

### Domestic Market Highlights:

- **Government has offered 901680 tonnes of rice in OMSS since July'18 until fourth tender in March'19** out of which 846080 tonnes was sold. Of the total quantity, state government and bulk consumers bought 844680 tonnes and 1400 tonnes of rice respectively.
- **Opening stock with FCI on 1<sup>st</sup> April registered at 293.94 lakh MT up by 45.21 lakh MT** against 248.73 lakh MT stock during the same time last year.
- **In the last 3 days, the uptrend prices is observed for Basmati rice. Demand from Iran triggered the market of basmati rice.** The export of basmati rice from last year has increased by 6.3% from April to February, reaching 38.6 lakh tons in the current year. Due to non-availability in the states of Haryana, Punjab and other Basmati and non-basmati producing states, the millers could not get paddy for milling.
- **Due to the production of bumper rice this year in Bangladesh, there was a sharp decline in rice exports from India,** from April 2018 to February 2019, 10.57 million tonnes of rice was exported, which is 9.4% less than last year.
- **The government is mulling to offload excess stocks of rice and wheat in the open market during the fresh procurement season. The FCI currently holds 26.3 million tonnes of rice and 20.1 million tonnes of wheat, according to data on its website.** The government expects to procure 45 million tonnes of rice (kharif and rabi) and 35.7 million tonnes of wheat in the current season. The government had targeted the sale of 10 million tonnes of wheat and 2 million tonnes of rice in the open market in the previous season.
- **As per latest IGC report, the outlook for global 2018/19 rice output is raised by 5 million tons m/m,** to a record 500 million tons, a 1% y/y rise. Although uptake is lifted, most of the net increase in supplies is channeled to stocks, pegged 4 million tons higher m/m, at 157 million tons, a 4% y/y gain. World trade in 2019 is predicted little-changed, at 47 million tons.
- **Despite record domestic production, the higher MSP has driven the MY 2018/19 domestic prices right** from the beginning of the season. Market prices during the second half of the season are likely to remain steady on the forecast lower rabi harvest. However, domestic prices may also respond to international price movements.
- **India's rice stocks in the central pool as on March- 1, 2019 stood at 40.09 million tons up by 20.31%** from 33.32 million tons recorded during the corresponding period last year, according to data from the Food Corporation of India (FCI). India's rice stocks in the central pool are down by 1.43% by from 40.67 million tons recorded on Feb-01, 2019. Highest stock could be seen in the state of Punjab (89.56 lakh tons) followed by Telangana (25.32 lakh tons) Uttar Pradesh (25.30 Lakh Tons) and Andhra Pradesh (23.42 lakh tons).
- **All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 01.04.2019 for 2018-19 was at 374.51 lakh tons** against the procurement of 300 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year.
- **Iraq's trade ministry is seeking at least 30,000 tons of rice of any origin in an international purchasing tender,** the deadline for offers is March 26 and offers should remain valid until March 31.
- **Rice export prices in India rose to their highest level in more than seven months as the rupee appreciated,** denting demand, while trading companies in Vietnam increased domestic buying to fulfill new overseas deals. India's 5 percent broken parboiled variety was quoted around \$392-\$395 per ton this week, up from \$386-\$389 last week. As per traders, Demand has been moderating due to the price rise. African buyers are not ready to pay higher prices. The Indian

rupee was trading near its highest level in seven months, trimming returns from overseas sales for traders in the world's largest rice exporter.

- **Demand of premium variety of GovindoBhog paddy of West Bengal is increasing from South India and Bangladesh.** Last year GovindoBhog Paddy prices were Rs 3000 per quintal, which now has increased 17% to Rs. 3500 per quintal. Similarly, GovindoBhog rice prices have increased by 9% from last year to Rs. 5100 per quintal; Last year, the GovindaBhog rice prices were Rs. 4700 per quintal.
- **The Maharashtra government announced a bonus of 500 rupees per quintal on the purchase of paddy** from farmers. Last year, the state government had given a bonus of Rs 200 per quintal on paddy in the kharif season. Due to drought in several districts of Maharashtra, the paddy crop was reduced.

### International Market Highlight:

- **MY 2019/20 Bangladesh rice import forecast is projected lower to 500,000 MT due to increased total supplies** because of higher production. MY 2018/19 import estimate is down to 575,000 MT because of slow import pace, likely caused by the application of a very high tariff and higher domestic production. Bangladesh primarily imports rice from India and Pakistan. India has been the largest supplier in recent years. Stocks: According to the Ministry of Food (MOF), as of March 19, 2019, public rice stocks are 1.37 MMT, which is approximately 33 percent higher than last year. From December 1, 2018 to March 3, 2019, the MOF procured 799,966 MT of monsoon (Aman rice) season rice at BDT 36 (US\$ 0.42) per kilogram.
- **Unofficial and preliminary Thailand rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for March 18-24, 2019 totaled 126,174 metric tons**, down 38,094 metric tons from the previous week and down 13,970 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 140,144 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – March 24, 2019 totaled 1,748,793 metric tons, down 23 percent from the same period last year.
- **From April 1, 2018 to March, 2019, Myanmar's rice and broken rice exports are expected to reach about 2.3 million tons**, down about 1.2 million tons compared with the same period last year. Myanmar Rice Federation (MRF) This year, country has exported more than two million tons of rice. The total rice exports are expected to hit about 2.3 million tons including the additional exports in March. In the past, Myanmar's fiscal year was from April 1 to March 31. Since 2018-2018 fiscal year, Myanmar has changed its fiscal year from October 1 to September 30.
- **Sri Lanka declared Minimum Support Price for Nadu and Samba variety rice which will be effective** from 1st April. MSP of Nadu Variety Rice is 80 Sq. Kg / kg (Indian Rupees 32 per kg) and Samba Variety MSP 85 Sri Lankan rupee per kg (Indian Rupees 34 per kg).
- **Rice export prices increased 1-2 percent, particularly for fragrant and parboiled rice, due mainly to the strengthening of the Thai baht** to 32.4 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the exchange rate of 32.6 baht/U.S. \$1.00 in the previous week. Meanwhile, export prices of white rice remained unchanged. Exporters have secured white rice supplies to fulfil the shipment contracts to the

Philippine and Chinese governments who respectively purchased 224,000 metric tons of 25% grade white rice, and 100,000 metric tons of 5% grade white rice in November 2018. The shipments have taken place since mid-December 2018 and will finish in January 2019. Thailand Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding premium white and fragrant rice) for December 10-16, 2018 totalled 245,482 metric tons, up 74,486 metric tons from the previous week and up 68,183 metric tons from the four-week moving average of 177,299 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – December 16, 2018 totalled 9,071,074 metric tons.

- Cambodia's rice exports to the international market fell more than 13 per cent for the first 11 months of the year**, compared to the same period last year. It showed a drop in exports to the international market in the first 11 months of the year, accounting for 497,240 tonnes – down from 562,237 tons in the same period last year. Decline is due to the lack of stockpiles and competition with neighboring countries.
