

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **With the shortage of rain in Andhra Pradesh, the sowing of Kharif crops is going much behind the previous year** and its speed remains slow. According to official figures, till July 17 this year, the total production area of kharif crops was reached at 6.01 lakh hectares which is much lower than last year's sowing area of 11.48 lakh hectares and the general average area is only 15.7 percent of 38.30 lakh hectare. The Andhra Pradesh government has set a target of sowing of kharif crops in 42.04 lakh hectares this time. According to latest data of State Agriculture Department, this year, the production of paddy in Andhra Pradesh has dropped from 4.17 lakh hectares to 2.06 lakh hectare compared to last year.
- **As per the ministry of Agriculture, Kharif Rice acreage as on 12th July 2019 has declined by 11 per cent at 97.77 lakh hectares** as compared to 109.88 lakh hectares same period & down by 19.4% from normal area as on date of 121.3 lakh hectares. This year, the area of paddy has decreased from 2.63 lakh hectares to 1.37 lakh hectares in Andhra Pradesh, 3.14 lakh hectares in Assam from 3.51 lakh hectares, and Chhattisgarh's 16.71 lakh hectares slipped from 15.47 lakh hectares, 8.60 lakh hectare in Haryana compared to last year. 5.90 lakh hectares, from 2.69 lakh hectares in Madhya Pradesh, 3.69 lakh hectare, Falling from 1.49 lakh hectares in Tamil Nadu, 81 thousand hectares fall in Telangana, 59,000 hectares slipped from 1.01 lakh hectares, Uttar Pradesh has decreased from 17.31 lakh hectare to 14.65 lakh hectares, 2.31 lakh hectares in Uttarakhand slips 2.09 lakh hectares and 2.44 lakh in West Bengal Hectare dropped from 1.69 lakh hectares .
- **The total procurement by FCI for Rice KMS 2018-19 stood at 437.51 lakh tonnes much higher than 381.84lakh tonnes in previous year** due to higher production estimate, procurement is higher this year as compare to last year. As on 8th July'19, highest procurement of 113.34 lakh tonnes was in Punjab followed by Telangana & AP procuring 51.86 lakh tonnes and 45.65 lakh tonnes respectively.
- **Government has offered 237290 tonnes of rice in OMSS until fourth tender in June'19 out of which 218690 tonnes was sold.** State government bought 218690 tonnes of rice whereas no sales happened among bulk consumers. In the month of June'19, government has sold 111000 tonnes of wheat against offered quantity of 190100 tonnes.
- **As per the ministry of Agriculture, Kharif Rice acreage as on 05th July 2019 has declined by 23.5 per cent at 52.47 lakh hectares** as compared to 68.60 lakh hectares same period down by 33% from normal area as on date of 79.36 lakh hectares. The area coverage is mainly reported from Uttarakhand (1.82 lakh hectares), Assam (3.14 lakh hectares), Nagaland (1.86 lakh hectares), Chhatisgarh (4.38 lakh hectares), Kerala (0.33 lakh hectares), Odisha (5.16 lakh hectares), Tamil Nadu (0.65 lakh hectares), J&K (0.07 lakh hectares), etc.
- **As per the ministry of Agriculture, Kharif Rice acreage as on 14th June 2019 has declined by 22 per cent at 4.26 lakh hectares** as compared to 5.47 lakh hectares same period last year. The area coverage is mainly reported from Uttarakhand (1.26 lakh hectares), Assam (1.11 lakh hectares), Nagaland (1.10 lakh hectares), Chhatisgarh (0.28 lakh hectares), Kerala (0.13 lakh hectares), Odisha (0.12 lakh hectares), Tamil Nadu (0.10 lakh hectares), J&K (0.07 lakh hectares), etc.

- **The Government has announced to increase the MSP of normal grade paddy by 65 rupees to 1815** and 'A' grade Paddy MSP of 1835 rupees per quintal. MSP increased in paddy, not according to expectation. The government does not want to encourage paddy sowing to see the water crisis. Increasing the MSP will not affect the prices of paddy.
- **Rice export prices in India edged higher this week, helped by an uptick in demand, while a strong Thai baht** propped up prices in the world's second largest rice exporter amid subdued consumption. In India, the top exporter of the staple grain, 5 percent broken parboiled variety was quoted around \$369-\$372 per tonne this week, up from last week's \$367-\$370. Traders are seeing interest building up from West African markets. Farmers have planted summer-sown rice on 630,000 hectares as of June 21, down 32% compared with the same period a year ago, according to provisional data from the Ministry of Agriculture, as the monsoon delivered less-than-average rainfall.
- **To save Basmati export to Europe, USA and Arab countries, Punjab, which is highest user of fertilisers** and insecticides per hectare in the country, much above the national average, has launched a 'pesticide-free' Basmati campaign in the state. Basmati exporters and Basmati growers in the state are now working together to use fewer pesticides in order meets the new guidelines of the European Union (EU) and other countries regarding the Basmati import from India. This effort is to achieve total compliance with EU Maximum Residue Level (MRLs). The Department of Agriculture, through its network of field officers, would recruit fresh agriculture graduates to fan out to all the Basmati clusters in the state and directly remain in touch with the farmers.
- **NCDEX started futures trading of Mung and basmati from July 1, NCDEX has sought approval** from SEBI to launch futures trading in Tur and Urad.
- **Due to the decrease in supply and availability during the last few weeks, there has been a huge increase** of about 20 per cent of the price of Sona mansuri and kolam. In the eastern part of Karnataka and in the Vidarbha region of Maharashtra, this non-basmati coconut rice is mass production and the customer likes it very much. In fact, due to severe drought in major producing areas of these two states, the paddy crop was badly affected and accordingly the production of rice decreased.
- **With the delay in the monsoon, paddy sowing is being affected in the country. Paddy sowing has** been done in 4.3 lakh hectare in the country till June 14, which was 5.47 lakh hectares during the same period last year. If monsoon is weak, then it may have an impact on paddy production.

International Market Highlight:

- **Thailand Rice export prices declined 1-2 percent due to the weakening Thai baht and the lack of new** inquiries. The Thai baht weakened to around 30.7 baht/U.S. \$1.00 from the record exchange rate of 30.4 baht/U.S. \$1.00 over the past two weeks. However, new inquiries for Thai rice remain quiet as Thai white rice prices are U.S. \$15-20/MT higher than Vietnamese and

Indian rice. Additionally, Thai fragrant rice prices are U.S. \$500-600/MT higher than Vietnamese fragrant rice. Unofficial and preliminary Thailand rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for June 24-30, 2019 totaled 100,146 metric tons, down 14,267 metric tons from the previous week and down 15,317 metric tons from the four week moving average of 115,463 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – June 30, 2019, totaled 3,373,365 metric tons, down 26 percent from the same period last year.

- **Restrictions will be imposed on rice cultivation in Iranian provinces other than the two Northern provinces** of Gilan and Mazandaran. According to deputy agriculture minister for water and soil affairs, the decision has been made by the Cabinet and conveyed to provinces across the country for implementation.
- **In the international market, India's 5% broken parboiled rice was quoted around \$371 - \$374 per tonne this week-** down from last week's \$373 - \$376. Aggressive selling of old inventories by China was reported to weigh on the global prices.
- **Bangladesh has postponed a decision on lifting its ban on rice exports** until the completion of summer rice harvest as cyclone Fani is estimated to have partially damaged the summer sown "Boro" crop on 55,600 hectares of land.
- **Egypt is seeking to buy at least 20,000 tonnes of 10-12 percent broken rice for delivery between July 25 and Aug. 20**, a source with Vietnam's Ministry of Industry and Trade was reported saying.
- **Ivory Coast banned rice imports from Singapore-based commodity trader Olam International for one year** after destroying an 18,000-tonne shipment of spoilt.
- **Rice production in Burma (also called Myanmar) in MY 2019/20 is forecast to increase as farmers increase** planting acreage in anticipation of favorable weather and due to attractive prices. Burma's overall rice exports in MY 2019/20 are forecast remain at the same level as MY 2018/19 at 3.0 MMT. There will be some lost market potential in the EU, offset by some increased market potential in China.
