

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **China recently sanctioned 4 more Indian Rice mills / companies to export rice. Now, 24 rice millers can export** non-basmati rice to China. China is one of the largest rice producing and consuming countries in the world and imports 5 million tons of rice annually. India can export one million tons of rice to China. India has become the world's largest exporting country by exporting 127 million tons of rice. During the visit of Prime Minister of India to China, the two countries had compromised on rice imports, after which the first shipments of 100 metric tons from Nagpur to China came out in November. If the pesticide in exported rice is done according to excise standards then it will be good news for rice markets.
- **Due to the all-round active buying of paddy, the prices touched the sky. Small Rice Millers are in a state of distress and confused by seeing this fast that they do not buy or buy paddy.** The fastest firmness came in the fine paddy, the production of fine rice this year, half of last year and the end of the old stock got support. The other paddy also caught the speed of the fine rice arrival.
- **In the domestic division, the prices of basmati paddy are high; especially Punjab and the farmers are getting better earnings.** Demand for Indian basmati rice is being revived in the global market due to which the millers and exporters are showing good interest in procurement of this paddy. Basmati rice prices in Haryana's mandis have reached this level of Rs 3,700 per quintal, which is about 30 percent higher than last year.
- **Despite the increase of paddy, the prices of paddy are going up fast. Whatever the paddy arrival are coming** in the market, rice millers are buying it in greater quantity. With the possibility of lower production of paddy and the old stock was reduced, rice mills came in all round purchase. This is the half of the paddy arrival in comparison to the previous year due to which the prices of paddy remained steady to firm. 1121 paddy price is likely to touch Rs.4000/quintal in coming month.
- **In the last 2 days, arrival progression of paddy in mandis has reduced the prices. Arrival of paddy is weak** in Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand. Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Punjab, production of 1121 paddy per hectare is estimated to be 7% less. In Pakistan also, paddy crop is weak. After the pressure of incoming pressure, the paddy should be purchased as soon as the price breaks, thereafter; the paddy market can be sharp.
- **All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 15.10.2018 for 2018-19 was at 26.04 lakh tons** against the procurement of 25 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year. Higher procurement has been received from northern states of Punjab (7.10 lakh Tons), Haryana (18.83 lakh tons).
- **India's basmati-rice exports are expected to pick up, as key importer Saudi Arabia is set to adopt easy residue** parameters to take delivery of consignments. With India taking steps to reduce the deposit of harmful chemicals on rice, local authorities expect the European Union also step up imports from India. India is the top exporter in the Rs 26,000-crore global basmati market. Shipments from the country to Saudi have taken a hit after Riyadh sought undertakings from exporters on minimum residue levels (MRL). Also, Saudi rejected a few consignments of Indian rice from a Singapore-based company. Since the Saudi Food and Drug Authority (SFDA) have not defined MRLs, customs authorities rejected the consignments based on the stringent lowest limit of analytical determination criteria followed by the EU and the US.

- **After becoming an area of low pressure in the Bay of Bengal, the Odisha government has been preparing at the war-level to deal with the hurricane that has transformed the shape of a cyclone.** Hurricane TITLI hits in Kerala and this storm is very tremendous and will soon enter Andhra Pradesh. With this storm there were heavy rains in many areas of Kerala and it rained 145 km / hour. It is too early to say something about the loss. It is impossible for any crop to stand in front of heavy rains and storms of this speed. Due to Storm TITLI in Odisha, state government has issued a high alert. In many places the relief agencies and security have been arranged. According to the forecast of the Meteorological Department, most areas of Odisha have expressed apprehensions of heavy rains. In addition, it will increase intensity of wind.

- **Saudi Arabia eased the rules of rice imported from India and said that India will have to reduce the level of pesticide** in rice in the future. This issue was discussed in a high-level meeting between India and Saudi Arabia last week. This is good news for rice markets.

- **As per latest data received from FCI, procurement for new MY-2018-19 starts in some regions and reached** to 3.92 lakh tons so far. Only Haryana and Punjab contributing the paddy procurement with quantity of 3.78 lakh tons and 0.14 lakh tons respectively.

- **The government has cut the rice procurement target this year. The procurement of rice in Kharif season starting** from October will be reduced by 11.56 lakh tons compared to last year. The procurement of 114 lakh tons of rice from Punjab and 39.75 lakh tons of rice is procured from the Haryana. The government procurement of rice in these two states will be done from October 1 to December 15. Apart from this, the Government has set a target of procuring 30 lakh tons in Andhra Pradesh, 15 lakh tons in Telangana, 40 lakh tons in Chhattisgarh, 13 lakh tons in Madhya Pradesh, 8 lakh tons from Bihar, 33 lakh tons in UP, 3 million tons in Odisha, 23 lakh tons in West Bengal, 8 lakh tons in Tamil Nadu, 5 lakh tons in Uttrakhand, 4 lakh tons from Maharashtra.

International Market Highlight:

- **As per latest report by USDA, Bangladesh rice production estimate for marketing year (MY) 2018/19 (May-April)** is revised slightly upward to 34.5 million metric tons (MMT) based on increased Aus rice production. It is raised for MY 2018/19 rice imports to 0.8 million metric tons based on slightly increased demand until the next Aman rice harvest. Based on the latest official data, in MY 2018-19, Aus rice area and production estimates (May-April) are revised up to 1.1 million ha and production of 2.4 MMT. Aman rice cultivated area and its production forecast are marginally revised to 5.8 million ha and 13.2 MMT, assuming optimal growth and normal yield.

- **The TY 2017/18 (Jan-Dec) Bangladesh rice import forecast is lowered to 1.7 MMT from old post's estimate** based on weak import pace after imposing a higher import duty on rice in the July budget for FY 2018-19. According to official sources, 1.626 MMT of rice was imported in the period January to September, 2018. Imports in Jan-June were 1.557 MMT, and from July to September it was 0.68 MMT. In MY 2018/19, the rice import forecast is raised to 0.8 MMT from old post's estimate following yearly average imports.

- **Thailand Rice export prices declined 1-2 percent due mainly to the weakening Thai baht which declined** to 32.73 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from 32.08 baht/U.S. \$1.00 over the past week. The weaker Thai baht will help Thai rice to better compete with Vietnamese and Indian rice on the new Philippine tender for 250,000 metric tons of 25 % grade white rice to be issued October 18, 2018. Traders expect strong competition for this public tender as the shipment will take place in November 2018 when new-crop rice supplies are entering the market. Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for September 24-30, 2018, totaled 187,224 metric tons, down 4,402 metric tons from the previous week and down 11,366 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 198,590 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – September 30, 2018 totaled 7,126,897 metric tons.
- **Hom mali fragrant rice production for the 2018-19 main crop is expected to drop 10% from the previous season** because of drought in the North and Northeast. As a result, paddy production for the annual harvest season, which starts later this month, will decline from 7.6 million tonnes in the previous season. Last year's premium rice production also fell from 7.9-8 million tonnes of paddy in previous years because of the impact of floods. Overall rice production will stay at around 25 million tonnes of paddy rice this year, on par with the previous season, boosted by white paddy and glutinous paddy production. White paddy production is estimated at 9.2 million tonnes, a marginal rise from the previous season, while glutinous paddy production is predicted to rise to 6.2 million tonnes from 6 million.
- **The National Food Authority of the Philippines has issued an invitation to a tender, expected to take place on October 18, for importing 250,000 tons of 25% broken rice under government-to-private (G2P) contracts,** according to the Vietnam Food Association in an announcement to local food traders.
- **MY 17-18 Philippines rice production is revised downwards to 19.4 million tons (paddy) based on the latest estimates from the PSA.** Like corn, rice production in the second quarter of 2018 declined 1.4 percent from the previous year's level as area harvested and yields were lower by 1.5 percent and 0.1 percent, respectively, due to early plantings in some areas. Output during the July-September 2018 period will again likely decline 2.0 percent compared to the previous year's level as area harvested and yields are estimated to drop by 2.8 percent and 0.9 percent, respectively.
- **Rice exports from Pakistan during first month of current financial year grew by 2.85 percent as compared the corresponding month of last year** and about 212,518 metric tons of rice worth US\$ 110.966 million exported as against the exports of 190,455 metric tons valuing US\$ 107.893 million of same period of last year. During the month of July, 2018, about 37,661 metric tons of basmati rice worth US\$ 34.832 million exported as compared the exports of 31,433 metric tons valuing US\$ 33.91 million of the corresponding month of last year.
- **Iraq's state grains board said on Thursday it had purchased a total of 60,000 tons of rice in an international tender,** which closed this week. Traders said separately some 30,000 tons of rice was purchased from the United States at around \$655 a ton c&f free out.
- **The 2017/18 Indonesia harvested area for rice is estimated to decline slightly to 12.2 million hectares due to increased corn plantings.** Production for 2017/18 is estimated to remain at 37.0 million tons of milled rice equivalent as a result of better yields due to fewer incidents of pest and disease and increased use of higher yielding varieties. To replenish stocks, Government of Indonesia (GOI) is expected to continue issuing authorizations for importing rice to state-run

procurement agency BULOG. Rice imports for 2017/18 are estimated to increase significantly to 2.0 million tons, over 2016/17 imported volumes.
