

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **Telangana's Food-grain Output zooms on Back of Bumper Paddy:** Due to the tremendous production of paddy in Telangana, there has been a tremendous increase in the production of food grains in 2019-20, according to the first estimate, the production of food-grains in Telangana is estimated at 130 lakh tons, out of which rice production is estimated at 99 lakh tons. Grain production in Telangana increased by 40% as compared to last year, 93 lakh tons was produced last year.
- **The latest figures from the Directorate General of Commercial Vigilance and Statistics (DGCIS) show that during** January 2020, more than 9.09 lakh tonnes of rice were exported from the country, including 4,56,586 tonnes of basmati rice and 4,52,544 tonnes of normal or non-basmati rice Shipment included.
- **India spot basmati down on weak demand. Prices of Pusa 1121 basmati paddy fell due to a decline in demand from** local millers and exporters. Demand for the commodity– one of India's premium offering to the global market–has been subdued over the past few months due to lower shipments to Iran, they said. Iran accounted for almost onethird of India's basmati exports in 2018-19 (Apr-Mar). Exports to the West Asian country is seen lower on year due geopolitical tensions in the region. Weak exports to Iran is also seen weighing on overall basmati exports this financial year.
- **The central government has estimated domestic production of food grains to reach a new record level of 291.95** million tonnes during the entire marketing season of 2019-20, which is much higher than the total production of 285.21 million tonnes for the 2018-19 season. According to the second advance estimate released by the Union Ministry of Agriculture, the country is expected to produce 117.47 million tonnes of rice during the 2019-20 season which is higher by the government target of 116. Million tonnes.
- **In India, transplanting of Rabi rice is continuing in the eastern parts of the country under favourable conditions** with an increase in total sown area observed. In Viet Nam, dry-season rice (winter-spring rice) is developing in the south under watch conditions because of an expected shortage of freshwater for irrigation due to saline intrusion. Sowing has not yet begun in the north. In Thailand, dry-season rice conditions are under watch due to the reduction of available water for irrigation, which is also expected to decrease the total sown area compared to last year.
- **Rice exporters are hopeful that the Pesticide Management Bill, 2020 will exhort pesticide manufacturers** to register their products in foreign markets such as the US and European Union and help boost shipments from India, the largest producer of premium rice.
- **As per trade sources, the prices of Thai varieties remain higher than competitors because of the drought** that has hit many rice-growing regions and curbed production. There is a bullish feeling in the market that prices will stay high and may even go up further. The exporters association set an export target of 7.5 million tonnes for 2020, the lowest in seven years, and noted that Thailand could lose its place as the world's second-biggest rice exporter.
- **Meanwhile, prices for India's 5% broken parboiled variety rose to their highest since late September** at \$371-\$376 a tonne, up from \$370-\$375 quoted last week. Demand has been trickling in from African countries.
- **The central pool had a stock of 578.17 lakh tonnes of rice as on 1 February 2020, of which the quantity of** rice is 274.51 and that of. On January 1, 2020. Rice stock in the central pool increased as

rice procurement became operational. Government procurement of rice reached 521.38 lakh tonnes by 10 February 2020.

- **This year, rice exports from India may decline by 18–20% over** the previous year due to declining demand for Indian rice from West Asian countries. Rice exports to Iran decreased 22% in the current year, 33% to the UAE, 23% to Nepal, 90% to Senegal, 93% to Bangladesh, 2% to Yemen.
- **West Bengal Govt procured only 22% of paddy crop target for this season.** West Bengal government's Agriculture Department has managed to procure only 22% of the rice they had promised to procure from the cultivators across the state till now. The farmers in the state are refusing to sell their produce to the government because of various flaws in the process of procurement. Earlier in November 2018, the West Bengal government had announced that during the current season, it would buy 52 lakh metric tons of paddy from the farmers in the state. Out of these 52 lakh metric tons, 24 lakh metric tons were to be procured by the government directly from the farmers, through Central Purchase Centres (CPCs), while the remaining 28 lakh metric tons are to be procured from cooperatives like National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation (NAFED), West Bengal State Cooperative Marketing Federation Ltd. (BENFED), and West Bengal State Consumer Cooperative Federation (CONFED).
- **Prices of India's 5-percent broken parboiled rose to their highest since the first week of October,** around \$369-\$373 per tonne, from \$366-\$371 last week, also helped by a depreciation of the rupee. Buyers from Africa have been making purchases fearing prices could rise further due to the drought in Thailand.

International Market Highlight:

- **Myanmar has set a target of exporting 2.5 million tonnes of rice in present fiscal year 2019-2020 which started in October.** The country exported 986,345 tonnes of rice and broken rice, earning over 282.9 million USD as of January 10, according to the Myanmar Rice Federation (MRF). From October 1, 2018 to January 10, 2020, Myanmar pocketed 245 million USD from the export of over 842,342 tonnes of rice via sea routes while 144,002 tonnes of rice valued at 37.8 million USD were exported through border gates. During the period, 29 percent of Myanmar's rice and broken rice were shipped to China, EU member states and African countries. From 2018 to 2019, the country exported more than 2.35 million tonnes of rice and broken rice worth 709.6 million USD.

- **Thai rice prices climb to over 20-month high.** Thai rice export prices scaled a more than 20-month peak this week as a persistent drought heightened supply concerns, while improved demand from African countries drove an uptick in rates for the Indian variety. Thailand's benchmark 5% broken rice prices rose to their highest since late April 2018 at \$435-\$445 compared with \$425-\$435 last week. Risks to supply from the ongoing drought, coupled with a strong baht have supported Thai

prices. Exports from Thailand, the world's second largest rice exporter after India, are forecast to drop to their lowest in seven years, at 7.5 million tonnes, in 2020.
