

**Domestic Market Highlights:**

**Wholesale Prices for India as an average for 03rd week of March traded firmed by 0.77% from last week.** Prices are currently hovering at Rs.3012-3015/quintal and 6.38% up from price of Rs.2832/Quintal during corresponding period last year. Agriwatch expects rice market to move in firm tone as demand is continuously strong from African countries in the market.

**India's rice stocks in the central pool as on March- 1, 2017 stood at around 31.43 million tons** down by about 7.72% from around 34.06 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are up about 7.30% from around 29.29 million tons recorded on February-01, 2016. The current rice stocks are about one million tons more than the required strategic reserve norms of around 1.25 million tons for this time of the year, according to the FCI.

**As per market sources as on 23 Mar,** 1121 golden sella rice traded @ Rs. 6350-6400/quintal while 1121 sella at Rs.6200/quintal, 1121 steam rice traded @ Rs.7100-7200/quintal, sharbati steam rice traded at Rs.4900/quintal and Parmal-11 steam at Rs.3100-3250/quintal.

**As per market sources as on 24-Mar,** 1121 paddy arrival in Amritsarmandi is 3500 bags and traded at Rs.3315/quintal and in Taraorimandi 1121 paddy traded @Rs.3250/quintal.

**As per market sources as on 24-March,** total paddy arrival in narelamandi is 20000 bags with 1121 rate of Rs.3285/quintal, 1509 paddy traded @ Rs.3100/quintal, Sugandha paddy @ Rs.2960/quintal and DP paddy at Rs.3100/quintal.

**As per Bihar Cooperative Minister, adequate outlets for procurement of paddy had been opened** across the state to enable the farmers to sell their produce and get reasonable price. Also state government had made arrangement for procurement of paddy through 7,500 Primary Agriculture Credit Cooperative Society (PACS) to enable farmers to sell their produce at Minimum Support Price (MSP).

**As per latest update, rice export in terms of value is up by around 41% from last year to USD 56.09Crore** in February -2017 which was only USD 39.66 crore in 2016. In first ten months of FY 2016-17(Apr-Jan) total rice export is 84, 66,304 tons in which basmati rice is 32, 51,801 tons and non –basmati rice is 52,14, 503 tons, where as in FY-2015-16 total rice export rice in first ten months were 87,85,606 tons out of which basmati rice was 34,31,391 tons and 53,54,2016 tons was non-basmati rice.

**All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 10.03.2017 for the Kharif marketing season 2016-17** was 312.51 lakh tonnes against the procurement of 289.92 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period of last year.

**Rice prices were stable in India and Vietnam on weak demand while in Thailand rice price** moving in north direction. India's 5 percent broken parboiled rice prices were steady at \$373-\$378 per tonne as exporter demand remained slack. Even with lower demand export price are not lower due to higher paddy prices and strong rupee. In Vietnam, the world's third largest rice exporter, 5 percent broken rice prices were stable at \$350-\$355 a tonne. Local prices may drop in the next few weeks when the main harvest season fully starts. Meanwhile, Thai benchmark 5-percent broken rice widened to \$350-\$360 a tonne, free-on-board (FOB) Bangkok, from \$350-\$355 a tonne last week.

**Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of February moved firm from last month and currently** is in the range of USD 1090-1092/MT which is up by 15% from last month price of 954USD/T. Average basmati rice price too firm with lower aromatic rice production estimates which is around 25-30% lower than last year, according to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO). Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is hovering in the range of USD 1028-1030/MT which is also up by 6.19% from last month FOB of USD 969/MT.

**As per second advance estimate released by Agriculture Ministry, Total production of rice is** estimated at record 108.86 million tonnes which is also a new record. This year's Rice production is higher by 2.21 million tonnes than previous record production of 106.65 million tonnes achieved during 2013-14. It is also higher by 3.44 million tonnes than the five years' average Rice production of 105.42 million tonnes. Production of rice has increased significantly by 4.45 million tonnes than the production of 104.41 million tonnes during 2015-16. . As a result of very good rainfall during monsoon 2016, record rice production seen in the current year.

**The Centre has approved the Odessa Government proposal for extension of Kharif paddy procurement** deadline to April 30. Paddy procurement is in full swing in most of the districts except Kandhamal where the the process will start from next week. Setting a target to procure 30 lakh tons of rice for the 2016-17 kharif marketing season (KMS), the state government started the procurement operation from Bargarh district on November 29 last year. Since post-harvest operation of paddy is still on in many parts of the state, the state government requested the Ministry of Agriculture to extend the paddy procurement deadline from March 30 to end of April, 2017. About 17.45 lakh tons of

paddy (equivalent to 11.87 lakh tons of rice) worth Rs 2,562 crore has been procured till date.

**Price Outlook:-Average Rice price in all India is likely to trade steady to firm tone due to fresh demand with lower arrival.**

### **International Market Highlight:**

**As per USDA latest report, china rice imports for MY-2016-17 is unchanged at 5 million tons.** Vietnam and Thailand remain leading exporters of rice to China due to their competitive prices and freight advantage. Rice imports will continue to be profitable if South East Asian countries offer the prices below China's floor price of renminbi 2,660 per ton (\$389). The average CIF rice price from South East Asia to China is renminbi 2,432 per ton (\$350).

**On a July- June MY basis, rice imports in MY 16/17 are forecast at 1 million tons, down 38 percent** from the MY 15/16 level. The decline is due to adequate ending stocks. Rice imports should increase significantly in MY 17/18 due to the anticipated decline in local production as a result of the expiration of the QR and to replenish low inventory levels. Post forecasts overall imports in MY 17/18 at two million tons or double the MY 16/17 level. Ending rice stocks in MY 16/17 have dropped considerably from the previous year's level due a significant decline in production and imports. Stocks are estimated to be sufficient for 46 days (at a daily requirement of 32,000 tons) in MY 16/17 and 56 days in MY 17/18.

**In a recent tender, Iran purchased about 40,000 tons of rice from Thailand which indicates** that sanctions have been lifted. According to Thailand authorities, in late January that they had secured a deal to sell rice to Iran for the first time in 10 years, with delivery of 50,000 to 100,000 tons of white rice due over the next one to two months. About 300,000 tons in shipments would be made in total. The Iranian state grains buyer GTC bought Hom Mali grade A rice from Thailand at about €600 (US\$645) a ton. The rice was for shipment between April 15 and May 15 to Bandar Imam Khomeini or Bandar Abbas ports.

**Mexican rice production for MY2017/18 (October-September) is forecast to reach 290,000 MT (rough rice) due to additional harvested area in the southeast region (mainly Campeche and Veracruz),** as well as in the state of Nayarit. This year's rough rice production level converts to 199,000 MT of milled rice. According to private sources, the main factor driving this increase in harvested area is the governmental support program announced last July 2016 (see 2016 GAIN Report MX6031 "Wheat, Corn, and Sorghum Estimates Down Slightly; New Rice Program Announced").

Increased planting of new certified long grain variety seeds and the use of new cultivation technological package, based on the Brazilian model, will also contribute to the production increase. The National Rice Product System industry group stated that the adoption of this new technological package in the last couple years has allowed slight production and productivity increases in several planting areas.

**Thailand Unofficial preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for February 27 – March 5, 2017**, totaled 39,166 metric tons, down 99,799 metric tons from the previous week, and down 92,910 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 132,076 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – March 5, 2017, totaled 1,280,409 metric tons. Export prices declined 1-2 percent following the sale of 1.3 million metric tons of government food-quality rice stocks. The government is likely to retender the remaining food-quality rice stocks and issue a new tender for feed-quality rice stocks by the end of March 2017.

**According to the Thai Custom Department, rice exports totaled 9.9 million metric tons in 2016**, up around 1 percent from 2015 (Figure 1.3). This is due to a surge in fragrant rice exports which increased 19 percent from last year to reach 2.4 million metric tons. Meanwhile, parboiled rice exports declined to 2.1 million metric tons, down 10 percent from last year due to tight supplies caused by reduced 2016 off-season rice production. Also, white rice exports declined slightly to 5.4 million metric tons as the government suspended sales of rice stocks from September to December in 2016.
