

### Domestic Market Highlights:

- **Andhra Pradesh government released its Rabi second advance production estimate in which paddy production** is estimates to 130.62 lakh tons which is higher by 5.6 lakh tons from last year production of 123.70 lakh tons that in the current Rabi season, also there will be a huge increase in the production of all crops except sugarcane in Andhra Pradesh. In terms of percentage, the maximum increase has been in the production of gram, the gram crop can more than double from last year to reach 5.12 lakh tons. Good growth in production of paddy, maize, groundnut, cotton and red chili.
- **DGFT made minor changes to the Basmati, Non-Basmati rice export rules by issuing notification 41 / 2015-20** dated 09 January 2020. Basmati and non-basmati rice in Europe Member State and Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, for export to LIECHTENSTEIN, an inspection certificate will have to be obtained from the Export Inspection Council or Export Agency. In the remaining European countries, an inspection certificate by both agencies will be mandatory on every shipment from 1 July 2020 i.e. by 1 July 2020 all European countries, Europe Member State and Iceland, Certificate of export will have to be given at LIECHTENSTEIN in Norway, Switzerland. Basmati rice prices declined due to Iran, US dispute which also had a direct impact on Basmati paddy. The farmers were also harmed by the ongoing stir between the two countries.
- **Paddy procurement: APSCSC likely to go for Rs. 3000-cr. loan.** Andhra Pradesh State Civil Supplies Corporation will have to avail a loan of Rs. 3,000 crore from the banks to facilitate uninterrupted procurement of paddy from farmers. The loan is to meet the working capital requirements for procurement. The corporation is negotiating with the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) and is likely to be finalised in a couple of days.
- **India basmati exports to biggest buyer Iran come to a halt.** Rice millers in India face a squeeze on margins as basmati trade to Iran has come to halt, as insurers aren't ready to provide cover to shipments following the latest escalation in Iran-United States conflict. Iran is the largest buyer of the premium rice from India, and the situation has arisen at the onset of the procurement period by the West Asian country. In this volatile situation, payments for any shipments are also sure to be delayed for several months. Payments were late by five months last year and exporters are not ready to take more risk. The rising hostilities in the US-Iran relations have dampened the scope of a revival in basmati trade. Global shipments from India were down by 10 per cent in April-October 2019, but had increased marginally in November 2019. That was due to higher shipments to Saudi Arabia, Iran, Jordan, Kuwait and the US. Indian rice exporters were expecting momentum in trade after government of Iran had opened a fresh tender in December for 200,000 tonnes of basmati from India. Basmati trade is hit hard as Iran buys more than one-third of the total export of the commodity from India.
- **Mandis refuse to buy paddy as millers fail to lift stock in Odisha.** Paddy procurement has come to a halt in many parts of coastal districts as storage capacity of mandis (paddy procurement centres) are full to the edge since the millers have not lifted the stock. Reports coming in from districts such as Cuttack, Puri, Nayagarh, Jagatsingpur, and Kendrapara reveal that custom millers allowed to participate in procurement are not lifting paddy stock from identified mandis for the last two days under the pretext that they did not have storage capacity. However, the fact remains that the millers do not want to lift the paddy due to heavy moisture content. With no storage facilities in many of the

Primary Agriculture cooperative Societies (PACS), the principal agent of Odisha State Civil Supply Corporation for procurement, purchased paddy stocked in open are exposed to unseasonal rains.

- **Indian rice export prices edged higher this week, buoyed by a stronger rupee and higher local paddy prices**, while trade remained thin in rival hubs because of the holiday season. Top exporter India's 5% broken parboiled variety was quoted around \$362-\$366 a ton, up from last week's \$360-\$365. The slight upturn was because of a strong rupee, which trims exporters' margins from overseas sales, though demand remains weak.
- **Telangana procures 23 lakh tons of paddy. The Telangana Government has procured 23 lakh tons of paddy so far** from the kharif season, with Nizamabad district topping the list with about 4 lakh tons. The State government spent Rs. 4,200 crore on procuring the commodity from about 4.16 lakh farmers. Government has opened 3,500 procurement centers this year. Of the 23 lakh tons of paddy procured, around 22 lakh tons to the mills for processing.
- **FCI sold 6,86,600 tons of rice in the first sale tender on 1 January, of which 150 tons was sold by bulk consumers**, 6,86,450 tons to various states. FCI had targeted 9,40,700 tons of rice in the first tender of January.
- **Tamil Nadu, an important agricultural producing state in South India, is projected to have a spectacular production** of food grains during the current Samba season. According to the State Agriculture Department, this time there has been a good increase in the sowing area of various crops as compared to last year and the rains have also become normal in the northeast monsoon season. In Tamil Nadu, the production of food grains rose sharply to a record level of 127.95 lakh tonnes in the 2014-15 season. According to the Department of Agriculture, it is to be seen whether the production for the 2019-20 season reaches above that record level. During the 2014-15 season, the state produced 79.50 lakh tonnes of paddy.
- **So far 335.28 lakh tons of paddy has been procured by the Central Government's subordinate agency Food Corporation of India (FCI)** and its associated provincial agencies in the procurement marketing season of 2019-20 Paddy at the minimum support price from farmers in major producing states is being procured. This time the support price of paddy has been increased by Rs 65 per quintal. As a result, the support price of paddy for the 2019-20 season increased from Rs 1750 per quintal in the general category to Rs 1815 per quintal and the support price of 'A' grade increased by Rs 1770 to Rs 1835 per quintal as compared to the 2018-19 season. As per the available data, so far Food Corporation's participation in the total government procurement of 335.28 lakh tons of paddy was 3.29 lakh tons and the share of provincial agencies was 331.99 lakh tons.
- **During the period under review, procurement of paddy is 162.28 lakh tons in Punjab, 64.23 lakh tons in Haryana, 36.45 lakh tons in Uttar Pradesh, 9.14 lakh tons in Uttrakhand, 12.61 lakh tons in Orissa, 3.43 lakh tons in Madhya Pradesh, 1.94 lakh tons in Maharashtra, 1.63 in Kerala.** Government procurement has been done for lakh tons, 33.39 lakh tons in Telangana and 9.17 lakh tons in Andhra Pradesh.

- **All-India progressive procurement of Rice as on 20.12.2019 for Kharif Marketing Season (KMS) 2019-20 is 214.68 lakh tonnes** against the procurement of 205.28 lakh tonnes in the corresponding period of last year.

### International Market Highlight:

- **According to the USDA, Pakistan exported 4.5 million tonnes of rice during the 18–19 season, which is the largest record ever.** Estimated to produce 7.5 lakh tonnes of rice in Pakistan this year according to USDA. China was an importer of rice before 2019 but became a major exporter of rice in 2019, China competed with India in 2019 and increased rice exports to African countries.
- **Thailand rice export prices further increased 2-3 percent from the previous week, particularly for white and parboiled rice,** due to tighter supplies of new-crop white paddy rice. MY2019-20 main rice crop harvest is reportedly finished. Additionally, rice traders and millers expect MY2019-20 off-season rice production will be far below normal as the government will restrict irrigation for agriculture due to critically low water supplies in major reservoirs. Unofficial and preliminary rice exports (excluding fragrant rice) for December 9-15, 2019, totaled 101,186 metric tons, up 28,783 metric tons from the previous week and up 19,373 metric tons from the four weeks moving average of 81,813 metric tons. Rice exports from January 1 – December 15, 2019, totaled 5,658,722 metric tons, down 37 percent from the same period last year.
- **Thailand's rice export prices rose this week on concerns that a drought hitting the country may harm future** supplies of the crop, while the festive season led to thin trade in India and Vietnam. Thailand's benchmark 5 percent broken rice prices were quoted at \$424-\$435 on Thursday, an increase from \$395-\$420 the week before. There are concerns that the ongoing drought could hurt future supply so there is speculative buying and stockpiling by some mills and exporters, which has driven up the prices. The government introduced emergency measures last week in 11 provinces around the country, many of them rice-growing areas.
- **Thailand, the world's second-largest rice exporter, will not have enough water to grow the crop in some 960,000 hectares** of rice fields around the Chao Phraya River basin. The dry season is expected to last through to April 30 next year.
- Rice export rates notched up in Vietnam as well, with 5 percent broken quoted at \$355-\$360 a ton, slightly higher from last week's \$350-\$352. The market is just quiet during this Christmas and New Year holiday. Despite domestic inventory being nearly empty, prices would likely not go up in the short term due to weak demand.
- **The US Department of Agriculture (USDA) in its November report had estimated the global availability of rice to be 67.10 million tons in the 2019-20 marketing season,** which has been increased from 6 lakh tons to 67.16 million tons in the December report. The main reason for this is the increase in China's production. USDA has increased rice production estimates by 7 lakh tons to 14.77 million tons, based on the latest data from the National Bureau of Statistics of China.
- **On the other hand, USDA has fixed the global consumption estimate of rice during 2019-20 season by 2 lakh tons to 49.38 lakh tons.** Similarly, the global rice business (import-export) has also been reduced to 49.5 million tons. According to USDA, rice exports from India and Thailand are expected to fall sharply, while exports from Vietnam and Burma (Myanmar) are expected to increase slightly. But this will not make up for the shortfall.
