

Domestic Market Highlights:

Punjab and Haryana governments have counsel paddy farmers not to undertake sowing of a high- yielding variety 'PUSA Basmati 1509' before July 15 after exporters complained of high incidence of breakage in basmati rice due to early plantation.

All India Average rice price in the fourth week of June, moved up by 1.47% from previous week and currently hovers in the range of Rs.2715-2720/quintal. We expect that the market will move in the range bound with some positive tone in coming week due to lower area coverage compared to last year. Basmati Rice price get firmed by Rs 200-300 per quintal (major varieties) at the wholesale grain markets from last week due to limited supply from producing belts.

The total sown area as on 26th June, as per reports received from States, stands at 165.62 lakh hectare as compared to lakh hectare at this time last year. It is reported that rice has been sown/transplanted in 23.28 lakh ha, pulses in 11.04 lakh ha, coarse cereals in 19.28 lakh hectare, oilseeds in 27.89 lakh ha and cotton in 34.87 lakh ha.

This kharif season 2015-16, better-than-expected monsoon rains in the past two weeks have helped farmers in several parts of India sow all kharif crops like paddy, cotton, pulses and oilseeds on time, but the IMD is still sticking to its forecast of a likely drought. Although a delayed arrival of the monsoon had worried farmers, more than two-thirds of the country has now received normal or above-normal levels of rainfall so far this monsoon season, which starts on June 1. Overall, rainfall is 23 percent above normal as of Wednesday. Agriwatch first preliminary rice production estimates that this year (KMS 2015-16) rice production is expected to be around 104 million tonnes under current rainfall condition. However if paddy growing states receives lower rain fall between -5 to -10%, production may decreases by 1.5% to 103.23 million tonnes.

Price Outlook:-Average Rice price in all India is likely to trade steady to firm with lean season in coming days.

International Market Highlight:

Pakistan's total exports declined sharply in May 2015, continuing to decline for the second consecutive month after increasing about 33% m/m in March 2015. Pakistan



exported around 263,044 tons of rice (including basmati and non-basmati) in May 2015, down about 27% from around 360,446 tons exported in April 2015, according to provisional data from the Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (PBS). In terms of value, Pakistan's rice export earnings declined about 16% to around \$152 million in May 2015 from around \$180 million earned in April 2015.

Thai Rice Mill Association President Manus Kitprasert has expressed concern that the prolonged low rice price in Thailand could force many rice mill operators to exit the market.

The Thailand Commerce Ministry plans to auction another 1.4 million tonnes of rice on July 7, the Foreign Trade Department under fourth auction program. As per Director-general Duangporn Rodphaya, the fourth auction this year will offer 1.395 million tonnes of both fragrant and white rice in different grades. In the 3rd auction The Ministry of Commerce reported that 840,000 tons of rice out of the 1.06 million tons worth 7.8 billion baht in the government stockpile was sold.

Unofficial preliminary Thailand rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for May 25-31, 2015 totaled 42,489 metric tons, down 46,286 metric tons from the previous week and down 21,673 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 64,162 metric tons. Rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) from January 1 – May 31, 2015, totaled 1,515,086 metric tons, down 12 percent from the same period last year. Total rice exports from January to April 2015 totaled 2,826,561 million metric tons, down 4 percent from the same period last year.
