

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **The outbreak of Corona virus epidemic has not only weakened the demand for basmati rice in the importing countries** but is also making it difficult to get sufficient number of containers for its export shipments from India. Countries like Qatar have almost ceased trading from India.
- **According to the former chairman of Aria, in the first 10 months of 2019-20 as compared to FY 2018-19 i.e.** April 2019 to January 2020, Indian basmati rice exports are just 1 percent in terms of quantity and in dollar terms. There was a 10 percent drop. But its exports were affected in February and there are also signs of lower shipments in March. This suggests that basmati rice export volume may decline by up to 5 percent overall.
- **Paddy crop affected by pests in Telangana:** Paddy sowing has more than doubled to 27 lakh acres in Telangana as compared to last year, but the crop got damaged due to rice blast disease, which may potentially the dedine in productivity per hectare. Due to the huge difference in day and night temperature and excess moisture, there was a disease called rice blast. If strong winds prevail, this disease can spread to other states as well with the favourable weather.
- **Rice stocks with the government rose sharply due to weak off-take from the central pool by private players,** robust procurement in the on-going Kharif marketing season (Oct-Sept) and higher ending stocks from the previous year. As on 01st February 2020, the government had 30.4 million tonnes of wheat in its stocks, 27 per cent higher on year. Rice inventory with the government was at 27.4 million tonnes up 20 per cent on year.
- **Prices of basmati rice, cotton and soyabean have dropped by up to 10 per cent in the last one month as the** coronavirus outbreak curtailed overseas shipments leading to a build-up of stock. Since early February, cotton and yarn prices in the wholesale market have fallen by 7 per cent, while basmati is cheaper by 10 per cent and soybean by 5 per cent.
- **According to the IGC latest report, during the current marketing season of 2019-20, the global production** of rice is estimated to be 49.90 million tonnes which is less than 1 million tonnes from the peak production of 50.00 million in 2018-19. Earlier, global production of rice was 49.40 million tonnes in the 2017-18 season and 492 million tonnes in the 2016-17 season.
- **India's 5% broken parboiled variety was quoted at \$369-\$373 per tonne this week, down from \$371-\$376 last** week and the week before. Demand from African and Asian buyers has been faltering as they expect rice prices to correct like other commodities. Meanwhile, prices for Thailand's benchmark 5% broken rice widened to \$430-\$452 on Thursday from the \$430-\$445 quoted last week. There are no major deals, just small ones from old customers.
- **Telangana's Food-grain Output zooms on Back of Bumper Paddy:** Due to the tremendous production of paddy in Telangana, there has been a tremendous increase in the production of food grains in 2019-20, according to the first estimate, the production of food-grains in Telangana is estimated at 130 lakh tons, out of which rice production is estimated at 99 lakh tons. Grain production in Telangana increased by 40% as compared to last year, 93 lakh tons was produced last year.

- **The latest figures from the Directorate General of Commercial Vigilance and Statistics (DGCIS) show that during January 2020**, more than 9.09 lakh tonnes of rice were exported from the country, including 4,56,586 tonnes of basmati rice and 4,52,544 tonnes of normal or non-basmati rice Shipment included.
- **The central government has estimated domestic production of food grains to reach a new record level of 291.95 million tonnes** during the entire marketing season of 2019-20, which is much higher than the total production of 285.21 million tonnes for the 2018-19 season. According to the second advance estimate released by the Union Ministry of Agriculture, the country is expected to produce 117.47 million tonnes of rice during the 2019-20 season which is higher by the government target of 116. Million tonnes.
- **In India, transplanting of Rabi rice is continuing in the eastern parts of the country under favourable conditions** with an increase in total sown area observed. In Viet Nam, dry-season rice (winter-spring rice) is developing in the south under watch conditions because of an expected shortage of freshwater for irrigation due to saline intrusion. Sowing has not yet begun in the north. In Thailand, dry-season rice conditions are under watch due to the reduction of available water for irrigation, which is also expected to decrease the total sown area compared to last year.
- **This year, rice exports from India may decline by 18–20% over** the previous year due to declining demand for Indian rice from West Asian countries. Rice exports to Iran decreased 22% in the current year, 33% to the UAE, 23% to Nepal, 90% to Senegal, 93% to Bangladesh, 2% to Yemen.

International Market Highlight:

- **Myanmar has set a target of exporting 2.5 million tonnes of rice in present fiscal year 2019-2020 which started in October.** The country exported 986,345 tonnes of rice and broken rice, earning over 282.9 million USD as of January 10, according to the Myanmar Rice Federation (MRF). From October 1, 2018 to January 10, 2020, Myanmar pocketed 245 million USD from the export of over 842,342 tonnes of rice via sea routes while 144,002 tonnes of rice valued at 37.8 million USD were exported through border gates. During the period, 29 percent of Myanmar's rice and broken rice were shipped to China, EU member states and African countries. - **Thai rice prices climb to over 20-month high.** Thai rice export prices scaled a more than 20-month peak this week as a persistent drought heightened supply concerns, while improved demand from African countries drove an uptick in rates for the Indian variety. Thailand's

benchmark 5% broken rice prices rose to their highest since late April 2018 at \$435-\$445 compared with \$425-\$435 last week. Risks to supply from the ongoing drought, coupled with a strong baht have supported Thai prices. Exports from Thailand, the world's second largest rice exporter after India, are forecast to drop to their lowest in seven years, at 7.5 million tonnes, in 2020.
