

**Domestic Market Highlights:**

**Total non-basmati Rice export in the 02nd week of July was 151219.83 tons.** Gangavaram Sea, Kolkata Sea and Kakinada Sea were the major ports for non-basmati rice export during this period. These five ports cover approx 76% of total export in this period. Total basmati Rice export in the 02nd week of July was 83772 tons. Mundra Sea, Kandla Sea and Loni ICD were the major port for basmati rice export center during this period. These three ports cover more than 90% of total export in this period.

**Among the food grains, the inflation for Cereals has increased to 6.32% from the previous month's level of 4.60%, Rice to 3.37% from the previous month's level of 2.22% and Wheat 6.83% from the previous month's level of 3.85%. The inflation for Pulses has decreased to 26.61% from the previous month's level of 35.56%.**

**Total non-basmati Rice export in the 01st week of July was 125175.72 tons.** Kakinada Sea, Kolkata Sea and Vizag Sea were the major ports for non-basmati rice export during this period. These five ports cover approx 83% of total export in this period. Total basmati Rice export in the 01st week of July was 70940.22 tons. Mundra Sea, Loni ICD and Dadri ICD were the major port for basmati rice export center during this period. These three ports cover more than 88% of total export in this period.

**Wholesale Prices for India as an average for second week of July traded firmed by 8% from last week.** Prices are currently hovering at Rs.2970-2975/quintal and 12.58% up from price of Rs.2662/Quintal during corresponding period last year. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range bound with firm tone in coming week. Prices of Basmati rice remained weak for the fourth week of June on sluggish demand from retailers against supply from producing regions.

**Preliminary reports of crop coverage in the Kharif season have started coming in. The total sown area** as on 15th July, as per reports received from States, stands at 559.76 lakh hectare compared to 548.38 lakh hectare at the corresponding time last year. It is reported that rice has been sown/transplanted in 123.93 lakh ha which is 0.76% higher than last year area of 122.99 lakh hectare till date.

**Till July 15, higher area coverage under rice, compared to normal area coverage of corresponding week** (average of 2011-12 to 2015-16),was reported from Punjab 26.90 lakh hectare up by around 11% from same period corresponding year followed by Chhattisgarh(18.27 lakh Ha,) Odisha(10.28 lakh Ha,) Haryana (7.01 lakh Ha,) and U.P( 15.14 lakh Ha,).

**According to the preliminary official statistics for January-April 2016, rice exports from India in** the first four months of CY 2016 are estimated at 3.48 MMT compared to 4.14 MMT during the corresponding period last year down 16 percent over last

year. Assuming no significant change in the export demand and price parity for Indian rice vis-avis rice from competing origins, CY 2016 exports are likely to reach 10 MMT.

**Wholesale Prices for India as an average for first week of July traded firmed by 2.6% from last week.** Prices are currently hovering at Rs.2750-2755/quintal and 3.34% up from price of Rs.2662/Quintal during corresponding period last year. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range bound with firm tone in coming week. Prices of Basmati rice remained weak for the fourth week of June on sluggish demand from retailers against supply from producing regions.

**Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of June moved up from last month and currently is in the range of USD 895.897/MT** which is up by around 1.02% from last month price. Average basmati rice price increased due to increase buying interest for stockpiling which push the price in northward direction. Pakistani basmati price has too up from USD 750/MT to 825\$/MT, according to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO). Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is hovering in the range of USD 825-826/MT which is up by 10.00% from last month FOB of USD 750/MT.

**India's rice stocks in the central pool as on June 1, 2016 stood at around 27.21 million tons up by about 8%** from around 25.72 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are up about 27.62% from around 21.32 million tons recorded on April 1, 2016. The current rice stocks are about one million tons more than the required strategic reserve norms of around 1.25 million tons for this time of the year, according to the FCI.

**Price Outlook:-Average Rice price in all India is likely to trade steady with firm tone due to normal demand and tight supply.**

#### **International Market Highlight:**

**Vietnam's rice export is estimated to drop to 5.65 million tonnes in 2016, down 14 percent** against the previous year and 800,000 tonnes lower than initial forecast. According to the Vietnam Food Association (VFA), this is the first time since 2009 Vietnam's rice export may fall below 6 million tonnes. At present, Vietnam's big rice importers like the Philippines and Indonesia are showing no intention of buying more rice. Meanwhile, the purchasing power of China, which accounts for nearly 35 percent of Vietnam's export volume, is declining. VFA statistics showed that Vietnam shipped abroad 2.65 million tonnes of rice in the first half of this year, earning 1.14 billion USD.

China remained Vietnam's largest rice importer, accounting for 35 percent of the market share, followed by Africa and Indonesia. As of late 2016, there are about 1.27 million tonnes of rice in stock. However, the rice output of the summer-autumn crop is predicted to decrease due to long-lasting drought and saline intrusion.

**Cambodia exported 268,190 tons of milled rice in the first half of 2016, down 5.8 percent from the 283,825 tons in the same period last year.** The Southeast Asian country has exported its milled rice to 57 countries and regions around the world. Three top buyers are China, France and Poland, adding that China imported some 47,024 tons of milled rice from Cambodia during the January-June period this year, France imported 37,463 tons and Poland purchased 36,164 tons. Cambodia produced over 9 million tons of paddy rice a year. With this amount, country has over 3 million tons of milled rice left over for annual export.

**The Thai Government announced that it will issue two new tenders for 2.6 million metric tons of its rice stocks on July 25, 2016.** The first tender for 2.2 million metric tons will be contingent for export only as eligible bidders are required to have export orders from their foreign buyers. These tenders will mainly consist of 5% grade white rice and broken rice (A1 Super) from carry-over stocks under the MY2012/13 and MY2013/14 rice pledging programs. Meanwhile, the second tender for 0.4 million metric tons will be industrial uses.

**The Thai government issued 4 tenders totaling 4.6 million metric tons during January – June 2016.** It has reportedly sold around 2.8 million metric tons. The government reported that it is still holding rice stocks of around 9 million metric tons, which consist of 3 million metric tons of food- grade rice and 6 million metric tons of industrial grade rice (including food processing and feed industries).

**Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for May 29 – June 5, 2016** totaled 64,534 metric tons, down 30,834 metric tons from the previous week and up 3,862 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 60,671 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – June 5, 2016 totaled 1,571,114 metric tons, down 0.3 percent from last year.

**The Thailand Commerce Ministry has set a target to sell the remaining 10 million tonnes of rice bought** under the Yingluck government's rice pledging scheme within this year. The remaining rice stockpiles are divided into three lots: over six million tonnes of PAA-grade or good quality rice; about two million tonnes of Grade C rice which are not suitable for human consumption; and about two million tonnes of rotten rice which are good for industrial use such as for producing ethanol. As said by Commerce Ministry they would try to sell the 10 million tonnes of rice through every channel, including open

auctions, G-to-G deals, direct sale to domestic and overseas customers and even donations.
