

Domestic Market Highlights:

- Top exporter India's 5% broken parboiled variety was quoted at \$374-\$378 a tonne this week, up slightly from \$372-\$375 a week ago. Rice production could fall in key states like West Bengal and Andhra Pradesh due to lower rainfall. India received 14% less rainfall than the 50-year average in the week to Aug. 28, data from the India Meteorological Department (IMD) showed.
- According to the August report released by IGC, the production of rice in the world is estimated
 to be 501 million tons, the world will be trading 460 million tons of rice this year, after consuming
 496 million tons, the outstanding stock of 1780 lakh tons of rice will be left for next year carry
 over stock.
- FCI sold 4,410 metric tons of rice from Jammu and Kashmir at Rs 2,785 per quintal on August 28 under the OMSS scheme. Whereas Under the FCI OMSS scheme, on August 28, 23,700 metric tonnes of rice was sold from Karnataka at a price of Rs 2,785 per quintal.
- As the basmati rice exports have come down, Basmati rice Prices too come down with new paddy coming from Uttar Pradesh in the mandi of Haryana. According to experts, the planting of paddy in Haryana and Uttar Pradesh has increased compared to last year, and the weather is also favourable for the crop. Therefore, if the weather remains favorable in the future, production in these states is expected to be more. On the other hand, the planting of paddy in Punjab has decreased slightly compared to last year but in September in Punjab and Haryana, Pusa 1509 will increase in mandis, therefore, along with rice, the prices of paddy are also expected to moderate.
- Basmati rice export deals are coming down, although exporters will benefit from the strengthening of the dollar against the rupee. In such a situation, there may be an improvement in the prices of basmati rice, but in October onwards new paddy crop will come in, in which case the prices of paddy along with rice will come down. According to traders, due to the shortage of paddy stocks in the producing markets, there is still limited upside. Paddy transplanting in Haryana and Uttar Pradesh has been more in the current Kharif than in the previous year, although it has decreased slightly in Punjab.
- The central government has set a target of procuring 416 lakh tons of rice for the marketing season (October-September) of 2019-20, which is more than 382 lakh tons for the 2018-19 season. It is noteworthy that for the marketing season of 2018-19, the government had exported a target of procuring 370 lakh tons of rice. Government procurement of rice in Chhattisgarh is expected to increase from 41 lakh tons in 2018-19 to 48 lakh tons in the 2019-20 season. Similarly, procurement of rice in Andhra Pradesh is expected to jump from 3 million tons in the last season to 4 million tons in the current year.
- Paddy sown over 380,000 acres of land across Punjab. Paddy has been sown over an area of 380,000 acres across the province out of which 40 percent area is under Basmati, 37 percent under Sela, 7 percent under Coarse and two percent under Hybrid rice.
- Millers Association agrees to cut down price by 1 per kg. The rice millers have agreed to reduce
 price of rice supplied to TTD by one rupee for next three months as their contribution towards
 the Nitya Annaprasadam programme. Speaking to the media after a meeting with Rice Millers
 Association including those of AP and Telangana at the Annamayya Bhavan in Tirumala, the millers
 had agreed to provide rice at Rs 37 per kg instead of existing price Rs 38.



- According to the fourth and final advance production estimate released by the Ministry of Agriculture, India is projected to produce 284.95 million tonnes of foodgrains in 2018-19 as against 285 million tonnes during 2017-18. According to fourth and final advance production estimates, the production of coarse grains is estimated to increase by 8.6% to 42.95 million tonnes from 2017-18. Rice production was estimated to increase by 3.25% to 116.42 million tonnes and wheat production to 102.19 million tonnes from 112.76 million tonnes in 2017-18.
- India's April-June Rice Exports Dive 28.2%. India's rice exports in April-June dived 28.2% from a year ago to 2.35 million tonnes, a government body said on Monday, as demand for non-basmati rice was subdued from African buyers. The country's non-basmati rice exports plunged 43% during the period to 1.2 million tonnes. India's rice exports in 2019/20 are likely to fall to their lowest level in seven years as weak demand from African countries weighs and shippers absorb the absence of government incentives that supported previous sales.
- Top rice exporter India saw prices of its 5% broken parboiled variety ease to about \$374-\$377 per tonne from last week's \$377-\$381. Africa market is again active now. Due to the currency depreciation in the last couple of days, prices have corrected. India's rice exports in April-June dived 28.2% from a year ago to 2.35 million tonnes, a government body said on Monday, due to subdued demand for non-basmati rice from Africa.
- Transplanting of Paddy nursery has been completed in Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh. Crop in these states is pre-tillering to vegetative stage. Transplantation is under progress in Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Jharkhand, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana and Karnataka States. Crop in these states is in root establishing to tillering stage. In areas where crop was sown through DSR (Direct Seed Rice) method, crop is in vegetative stage. Rainfall received during 2nd week of August`19 was beneficial to crop.
- Incidence of disease and pest has not been observed in the paddy field till date. Overall crop condition is normal Paddy is mainly grown in irrigated areas; the crop requires favorable climatic conditions for crop growth after transplantation. Acreage of Paddy in the current week was lower than the corresponding week of 2018 as the weather was not congenial for transplantation in Jharkhand, Karnataka, Assam and West Bengal since June`19. Kharif Rice acreage during current season is lagging behind by 11 per cent at 265.20 lakh hectares as compared to 304.18 lakh hectares same period last year.
- Indian rice exporters seek parity in import duty. Exporters of non-basmati rice, who are facing higher procurement costs due to an increase in minimum support prices over the last couple of years, are seeking import duty parity for shipments to prospective countries of the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP). The RECP is a proposed free trade agreement (FTA) between the 10 member states of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations and its six FTA partners. Govt increased paddy's MSP to INR 1,815 per quintal for 2019-20, while the A-grade variety's MSP hiked to INR 1,835 an increase of 3.7% over the previous year. The MSP increased by 13% for the 2018-19 season.



International Market Highlight:

- Thailand Rice export prices further increased around 3 percent from the previous week due to strong export demand for white rice, particularly to Malaysia. Large exporters are reportedly securing new-crop white rice supplies to fulfill contracted shipments with the Malaysian government. These contracted shipments which will take place in the latter half of August have put upward pressure on the domestic price of white rice. The government is proposing for cabinet approval this week to replace the Paddy Rice Pledging program with the Paddy Rice Price Guarantee program for MY-2019-20 main crop rice. The government previously implemented this program during MY-2009-2010 MY-2010-11. This year the proposed guarantee prices of white paddy rice are approximately 30 percent above current market prices. Meanwhile, the proposed guarantee prices of other rice varieties are mostly lower than current market prices. The eligible tonnage will vary by rice varieties based on the average yield of paddy rice production from a maximum acreage of 40 rai (6.4 hectares) per household. Farmers will directly receive this compensation when market prices are lower than the guarantee prices.
- Philippine's rice stocks inventory for July increased by more than 31 percent from year-ago levels as more imports came in following the passage of the rice tariffication law. The country's rice buffer during the period reached 2.62 million metric tons (MT), exceeding the previous year's level of 1.99 million MT and enough to meet the country's daily requirement for 81 days. Of the total inventory, 41.9 percent came from commercial warehouses while 38.4 percent were in the households. NFA depositories contributed 19.7 percent of the total stocks, a majority of which were imports commissioned by the agency last year. A total of 967,000 MT of rice had passed through the Bureau of Customs since the passage of the rice tariffication law, generating about P5.89 billion in taxes. That number is expected to swell as the country enters the lean months when local rice harvest is almost nil.
- Myanmar rice exported 4 lakh tones of broken rice from 1 October 2018 to 2 August 2019 and earned \$ 100 million. Out of this export, 1.9 lakh tons were sold to Belgium, 25000 tons to Indonesia, 23000 tons to China, 20000 tons of rice to the Netherlands.
- Thailand Rice Market: Paddy harvesting starts in many area in Thailand even the rice export prices are high due to drought conditions in Thailand. 5% Broken Rice prices were 406-425 \$ / tonne compared to 395-405 \$ / tonne last week.


