

Domestic Market Highlights:

All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 13.03.2015 for the marketing season 2014-15 was 232.33 lakh tonnes against the procurement of 237.02 lakh tonnes upto the corresponding period of last year. Punjab, Chhattisgarh and Haryana are the major contributor for rice procurement with contribution of 77.81 lakh tonnes, 33.54 Lakh T and 19.96 Lakh T respectively, However in MY-2014-15 contribution by Punjab is lower by 4% from last year same period of 88.06 lakh tonnes due to lower production estimates for MY-2014-15 and comparatively high open market price.

The area under rice in the Rabi season has dropped some 10 per cent to 38.27 lakh hectares (lh) compared with 42.56 lh during the corresponding period a year ago, data released by the Agriculture Ministry on 20th March 2015.

Basmati Rice Market Unaffected due to rain: Recent rains accompanied by strong wind and hails storm have damaged rabi crops, specially wheat, pulses and oilseeds adversely and production of these crops is likely to be revised down by 5 to 10 percent. The rabi rice crop remains unaffected in A.P., West Bengal and Chhattisgarh.

Rice markets in Punjab and Haryana remain unmoved so far. Market participants expect stable price in the weeks ahead as there is no support from demand side. As prices are ruling at lower level, farmers may decrease aromatic rice area by 25 to 30 percent in coming year despite normal weather forecast by IMD.

Karimnagar district, which is now known as the rice bowl of Telangana, now faces a depressing future as the area under paddy cultivation has declined drastically, causing concern among farmers and others. The main reason behind decreasing of paddy area in rabi is due to severe drought condition, a depleting groundwater table. Paddy cultivation came down to 90,850 hectares compared to 1.38 lakh hectares in 2013-14.

Price Outlook:-Average Rice price in all India is likely to trade steady to slightly weak in 03rd Week of March.

International Market Highlight:

Thailand Commerce Ministry delayed the second crop auction from the government stockpile for avoid the bearish rice price in medium term. Auction for main rice is going in the country and thus FOB price is moving down by 5-7% from same period last year for Thai white rice high quality. As per by ministry of Thailand, price is likely to up in coming weeks due to global demand from Philippines and China,



Indonesian wholesale rice prices grew by 22 percent in February, 2015, while retail prices increased more than 5 percent during the same period. USDA attributes the price rise due to supply declines caused by delayed harvests, As per USDA latest report. The Indonesian government has allocated 300,000 MT of rice in order to offset rising prices, and also distributed 174,000 MT of rice through its raskin program during January/February 2015.

As per latest report by USDA, world rice production is likely to down about 0.4% from last year production of 477,080 Thousand metric tonnes due to major fall in Asian countries like India, Thailand and Pakistan. On the other hand, We can see slightly compensated by increases rice production in Bangladesh, China, Myanmar, Vietnam and Philippines. In 2014-15, India's milled rice production is likely to reach about 102,500 thousand metric tonne, down by around 3.79% from last year production of 106.54 million tonnes.

Peru a country in western South America's Rice production in MY 2015/16 is forecast at 2.15 MMT (milled basis), remaining in the same level as current production. Rice production has reached a maximum level and is now limited by water availability and demand. The total rice harvested area for MY 2015/16 is forecast to fall to 400,000 hectares, about the same as the previous year. With good weather conditions and plentiful water, rice production in CY 2014 reached almost 2 MMT. Rice is normally harvested April through May in the country, averaging \$317 per MT in CY 2014. This price represents a 3.6 percent increase compared to the previous year.

At price front Vietnam remains the cheapest supply source with an offer at \$365-\$375 per tonne for 5% white broken rice. India offers the same variety at \$400-405 per tonne. Thai white rice is a little bit costly at \$420-425 per tonne for 100 % white rice. We see here the difference between offering price is almost \$25/35per tonne. However, variation is due to quality to some extent. This shows that all suppliers are intending to offload as much quantity as they can under tough marketing condition. Slight recovery is expected from current level as rice market is almost hovering at its bottom level. Major suppliers can not offer rice at high price as they know that other suppliers are ready to attract them immediately.
