

**Domestic Market Highlights:**

**Average wholesale weekly non-basmati rice prices in India stood at around Rs.3257 per quintal in third week of January- 2018**, up by about 0.07% from Rs.3253 per quintal in previous week, and up by about 7.18% from Rs.3038 per quintal a year ago. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range bound with firm tone in coming month due to overseas and local demand.

**As per FCI latest data, progressive paddy procurement as on 19th January-2018 for KMS-2017-18 reached 272.87 lakh tons**, 1.49% higher than 268.85 lakh tons during the corresponding period last year at. Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (118.33 lakh Tons), Haryana (39.67 lakh tons), and U.P (23.99 lakh tons) and in south it is picking up in Telangana (12.10 Lakh Tons). Andhra Pradesh Government procurement has reached to 16.81 lakh tons. Chhattisgarh government has also procured around 31.45 lakh tons of rice as of now. Madhya Pradesh and Odisha procurement has reached 10.95 and 14.59 lakh tons respectively. Procurement in West Bengal and other rice growing states is still underway.

**As on 19<sup>th</sup> January-2018, acreage under rice was reported at 22.32 lakh hectares compared to 15.99 lakh hectares corresponding time** last year, thus 6.33 lakh hectares more area has been covered compared to last year. States having higher acreage compared to last year are Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, Kerala and Chhattisgarh. States where acreage has declined are West Bengal and Karnataka.

**Rice prices in Thailand and Vietnam received a major increase this week from a potential deal with Indonesia**, while robust demand from Bangladesh pushed rates higher for the staple grain in top exporter India. In Thailand, the world's second-biggest rice exporter, benchmark 5 percent broken rice was quoted at \$415-\$420, free-on-board (FOB) Bangkok, up from \$395-\$410 last week. Rice prices in India jumped on strong demand from neighboring Bangladesh, which has emerged as a major importer of the grain since 2017 after floods damaged its own crops. India's rice exports likely jumped 22% in 2017 to a record 12.3 million tons as Bangladesh ramped up purchases. In India, the 5 percent broken parboiled rice prices rose by \$9 to \$432-\$436 per ton, with the gains also supported by expectations of demand from Philippines and Indonesia.

**After flooding hit the rice crop in Bangladesh, India's rice exports likely jumped 22 percent in 2017 to a record 12.3 million tons**. Bangladesh and Sri Lanka continue to buy aggressively amid depleting inventories in Number two exporter Thailand. Bangladesh's purchases likely lifted India's non-basmati rice exports by 38 percent in 2017 to 8.4 million tons and total exports to 12.3 million tons; Last year Bangladesh reduced import taxes on rice to boost private buying. It also bought rice from India in state-to-state deals. For key markets like Bangladesh and Sri Lanka, India has freight advantage over Thailand. This will help even in 2018.

**Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of December moved weak from last month and currently is in the range of USD 1080-1085/MT** which is down by 3.65% from last month price of USD 1126/T due to supply pressure in local markets, however prices of aromatic is likely to up in coming months due to higher overseas demand. Local aromatic rice prices too, are weak this month even with active demand from international markets. According to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is moving weaker from last month and is now hovering in the range of USD 1135.6/MT which is down by 1.67% from last month FOB of USD 1155/MT.

**India's rice stocks in the central pool as on December- 1, 2017 stood at around 30.13 million tons up by about 11.79%** from around 26.95 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are up

about 10.81% from around 27.19 million tons recorded on November-01, 2017. Highest stock could be seen in the state of Punjab(40.93 lakh tons ) followed by Uttar Pradesh(10.67 lakh tons) and Andhra Pradesh(9.69 Lakh Tons).

**Price Outlook:** - Rice prices are expected to ease to some extent in November with the arrival of the new crop across the country. However, domestic prices during the marketing year will also depend on the export demand and international price movement.

#### **International Market Highlight:**

**Unofficial and preliminary Thai rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for December 18-24, 2017,** totaled 189,458 metric tons, down 5,489 metric tons from the previous week and down 3,157 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 192,615 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – December 24, 2017, totaled 9,097,394 metric tons.

**Harvesting of the MY2017/18 rice crop is complete and production is estimated at 7.2 MMT, up 350,000 tons from a year ago.** According to preliminary data during MY 2016/17, Pakistan exported 3.6 MMT of rice compared to 4.2 MMT during MY 15/16. Lower exports are mainly due to stiff competition from other suppliers such as Thailand, Vietnam, and India which continue to supply rice more competitively than Pakistan.

**Vietnam exported roughly 5.9 million tons of rice worth nearly 2.7 billion U.S. dollars in 2017, posting respective year-on-year rises of 20.5 percent and 20.8 percent.** Vietnam is likely to export 6.3 million tons of rice in 2018, mainly due to high demand from the Southeast Asian market, especially the Philippines. Vietnam's paddy rice-growing area was over 7.7 million hectares in 2017, down 26,100 hectares against 2016, said the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development. As a result, the country's paddy rice output dropped for the first time over the past 20 years to 42.8 million tons in 2017.

**Bangladesh has offered to buy an additional 200,000 tons of rice from Myanmar under a government to government agreement** before the end of December. Myanmar and Bangladesh signed a memorandum of understanding to buy 300,000 tons of rice under the agreement, a major increase from the 100,000 tons of Myanmar rice already sent to the neighbor this year in response to a shortfall. Rice demand in Bangladesh increased with a sense of urgency this year after floods damaged most paddy fields in the country. Bangladesh has imported 1.2 million tons of rice but still requires around another one million tons.

**According to the Vietnam Food Association, Vietnam exported nearly 5.2 million tons of rice in the first 11 months of the year,** surpassing the figure of the entire 2016 at 4.9 million tons. In November, rice export volume exceeded 371,000 tons, down from over 437,000 tons in October. The drop was attributed to limited supply after harvest of the autumn-winter crop completed in the Mekong Delta, the main source of rice for export. The USDA forecast that India and Thailand will continue to lead the world in rice export, while Vietnam's rice exports could reach six million tons in 2018, an increase of 6.6 percent from this year, driven by demand in Southeast Asia, particularly in the Philippines.

**Cambodia exported 562,237 tons of milled rice in the first 11 months of 2017, up 17 percent compared with the same period last year.** China is still the top buyer of Cambodian milled rice, followed

by France and Poland. Export to China accounted for 165,000 tons, or 29.3 percent of the total exports, during the January-November period this year, Cambodia is expected to sell 200,000 tons of rice to China this year and up to 300,000 tons next year.

**Japan's MAFF regularly maintains 828,100 MT of rice in reserve. An additional 640,000 MT (actual tonnage) of MA rice stocks were held (as of October 2016), of which 350,000 MT (actual tonnage) is set aside for the GOJ contingency feed grain reserve. As a result of the decline in table rice production, private stocks have decreased in 2016 and 2017. Accordingly, aggregated ending stocks are expected to total 2.4 million MT in MY2016/17, and are forecast to further decline to 2.2 million MT in MY2017/18 (given an anticipated decrease in production).**
