

Domestic Market Highlights:

- **Due to the arrival of monsoon at the right time and a strong system of irrigation resources, the farmers of Telangana are showing tremendous enthusiasm this time in the cultivation of kharif crops.** It is to be known that the Kharif season in Telangana is called Vanakalam season. The normal average area for kharif crops in Telangana has been set at 1.03 million acres, of which 34.53 lakh acres or about 33 per cent has been sown. Only 2.60 lakh acres were sown in the same period last year. The normal average area of paddy is 62 thousand acres, of which 27.25 lakh acres have been planted.
- **Farmers in Bangladesh are showing tremendous enthusiasm in paddy cultivation due to good monsoon rains.** There the cultivation of “Aus” paddy in Rangpur division is very popular among the farmers. Its area has reached a new record level of 64 thousand hectares. This area is the largest in the last 20 years.
- **Indian farmers are showing great enthusiasm in the sowing of kharif crops due to the extremely favourable weather and monsoon conditions.** As a result, the total sowing area has jumped from 154.53 lakh hectare last year to 315.63 lakh hectare, while vigorous sowing is still going on in different parts of the country. As far as paddy is concerned, its area has also increased by about 10 lakh hectare compared to last year to 37.71 lakh hectare. The entire country has reached the monsoon and with good rains everywhere, it is easy for the farmers to increase the speed of sowing of kharif crops.
- **The Agriculture Department of Karnataka has released the fourth advance estimate of crops produced** during the 2019-20 season. Under this, the production of all commodities except sugarcane is projected to increase compared to the 2018-19 season. According to the Agriculture Department, the production of rice is expected to improve from 34.48 lakh tonnes to 37.43 lakh tonnes during the 2019-20 seasons as compared to 2018-19.
- **During the current kharif season, farmers in Punjab, the state that contributed the most to food-grains** in the central pool, were worried about labour shortage as most migrant workers have returned to their homes. But still there is reported to be proper planting of paddy in the state. For the current season in Punjab, a target of paddy cultivation in a total of 67 lakh acres of land has been set, out of which 60% of it has been completed. Paddy sowing started in the state this time from June 10 and despite lack of labour, transplanting is going on uninterruptedly. At this time of pandemic, farmers have become dependent on their family members and village colleagues for cultivating kharif crops including paddy.
- **Apart from this, emphasis is being laid on paddy cultivation through this Direct Seeded Rice (DSR) method** which is a direct sowing method. Paddy farming is expected to be done in about 12 lakh acres by this method and due to which yield would likely to down by 15-20% in MY 2020-21.
- **Third advance estimate of 2019-20 crops season has been released in West Bengal on Friday.** Under this, the production of rice has been estimated to increase from 159.48 lakh tonnes in the 2018-19 seasons to 160.70 lakh tonnes and wheat to 7.30 lakh tonnes to 9.30 lakh tonnes in MY 2019-20.
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- **Recently, in Chandauli district of Uttar Pradesh, an exporter purchased about 90 tonnes of black rice** paddy at the rate of Rs 85 per kg. APEDA has urged farmers to increase production of this paddy so that they can get high and attractive income. A group of about 300 farmers produced 900 quintals (90 tonnes) of black paddy. The price of paddy is Rs 85 per kg and rice is Rs 160 per kg. It will be exported to Australia and New Zealand. This could be a better replacement of common paddy and basmati paddy due to higher returns.
- **As per Trade sources, Indian rice export in the month of May has been recovering after lockdown.** As most of the countries demand shift towards India, India exported around 14 lakh tons of rice in May-2020 out of which non-basmati and basmati rice exports were 8.76 lakh tons and 5.2 lakh tons respectively. Top importers in May for non-basmati rice were Benin, Nepal, Togo, Guinea and Cote'D Ivore whereas top aromatic rice importers were Saudi followed by Iraq, Iran, Yemen and UAE. Total rice export during MY-2019-20 starting from Oct to May was around 7.47 million tons out of which non-basmati and basmati rice exports were 3.86 million tons and 3.6 million tons respectively.
- **The Madhya Pradesh government claims that Basmati rice is traditionally produced in many districts** of the state, so the region should be given Geographical Indicator (GI) status (tag). The Madhya Pradesh government has been struggling for this GI tag for years, but it has not been successful so far. Government had filed a petition in this regard in the Madras High Court, but there it was a disappointment. Now the Madhya Pradesh government has decided to move the Supreme Court (Supreme Court) to challenge the decision of the Madras High Court. It is to be noted that in the year 2016, the Government of Madhya Pradesh and Basmati Producers Association had filed a separate petition for the GI tag in the Madras High Court, which was heard and in the beginning of the year 2020, the court rejected both the petitions. .
- **As per the latest assessment by FAO (Food & Agriculture Organization) the Coronavirus Pandemic** is would lead to the fall in Rice stock of Bangladesh. The percentage decline in the stocks of rice in Bangladesh would be 8.33% by 2021.
