

Domestic Market Highlights:

Paddy acreage is likely to be around 30 lakh hectares during current kharif season in Punjab, which has the highest contribution of rice in the central pool. From June 20 onwards, in Punjab, paddy transplanting started accordingly. The state government had asked the farmers not to transplant it before this. Last year there was about 30.65 lakh hectares of farming under paddy. Typically paddy transplant starts in Punjab from June 15 but due to lack of water, the state government had announced to start transplanting it from June 20 this year. Agriculture department officials say that in the process of transplantation, delay of 5 days will save about 24 lakh liters of water in Punjab. But it is understood that in some parts of the state, farmers have started transplanting the paddy before 20th June while ignoring the government directive. The Agriculture Department also took action against such a few farmers. Under this, action has been taken against farmers in Barnala, Sangrur and Bhatinda districts. In some places the sown crop was destroyed. In fact, the Agriculture Department is suggesting the farmers that a lot of moisture may be present in the cropped rice crop before June 20, which could hinder its government procurement. Alongside this, farmers have been advised not to cultivate paddy varieties that are suitable for long periods, including Pusa 44. Instead, farmers are being encouraged to cultivate paddy of PR 12-, 14 and 16 varieties.

As on 15th June 2018, About 6.93 lakh hectares area covered under rice has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week (5.69 lakh hectares). Thus 1.24 lakh hectares more area has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. The area has been reported mainly from the states of Uttrakhand, (1.23 lakh hectares), Meghalaya (1.00 lakh hectare), Assam (0.88 lakh hectares), Tamilnadu (0.80 lakh hectares), Mizoram (0.35 lakh hectares), Maharashtra (0.33 lakh hectares), West Bengal (0.20 lakh hectares), and Jammu & Kashmir (0.05 lakh hectares).

All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 08.06.2018 for 2017-18 was at 356.64 lakh tons against the procurement of 372.92 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year. The procurement of wheat for the rabi marketing season (RMS) 2018-19 was 351.40 lakh tons which was higher than the procurement of 302.36 lakh tons in the corresponding period of RMS 2017- 18.Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (118.33 lakh Tons), Haryana (39.67 lakh tons), and U.P (28.75 lakh tons) and in south it is picking up in Telangana (33.55 Lakh Tons). Andhra Pradesh Government procurement has reached to 36.14 lakh tons. Chhattisgarh government has also procured around 32.07 lakh tons of rice as of now. Madhya Pradesh and Odisha procurement has reached 10.96 and 27.59 lakh tons respectively. Procurement in West Bengal and other rice growing states is still underway and reached to 0.43 lakh tons.

The President of China told the Prime Minister of India that by 2020 India and China should have a \$ 100 billion Bi-lateral trade between the countries. China can import non-basmati rice and sugar from India to meet the shortage of rice and sugar. China rice production for MY-2018-19 is likely to down by 1.5 million tons to 144.50 million tons but domestic consumption is expected to up by 2.5 million tons, meanwhile china could import rice from India to fulfill the demand supply scenario.

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Indian FOB for 1121 steam in the month of May moved weak from last month and currently is in the range of USD 1062/MT which is down by 4.42% from last month price of USD 1111/T due to drop of rice price in the local market. Aromatic rice prices are also traded weak with sluggish buying from millers; Agriwatch expects that aromatic international rice price is likely to trade steady in coming months depends on kharif sowing intension by farmers. According to the UN's Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO), Currently Pakistani basmati FOB is moving weaker from last month and is now hovering in the range of USD 1042.5/MT which is down by 0.95% from last month FOB of USD 1052.5/MT.

Price Outlook: - Rice prices are expected to trade steady in June with the normal domestic demand across the country. However, prices during the last quarter of MY 2017-18 will largely depend on the progress of 2018 monsoon and the impact on MY 2018-19 rice planting.

International Market Highlight:

Unofficial and preliminary Thai rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for May 28 – June 3, 2018, totaled 136,488 metric tons, down 14,873 metric tons from the previous week and down 17,370 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 153,858 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – June 3, 2018 totaled 3,834,996 metric tons.

Philippines rice imports in 2019 could decline by 21.42 percent to 1.1 million metric tons (MMT), as the increase in palay output would allow the Philippines to end 2018 with more stocks. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) said in a report that the country's total rice imports next year would decline by 300,000 metric tons (MT), from the projected 1.4 MMT this year. The Philippines is down 300,000 tons to 1.1 million tons on more abundant domestic supplies,

Iran's state grains buyer GTC has issued an international tender to buy 20,000 tons of rice to be sourced from Pakistan. The tender closes on June 12. The super basmati rice is required in two 10,000 ton consignments.

Rice exports from Pakistan during first 9 months of current financial year increased by 27.67 percent as compared the exports of the corresponding period of last year. During the period from July-March, 2017-18, about 3,132,997 metric tons of rice worth US\$ 1.494 billion exported as compared the exports of 2,681,253 metric tons valuing of US\$ 1.170 billion of same period last year. Basmati rice exports from the country also grew by 19.13 percent as 332,179 metric tons of basmati rice costing US\$ 348.558 million exported during last 9 months as against the exports of 302,339 metric tons valuing US\$ 290.897 million of same period last year. During the period under review, about 2,800,818 metric tons of rice others then basmati were exported and earned US\$ 1.148 billion as compared the exports of 2,378,914 metric tons valuing of US\$ 897.804 million of same period last year, showing an increase of 30.49 percent



Indonesia's state food procurement agency Bulog is seeking offers from sellers in Pakistan to buy about 50,000 tons of rice. The agency is seeking rice of both 5 per cent broken grade and 15 percent broken grade. Bulog said on March 20 it planned to import a total 500,000 tons of rice up to the end of June to improve local supplies and cool domestic prices. Bulog bought about 500,000 tons of rice to be sourced from Vietnam and Thailand, traders said on March 29.Bulog also bought about 50,000 tons of rice from Pakistan on March 21 for shipment up to May 31.

MY 2018/19 (May-April) Bangladesh total rice area and production levels are forecast to increase to 11.7 million hectares (HA) and 34.7 million metric tons (MMT), due to a recovery from last year's Boro and Aman crop losses and an expected higher price. MY 2018/19 rice imports are forecast to fall to 0.8 MMT due to higher domestic production while assuming favorable weather conditions. The rice import estimate is revised upward to 3.6 MMT in MY 2017/18 due to increased imports to fill the supply shortfall caused by the previous year's devastating flood.

Indonesia's rice imports in 2017-18 are expected to rise to 1.3 million tons as the country attempts to stabilize prices and rebuild stocks. The Indonesian Bureau of Logistics (BULOG) has set its domestic procurement target for 2017-18 at 2.7 million tons of milled rice equivalent but only 650,000 tons had been procured through March. Faced with rising prices prior to the main harvest and BULOG's insufficient stocks, on Jan. 11 the Minister of Trade instructed BULOG to import 500,000 tons of rice.

According to Thai Rice Export Association, Rice exports of Thailand in 2018 will be less than the target growth of 9.5 percent due to strong baht and decrease in rice production, the target was 18 percent lower than 2017's 11.6 million tons. Meanwhile, The Thai Government recently announced the rice production in 2018 stands at 30 million tons, a decline compared to the 33 million tons of 2017.

Turkey's state grain board TMO has issued a series of international tenders to purchase a total 30,000 tons of rice. The TMO had made no purchase in its previous tenders for 41,250 tons of rice on March 8 when only one company participated, partly because of a rapid shipment period of March 15 to April 6. Shipment in the new tenders was also quick, requested between March 26 to April 16. The TMO has issued 30 separate tenders of 1,000 tons, long grain medium grain rice is sought. The TMO reserves the right to purchase 20 percent more or less than the tender volumes.
