

# **Domestic Market Highlights:**

As per FCI latest data, progressive paddy procurement as on 28th November-2017 for KMS-2017-18 reached to 172.98 lakh tons which is up by 4.24% from corresponding period last year procurement of 165 Lakh tons. Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (116.82 lakh Tons), Haryana (39.67 lakh tons), and U.P (6.46 lakh tons) and in south it is started in Telangana (7.49 Lakh Tons). Andhra Pradesh Government has just started the procurement of paddy and it has reached 0.73 lakh tons. Government agencies have procured 98.5 per cent of the paddy arriving in the grain markets in Punjab and nearly 95 per cent in Haryana. The remaining paddy has been procured by rice millers and private traders. Punjab is expecting a record procurement of over 182 lakh tons of paddy this year compared with over 168 lakh tons of the bumper crop last year.

More than 68.57 lakh tons of paddy had arrived in the 'mandis' of Haryana until yesterday as compared to over 69.56 lakh tons during the corresponding period that arrived during the last year. Government agencies had procured over 58.71 lakh tons of paddy whereas the remaining over 9.85 lakh tons was procured by the millers and maximum quantity of paddy has arrived in Karnal which is over 14.47 lakh tons followed by Kurukshetra at over 12.12 lakh tons.

Average weekly wholesale rice prices in India stood at around Rs.2978 per quintal in 04th week of November- 2017, up about 2.90 from around Rs.2893 per quintal in last week, and up about 5.99% from around Rs.2809/ quintal a year ago. Due to fresh demand from major countries like Bangladesh, Iran, Srilanka, price has firmed in this week and is likely to stay steady in coming week.

**The rabi paddy sowing in all India is started and as per latest data available area for MY-2017-18 is 9.49 lakh** hectares which is up by 30% from last year area of 7.32 lakh hectares and up about 12.73% from normal area as on date of area of 8.42 lakh hectares. Sufficient moisture in soil and favourable weather are the main criteria for increase in acreage under rabi paddy.

As per a directive by the Ministry of Industries, Mining and Trade, Iran government has temporary ban on rice imports has been lifted from Nov. 22 up until July 22, 2018. Every year and during the rice harvest season, the government bans rice imports in support of local farmers and production. Import tariffs have increased from 22% four years ago to 40% at present for the same reason. Iranians consume 3 million tons of rice a year while domestic production stands at 2.2 million tons. Therefore, there is need for around 800,000 tons of imports every year.

India's rice stocks in the central pool as on November- 1, 2017 stood at around 27.19 million tons down by about 12.85% from around 31.2 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are up about 64% from around 16.56 million tons recorded on October-01, 2017.Highest stock could be seen in the state of Punjab(44.33 lakh tons) followed by Madhya Pradesh(52.43 lakh tons) and Andhra Pradesh(12.06 Lakh Tons).

**Chhattisgarh government increases the bonus of RS.300/quintal on paddy which would result in the marginal hike** of rice price in the state. The decision would help the farmers in Chhattisgarh to earn Rs 1,850 per quintal for common grade and Rs 1,890 for 'A' grade variety of paddy given the procurement at the MSP fixed by the union government at Rs 1,550 for common grade variety and Rs 1,590 for 'A' grade variety. Due to severe drought, paddy production has been affected in the state and the farmers will prefer to sell whatever yield they get to the government due to bonus which is likely to inflate the rice price in open market.

As per commerce minister, The European Union has given time to India till December 31 to meet the bloc's new norms on importing Basmati rice. The new norms set by European Commission bring



down the maximum residue limit (MRL) level for Tricyclazole (a fungicide) in Basmati rice to 0.01 mg per kg from next year which is 0.03mg per kg now. The norms are applicable on all rice-exporting countries. The European Union probed India that not to send Basmati rice to them because of some plague or technical points, but government requested them for some time till Dec-31 to aware farmers that not the use of this particular pesticides, However, it is believe that it may take two crop cycles for India to meet the new import norms.

**Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of October moved firmed from last month and currently is in the range** of USD 1170/MT which is up by 9.22% from last month price of USD 1070/T due to increased price in local markets. Aromatic rice price too firmed this month with active demand from international markets and lower production aspects. According to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is moving firmer from last month and now it's hovering in the range of USD 1168/MT which is up by 6.25% from last month FOB of USD 1100/MT.

**Price Outlook:** - Rice prices are expected to ease to some extent in November with the arrival of the new crop across the country. However, domestic prices during the marketing year will also depend on the export demand and international price movement.

### International Market Highlight:

As per latest data by USDA, Iran rice production for MY-2017-18 is same as last year of around 2.2 million tons and country consumes 3 million tons of rice a year. Therefore, there is a need for around 800,000 tons of imports every year and thus the temporary ban was lifted last Tuesday as per a directive by the Ministry of Industries, Mining and Trade and was supposed to last until July 22, 2018. However import tariffs have increased from 22% four years ago to 40% at present for the same reason.

**Cambodia had exported 142,768 tons of milled rice to China in the first 10 months of 2017, a 59percent rise over the** same period last year, Export to China accounted for 29 percent of the country's total rice export, noting that the total export was 492,115 tons during the January-October period this year, up 17 percent over the same period last year. The Southeast Asian nation is expected to export 200,000 tons and 300,000 tons to China in 2017 and 2018, respectively. Cambodia produces more than 9 million tons of paddy rice a year. With this amount, it has over 3 million tons of milled rice for annual export.

**Pakistan's rice exports surged by 28.74% during the first three months of the country's current fiscal year starting from July** 2017. Rice exports from the country jumped to 621,094 metric tons during the period as compared to the exports of 482,445 metric tons of the same period last year. Exports of the Basmati rice rose by 2.43% and reached at 86,672 tons valuing at 90.31 million dollars in the three months as against 92,321 metric tons worth 88.772 million dollars of the same period last year.

**First Ten-month rice exports of Vietnam the world's third-largest shipper of the grain were forecast to rise 21.6 percent** to 5 million tons. Revenue from the January-October rice exports was seen rising 20.3 percent year-on-year to \$2.2 billion. Vietnam would ship an estimated 400,000 tons of rice in October, compared to 516,000 tons in September



**Japan's MAFF regularly maintains 828,100 MT of rice in reserve. An additional 640,000 MT (actual tonnage)** of MA rice stocks were held (as of October 2016), of which 350,000 MT (actual tonnage) is set aside for the GOJ contingency feed grain reserve. As a result of the decline in table rice production, private stocks have decreased in 2016 and 2017. Accordingly, aggregated ending stocks are expected to total 2.4 million MT in MY2016/17, and are forecast to further decline to 2.2 million MT in MY2017/18 (given an anticipated decrease in production).
