

### **Domestic Market Highlights:**

- Haryana Agricultural Department has released the second advance estimation of crop production for the entire marketing season (Kharif + Rabi) of 2018-19. Under this, the possibility of production of rice, wheat, sugarcane and guar is less than the 2017-18 seasons and the production of millet and cotton is expected more. As per the advance estimates, the production of rice in Haryana can be reduced by 4.3 percent from 48.80 lakh tons in 2017-18 season and 46.69 lakh tons in 2018-19 and wheat production could fall by 7.8 percent from 122.63 lakh tons to 113.01 lakh tons.
- All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 15.02.2019 for 2018-19 was at 348.24 lakh tonnes against the procurement of 291.42 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period of last year.
- Rice exports from India are set to swing in the last quarter of this year on a spate in orders after shipments slumped 14% in the last three quarters over high input costs and tepid demand from Bangladesh. Consignments in January are better than the previous year and the trade is likely to attain levels close to the previous year. Exporters have seen a surge in demand from the United Arab Emirates, Iran, Saudi Arabia and the US this quarter. The official said the supply for exports has streamlined after being affected for the last few months of 2018 because of assembly polls in some states. A bumper yield in Bangladesh also took toll on Indian exports. The 5% subsidy on export value extended to non-basmati rice under the Merchandise Exports from India Scheme (MEIS) in November helped in recovery of trade, but margins remained thin.
- All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 08.02.2019 for 2018-19 was at 339.39 lakh tons against the procurement of 288.35 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year. The procurement of wheat for the Rabi Marketing Season (RMS) 2018-19 was 357.95 lakh tons which was higher than the procurement of 308.24 lakh tons in the corresponding period of RMS 2017-18.
- The Telangana government has released the second advance estimation of agricultural production for the current marketing season (Kharif + Rabi) of 2018-19. Under this, the possibility of drop in the production of all other important crops, except paddy and sugarcane, has been expressed. According to the latest report of the State Agriculture Department, production of rice during the 2018-19 seasons in Telangana increased from 62.50 lakh tons to 63.50 lakh tons and sugarcane production from 25.58 lakh tons to reach 28.00 lakh tons Estimates.
- About 1.11 million tons of rice worth around \$1.1 billion were imported into Iran during the first 10 months of the current Iranian year (March 21, 2018-Jan. 20), which shows a 0.89% decline in weight and 4.41% rise in value compared with the similar period of last year.
- In the first 9 months of this financial year i.e. April-December 2018, the export of basmati rice was 28.6 lakh tonnes, which was 29.11 lakh tonnes in the same period last year i.e. the export of basmati rice decreased from last year, similarly non-basmati there was tremendous dedine in the export of rice. During the same period last year 65.15 lakh tonnes of non-basmati rice was exported. Rice exports from India decreased due to tough competition by Thailand, Indonesia in



non-basmati rice prices in international markets. Paddy and rice prices in the domestic markets are also sharper than last year and also the daily fluctuations between dollar and rupee are affecting exports. Paddy and rice prices may increase once again, when good export demand comes out.

- As per ministry of Agriculture latest sowing report, rabi paddy sowing area till 01st
   February2019 was 25.36 lakh hectares which was down by 18.68% from last year same period
   of 31.19 lakh hectares and down by 39.03% from normal area of 41.60 lakh hectares. All major
   Rabi growing paddy states like A.P, Tamilnadu, Telangana shows downfall under rabi paddy due
   to unfavorable weather and water availability.
- Average weekly wholesale rice prices in India stood at around Rs.3203 per quintal in this week
  of January- 2019, down by 4.77% from Rs.3364 per quintal in last week, and up by 13.9% from
  Rs.2812 per quintal a year ago. Agriwatch expects non-basmati rice market to move range
  bound with firm tone due to lower production estimates.
- The Andhra Pradesh government sought to relax the rules of paddy procurement quality from the center. Due to two consecutive storms in Andhra Pradesh, paddy crop was damaged due to lack of quality standards of about 3 lakh tons of paddy, FCI could not purchase the government. Paddy crop in bad condition in Andhra Pradesh's Guntur, Krishna and Srikakulam districts. In MY 2018-19 76 lakh tonnes of paddy production estimates in the kharif season in Andhra Pradesh, whereas Possibility of paddy production of 121 lakh tonnes in Andhra Pradesh together with Rabi and Kharif Season.
- Paddy crop in bad condition in Andhra Pradesh's Guntur, Krishna and Srikakulam districts. In MY 2018-19 76 lakh tonnes of paddy production estimates in the kharif season in Andhra Pradesh, whereas Possibility of paddy production of 121 lakh tonnes in Andhra Pradesh together with Rabi and Kharif Season.
- An important agricultural productive state of South India due to untimely rains in Telangana, there is news of heavy losses to paddy, arhar, maize and red chilli crop. Rain has inflicted heavy losses on its stock in the mandis. The rainy season began in the state from January 26, which continued on 27 and 28 January. The Meteorological Department has projected the situation in the state from general to heavy rains for the next four days.
- Paddy farmers in Telangana have reaped a bumper harvest this kharif, with total production likely to cross the 60-lakh-tonne mark at the end of the season. According to the latest reports with the Civil Supplies Department, procurement centers had already bought 30 lakh tonnes as against 18-19 lakh tonnes in the same period last year. Sharp increase in production to the increased minimum support price (MSP), improved irrigation facilities and pro-farmer policies' being implemented by the State Government.
- Among the food grains, inflation as per wholesale price index of Wheat increased to 9.61% from the previous month's level of 9.18%, pulses to 2.11% from the previous month's level of (-) 5.42% and Cereals to 7.59% from the previous month's level of 7.23%. The inflation for Paddy has decreased to 3.97% from the previous month's level of 4.29%.



- Rice export prices in India rose this week due to a rally in local rates, while Thai and Vietnam prices are expected to drop in the coming weeks with fresh supplies hitting the market. India's 5 percent broken parboiled variety was quoted around \$382-\$387 per ton this week, compared with \$376-\$383 last week. Export prices in India had shot up earlier after Chhattisgarh, a leading rice producing state in central India, raised the minimum paddy buying price.
- India's exports of basmati rice grew by 11.54 per cent to Rs 16,963 crore during April-October this fiscal. In volume terms, however, the exports declined to 22.95 lakh tons in April-October 2018-19 as against 23.72 lakh crore in the same period last fiscal. While there is a marginal decline of 3.28 per cent per cent in quantity terms, in value terms the exports have grown by 11.54 per cent. The major export destination for basmati rice are Iran, Saudi Arabia, Iraq, UAE, Kuwait, Yemen, the US, and UK.
- Rice cultivation in the current rabi season is down by 32 per cent as compared to the corresponding period last year, with Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh reporting a substantial drop in planting, As per the weekly sowing data published on Friday, rabi sowing has covered a total area of 512.53 lakh hectares (lh), about 4.6 %lower than 537.12 lh covered in the same period in 2017-18.
- By increasing the minimum support price (MSP) of Paddy by Rs. 1750 per quintal to 2500 rupees per quintal by the Chhattisgarh government, the government procurement of paddy will increase. Chhattisgarh has targeted the target of 55 lakh tons of Paddy this year. The paddy from state of Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and Orissa adjoining Chhattisgarh will now come to illegal use in Chhattisgarh. Due to the promise of increasing the MSP during the elections, government procurement of rice in Chhattisgarh and Border States was halted. So far, 21.6 lakh tons of paddy has been procured in Chhattisgarh. Paddy procurement is 60% higher than the target in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.
- Uttar Pradesh has kept the target of paddy procurement five lakh tonnes this year, but so far only 2.45 lakh tonnes of paddy has been procured by the government. During the same period last year 9.2 lakh tonnes of paddy was procured. Looking at the current situation, the state government's purchase of Paddy will be less in Uttar Pradesh this year. Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister issued an instruction to speed up the purchase while expressing displeasure.

#### **International Market Highlight:**

• Sri Lanka declared Minimum Support Price for Nadu and Samba variety rice which will be effective from 1st April. MSP of Nadu Variety Rice is 80 Sq. Kg / kg (Indian Rupees 32 per kg) and Samba Variety MSP 85 Sri Lankan rupee per kg (Indian Rupees 34 per kg).



- Rice export prices increased 1-2 percent, particularly for fragrant and parboiled rice, due mainly to the strengthening of the Thai baht to 32.4 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the exchange rate of 32.6 baht/U.S. \$1.00 in the previous week. Meanwhile, export prices of white rice remained unchanged. Exporters have secured white rice supplies to fulfil the shipment contracts to the Philippine and Chinese governments who respectively purchased 224,000 metric tons of 25% grade white rice, and 100,000 metric tons of 5% grade white rice in November 2018. The shipments have taken placed since mid-December 2018 and will finish in January 2019. Thailand Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for December 10-16, 2018 totalled 245,482 metric tons, up 74,486 metric tons from the previous week and up 68,183 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 177,299 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 December 16, 2018 totaled 9,071,074 metrictons.
- The European Commission has imposed tariffs on rice imported from Cambodia and Myanmar in a bid to curb a surge in rice imports from the two Southeast Asian countries. Significant increase of imports of Indica rice from Cambodia and Myanmar into EU caused economic damage to the EU producers. According to the commission's decision, from Friday, the EU will reinstate the normal customs duty on this product of 175 Euros (199 U.S. dollars) per ton in the first year, progressively reducing it to 150 Euros (171 U.S. dollars) per ton in the second year, and 125 Euros (142 U.S. dollars) per ton in the third year. Cambodia and Myanmar are beneficiaries of the EU's everything but Arms (EBA) trade scheme, which unilaterally grants duty-and quota-free access to the world's least developed countries, according to the statement. Cambodia exported a total amount of 626,225 tons of milled rice in 2018, with 42.9 percent of it going to the European markets.
- Vietnam targets 6.5 million tons of rice exports this year: The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD) has set a goal to export around 6.5 million tons of rice worth a total USD3 billion this year.
- All 16.84 million tons of Thai rice in the government stockpile has now been released to the markets, securing some Bt145.08 billion in sales over the few years, according to the Ministry of Commerce. With the total sales of government stock, Thailand exported 11.13 million tons of rice as targeted in 2018, down 3.36 per cent from the previous year, while rice export value rose 4.5 per cent to US\$5.62 billion or about Bt180.41 billion for the year.
- Cambodia's rice exports to the international market fell more than 13 per cent for the first 11 months of the year, compared to the same period last year. It showed a drop in exports to the international market in the first 11 months of the year, accounting for 497,240 tonnes down from 562,237 tonnes in the same period last year. Decline is due to the lack of stockpiles and competition with neighboring countries.
