

Domestic Market Highlights:

Wholesale Prices for India as an average for 01st week of March traded firmed by 7.08% from last week. Prices are currently hovering at Rs.3030-3035/quintal and 3.05% up from price of Rs.2943/Quintal during corresponding period last year. Agriwatch expects rice market to move in firm tone as demand is continuously strong from African countries in the market.

India average wholesale rice prices have increases in February- 2017 due to continuous demand coming from international markets as well diminishing stock from various producing states. Average monthly wholesale rice prices in India stood at around Rs.2, 977 per quintal in February 2017, up about 3.88% from around Rs.2, 866 per quintal in January 2017, and up about 3.94% from around Rs.2, 864 per quintal a year ago. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range bound with firm tone in coming month due to expectation of higher international demand.

Rice prices were stable in India and Vietnam on weak demand while in Thailand rice price moving in north direction. India's 5 percent broken parboiled rice prices were steady at \$373-\$378 per tonne as exporter demand remained slack. Even with lower demand export price are not lower due to higher paddy prices and strong rupee. In Vietnam, the world's third largest rice exporter, 5 percent broken rice prices were stable at \$350-\$355 a tonne. Local prices may drop in the next few weeks when the main harvest season fully starts. Meanwhile, Thai benchmark 5-percent broken rice widened to \$350-\$360 a tonne, free-on-board (FOB) Bangkok, from \$350-\$355 a tonne last week.

Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of February moved firm from last month and currently is in the range of USD 1090-1092/MT which is up by 15% from last month price of 954USD/T. Average basmati rice price too firm with lower aromatic rice production estimates which is aound 25-30% lower than last year, according to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO). Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is hovering in the range of USD 1028-1030/MT which is also up by 6.19% from last month FOB of USD 969/MT.

As per market sources as on 08Mar, 1121 golden sella rice traded @ Rs. 6100-6150/quintal while 1121 sella at Rs.5850/quintal,1121 steam rice traded @ Rs.7100-7200/quintal,sugandh steam rice traded at Rs.6000/quintal and Parmal-14 steam at Rs.3250-3300/quintal.

As per market sources as on 08-Mar, 1121 paddy arrival in Tarn-taranmandi is 500 bags and traded at Rs.3250/quintal while 1509 @ Rs.3065/quintal.



As per market sources as on 09-March, total paddy arrival in 25000narelamandiis 15000bags with 1121 rate of Rs.3100/quintal,1509 paddy traded @ Rs.2900/quintal, Sugandha paddy @ Rs.2861/quintal and DP paddy at Rs.3150/quintal.

As per Telangana State Agriculture Department, area under paddy is likely to four-fold increase following good monsoon. It was around 1.63 lakh hectares in MY-2015-16 rabi season which is 236% up to 5.48 lakh hectares in MY 2016-17 rabi season. Bountiful rains filled the projects in most of the districts. Comparatively, the Kharif of 2016 saw drought and delayed rainfall resulting in only 7.31 lakh hectares of area sown as against the 9.86 lakh hectares normally sown during Kharif.

India's rice stocks in the central pool as on February- 1, 2017 stood at around 29.29 million tons up by about 1.20% from around 28.94 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are down about 1.34% from around 29.69 million tons recorded on January-01, 2016. The current rice stocks are about one million tons more than the required strategic reserve norms of around 1.25 million tons for this time of the year, according to the FCI.

As per second advance estimate released by Agriculture Ministry, Total production of rice is estimated at record 108.86 million tonnes which is also a new record. This year's Rice production is higher by 2.21 million tonnes than previous record production of 106.65 million tonnes achieved during 2013-14. It is also higher by 3.44 million tonnes than the five years' average Rice production of 105.42 million tonnes. Production of rice has increased significantly by 4.45 million tonnes than the production of 104.41 million tonnes during 2015-16. As a result of very good rainfall during monsoon 2016, record rice production seen in the current year.

The Centre has approved the Odessa Government proposal for extension of Kharif paddy procurement deadline to April 30. Paddy procurement is in full swing in most of the districts except Kandhamal where the the process will start from next week. Setting a target to procure 30 lakh tons of rice for the 2016-17 kharif marketing season (KMS), the state government started the procurement operation from Bargarh district on November 29 last year. Since post-harvest operation of paddy is still on in many parts of the state, the state government requested the Ministry of Agriculture to extend the paddy procurement deadline from March 30 to end of April, 2017. About 17.45 lakh tons of paddy (equivalent to 11.87 lakh tons of rice) worth Rs 2,562 crore has been procured till date.

Price Outlook:-Average Rice price in all India is likely to trade steady to firm tone due to fresh demand with lower arrival.



International Market Highlight:

The Thai Government has set a target of exporting 10 million tonnes of rice in 2017, including 1 million tonnes sold in governmental contracts and the rest through private exporters. According to Thai Minister of Commerce, this year, the country will ship abroad 900,000 tonnes of rice to China under a contract with the Chinese Government after selling 100 tonnes to the country earlier. For the private sector, the Thai government will support domestic exporters in shipping 5.19 million tonnes of rice to the African market, 2.22 million tonnesto Asian countries, 630,000tonnesto the US and Canada, 390,000tonnes to Europe, 360,000tonnes to the Middle East and 210,000 tonnes to Oceania.

Ghana Government has set an ambitious target to increase rice production by an enormous 49% just this year as an extent to reduce rice imports to save the economy foreign exchange. As at the end of 2016, Ghana's rice production stands at 687,680 metric tonnes and 1,025,180 metric tonnes to be produced in 2017. Production in the country is to increase by 337,500 metric tonnes this year which may impact the import from different nation include Indian non-basmati rice.

Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for February 20-26, 2017, totaled 79,133 metric tons, down 99,420 metric tons from the previous week, and down 74,666 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 153,799 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – February 26, 2017, totaled 1,181,411 metric tons.

Rice Harvesting of the market year 2016/17in Pakistan rice crop is complete and initial reports suggest production was 6.6 MMT, down slightly from a year ago. Sri Lanka is to import over 250,000 tons of rice to maintain a buffer stock sufficient for one and half months owing to a possible shortage of rice during the first quarter of next year, due to drought. The Government has taken a decision to import rice through the private sector and provide bonded warehouse facilities for them as the country's rice production is expected to drop during the drought period. While the private sector will be allowed to freely import rice, there won't be any imports by the government unlike during the previous regime, he pointed out.

The Philippines' state grains agency has approved permits for local rice traders to import 641,080 tons of the staple grain from Thailand, Vietnam, Pakistan and India. The approved imports, which must be brought in by Feb. 28, 2017, account for 80 percent of



the maximum volume of 805,200 tons that private traders are allowed to bring in under an annual country-specific quota scheme. Private traders will import 284,780 tons of rice from Thailand; 294,020 tons from Vietnam; 56,140 tons from Pakistan; and 6,140 tons from India. Fresh demand from the Philippines, one of the world's biggest rice buyers, could underpin export prices particularly in Vietnam and Thailand, traditionally its main suppliers. Rice export prices in India and Vietnam weakened last week on thin demand, but still failed to attract buyers, while prices rose slightly in Thailand amid a slowing harvest.
