

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **Indian rice exporters seek parity in import duty. Exporters of non-basmati rice, who are facing higher** procurement costs due to an increase in minimum support prices over the last couple of years, are seeking import duty parity for shipments to prospective countries of the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP). The RCEP is a proposed free trade agreement (FTA) between the 10 member states of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and its six FTA partners. Govt increased paddy's MSP to INR 1,815 per quintal for 2019-20, while the A-grade variety's MSP hiked to INR 1,835 an increase of 3.7% over the previous year. The MSP increased by 13% for the 2018-19 season.
- **India rice exporters want Centre to obtain duty cuts at RCEP. Indian exporters also face non-tariff barriers** from countries such as Indonesia and Malaysia. India's non-basmati rice exporters want the government to bargain hard in the ongoing RCEP negotiations, seeking duty cuts from ASEAN nations, the second largest market for the cereal. Though India is the largest exporter of rice, it does not have any say in the South East Asian region, where four of the top five markets are located. Besides, the Indian exporters also face non-tariff barriers from countries such as Indonesia and Malaysia, from whom we import bulk of the edible oils. Indonesia, for example, specifies a short delivery period of five days for tenders, which works in favour of neighboring producers such as Thailand and Vietnam, but not for Indian exporters.
- **According to the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare's (MOAFW) July 26, 2019 report, the overall** planting for Kharif 2019 season is 7 percent lower (in area) than the five-year average due to delayed rains during the first half of monsoon. Planting for all major crops is lower compared to last year except for cotton. Area under paddy is down by 12.8% from last year area of 30.56 million hectares to 26.52 million hectares this year. Major fall can be seen in Andhra Pradesh, West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, Odisha, Jharkhand, Bihar etc.
- **Indian 5% Broken Parboiled Variety Rice prices in India were 377-381 \$ / tonne compared to 381-384 \$ / tonne** last week. The continuous increase in the MSP of paddy by the government forced the exporter to buy rice at higher prices, as well as FCI procured good amount of paddy this year. Demand for Indian rice declined in African countries as prices in China and Vietnam were cheaper than Indian rice. Export is very important for the rise in prices of rice.
- **Severe Floods in Bangladesh Cause Major Damage to Paddy Crop:** So far, about 4 lakh tons of rice-equivalent paddy crop have been destroyed due to torrential rains and severe floods in the country of Bangladesh, while there is a risk of further damage. The Ministry of Agriculture says that this will be a deep import for the country. The import of rice has been limited so far this year due to better domestic production of paddy in the previous season, but further rice imports may need to be increased. It is known that whenever floods or drought affects the production of paddy in Bangladesh, it mainly imports large quantities of rice from India. It may be noted that during the year 2017, due to severe floods in the Bangla country, the paddy crop was badly affected and the domestic market price of rice jumped to a new record level. Then he had to import record quantities of rice from India, at that time import duty on rice were very less but after that country increases to support domestic market.
- **New 1509 paddy variety arrival starts in many district of Punjab, Haryana and Uttar Pradesh. As per trade sources,** around 25000 bags of 1509 paddy arrived today in Karnal district of Haryana, traded at around Rs.2000-2270/quintal whereas green paddy with high moisture traded at Rs.1700-1900/quintal where as in Gharonda mandi(Haryana) 1509 new paddy traded at highest rate at Rs.2301/quintal today. It is also reported that 700 bags of PR Gobinda new paddy arrived today at Tarn Taran mandi in Punjab which traded at Rs.1360-1435/quintal.

- **The monsoon revives in Telangana sharply from the last 10 days. Farmers increased Kharif crop sowing speed.** 10 days ago the rainfall in Telangana was around 60-70% less than the average which is now comes to 19% only. However, paddy area is still lag behind from last year area of 5.87 lakh hectares which was reduced to 3.16 lakh hectares in MY-2019-20. On the same hand, area under paddy in Major states like Andhra Pradesh lag behind by 34% from 7.25 lakh hectares to 4.81 lakh hectares this year, West Bengal paddy area down by 39% from last year area of 16.91 lakh hectares to 10.33 lakh hectares.
- **Due to delayed arrival of monsoon in Andhra Pradesh and the decrease in the rainfall, kharif crops are being interrupted.** This year, till July 31, total area of Kharif crops reached 13.85 lakh hectares, whereas in 2018 it reached 19.15 lakh hectares and in 2017 it was 17.55 lakh hectares. For the current kharif season, the normal average area is estimated to be 38.30 lakh hectare, whereas the State Government has fixed the target of sowing of kharif crops in 42.05 lakh hectares. According to the latest data of State Agriculture Department, this year, the area of paddy in Andhra Pradesh dropped from 7.25 lakh hectares to 4.80 lakh hectares compared to last year.

International Market Highlight:

- **Thailand Rice Market:** Paddy harvesting starts in many area in Thailand even the rice export prices are high due to drought conditions in Thailand. 5% Broken Rice prices were 406-425 \$ / tonne compared to 395-405 \$ / tonne last week.
- **Vietnam Rice Market:** Prices of rice exported from Vietnam remain unchanged at 340-350 \$ / ton. From 2-10 August, Vietnam exported 1.03 lakh tonnes of rice, of which 42% was sent to West Africa, 29% to Iraq and the remaining quantity was sent to Philippines and Malaysia. In July, Vietnam exported 6.51 lakh tonnes of rice, which is 51 thousand tonnes more than the government estimate.
- **Rice production in India's eastern neighbor, Bangladesh is likely to be better than the previous season.** Data from the Bangladesh-based representative of the US Department of Agriculture (USDA) shows that paddy and rice production will be better in the 2019-20 season than in the 2018-19 season, which will help it reduce rice imports. Paddy area in Bangladesh is expected to decrease from 117.70 lakh hectare in 2018 to 117.30 lakh hectare in 2019 but its average productivity is expected to increase from 4.45 tons per hectare to 4.50 tons per hectare. As a result, the production of paddy there is expected to improve from 523.70 lakh tons to 528.05 lakh tons and milled rice production from 349.10 lakh tons to reach 352 lakh tons. However, after this estimate, torrential rains caused severe flooding in Bangladesh, which poses a serious threat to the paddy crop area at least 50 thousand hectares of land, but still there is a good rice production estimates which could fulfill the domestic demand in this season and thus import of rice would likely to go down.
- **Restrictions will be imposed on rice cultivation in Iranian provinces other than the two Northern provinces** of Gilan and Mazandaran. According to deputy agriculture minister for water and soil affairs, the decision has been made by the Cabinet and conveyed to provinces across the country for implementation.
- **In the international market, India's 5% broken parboiled rice was quoted around \$371 - \$374 per tonne this week-** down from last week's \$373 - \$376. Aggressive selling of old inventories by China was reported to weigh on the global prices.
