Domestic Market Highlights:

- In April, export of 4.33 lakh tonnes of basmati rice and 3.07 lakh tonnes of non-basmati rice from India.
- A stronger rupee helped lift rice export prices in top exporter India from a near seven-month low this week, while rates for the Vietnamese variety slipped as the harvest in the Mekong Delta gathered steam. A stronger rupee helped lift rice export prices in top exporter India from a near seven-month low this week, while rates for the Vietnamese variety slipped as the harvest in the Mekong Delta gathered steam. India's 5 percent broken parboiled variety was quoted around \$364-\$367 per tonne, up from last week's \$362-\$365.
- Bangladesh Government has fixed import duty on rice by doubling the present level of 28 percent to 55 percent now, considering the country's excellent domestic production of paddy. In this connection a government circular was issued on May 22. As a result, the prospect of importing rice from India, especially outside of Bangladesh, has diminished. In the statutory regulatory order issued by the National Revenue Board, it has been said that the new import duty has come into force with immediate effect. The Chairman of the Board said that the import duty was reviewed according to the directions of the Prime Minister and it was decided to increase rate of interest to ensure the safety of the interests of indigenous farmers.
- The Telangana Civil Supply Department (TCSD) has so far procured 68 lakh tons of paddy. Having more purchases made the problem of paddy storage. TCSD wants FCI to provide 23 lakh tons of rice for storage, FCI agreed to buy 3.44 lakh tons of raw rice from Telangana rice millers yesterday.
- Egypt has issued tender for purchase of Indian, Chinese and Vietnamese rice in international markets. Whose shipment will be from July 25 to August 20.
- All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 17.05.2019 for 2018-19 was at 405.32 lakh tons against the procurement of 300 lakh tons in the corresponding period of last year. According to available data, in the current kharif marketing season, Punjab has procured 113.34 lakh tones rice, 39.09 lakh tons in Haryana, 40.80 lakh tons in Chhattisgarh, 45.73 lakh tons in Telangana, 32.33 lakh tons in Uttar Pradesh 34.65 lakh tons in Orissa, 32.25 lakh tons in Andhra Pradesh, 13.95 lakh tons in Madhya Pradesh, 16.57 lakh tons in West Bengal, 4.62 lakh tons in Uttrakhand, 11.58 lakh tons in Tamil Nadu, 4.25 lakh tons in Maharashtra and 9.28 lakh tons in Bihar.
- The Maharashtra government has set up State Agriculture Committee to create a new agri export policy of the state, which aims to increase the export of rice and fruits.
- Rice export prices in top exporter India slid this week to their lowest in nearly seven months as demand continued to stagnate, while rates for Vietnamese rice dipped on expected increase in stockpiles after the summer harvest.
- West Bengal's rice industry was suffering similar losses due to lower demand but due to imposing duty on rice imports by Bangladesh, there was a possibility of further reduction in rice exports from West Bengal. Last year, Bangladesh imposed 28% duty on rice imports from India.



Because of which non-basmati rice exports came down heavily for Bangladesh. Because of this, there was tremendous decline in rice exports between April and February. From April 1, 2018 to February 2019, only 4.25 lakh tons of rice was exported from India compared to 70 lakh tons in the same period last year.

• An important agricultural productive state of South India Andhra Pradesh, the target of production of sowing area and production of different crops has been set for the forthcoming kharif season. It has set target of 84.59 lakh tonnes of paddy, 5.35 lakh tonnes of maize, 2.37 lakh tonnes of arhar (tuvar) and total 95.86 lakh tonnes of foodgrain production. The Andhra Pradesh Agriculture Ministry has increased the production estimation of paddy in the next season. According to the Ministry of Agriculture, the production target of paddy in the next season was 84.6 lakh tonnes, which was 78.28 lakh tonnes last year.

International Market Highlight:

- Unofficial and preliminary Thailand rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for April 15-21, 2019, totalled 43,611 metric tons, down 92,095 metric tons from the previous week and down 74,059 metric tons from the four week moving average of 117,670 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 April 21, 2019, totalled 2,219,471 metric tons, down 24 percent from the same period last year.
- In the international market, India's 5% broken parboiled rice was quoted around \$371 \$374 per tonne this week- down from last week's \$373 \$376. Aggressive selling of old inventories by China was reported to weigh on the global prices.
- Bangladesh has postponed a decision on lifting its ban on rice exports until the completion of summer rice harvest as cyclone Fani is estimated to have partially damaged the summer sown "Boro" crop on 55,600 hectares of land.
- Egypt is seeking to buy at least 20,000 tonnes of 10-12 percent broken rice for delivery between July 25 and Aug. 20, a source with Vietnam's Ministry of Industry and Trade was reported saying.
- Ivory Coast banned rice imports from Singapore-based commodity trader Olam International for one year after destroying an 18,000-tonne shipment of spoilt.
- Rice production in Burma (also called Myanmar) in MY 2019/20 is forecast to increase as farmers increase planting acreage in anticipation of favorable weather and due to attractive prices. Burma's overall rice exports in MY 2019/20 are forecast remain at the same level as MY 2018/19 at 3.0 MMT. There will be some lost market potential in the EU, offset by some increased market potential in China.
- From April 1, 2018 to March, 2019, Myanmar's rice and broken rice exports are expected to reach about 2.3 million tons, down about 1.2 million tons compared with the same period last year. Myanmar Rice Federation (MRF) This year, country has exported more than two million tons of rice. The total rice exports are expected to hit about 2.3 million tons including the additional exports in March. In the past, Myanmar's fiscal year was from April 1 to March 31. Since 2018-2018 fiscal year, Myanmar has changed its fiscal year from October 1 to September 30.
