

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **Telangana procures 23 lakh tons of paddy.** The Telangana Government has procured 23 lakh tons of paddy so far from the kharif season, with Nizamabad district topping the list with about 4 lakh tons. The State government spent Rs. 4,200 crore on procuring the commodity from about 4.16 lakh farmers. We have opened 3,500 procurement centres this year. Of the 23 lakh tons of paddy procured, we have sent 22 lakh tons to the mills for processing.
- **About 314 paddy purchase centres opened to ensure MSP to farmers:** East Godavari Collector East Godavari Collector said that as many as 314 paddy purchase centres were opened all over the district and so far 2.25 lakh metric tons of paddy was purchased from the farmers at minimum support price. The millers to cooperate with the government in purchasing of paddy from the farmers at minimum support price. Stating that during Kharif season paddy was raised in 2.5 lakh hectares and the crop yield was 14 lakh tons, Collector sought the miller's cooperation in paddy procurement at minimum support price and save the farmers from distress sales.
- **Over 74.83 lakh metric tonnes of paddy arrive in Haryana mandis.** More than 74.83 lakh metric tonnes of paddy has so far arrived in grain markets of Haryana as compared to over 73.94 LMT ng the corresponding period of last year. Govt agencies procured over 64.33 LMT of paddy and 1.04 MMT procured by millers and dealers. More than 35.06 LMT procured by Food, civil supplies and consumer affairs Dept., 19.84 LMT of paddy has been procured by HAFED, 9.37 LMT by Haryana warehousing corporation and 4725 MT by FCI.
- **Paddy procurement to start from Jan 1, said Karnataka Deputy CM.** Karnataka Deputy Chief Minister announced that the state government will start procurement of Tur and Paddy from the January 1 and compensation of flood reliefs of second stage would start very shortly. Farmer deaths are an old problem and the BJP government in the state had taken many steps to alleviate the difficulties of the cultivators.
- **Odisha records 18% more paddy procurement in 2019.** Despite State-wide conundrum over the protest on the token system of paddy procurement recently, Odisha government informed that the State has recorded 18 per cent hike in paddy procurement this year as compared to last year. State Food and Supplies Minister informed that the state government has collected around 3, 39, 65,465 quintals of paddy from farmers by December 7. He clarified that last year the government was able to collect only 30, 89,908 quintals of paddy during the same period. As many as 1, 42,932 farmers have received token for paddy procurement in as many as 1,971 mandis across 19 districts.
- **U.P. paddy procurement up 40% to 2.75 mln tonnes so far this Kharif season.** Paddy procurement is gaining momentum in Uttar Pradesh with the state agencies purchasing nearly 2.8 million tonnes (MT) in the current kharif marketing season. Since, paddy procurement had stood under 2 MT during the corresponding period last year, UP has clocked 40 per cent upswing in the season so far. Govt is targeting procurement of 5 MT of paddy this year. The procurement season started on October 1 and will continue till February 2020-end, covering all districts in phases. In 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19, UP had posted paddy procurement figures of 3.5, 4.3 MT and 4.9 MT respectively against the season's target of 5 MT. Earlier, the state cabinet in September 2019 had announced the paddy procurement policy for 2019-20 season, which increased the minimum support price (MSP) to Rs 1,835 per quintal

for grade A paddy, apart from providing Rs 20 per quintal extra to farmers as transport and other support, which effectively increases the net payable to Rs 1,855 per quintal in UP.

- **Higher MSP fosters surge in paddy arrivals in Chhattisgarh's centres. There has been a spurt in paddy arrivals at Chhattisgarh's** procurement centres, which have been set up for purchasing the crop at the minimum support price (MSP) announced by the state. Procurement had started on December 1. Chhattisgarh Marketing Federation, the nodal agency for purchasing paddy from farmers, had set up over 2,000 procurement centres under the primary cooperative societies. Over 700,000 tonnes of the crop had arrived in the centres. The state government has till date disbursed Rs 7,000 crore to farmers, who will be paid Rs 1,815 a quintal for common grade and Rs 1,835 for A-grade produce. Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel had declared that farmers would get Rs 2,500 a quintal and the difference between the Centre's price and the MSP would be paid under another head. The state government had set up an inter-ministerial committee to examine under which scheme farmers would be paid the difference. Baghel had urged the Centre to increase the quota of rice purchase from the state to 3.2 million tonnes (MT). Last year, Centre had procured 2.4 MT from Chhattisgarh. The state had set a target to procure 8.5 MT in the current season. In the kharif marketing season 2018-19, it had purchased 8.04 million tonnes of paddy and disbursed Rs 16,933.06 crore to farmers.
- **About 15.05 lakh ton wheat and rice sold in open market till Nov 20 by Govt. The government is sitting on a huge** stock of over 600 lakh tonnes of food grain, has sold 15.05 lakh tonnes of wheat and rice in the open market so far this fiscal. About 8.99 lakh tonnes of wheat and 6.06 lakh tonnes of rice has been sold through the open market sale scheme (OMSS) till November 20 of this year. The government, through the Food Corporation of India (FCI), sells wheat and rice to bulk consumer/traders/state governments from the central pool at pre-determined prices in the open market from time to time through e-tender to enhance the supply in lean season and check prices. It aims to sell 100 lakh tonnes of wheat and 50 lakh tonnes of rice under OMSS during the ongoing 2019-20 fiscal. In 2018-19 financial year, the government had sold 90.30 lakh tonnes of foodgrain, comprising 81.84 lakh tonnes of wheat and 8.46 lakh tonnes of rice.
- **India Govt plans cut in reserve price of rice by almost Rs 500 per quintal. The government is considering** downward revision of reserve price of rice from Rs 2,785 per quintal to Rs 2,250 per quintal in order to boost sale from central pool stock under the Open Market Sale Scheme. Sitting on a huge buffer stock, the government is considering cutting reserve price of rice by almost Rs 500 per quintal for bulk buyers to boost its sale through open market. The government is considering downward revision of reserve price of rice from Rs 2,785 per quintal to Rs 2,250 per quintal in order to boost sale from central pool stock under the Open Market Sale Scheme in 2019-20.

International Market Highlight:

- **The US Department of Agriculture (USDA) in its November report had estimated the global availability of rice to be 67.10 million tons in the 2019-20** marketing season, which has been increased from 6 lakh tons to 67.16 million tons in the December report. The main reason for this is the increase in China's production. USDA has increased rice production estimates by 7 lakh tons to 14.77 million tons, based on the latest data from the National Bureau of Statistics of China.
- **On the other hand, USDA has fixed the global consumption estimate of rice during 2019-20 season by 2 lakh tons to 49.38 lakh tons.** Similarly, the global rice business (import-export) has also been reduced to 49.5 million tons. According to USDA, rice exports from India and Thailand

are expected to fall sharply, while exports from Vietnam and Burma (Myanmar) are expected to increase slightly. But this will not make up for the shortfall.

- **The outstanding surplus stock of rice is expected to rise to a new record level of 17.78 million tons at the end of 2019-20 season**, which is 8 lakh tons more than the November estimate. About 66 percent of this entire outstanding stock will be present in China.
- **For rice marketing year (MY) 2019/20 (May-April), Bangladesh's rice production area and output have been** marginally increased to 11.8 million hectares (HA) and 35.8 million metric tons (MMT), respectively. The increase is due to a reportedly strong year for Aus rice (April-August) production and a forecasted good season for Aman rice (July-December). Harvested Aus rice area is revised up to 1.1 million HA and production up to 2.45 MMT, based on official data from the Government of Bangladesh (GOB). Harvest of Aman rice is just started in November. The planted Aman rice area is revised at 5.8 million HA and production forecast is raised to 14 MMT as official sources and other contacts believe that continued favorable weather will result in an above average Aman rice harvest.
