

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **According to Ministry of Agriculture, Rice acreage during current season as on 24th August 2018 was down at 356.83 lakh hectares** as against 359.52 lakh hectares same period last year.
- **All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 20.08.2018 for 2017-18 was at 364.45 lakh tons against the procurement of 380.80 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year.** Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (118.33 lakh Tons), Haryana (39.92 lakh tons), and U.P (28.75 lakh tons) and in south it is started in Telangana (36.20 Lakh Tons). Andhra Pradesh government's procurement has reached 39.72 lakh tons. Chhattisgarh government also procured around 32.55 lakh tons of rice as of now. Procurement in Madhya Pradesh and Odisha has reached 10.96 and 32.87 lakh tons respectively. Procurement in West Bengal and other rice growing states is still underway.
- **China is set to import Indian basmati and non-basmati rice for the first time, said millers and traders** who have started getting inquiries from buyers from the neighboring nation. Beijing has already cleared 19 Indian rice companies to buy rice from. India exports 4 million tons of aromatic basmati rice a year and expects that to grow 5% this year with the opening of the new market, traders said. The country ships another 8.5 million tons of non-basmati rice to international markets.
- **Trading companies like Louis Dreyfus, Cofco Agri and regional players like Beijing Guchuan Rice Mills and Nice Foods** are keen to import basmati, nonbasmati and even broken rice from India. It is a good development for Indian rice companies and farmers, said Vijay Setia, president of the All India Rice Exporters Association. Kohinoor Foods, LT Foods, KRBL, Lalitha Enterprises Industries, Sriram Foods and Gajanan Rice Mills are among companies which have the permission to export to China and are already in talks with buyers. The trade expects four more Indian companies to get clearance to export post China's General Administration of Customs and state-owned food processing company Cofco making an inspection of Indian mills, said BV KrishnaNSE 0.00 % Rao, managing director of Pattabhi Agro Foods. It's a great opportunity and a huge market to tap into. With large disposable incomes, the consumer is looking for quality product. China wants freshly milled rice which is soft and sticky.
- **Rice export prices in India fell this week as the rupee weakened, with the drop in rates from the top exporter** also weighing on demand for the Vietnamese variety. Rates for India's 5 percent broken parboiled rice fell by \$3 per ton to \$389-\$393 per ton this week. Rupee depreciation is allowing traders to lower prices, but at the same time competitors are also lowering their quotes. The Indian currency fell to a record low against the dollar on Thursday.
- **India's rice stocks in the central pool as on Aug- 1, 2018 stood at around 24.94 million tons up by 5.23% from 23.70 million tons** recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are up by 5.23% by from 23.25 million tons recorded on July-01, 2018. Highest stock could be seen in the state of Punjab (80.61 lakh tons) followed by Andhra Pradesh (19.58 lakh tons) and Haryana (17.16 lakh tons) and Uttar Pradesh (14.48 Lakh Tons). The highest stock recorded of 339.6 lakh tons recorded in Feb- 2018.
- **This time, due to the absence of water in Ranbir Kennel in Jammu, farmers of Basmati paddy are not interested.** Last year, the area under basmati paddy had decreased and this year also has decreased i.e. this year also the production of basmati rice will be low. The future of

basmati rice depends entirely on Iran. If China buys basmati rice then it will be a bonus. Overall this year it will be good for Basmati and non-basmati rice.

- **As on 10th Aug, About 307.78 lakh hectares area covered under rice has been reported compared to normal of corresponding week** (316.82 lakh hectares). Thus 9.04 lakh hectares less area has been covered compared to normal of corresponding week. Higher area is mainly reported from the states of Andhra Pradesh (8.54 lakh Ha.), Telangana (5.95 lakh Ha.), Haryana (12.77 lakh Ha.), Punjab (30.2 lakh Ha.), Chhattisgarh (33.64 lakh Ha.), Madhya Pradesh (19.66 lakh Ha.). Less area is reported from the states of U.P, Bihar, West Bengal, Manipur, Assam, Tripura, Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Arunachal Pradesh etc.
- **All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 03.08.2018 for 2017-18 was at 363.52 lakh tons against the procurement of 380.09 lakh tons** in the corresponding period of last year. Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (118.33 lakh Tons), Haryana (39.67 lakh tons), and U.P (28.75 lakh tons) and in south it is started in Telangana (34.92 Lakh Tons). Andhra Pradesh government's procurement has reached 38.72 lakh tons. Chhattisgarh government also procured around 32.07 lakh tons of rice as of now. Procurement in Madhya Pradesh and Odisha has reached 10.96 and 28.65 lakh tons respectively. Procurement in West Bengal and other rice growing states is still underway.
- **In Andhra Pradesh this year, 42.78 lakh hectare area has been targeted for sowing of kharif crops, whereas** actual production area has reached only 21.34 lakh hectares which is 54 percent of the normal average area of 39.53 lakh hectare for the season. But this area is 1.13 lakh hectares more than last year's sowing area of 20.21 lakh hectare. According to latest data of the State Agriculture Department, this time in Andhra Pradesh, till August 8, the area of paddy increased from 7.33 lakh hectares to 8.54 lakh hectares in the same period of last year.

Price Outlook: -Rice prices are expected to trade steady in Last week of July with the normal domestic demand across the country. However, prices during the last quarter of MY 2017-18 will largely depend on the progress of 2018 monsoon and the impact on MY 2018-19 rice planting.

International Market Highlight:

- **Unofficial and preliminary Thai rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for July 30 – August 5, 2018**, totaled 197,310 metric tons, up 21,489 metric tons from the previous week and up 16,866 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 180,444 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – August 5, 2018 totaled 5,474,424 metric tons.
- **Iraq's state grains board said on Thursday it had purchased a total of 60,000 tons of rice in an international tender**, which closed this week. Traders said separately some 30,000 tons of rice was purchased from the United States at around \$655 a ton & free out.
- **For marketing year (MY) 2018/19 (May to April), forecast for Bangladesh total rice area and production levels** are revised downward to 11.6 million hectares and 34.4 million tons respectively based on marginal production loss in Boro rice (planted in December/January) due to

heavy downpours in harvesting season and lower Aus rice harvested area due to expected flooding in this current monsoon season.

- **Vietnam's rice exports in the first seven months of this year brought home 2 billion USD, rising 32 percent** against the same period last year. From January to July, the country sold 3.86 million tons of the grain abroad, a year-on-year increase of 12.8 percent. In the first six months of the year, China remained the largest importer of Vietnamese rice with 1.13 million tons, followed by African market with 537,000 tons, the Philippines with 429,000 tons, Indonesia with 776,000 tons, and Malaysia with 305,000 tons.
- **The 2017/18 Indonesia harvested area for rice is estimated to decline slightly to 12.2 million hectares due to increased** corn plantings. Production for 2017/18 is estimated to remain at 37.0 million tons of milled rice equivalent as a result of better yields due to fewer incidents of pest and disease and increased use of higher yielding varieties. To replenish stocks, Government of Indonesia (GOI) is expected to continue issuing authorizations for importing rice to state-run procurement agency BULOG. Rice imports for 2017/18 are estimated to increase significantly to 2.0 million tons, over 2016/17 imported volumes.
- **MY 2017/18 Brazil imports are forecast at 650,000 metric tons (MT), virtually unchanged from MY 2016/17 levels.** The vast majority of Brazil's rice imports come in duty-free from its MERCOSUL neighbors: Paraguay, Uruguay, and Argentina, with nearly 60 percent of MY 2016/17 imports coming from Paraguay alone. MY 2018/19 imports are forecast at 725,000 MT to account for a small uptick in consumption based on population growth.
- **The rice exports from Pakistan during 11 months of current financial year registered 29.15 percent growth as compared the** exports of corresponding period of last year as about 3.842 million metric tons of rice worth \$1.889 billion exported. During the period from July-May, 2017-18, 461,472 metric tons of basmati rice worth \$478.853 million was exported as against the exports of 406,824 metric tons worth \$385.746 of same period last year. In last 11 months of financial year 2017-18, basmati rice exports grew by 24.14 percent as compared the exports of the corresponding period of last year. The exports of rice other than basmati witnessed 104.16 percent growth during the period under review and about 322,802 metric tons of rice worth \$156.514 million exported as against the exports of 173,782 metric tons valuing \$76.664 million of same month of last year.
- **Philippines rice imports in 2019 could decline by 21.42 percent to 1.1 million metric tons (MMT), as the increase in palay** output would allow the Philippines to end 2018 with more stocks. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) said in a report that the country's total rice imports next year would decline by 300,000 metric tons (MT), from the projected 1.4 MMT this year. The Philippines is down 300,000 tons to 1.1 million tons on more abundant domestic supplies.
