

Domestic Market Highlights:

- China has pledged to purchase 400,000 tonnes of rice from Cambodia this year. Last year, Cambodia exported 626,225 tonnes of rice to international markets, a drop of 1.5 percent compared to 2017. By individual country, the largest buyer was China (170,000 tonnes), followed by France (90,000 tonnes), Malaysia (40,000 tonnes), Gabon (30,000 tonnes), and the Netherlands (26,000 tonnes). China's pledge to buy more rice from Cambodia came as the European Commission last week imposed tariffs on rice imports from Cambodia and Myanmar.
- Average weekly wholesale rice prices in India stood at around Rs.3190 per quintal in this week
 of January- 2019, up by 0.58% from Rs.2998 per quintal in last week, and up by 4.08% from
 Rs.3065 per quintal a year ago. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range
 bound with firm tone due to lower production estimates.
- All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 11.01.2019 for 2018-19 was at 283.69 lakh
 tons against the procurement of 264.48 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year. The
 procurement of wheat for the Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2018-19 was 357.95 lakh tons
 which was higher than the procurement of 308.24 lakh tons in the corresponding period of RMS
 2017-18.
- The rice stock was 18.3 Million tons as on January 1-2019, last year 1 January 2018 was 16.2 million tons of rice stock in central pool kitty of the country. Rice stock increased by 2.1 million tons compared to last year.
- The European Union is likely this week to impose tariffs on rice coming from Cambodia and Myanmar for the next three years to curb a surge in imports. The Commission's proposal is to set a duty of 175 euros (\$200.73) per tonne of rice in the first year, dropping to 150 euros in the second and 125 euros in year three.
- Rice export prices in India rose this week due to a rally in local rates, while Thai and Vietnam prices are expected to drop in the coming weeks with fresh supplies hitting the market. India's 5 percent broken parboiled variety was quoted around \$382-\$387 per ton this week, compared with \$376-\$383 last week. Export prices in India had shot up earlier after Chhattisgarh, a leading rice producing state in central India, raised the minimum paddy buying price.
- Rice procurement this season crossed 263 lakh tons as of Friday compared to 254 lakh tons in the last year till January 2018. Rice procurement is higher than last year so far and it may turn out to be a record high if the trend reflects in Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal where procurement lasts till June. After a sluggish beginning, paddy procurement picked up in UP in the last few weeks as the state relaxed procurement norms. The state allowed up to 35 per cent of hybrid paddy in overall procurement. Procurement has picked as Uttar Pradesh government has announced various relaxations including 3 per cent higher Out Turn Ratio for hybrid paddy.
- As per ministry of Agriculture latest sowing report, rabi paddy sowing area till 28th December-2018 was 11.81 lakh hectares which was down by 28% from last year same period of 16.45 lakh hectares and down by 17% from normal area of 14.21 lakh hectares. Except Chhattisgarh, all



major rabi growing paddy states like A.P., Tamilnadu, Telangana shows downfall under rabi paddy due to unfavourable weather and water availability, however Chhattisgarh new Govt announces the hike of paddy MSP from rs.1750 to rs.2500/quintal which influence the farmers to grow paddy In rabi season too.

- India's exports of basmati rice grew by 11.54 per cent to Rs 16,963 crore during April-October this fiscal. In volume terms, however, the exports declined to 22.95 lakh tons in April-October 2018-19 as against 23.72 lakh crore in the same period last fiscal. While there is a marginal decline of 3.28 per cent per cent in quantity terms, in value terms the exports have grown by 11.54 per cent. The major export destination for basmati rice are Iran, Saudi Arabia, Iraq, UAE, Kuwait, Yemen, the US, and UK.
- Rice cultivation in the current rabi season is down by 32 per cent as compared to the corresponding period last year, with Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh reporting a substantial drop in planting, As per the weekly sowing data published on Friday, rabi sowing has covered a total area of 512.53 lakh hectares (lh), about 4.6 %lower than 537.12 lh covered in the same period in 2017-18.
- By increasing the minimum support price (MSP) of Paddy by Rs. 1750 per quintal to 2500 rupees per quintal by the Chhattisgarh government, the government procurement of paddy will increase. Chhattisgarh has targeted the target of 55 lakh tons of Paddy this year. The paddy from state of Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Orissa adjoining Chhattisgarh will now come to illegal use in Chhattisgarh. Due to the promise of increasing the MSP during the elections, government procurement of rice in Chhattisgarh and Border States was halted. So far, 21.6 lakh tons of paddy has been procured in Chhattisgarh. Paddy procurement is 60% higher than the target in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.
- Uttar Pradesh has kept the target of paddy procurement five lakh tonnes this year, but so far only 2.45 lakh tonnes of paddy has been procured by the government. During the same period last year 9.2 lakh tonnes of paddy was procured. Looking at the current situation, the state government's purchase of Paddy will be less in Uttar Pradesh this year. Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister issued an instruction to speed up the purchase while expressing displeasure.

International Market Highlight:

- Vietnam targets 6.5 million tons of rice exports this year: The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD) has set a goal to export around 6.5 million tons of rice worth a total USD3 billion this year.
- All 16.84 million tons of Thai rice in the government stockpile has now been released to the markets, securing some Bt145.08 billion in sales over the few years, according to the Ministry of Commerce. With the total sales of government stock, Thailand exported 11.13 million tons of



rice as targeted in 2018, down 3.36 per cent from the previous year, while rice export value rose 4.5 per cent to US\$5.62 billion or about Bt180.41 billion for the year.

- Cambodia's rice exports to the international market fell more than 13 per cent for the first 11 months of the year, compared to the same period last year. It showed a drop in exports to the international market in the first 11 months of the year, accounting for 497,240 tonnes down from 562,237 tonnes in the same period last year. Decline is due to the lack of stockpiles and competition with neighboring countries.
- Indonesian Rice imports for 2017/18 are estimated to reach 2.15 million tons, based on realized imports of state owned purchasing and logistics agency BULOG. Ample stocks will lead to lower imports of 800,000 tons in 2018/19. According to Global Trade Atlas, during the period of January to September 2018, Indonesia sourced the imported rice from Vietnam (36 percent), Thailand (34 percent), Pakistan (17 percent), and India (11 percent). As of September 2018, BULOG had distributed 960,000 tons of rice under rastra and 381,000 tons of rice under market operations. Continuing market sales for the final quarter of 2018 along with rastra allocation for December are estimated to leave BULOG with 2.2 million tons of rice stocks at the end of 2018. Under normal rastra distribution and market operations this level of stocks should be sufficient to sustain BULOG until the first harvest of 2019, without need for imports.
- On November 13, 2018, Statistics Korea (KOSTAT) released its revised 2018 rice production estimate of 3,868,045 metric tons, representing a minor decrease (7,000 MT) from the recent update of PSD (KS1837) due to unfavorable weather developments during planting and growing stages that resulted in a lower rice yield of 5,244 kg per hectare (ha), down 0.4 percent from 2017. The PSD has been revised accordingly.
- Iran has ended its seasonal ban on rice imports, allowing importers to register their orders, Deputy Agriculture Minister Ali Akbar Mehrfard announced the end of the annual ban in a letter dated Nov. 28.
- Thailand Rice export prices remain unchanged from the previous week. Traders are waiting for the shipping arrangements to be finalized for the contracts under the November 20, 2018 Philippines tender for 500,000 metric tons of 25% grade white rice from various origins to be finalized. The first shipment totaling 250,000 metric tons will be delivered in December 2018 and the remainder in January 2019. Traders expect that around half of the shipments will be the Thai origin white rice. In Vietnam, the news media reports that 118,000 metric tons will come from Vietnam. The remainder will be white rice from other origins, including Pakistan and India. Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for November 12- 18 totaled 158,941 metric tons, up 2,426 metric tons from the previous week and up 1,587 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 157,354 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 November 18, 2018 totaled 8,361,879 metrictons.



• Egypt has disapproved Indian rice buying tender for 2018 as all Indian rice samples failed the cooking test required for the approval. China and Vietnam samples have approved.
