

## **Domestic Market Highlights:**

- India's rice exports in April-July plunged 26.5% from a year ago to 3.14 million tonnes, as demand for non-basmati rice was subdued from African buyers.
- At the all-India level, the area under paddy has come down from 376.20 lakh hectare last year to 10.50 lakh hectare, this time to 365.70 lakh hectare, which is far behind the normal average area of 396.25 lakh hectare. Paddy area was recorded 371.45 lakh hectare in 2017, 376.90 lakh hectare in 2016, 370.35 lakh hectare in 2015 and 366.50 hectare in 2014 in the same period before that.
- As compared to last year, this time the paddy area has dropped from 12.85 lakh hectare in Andhra Pradesh to 11.40 lakh hectare, from 32.45 lakh hectare in Bihar to 27.72 lakh hectare, slipping from 13.30 lakh hectare in Haryana to 13.05 lakh hectare, 14.60 lakh hectare in Jharkhand Plummeted to 13.40 lakh hectare, from 8.45 lakh hectare in Karnataka to 5.95 lakh hectare, from 30.40 lakh hectare in Punjab to 29.20 lakh hectare, 3 in Tamil Nadu Fell from .55 lakh hectare to 2.05 lakh hectare and in West Bengal from 42.20 lakh hectare to 39.05 lakh hectare.
- On the other hand, its area has increased from 37.30 lakh hectare in Chhattisgarh to 37.80 lakh hectare, improved from 8.00 lakh hectare in Gujarat to 8.25 lakh hectare, it has risen from 21.05 lakh hectare in Madhya Pradesh to 24.20 lakh hectare, and Orissa has increased from 35.10 lakh hectare to 36.50 lakh hectare in Telangana. It improved from 9.65 lakh hectare to 10.70 lakh hectare and from 59.80 lakh hectare in Uttar Pradesh to 60.05 lakh hectare. In other provinces, the paddy area remained almost equal to the previous year.
- Indian basmati rice exporters have been relieved for a few months because of the strict rules that a major importing country- Saudi Arabia had made regarding its quality and the presence of residues of foreign substances and chemicals in it for four months i.e. 31 December have decided to give concession till 2019. It is noteworthy that Saudi Crude and Drug Authority had just started seeking confirmation certificate from the Indian exporter as well as laboratory test report on minimum residue level but now postponed it for four months. There the new strict rule was going to be effective from 1 September 2019 which will now be postponed till 31 December.
- Due to the record production and high MSP compared to open market prices, government rice
  procurement during the ongoing season has continued to grow. Government estimates MY 201819 rice procurement through August 23rd, 2019 at 44.19 MMT compared to 36.4MMT during the
  same period last year. With some additional procurement in eastern and southern states to
  continue through September, total MY 2018-19 rice procurement is already crosses the record of
  44 MMT, a whopping 15 percent increase over last year's record procurement.
- According to the August report released by IGC, the production of rice in the world is estimated
  to be 501 million tons, the world will be trading 460 million tons of rice this year, after consuming
  496 million tons, the outstanding stock of 1780 lakh tons of rice will be left for next year carry
  over stock.
- FCI sold 4,410 metric tons of rice from Jammu and Kashmir at Rs 2,785 per quintal on August 28 under the OMSS scheme. Whereas Under the FCI OMSS scheme, on August 28, 23,700 metric tonnes of rice was sold from Karnataka at a price of Rs 2,785 per quintal.



- As the basmati rice exports have come down, Basmati rice Prices too come down with new paddy coming from Uttar Pradesh in the mandi of Haryana. According to experts, the planting of paddy in Haryana and Uttar Pradesh has increased compared to last year, and the weather is also favourable for the crop. Therefore, if the weather remains favorable in the future, production in these states is expected to be more. On the other hand, the planting of paddy in Punjab has decreased slightly compared to last year but in September in Punjab and Haryana, Pusa 1509 will increase in mandis, therefore, along with rice, the prices of paddy are also expected to moderate.
- Basmati rice export deals are coming down, although exporters will benefit from the strengthening of the dollar against the rupee. In such a situation, there may be an improvement in the prices of basmati rice, but in October onwards new paddy crop will come in, in which case the prices of paddy along with rice will come down. According to traders, due to the shortage of paddy stocks in the producing markets, there is still limited upside. Paddy transplanting in Haryana and Uttar Pradesh has been more in the current Kharif than in the previous year, although it has decreased slightly in Punjab.
- The central government has set a target of procuring 416 lakh tons of rice for the marketing season (October-September) of 2019-20, which is more than 382 lakh tons for the 2018-19 season. It is noteworthy that for the marketing season of 2018-19, the government had exported a target of procuring 370 lakh tons of rice. Government procurement of rice in Chhattisgarh is expected to increase from 41 lakh tons in 2018-19 to 48 lakh tons in the 2019-20 season. Similarly, procurement of rice in Andhra Pradesh is expected to jump from 3 million tons in the last season to 4 million tons in the current year.
- Paddy sown over 380,000 acres of land across Punjab. Paddy has been sown over an area of 380,000 acres across the province out of which 40 percent area is under Basmati, 37 percent under Sela, 7 percent under Coarse and two percent under Hybrid rice.
- Millers Association agrees to cut down price by 1 per kg. The rice millers have agreed to reduce price of rice supplied to TTD by one rupee for next three months as their contribution towards the Nitya Annaprasadam programme. Speaking to the media after a meeting with Rice Millers Association including those of AP and Telangana at the Annamayya Bhavan in Tirumala, the millers had agreed to provide rice at Rs 37 per kg instead of existing price Rs 38.

## **International Market Highlight:**

- An official report showed that 132,947 tons of milled rice have been exported from Cambodia to China in the starting 8 months of 2019, having a 54 percent rise from the same time frame of the previous year. Rice Export from Cambodia showed that China remains the top buyer of Cambodian rice during the period. The exports to China made up 39 percent of the total rice exports in Cambodia. 120,061 tons of rice was shipped from Cambodia to the European market, having a 47 percent decrease. The European Union (EU)'s market share for Cambodian rice had gone down from 52 percent to 35 percent. According to the report, Cambodia exported a total of 342,045 tons of rice to 51 countries and regions during the first eight months of this year, up only 0.1 percent over the same period last year.
- Farmers in South-East Asia- farmers are worried about the regular fall in the price of plant rice in the Philippines and are being forced to cut the paddy production area. The area under paddy declined by 1.87 percent while the average yield rate of the crop also decreased by 4 percent. An official statement of Manila said that in 16 of the 16 producing regions of the Philippines, production of plant paddy declined in 13 areas. Production of paddy in Mimaropa Division, Bicol



- and Western Visayas decreased by about 51 thousand tonnes. Mimaropa Division consists of four provinces Mindoro, Marinduk, Romblon and Palawan. Paddy-rice production has increased in only three divisions of Jambonga Peninsula and Northern Mindanao.
- Thailand Rice export prices further increased around 3 percent from the previous week due to strong export demand for white rice, particularly to Malaysia. Large exporters are reportedly securing new-crop white rice supplies to fulfill contracted shipments with the Malaysian government. These contracted shipments which will take place in the latter half of August have put upward pressure on the domestic price of white rice. The government is proposing for cabinet approval this week to replace the Paddy Rice Pledging program with the Paddy Rice Price Guarantee program for MY-2019-20 main crop rice. The government previously implemented this program during MY-2009-2010 MY-2010-11. This year the proposed guarantee prices of white paddy rice are approximately 30 percent above current market prices. Meanwhile, the proposed guarantee prices of other rice varieties are mostly lower than current market prices. The eligible tonnage will vary by rice varieties based on the average yield of paddy rice production from a maximum acreage of 40 rai (6.4 hectares) per household. Farmers will directly receive this compensation when market prices are lower than the guarantee prices.
- Philippine's rice stocks inventory for July increased by more than 31 percent from year-ago levels as more imports came in following the passage of the rice tariffication law. The country's rice buffer during the period reached 2.62 million metric tons (MT), exceeding the previous year's level of 1.99 million MT and enough to meet the country's daily requirement for 81 days. Of the total inventory, 41.9 percent came from commercial warehouses while 38.4 percent were in the households. NFA depositories contributed 19.7 percent of the total stocks, a majority of which were imports commissioned by the agency last year. A total of 967,000 MT of rice had passed through the Bureau of Customs since the passage of the rice tariffication law, generating about P5.89 billion in taxes. That number is expected to swell as the country enters the lean months when local rice harvest is almost nil.
