

Domestic Market Highlights:

As per market sources, 100% broken sona masuri rice Telangana region price is hover in the range of Rs.1950-2000/quintal while the FOB JNPT price is USD 318-321/MT.

As per market sources as on 10-June, total paddy arrival in Narela mandi is 2500 bags with 1121 rate of Rs.2915/quintal.

As per market sources as on 09-June, gobindobhog old rice traded at Rs.5600/qtl,IR-64- 5% parboiled traded at Rs.2250-2300/qtl,broken 100% raw ex-mill Raipur traded at Rs.1750-1800/qtl and swarna raw 5% ex-mill Burdwan traded at Rs.2300-2350/qtl.

As per market sources as on 09-June, Basmati rice traded at Rs.7000-7100/quintal,1121 golden sella rice traded @ Rs. 6200/quintal while 1121 sella at Rs.5950/quintal,1121 steam rice traded @ Rs.6900/quintal, sharbati steam rice traded at Rs./quintal and sambhamasuri at Rs.2950/quintal.

Due to current political unrest going on in Iran, major importers of 1121 rice are unwilling to buy in prevailing condition. Besides, liquidity crunch also is impacting price of 1121 rice. There is a common view that lower demand may further drag price down by Rs.150-200/quintal in the short term. Major Mills in markets of aromatic rice like Taraori, Kaithal, and Cheeka, 1121 sella traded at Rs.5850-5900/quintal. Paddy markets also traded weak. As new crop is still 4 months away,so market would improve once again from mid-July, by then more than 50 % of stock held with stockiest would be consumed and it would push price up once again in the medium term.

All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 01.06.2017 for 2016-17 was 375.46 lakh tonnes against the procurement of 330.61 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period of last year. The procurement of wheat for the rabi marketing season (RMS) 2017-18 was 298.54 lakh tonnes against the procurement of 229.28 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period of RMS 2016-17.

Indian rice exports from October 2016 to March 2017 were estimated at 5.2 MMT compared to 4.8 MMT for the corresponding period last year, largely on strong resurgence in the demand for both Basmati and non-Basmati rice since December 2016. Assuming no significant changes in the price parity for Indian rice during the remaining marketing year, MY 2016-17 exports are likely to reach 11 MMT compared to 10.2 MMT in the previous year. However, any change in the import policy of the major destination country or in the value of Indian rupee against the US dollar may affect the export prospects in the second half of the marketing year. MY 2017-18 rice exports are forecast at 10 MMT on sufficient domestic supplies, assuming continued export demand and international price parity for Indian rice.

Average weekly wholesale rice prices in India stood at around Rs.3077 per quintal in first week of June- 2017, steady about 6.74% from around Rs.2882 per quintal in last week, and up about 6.44% from around Rs.2890 per quintal a year ago. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range bound with firm tone in coming month due to expectation of higher international demand.

Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of May moved weak from last month and currently is in the range of USD 1159-1160/MT which is down by 5.63% from last month price of USD 1229/T. Average basmati rice price too frail this month with lower demand even with lower stocks, however overall sentiments for basmati rice price remains firm in coming months. According to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is moving firmer from last eight months due to lower production estimates and now it's hovering in the range of USD 1213-1215/MT which is also up by 0.84% from last month FOB of USD 1203/MT.



Arrival in the mandis of major producing hubslike -Punjab and Haryana has come to halt now and sources say that old stock too is depleting fast in the mandis. Besides shortage of paddy, exporters start buying in the mandis. It drove the price of 1121 by rs 100 to Rs 6150 to Rs6250 per qtl. New crop is at least away from 4 to 4.5 months from now. As buyers/exporters remain active, prices of rice is bound to move up by Rs 300/400 per qtl from current level. Firmness in rice market may continue on export demand.

Basmati area is expected to up in MY-2017-18 as farmers in Punjab and Haryana is likely to increase their basmati acreage around 50% compared to last year due to higher remuneration. Mostly farmers admitted that they will grow more aromatic paddy instead of normal paddy. In MY-2016-17, only 4.94 lakh hectares were cultivated in Punjab against normal area of 7.5 lakh hectare and 5.75 lakh hectares in Haryana which is around 7.2 lakh hectare is normal for aromatic paddy. Unlikely this year the total cultivation of basmati paddy in both states can go up to 15 lakh hectares, which is higher by around 50% than last year.

Total production of Rice is estimated at record 109.15 million tonnes which is also a new record. This year's Rice production is higher by 2.50 million tonnes (2.34%) than previous record production of 106.65 million tonnes achieved during 2013-14. It is also higher by 3.73 million tonnes (3.54%) than the five years' average Rice production of 105.42 million tonnes. Production of rice has increased significantly by 4.74 million tonnes (4.54%) than the production of 104.41 million tonnes during 2015-16.

Price Outlook:-Average Rice price in all India is likely to trade steady to firm tone due to fresh demand with lower arrival.

International Market Highlight:

Unofficial preliminary Thailand rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for May 15-21, 2017, totaled 178,401 metric tons, down 24,234 metric tons from the previous week, and down 7,941 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 186,342 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – May 21, 2017 totaled 3,334,380 metric tons. Export prices further increased 1-2 percent due to the strengthening of the Thai baht. The government is expected to sell 1.7 million metric tons of food-quality rice stocks and 0.5 million metric tons of deteriorated rice stocks next week.

Vietnamese Minister of Industry and Trade (MoIT) TrầnTuấnAnh and Bangladeshi Minister of Food Advocate Qamrul Islam signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) on the extension of rice trading in HàNội. Under the MoU--which will be extended till 2022--Việt Nam will supply up to one million tonnes of rice to Bangladesh. Bangladesh announced its expectation to buy around 250,000 to 300,000 tonnes of 5 per cent broken milled white rice from Việt Nam, The amount could be increased to 500,000 tonnes this year.

Thailand's government has announced a plan to organize the second rice auction in 2017 with a total volume of up to 1.82 million tons. Interested buyers could examine the rice's quality before bidding on May 24. The result of the auction is scheduled to be announced in the first week of June. To date, the Thai government has stocked 4.82 million tons of rice, much lower than the volume of 18.7 million tons between 2011 to 2014. In the first five months of this year, Thailand exported 4.1 million tonnes of rice, up 9 percent, earning 1.74 billion USD, up 6 percent against last year.

Thai upward price trend continues on ongoing demand, export prospects, Vietnamese traders store rice, anticipate more gains while India's high prices slow down trade, turn away main buyers. Thai benchmark 5-percent broken rice rose this week to \$385-\$411 a tonne, free-on-board (FOB) Bangkok,



from \$387-\$392 last week, Thai rice prices hit their highest in nine months. Vietnam's 5-percent broken rice was quoted at \$365-370 a tonne, FOB Saigon, up from \$355-\$360 last week, following the trend in Thailand. India, the world's biggest rice exporter, 5-percent broken parboiled rice prices eased by \$3 per tonne to \$391-\$396 a tonne this week on sluggish export demand.

The Philippines is likely to import an additional 250,000 tonnes of rice from Việt Nam and Thailand. The country would import more rice to boost its stocks ahead of the lean harvest season. Rice inventory in the Philippines is running low, with government stockpiles shrinking to the least in more than three years in April, just enough to cover 10 days of the national requirement.

Indonesia will export 15 to 50 thousand tons of rice to Malaysia in an effort to meet the country's demand. In addition to exporting rice to Malaysia, Indonesia had exported rice to Papua New Guinea, which was shipped from Papua Province. According to government, rice stock now reaches 1.9 million tons and is sufficient to meet the publics need during the fasting month of Ramadan.

As per USDA latest report, china rice imports for MY-2016-17 is unchanged at 5 million tons. Vietnam and Thailand remain leading exporters of rice to China due to their competitive prices and freight advantage. Rice imports will continue to be profitable if South East Asian countries offer the prices below China's floor price of renminbi 2,660 per ton (\$389). The average CIF rice price from South East Asia to China is renminbi 2,432 per ton (\$350).
