

### Domestic Market Highlights:

- **Due to drought situation in more than half of the area in UP, problems started in paddy transplantation.** In the country's largest food producing state-Uttar Pradesh, the monsoon's eye mitosis is continuing, which has remained almost dry in half. It includes a semi-arid Bundelkhand area. There is a serious threat to the cultivation and progress of other kharif crops including paddy. Although the government is not considering these areas as drought-prone, but a situation is worsening, a comprehensive plan is being prepared to handle the condition.
- **According to latest kharif crop sowing data released by the Agriculture Ministry on 13 July, the planting** was taken up on around 502 lakh hectares (lh) as against 557 lh covered during the same period last season. But the sowing is yet to cross the half of what is normal for a year. The announcement of minimum support prices (MSP) for kharif crops last week and the improved monsoon activity across the country seemed to have a positive impact as the shortfall in sowing came down to 10 per cent from 14 per cent last week. The area under rice cultivation increased to 116.92 lh — 8 per cent lower than 126.92 lh in the same week last year.
- **All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 13.07.2018 for 2017-18 was at 362.54 lakh tonnes** against the procurement of 379.52 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period of last year. The procurement of wheat for the Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2018-19 was 355.22 lakh tonnes which was higher than the procurement of 306.65 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period of RMS 2017-18. Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (118.33 lakh Tons), Haryana (39.67 lakh tons), and U.P (28.75 lakh tons) and in south it is started in Telangana (34.92 Lakh Tons). Andhra Pradesh Government procurement has reached to 38.72 lakh tons. Chhattisgarh government also procured around 32.07 lakh tons of rice as of now, Madhya Pradesh and Odessa procurement reached to 10.96 and 28.65 lakh tons respectively. Procurement in West Bengal and other rice growing states is still underway.
- **Average weekly wholesale prices of rice in India stood at around Rs.3020 per quintal in 01st week of July**, down about 1.27% from around Rs.3060 per quintal last week, and down about 2.47 % from around Rs.3096 per quintal a year ago. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move steady to firm with inducing overseas demand.
- **In order to encourage the farmers just before the 2019 general elections, the Union Cabinet approved the Minimum Support Price (MSP) for Kharif crops for 2018-19.** The move to hike the MSP for Kharif crops is in line with the government's Budget announcement of hiking the support price by one-and-a-half times of the production cost for Kharif crops. The government increases the minimum support price (MSP) of paddy by Rs 200 per quintal to Rs 1,750 for the MY- 2018-19 crop year starting from October.
- **With the advance of the South-West monsoon cheered last week, planting was hit in many parts of the country**, Kharif sowing till Friday has only covered 165 lakh hectares (lakh ha), 78 per cent of the area (210 lakh ha) planted, during the corresponding period in the previous season, the official data showed. The acreage under rice, on other hand, is 26.91 lakh ha which 10% is lower than 30 lakh ha reported in the corresponding week last year. Tamilnadu, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and M.P are the only states where sowing of paddy is reported higher than last year. Agriwatch expects that, sowing will peak from second week of July once MSP will declare by govt.

- **Rice export from India in the month of May-2018 was 12.53 lakh tons in which basmati rice contribution was 23.34%** of total and around 2.92 lakh tons of aromatic rice was exported in the month, Iran, U.A.E and Saudi Arabia were the major Indian aromatic rice importers in this month; on the other hand non-basmati rice export in this month was 9.60 lakh tons which was higher by around 55% from previous month export, major importing countries of non-basmati rice in the month were Benin, Indonesia and Saudi Arabia followed by Bangladesh. Total rice export in MY-2017-18 (From Oct to May) from India was 90.34 lakh tons up by 33% from corresponding period of last year export of 67.86 lakh tons.
- **The Telangana State government has instructed the ration shop dealers to pay the amount through Mee Seva Centre** for securing the required quantity of ration by securing RO (release order) by June 28 and cooperate with the government to ensure proper supply of rice to the ration card holders in the State. According to Joint Collector S. Yasmeeen Basha they would be forced to remove the ration dealers who fail to pay the required amount before June 28.
- **India's rice stocks in the central pool as on June- 1, 2018 stood at around 29.54 million tons up by about 2.42%** from around 28.84 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are down by 0.67% about by from around 29.74 million tons recorded on May-01, 2018. Highest stock could be seen in the state of Punjab (95.37 lakh tons) followed by Uttar Pradesh (19.91 Lakh Tons), Andhra Pradesh (20.91 lakh tons) and Haryana (21.22 lakh tons).

**Price Outlook:** - Rice prices are expected to trade steady in June with the normal domestic demand across the country. However, prices during the last quarter of MY 2017-18 will largely depend on the progress of 2018 monsoon and the impact on MY 2018-19 rice planting.

#### **International Market Highlight:**

**The federal government of China has already provided theoretical approval for the import of non-basmati rice and for this there has been a stamp on the name of some Indian rice mills (firms) but its actual contract or shipment has not been possible so far.** According to a senior government official, Chinese officials are inspecting Indian rice mills, so that they can be duly approved for the import of non-basmati rice. While China is the world's largest rice-producing country, there is a need to import it there. So far, he has been importing rice mainly from Thailand, Vietnam, Myanmar, Cambodia and Pakistan, while further importing its vast quantity from India. Indian Millers are giving China the confidence to provide good quality rice at competitive prices.

**Cambodia exported 271,500 tons of milled rice in the first six months of 2018, down 5.9 percent from 288,500 tons** over the same period last year.

**Iran rice imports in the first three months of current year (March 21-June 21), were around 379,000 tons of rice worth \$375 million** showing 7.9% and 1.3% decrease in volume and value respectively compared with the corresponding period last year

**Thailand Rice export prices declined 2 percent due to the Thai baht weakening from 31.9 baht/U.S. \$1.00 to 32.5 baht/U.S. \$1.00** over the past week. This is the lowest the Thai baht has been since December 2017. Additionally, the government is expected to sell almost all of the remaining 2 million metric tons of rice stocks through the two tenders issued last week. Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for June 4-10, 2018, totaled 210,924 metric tons, up 74,436 metric tons from the previous week and up 48,202 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 162,722 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – June 10, 2018 totaled 4,045,895 metric tons.

**The rice exports from Pakistan during 11 months of current financial year registered 29.15 percent growth as compared the** exports of corresponding period of last year as about 3.842 million metric tons of rice worth \$1.889 billion exported. During the period from July-May, 2017-18, 461,472 metric tons of basmati rice worth \$478.853 million was exported as against the exports of 406,824 metric tons worth \$385.746 of same period last year. In last 11 months of financial year 2017-18, basmati rice exports grew by 24.14 percent as compared the exports of the corresponding period of last year. The exports of rice other than basmati witnessed 104.16 percent growth during the period under review and about 322,802 metric tons of rice worth \$156.514 million exported as against the exports of 173,782 metric tons valuing \$76.664 million of same month of last year.

**Philippines rice imports in 2019 could decline by 21.42 percent to 1.1 million metric tons (MMT), as the increase in palay** output would allow the Philippines to end 2018 with more stocks. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) said in a report that the country's total rice imports next year would decline by 300,000 metric tons (MT), from the projected 1.4 MMT this year. The Philippines is down 300,000 tons to 1.1 million tons on more abundant domestic supplies,

**MY 2018/19 (May-April) Bangladesh total rice area and production levels are forecast to increase to 11.7 million hectares (HA)** and 34.7 million metric tons (MMT), due to a recovery from last year's Boro and Aman crop losses and an expected higher price. MY 2018/19 rice imports are forecast to fall to 0.8 MMT due to higher domestic production while assuming favorable weather conditions. The rice import estimate is revised upward to 3.6 MMT in MY 2017/18 due to increased imports to fill the supply shortfall caused by the previous year's devastating flood.
