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Commodity-wise Domestic, International Prices and Arrivals at Different Centers



Weekly Highlights-Domestic Market:

- With favorable weather condition rabi pulses sowing is running smoothly. Farmers have planted 162.09 lakh ha area so far against normal of 144.89 lakh ha. Out of total farmers have covered 109.14 lakh ha area under gram against normal of 92.77 lakh ha. Farmers have covered 16.43 lakh ha under lentils (normal 15.86 lakh ha),10.60 lakh ha under field pea (normal 8.78 lakh ha),7.57 lakh ha under urad (normal 8.93 lakh ha),5.23 lakh ha under moong(normal 9.86 lakh ha),6.24 lakh ha under other pulses(normal 6.04 lakh ha).Gram area is running ahead by 3.49 % from last year so far, field pea down by 2.39%, lentils up by 2.50 %, other pulses up by 10.25%. Moong coverage is down by 4.21 % so far. Farmers may increase sowing activities in coming weeks under moong and urad.
- Chana cash market continues to trade under pressure due to increasing area, good crop condition so far, weak demand ahead of new crop and higher availability of old crop. Nafed may face difficulty to release stock at Rs 4875 per qtl. As new crop is hardly 40-45 days away, pressure of releasing stock would continue on Nafed. It may prompt Nafed to give discount and release stock before new crop hits in. Even private trades too would prefer to release stock whenever market improves. It would not allow chana market to go up beyond 4600-4750 in coming weeks. If weather turns rough (rains & hails storm) in Feb & March prices may move up. Under normal condition overall sentiments remain weak.
- Lentils prices continue to cool down with easing supply side from import and smooth sowing activities, supported by congenial weather condition in major producing states like Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Bihar. Agriwatch expects 13.25-13.50 lakh Mt production this year under normal weather condition. Major exporters like Australia and Canada are trying to sell as much as they can before duty revision from 10 to 30% from 1st Jan-2021. Pulses prices may be under pressure due to increasing rabi area and higher flow of import this year. Lentils price may decrease to Rs-4750-4800 by end Feb. New crop would hit market in Feb end. Overall tone is bearish. Current uptrend is unlikely to continue.
- Tur cash market traded steady to slightly firm with help of ongoing procurement drive despite increasing arrivals in major markets of Karnataka, Maharashtra, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh and higher import flow. Nafed has slowed down sale of tur.As crop is coming market is likely to trade stable to slightly firm. Private mills are active. All these factors may support cash market to some extent. Arrivals are likely to increase in Kurnool and Yammiganuar during the week under review. It was registered at 4254 bags in Kurnool and will continue to increase in other markets also.Crop condition in south Indian states is good despite some crop loss (around 5,000 ha) in AP due to recent storm and rains. Prices have slipped below MSP. and intervention through procurement activities is required to speed up.
- Short supply of quality crop and low flow of import amid restricted arrivals from rabi crop may support urad market to some extent in coming weeks. Mills are depending on imported volume and central pool stock. As impact of rabi arrival would be limited due to lower crop size, any major decline at all India level is unlikely. As there is a gap in supply-demand side, cash market may continue to trade sideways. Farmers have covered 7.57 lakh ha so far against 7.11 lakh ha last year. Farmers in AP have covered 2.82 lakh ha area against 2.58 lakh ha last year. It is higher by 9.30 % in AP while it is up by 3.11% in Tamil Nadu.
- Moong cash market traded stable with weak bias likely to continue in coming weeks. Import flow & weak
 demand in recent weeks have pushed moong price down by Rs300-400 in south India. Prices in market like
 Gannavaram traded down at 7400-7500 during the week. In north and central India prices have decreased
 below MSP. However, quality crop is still ruling above MSP. Tone remains weak as supply from central pool is
 expected soon.Arrival from rabi crop is expected from end Feb-Mar.Overall tone remains weak.



Peas import remains halted as the DGFT has not allowed an additional import beyond 1.5 lakh Mt for the
ongoing season. Stock at ports is low while arrival too in domestic markets has decreased to a negligible
level. New crop is still one month away, so steady tone may prevail. Demand is weak at higher level. Consumers
preferred to shift to other pulses as prices are higher.

Global Market:

- Lentil markets traded mixed during the past week as markets switched to holiday mode. Movement of lentils from origin to port locations in Canada have slowed considerably because of the loss of demand from India and stock accumulations in many destinations during the early fall shipping period. Markets continue to pay attention to rabi seeding planting progress in India. As of December 18 area had reached 1.531 million hectares of lentils, compared to 1.462 million at this time last year.
- For 2020-21, chickpeas production in Canada is likely to decrease by 15 % from last year to 214 Kt due to lower harvested area. Supply would be higher by 16% due to higher carryout. Production of desi types is expected to be higher while Kabuli type would decrease slightly. Despite lower production size total supply would increase from 439 to 539Kt this year. Export may stay steady at 105Kt while average price for the year may be \$560 per MT.
- Lentils production in Canada is expected to increase by 29 % to 2.9 MMT in 2020-21 due to higher yield and coverage area. Out of total production of red lentils would increase to 2.1Mt while large green lentils production may decrease to 0.6 MMT, followed by other types at 0.2 MMT. Export may increase slightly from 2861 to 2900 Kt. Average price for the ear may rule at \$625 per MT.
- Dry peas production in Canada is expected to increase by 8 % to 4.6 million tonne due to 10 % higher yield in major growing states in 2020-21. The major producing states like Alberta and Saskatchewan may contribute 4.1 MMT. Out of total production yellow peas would contribute 3.5 MMT. Average price may rule near \$295 per MT. Canada may export 3.8 million MT in 2021.
- Movement of field peas for Lithuania were up sharply from the previous month in October as per data
 published by Eurostat. Shipment reached 18,207 metric tons (MT) in Sep against 8,086 MT in Sep-2020. This
 brings total to 102,288 during the calendar year till Oct, down 34% last year. Netherlands was top buyer,
 receiving 7,341 MT in the month. United Kingdom was the second most important buyer buying 5,099 MT,
 followed by Norway at 2,750 MT.
- Global Chickpeas market traded almost flat last week. However desi chickpeas traded slightly weak due to higher production in Australia. Harvesting activities are on in parts of Australia. Australian exporters are hoping that India may reduce import duties on chickpeas in an effort to reduce food prices to urban consumers. Export in Sep was recorded up at 27,310 MT, up from 19,812 MT Aug-2020. This boosted shipments so far during the marketing year to 310,730, down 4% last year. Bangladesh brought 11,243 MT and Pakistan taking 5,971 MT, followed by United Arab Emirates at 3,592 MT.
- Global field peas market traded slightly up on the back of higher buying by exporters for meeting sales commitments. Whole green and yellow peas prices are increasing in Canada and USA too as they paid farmers higher prices. Maximum stock in Canada has been sold out by farmers. It leads to higher prices of peas.
- Lentils production in Australia is expected to decrease by 6.89% from 5.34 to 4.97 lakh tons in 2020-21. It is due to lower coverage (6.11%) of area from last year. Victoria and South Australia are major producing regions that contribute 92% of total production.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade mixed in coming weeks.




Pulses-Wise Scenario:

Chana

Current Scenario:

Chana cash market is likely to improve in the weeks ahead as Nafed has indicated that it will sell chana not below 4875 from its stock. Apart from it January is considered the second highest month of consumption. Area is up by 5 % so far and may cross 114-115 lakh ha this year against 110 lakh ha last year. Weather is favorable barring some parts of south India. Cash market is expected to trade firm and may improve by 200-250 in coming weeks. New crop is expected to hit market only in mid-February-2021. So, Agriwatch expects steady to slightly firm tone in the weeks ahead. Sensing firm price momentum stockists too may restric releasing stocks in Jan. Sowing is on and weather condition is good so far and a good production prospects seems on the sight now. There is no import parity due to high duty (60%). However, import continues from LDC at zero duty. At Rs 4300-4350, millers may start buying again. Nafed selling strategy would be main price driving force in Jan.

All India average price of chana decreased by 0.41 % to 4605 against Rs 4675 previous week. Australian chana traded up at Rs 5150-5200 per qtl in Mumbai market. As there is demand for dal at current price, chana is expected to move sideways. Following graph illustrates chana price movement in different markets:



Market Outlook: Steady to slightly firm movement is expected in cash chana market this week. Nafed's current selling strategy would continue to determine price trend in coming weeks. As Nafed has decided to accept bids at or around 4875, some support might be seen. However, higher area coverage prospects may cap upward momentum to a certain extent. Indian importers have imported around 3.25 lakh MT chana during April to Oct 2020.




Peas (Matar):

Market Recap:

Despite negligible availability of field peas at ports, prices of yellow and green peas are stable despite new arrivals of green peas started in various markets. As arrival of green peas would increase in coming weeks, pressure on price might be seen. Arrival from new crop is expected to increase in Jan-2021, so stockists who have stocks of peas, are now selling it. Import is not taking place and the govt. is not in favor of allowing import above 1.5 lakh MT. As prices are lower in global market, Bangladesh and Nepal are buying more matar hoping for an arbitrage opportunity in selling to India. Demand is weak as other pulses are available comparatively at cheaper price. Matar in Kanpur market is being traded at Rs 6500-6600 per qtl. At port it is being quoted at Rs 7500.

Despite improved demand for peas and daal, prices are expected to trade steady to slightly weak. Govt. is not in favor of additional import despite higher prevailing price in domestic market. As prices are higher, area may increase this year by 3 to 5 percent. Sowing starts from mid Oct. As of now farmers have covered 10.39 lakh ha against season's normal of 8.78 lakh ha. It is down by 1.8 % till date. Following chart shows price movement in various markets:




Current Market Dynamics & Outlook: Peas market traded slightly up due to short supply. However, prices are likely to decrease as bulk arrival expected in Jan-2021. Stockists are now willing to sell at higher level. In Kanpur market it was quoted at Rs 6500-6600 per qtl. Any major spike from here is unlikely due to stockists's selling and expected bulk arrival soon. Overall, all India average price was down by 0.15% to Rs 6550 per qtl. In Mumbai market, there was no quote for yellow peas as stock has been exhausted. Canadian yellow pea in Kolkata is being traded at Rs 7000-7250. No trade has been reported at this price this week too.



Spread With Chana:

Spread between Chana and Peas, at Kanpur market remained in negative zone. Gap has increased considerably from Rs 1750 to Rs 1900 due to decreased chana price. Spread is expected to remain in the negative zone in Dec too on relative movement in Chana prices. Overall outlook seems steady to slightly weak this week too.



MarketOutlook: Steady to slightly weak tone may prevail.

Lentils (Masoor):

Market Recap:

Slight recovery was seen in Masur market during the review week. But it is a temporary recovery as import flow is likely to continue till end Dec due to applicable duty of 10%. Demand for daal is weak too. Around 3.85 lakh MT was imported in Aug, Sep and Oct-2020 at the lower duty and around 2 to 2.25 lakh MT is expected in Nov and Dec. So supply side would be at comfortable level in these months too. It would not allow market to move up despite it being a lean season. Import volume would be higher in Nov-Dec too, so prices are unlikely to move up beyond a certain level (Rs4900-5300). Stock at ports is said to be around 1.25 lakh MT. Despite the higher import, prices are not likely to decrease below Rs4900 as stockists are unwilling to sell it below 4900 even in producing centres. It may help retaining acreages. Farmers have covered 15.31 lakh ha so far. Higher MSP for masur from Rs4800 to Rs5100 for MY 2020-21 has encouraged farmers to plant more this year.


At Mumbai ports importers are selling masur at Rs 5100-5150.As prices are ruling near MSP in domestic market, Nafed would not sell its stocks until price moves up again. Old stock with Nafed is around 21,000 MT. Supply side would be at comfortable level as import flow would continue till Dec-2020.In January, it may move up slightly and rule in the range of Rs 5000-5400.

Current Scenario:



Ample stock is available at ports .At Mumbai ports importers are selling masur at Rs 5100-5150. Any spike in masur market is unlikely. Demand is stable, so price may trade in limited range this week too. Higher import flow would also cap market.





Market Outlook: Prices may trade steady to slightly firm due to improved demand in the short term. Overall tone in masur market remains firm in the first week of Jan-2021..



Pigeon Pea (Tur/Toor):


Market Recap:

Extended time line for import till 31st Dec-2020 and likely higher import volume inDec amid normal crop condition in major growing region would not allow tur market to move up beyond a certain level. Right now it is being traded at Rs 5700-5850 in Gulberga market and may move up to Rs 5800-6000 in coming weeks. Nafed has accepted bids at 5400-5500 in Karnataka. Supply side would increase while Nafed continues to sell tur through auction accepting bids near Rs 5400-5500. However, with commencement of procurement, prices are unlikely to decrease from current level. Farmers have restricted release as they are willing to sell iton MSP. Nafed still has around 3.15 lakh MT tur stock..


Old lemon tur too are being quoted at Rs 5600-5700 per qtl in Mumbai market. Arrivals are likely to increase in major centers like Jalgaon, Akola and Amravati line from mid Jan. Local tur(new) in Gulberga(Sholapur) too moved up to Rs 5800 and with help of procurement support it may move up further by Rs 100 to 200 under prevailing market fundamentals. Crop condition is good so far. Indian farmers had covered 48.49 lakh ha against 45.88 lakh ha last year. As per Agriwatch estimate India may harvest 38.15 lakh Mt crop this year. Weather condition in next one month is very crucial for driving price up and down in jan-2021.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

Recent rains in Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Karnataka have affected standing tur crop and harvesting may be delayed by couple of weeks. Some losses have been reported in south India, however, these losses may be compensated by higher expected yield in Kar and Mharashtra. Arrival from new crop may be delayed by 15 days due to delayed sowing and high moisture level in the field. Stake holders should start releasing stock as soon as market improves. Higher import quantity is expected in Nov and Dec. The production share of tur in total kharif pulses production is 34.8 % and farmers have covered around 109.5 % (48.49lakh ha) area of normal (45.53 lakh ha).







In the3rd week of Jan-2021, average price in Gulberga market was up by Rs 100 to Rs 5800-5850 due to commencement of procurement and slower release by farmers. It may continue to support prices in coming weeks. Apart from this likely restricted selling by Nafed may support market in coming weeks. Import volumes (G to G basis) are likely to increase in Dec due to issuance of import licenses for private millers and extended time limit for import. Tur price is likely to trade steady to slightly firm this week too.

Black Matpe (Urad):

Urad traded slightly down during 3rd week of Jan due to weak demand and likely higher volume of import and new arrivals in Jan. Besides, rabi area is expected to increase. Import volume may increase as govt has allowed 1.5 lakh Mt urad import. As kharif arrivals are low and rabi arrival is expected by end Dec any major dip is unlikely at this point of time. Farmers too are restricting release of the crop sensing strong inner tone. Apart from it, the news of some crop loss too helped market to push up by Rs 100 during 4th week of Dec. DGFT has not allowed release of old stocks lying at ports as these stocks have been imported without proper documents or presenting wrong information about mills/ capacity. Quotes for FAQ urad stay down at \$800 per MT while SQ moved down by \$20 to \$900 per MT basis Indian port. Prices in domestic market moved down to Rs 7000-7100- for FAQ and Rs 7550-7600 for SQ at week endRabi sowing is on and may continue till mid jan-2021.

Stock position of urad for export in Myanmar is said to be around 1.0 to 1.25 lakh MT. New crop is expected to hit market in mid -March-2021.By then Myanmar may export around 1.25 lakh MT under quota system before new crop hits the market and would consume 50,000 MT for domestic consumption. As India has allowed only 1.5 lakh Mt import, pressure on price in Myanmar might be seen. Under prevailing market fundamental market may trade steady to slightly weak in Jan-2021.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:


The production share of urad in total kharif pulses production is 27.95 % and farmers have covered around 110 % (38.96 lakh ha) area of normal so far. Normal area of urad is 35.53 lakh ha. Planting is almost over



now. Area in M.P.,MH & Kar has increased while it is down in Raj,U.P. & Telangana. However, overall area is higher so far. Due to heavy rains around 10000-15000 ha area is said to be inundated. However it would not affect the final size of the crop. Overall, planted area is higher by 44,000 ha from last year. Under rabi season farmers have covered 4.58 lakh ha so far.

Market Outlook: Urad Prices are likely to show weak movement.








Green Gram (Moong):

Market Recap:

Downward trend in moong cash market continued as other pulses like chana, tur, urad and peas traded down too in the 3rd week of Jan. Procurement of moong is on in states like Karnataka, Maharashtra and Rajasthan. As prices are higher in some regions, procurement pace remains slow so far. As rains have affected quality of moong, so price range is wider this year. It is being traded at Rs 5500-7400, depending on quality of the crop. If demand improves, slight recovery might be seen for a shorter time. There is a parity for import as moong price is ruling higher than Myanmar right now. Stockists are preferring to sell now as import possibility has increased now. So, overall trend seems weak in the medium term despite minor loss in Karnataka (3500 ha) and Telangana (750 ha) by flooding.

Rabi sowing has already started now and farmers have planted 3.36 thousand ha so far against normal of 9.86 lakh ha .Farmers had planted 35.84 lakh ha in kharif season.Kharif arrival is on . As kharif production is lower than expected earlier, price would not decrease more from current level. Moong would continue to trade in the range of Rs 5500 to 7500 in Jan-2021 against MSP of Rs 7196 per qtl.
