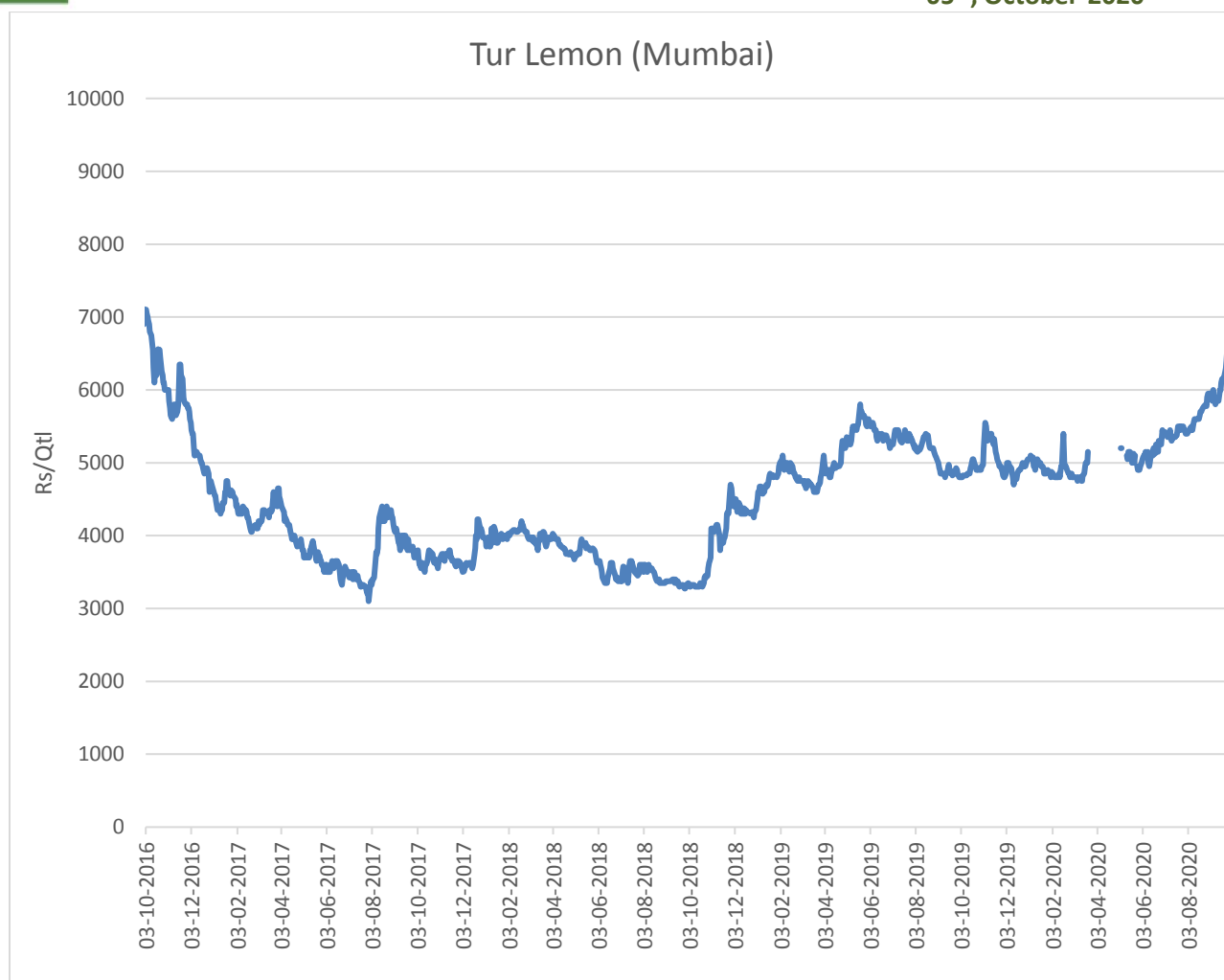
Market Recap:

Tur cash market continued to trade up against all expectations and it may continue to move up in coming weeks due to low availability of stocks at ports at this point of time. Import licenses have not been issued to importers yet, so millers may continue to buy tur from local markets. Even stockists are unwilling to sell sensing tight supply side in cash market. Arrivals in local market have decreased considerably. So any downward correction is unlikely in the near term. Tur was quoted at Rs 6900-7000 in Mumbai market. It is being traded at Rs 7100-7200 in Gulberga market. Overall sentiment seems firm. Importers are active in Myanmar, so it hints that govt may issue licenses soon, likely in mid Oct. Under prevailing conditions tur price may move up again by Rs200-300- from current levels.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

The production share of tur in total kharif pulses production is 34.8 % and farmers have covered around 109.5 % (48.49 lakh ha) area of normal (45.53 lakh ha). Planting is almost over and area may end at 48.50 lakh ha. Higher offtake from mills and improved demand for tur dal amid lower pace of import have helped market to trade up by Rs 250-350 in various markets, despite good planting and crop condition so far. Apart from renewed demand, arrivals in major markets are decreasing now amid restricted sales by Nafed and private trade. It would continue to support tur cash market if demand improves again. Demand for tur dal may increase again in the coming weeks due to festive season. As import licenses are yet to be issued, volume of imports from allocated quota of 4 lakh MT is expected to be lower in Oct, even if licences are issued in the beginning of Oct. uncertainty still prevails over issuing licenses.





In the first week of Oct-2020, average price in Gulberga market was up by Rs 100 to Rs 6950-7150 due to slower pace of import, improvement in demand for dal and improved buying by private traders. However, increasing kharif area and likely selling by Nafed may cap upward momentum to some extent in coming weeks. Import volumes (G to G basis) are likely to increase in Sep-Oct, while import licenses could be issued soon for private millers. Tur price is likely to trade steady to slightly firm this week.

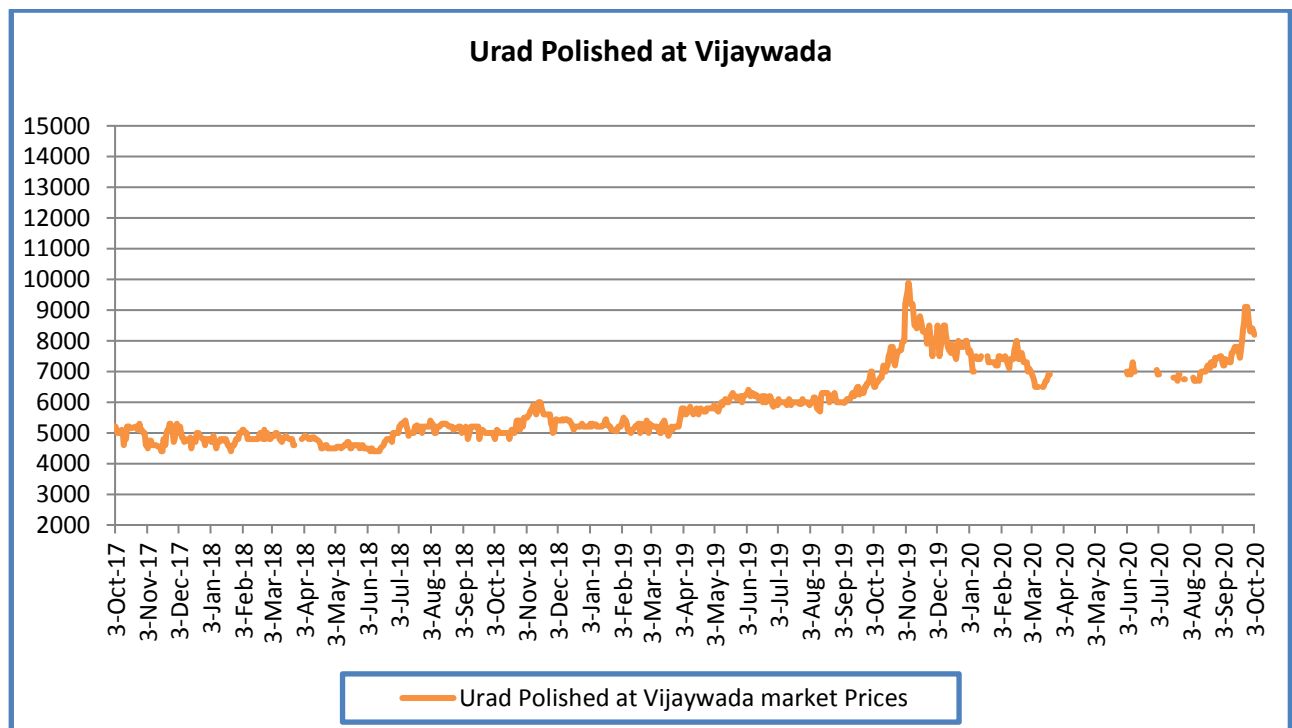
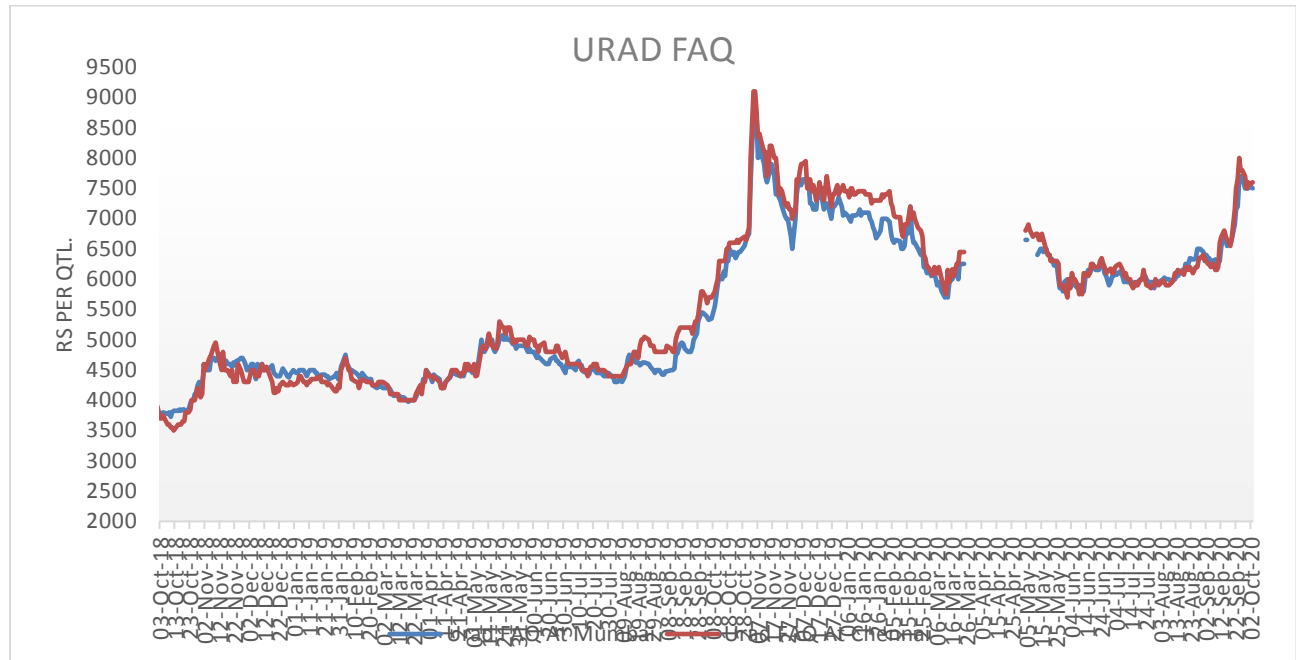
Black Matpe (Urad):

Slight downward correction was seen in urad market during week under review as govt has allowed 1.5 lakh Mt urad import. It has cooling impact on price. As kharif arrival is low and private buyers are active, any major dip is unlikely in urad cash market right now. Farmers too are restricting release of the crop sensing strong inner tone. Apart from it, the new crop loss too helped market to push up by Rs 100-200. DGFT has not allowed release of old stocks lying at ports as these stocks have been imported without proper documents or presenting wrong information about mills/ capacity. Quotes for FAQ urad moved up by \$70 to \$900 per MT while SQ moved up by \$60 to \$1010 per MT basis Indian port. Prices in domestic market moved up to Rs 7500-7600- for FAQ and Rs 8400-8600 for SQ at week end. If demand improves and new arrival is delayed, prices would increase against normal expectation. Arrival pressure from kharif crop is expected now Demand at higher level may decrease.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

The production share of urad in total kharif pulses production is 27.95 % and farmers have covered around 110 % (38.96 lakh ha) area of normal so far. Normal area of urad is 35.53 lakh ha. Planting is almost over now. Area in M.P.,MH & Kar has increased while it is down in Raj,U.P. & Telangana. However, overall area is higher so far. Due to heavy rains around 10000-15000 ha area is said to be inundated. However it would not affect the final size of the crop. Overall, planted area is higher by 44,000 ha from last year.

Market Outlook: Urad Prices are likely to show steady to slightly firm momentum.

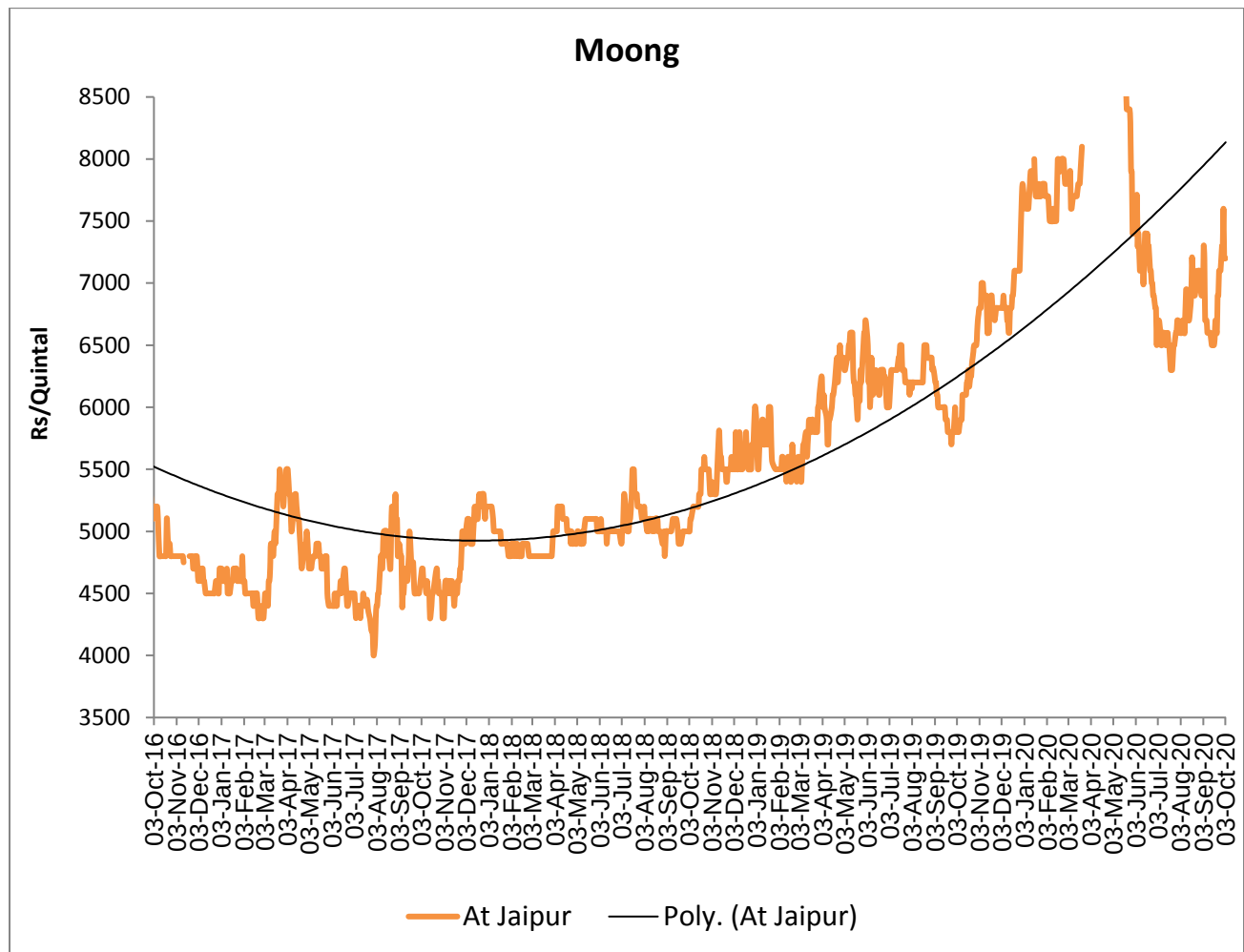


Green Gram (Moong):

Market Recap:

Prices are mostly steady but pressure should begin now, as arrivals from new kharif season has started increasing from Karnataka, Gujarat and MH. Besides, higher area coverage and good crop condition so far would not allow market to move up from current level. Arrival from MP is expected now, followed by Telangana and Raj.. If demand improves, slight recovery might be seen this week. There is no parity for import as moong price is ruling lower than Myanmar right now. Expecting a huge crop from Rajasthan, stockists prefer to sell now So, overall trend seems weak in the medium term despite minor loss in Karnataka (2500 ha) and Telangana (650 ha) by flooding.

.As demand is weak, prices may decrease by Rs300-400 from current level. Crop condition is good while some quality issues have been reported from those areas where heavy rains occurred during harvesting time. However, loss is minor when we consider higher area this year. Kharif production is expected to be in the range of 16.50-17 lakh Mt this year. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 7000-7200, may come down to Rs 5200-6800 in Oct. If Nfed starts bulk buying at MSP, price may sustain at current level.



Market Outlook: Moong prices are likely to trade steady to slightly weak in the near term.
