

Domestic Market Highlights:

A ship from India has arrived in Indonesia, carrying 10,000 tons of imported rice. The ship has entered the Belawan Port in North Sumatra and is waiting to dock. Imported rice will be stored in Bulog's North Sumatra warehouse along with the 10,000 tons of imported rice from Thailand that arrived on Feb 24.

All India progressive procurement of Rice as on 05 .03.2018 for 2017-18 was 301.39 lakh tons against the procurement of 298 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year. Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (118.33 lakh Tons), Haryana (39.67 lakh tons), and U.P (28.61 lakh tons) and in south it is picking up in Telangana (12.23 Lakh Tons). Andhra Pradesh Government procurement has reached to 25.59 lakh tons. Chhattisgarh government has also procured around 32.07 lakh tons of rice as of now. Madhya Pradesh and Odisha procurement has reached 10.95 and 22.38 lakh tons respectively. Procurement in West Bengal and other rice growing states is still underway and reached to 0.19 lakh tons.

Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of February moved weak from last month and currently is in the range of USD 1148/MT which is down by 0.32% from last month price of USD 1152/T due to correction in the market. Aromatic rice prices are also traded weak with lethargic buying from millers; Agriwatch expects that aromatic international rice price is likely to trade firm in coming months with good overseas demand. According to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is moving firmer from last month and is now hovering in the range of USD 1095/MT which is up by 0.75% from last month FOB of USD 1086.75/MT.

India's rice stocks in the central pool as on February- 1, 2017 stood at around 33.96 million tons up by about 16% from around 29.29 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are up about by 2.13% from around 33.25 million tons recorded on January-01, 2017. Highest stock could be seen in the state of Punjab (66.93 lakh tons) followed by Uttar Pradesh (22 Lakh Tons), Andhra Pradesh (17.55 lakh tons) and Haryana (16.34 lakh tons).

As per second advance estimate released by government on Tuesday, India's food grains output is estimated to reach a record 277.49 million ton in 2017-18. Rice production is estimated at record 111.01 million tons, including 96.48 million tons in kharif and 14.53 million tons in Rabi, as against 109.70 million tons during 2016-17. The kharif (summer) crops are harvested from October while Rabi (winter) crops have already started arriving in mandis and arrival will increase from April onwards.

Average wholesale weekly non-basmati rice prices in India stood at around Rs.3146 per quintal in fourth week of February- 2018; firm about 5.58% from last week price of Rs.2980/quintal, and up by about 12.92% from Rs.2785 per quintal a year ago. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range bound with firm tone in coming month, due to overseas and local demand.

Price Outlook: - Rice prices are expected to ease to some extent in November with the arrival of the new crop across the country. However, domestic prices during the marketing year will also depend on the export demand and international price movement.



International Market Highlight:

Thailand plans to offer for sale 2 million tons of rice still remaining in state stockpiles next month or in May. Thailand's military government inherited 18.7 million tons of rice stocks built up under the previous government's rice subsidy scheme, and has held several auctions since taking power in May 2014. The last auction was in July 2017. An auction that will be set for next month or May will aim to offload the remaining amount, which includes 40,000 tons of rice for human consumption and 2 million tons of rice unfit for human or animal consumption and intended for industrial use. Thailand is planning to participate in a rice tender due out from the Philippines, which is looking to import 250,000 tons.

Myanmar will likely export at least 3.2 million tons of rice by the end of the current 2017-18 fiscal year by month-end taking rice exports to their highest level in 70 years. According to government estimates, country has exported 3.2 million tons of rice to this day (March 4). The numbers could increase if we continue exporting. However, Myanmar is still mainly exporting average-grade rice to China, implying that the country is still overly reliant on its neighbor. As such, the country should take steps to improve its rice quality for better value while expanding its market beyond China to diversify risk.

Unofficial and preliminary Thailand rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for February 5-11, 2018, totaled 261,032 metric tons, up 26,619 metric tons from the previous week and up 29,095 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 231,937 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1- February 11, 2018, totaled 1,232,170 metric tons.

Rice exports from Pakistan have seen sizeable growth of 14 percent in quantity and 27 percent in value during the eight months of the current fiscal year; July 2017-February 2018. Pakistan exported 2.59 million tons amounting to \$1.224 billion, whereas last fiscal year in the same period 2.27 million tons amounting to \$.961 million were exported, which shows a growth of 27 percent in value terms and 14 percent in terms of quantity. Kenya is the largest buyer of Pakistani non-Basmati rice and during eight months of this fiscal year, 323,000 tons of rice, amounting to \$118 million, was exported to Kenya. China came out as the second largest destination for Pakistani non-basmati rice, as 233,000 tons valuing \$83 million were exported to the country.

According to the Vietnam Food Association (VFA), more than 5.7 million tons of rice was shipped abroad in 2017, surpassing last year's target. There remain some 630,000 tons of rice under contracts signed last year to be shipped in 2018. Global rice demand is forecast to soar in 2018, and China will remain the biggest rice importer. While Indonesia resumed rice imports after a two-year halt, the Philippines is also predicted to buy more rice. These rosy signs are expected to give a boost to rice exporters, including Vietnam, according to the VFA. In January, the country shipped 524,000 tons of rice worth 249 million USD abroad, up 56.5 percent in volume and 74.2 percent in value from a year earlier

MY 2017/18 (May-April) Bangladesh rice production is forecast down slightly to 32.65 million metric tons on lower Aman variety production caused by unexpected rain during the grain maturing stage. Post raised MY 2017/18 rice imports to 3.4 million metric tons based on increased demand until the next harvest. MY 2017/18 (July-June) wheat imports are forecast at 6.5 million tons, due to competitive international prices and strong demand. For MY 2017/18, Post's corn import forecast is raised by 0.1 MMT due to increased demand in the feed industry.

MY 2017/18 total rice area and production in Turkey are estimated at 99,000 hectares and 776,000 metric tons, up slightly from last year. Paddy rice was planted in April and the harvest was completed in October due to rains. The rice harvest started two weeks late all over the country. According to producers, new seed varieties have contributed to better yields.



Harvesting of the MY2017/18 rice crop is complete and production is estimated at 7.2 MMT, up 350,000 tons from a year ago. According to preliminary data during MY 2016/17, Pakistan exported 3.6 MMT of rice compared to 4.2 MMT during MY 15/16. Lower exports are mainly due to stiff competition from other suppliers such as Thailand, Vietnam, and India which continue to supply rice more competitively than Pakistan.
