

Domestic & International Market Highlights:

- **All India Kharif sowing as on 24 July 2020 is reported to 21.96 million hectares which is up by 17.6% from last year** corresponding period area of 18.67 million hectares.
- **Kharif crops were sown in Telangana on 79 lakh hectare till July 22, 2020 which was 58.17 lakh hectares** during the same time last year. Paddy sowing has increased from 4 lakh hectares to 10.20 lakh hectares during the same period last year.
- **Punjab Government has urged Union Minister Ram Vilas Paswan to restore the commission of "arhtiyas"** (commission agents) to the statutory norm of 2.5 per cent of minimum support price (MSP). Any deviation from the existing policy could cause serious disruptions to paddy procurement process. The flat rate commission provided for rabi marketing season (RMS) was contrary to the statutory norm of 2.5 per cent of MSP. The chief minister requested Paswan to accordingly amend the provisional cost sheet for RMS 2020-21, issued by the Department of Food and Public Distribution, Government of India. As per the sheet, arhtiyas' commission has been allowed at a flat rate of Rs 46 per quintal, which appears to be based on certain estimates of the actual expenditure incurred
- **The offer price of 5 percent broken sela-grade rice export in India, remains stable at the previous level** of USD 377-382 per tonne.
- **More farmers seek to shirk paddy, Haryana eyes 12% water savings.** Haryana government hopes to save 12 per cent water this crop season, with farmers applying to shift to alternatives to the water-guzzling paddy, like cotton, bajra and maize in over 2.86 lakh acres under the government scheme 'mera pani-meri virasat', this year. It is a matter of great satisfaction that farmers have given their consent for growing alternative crops other than paddy in over around one lakh hectare (2.47 lakh acres) of land. Around 12-13 per cent water will be saved this way, said Haryana Chief Minister. Paddy is cultivated in about 30 lakh acres in the state. This includes water savings from all sources including canal and underground water which is pumped through tubewells for the paddy crop. However, an official of the agriculture department cautioned to wait till July-end, when the transplantation of basmati variety of paddy will conclude. The alternative crops require 80 per cent less water than the needs of paddy cultivation
- **Paddy sowing Shows a Decreasing Trend in Andhra Pradesh:** On the back of a normal monsoon in the State, the cultivation target for paddy in the kharif season is 15.90 lakh hectares. It is less than the last year's target of 16.25 lakh hectares. In fact, the target was less last year also when compared to the 2018 kharif season which was 16.26 lakh hectares. Normal sowing during the season was 16.03 lakh hectares in the 2016 kharif season. Now, the normal sowing during the season is just 14.97 lakh hectares. The normal sowing has been on decline since 2016. Districts such as East and West Godavari and Krishna, which are known for paddy cultivation, have shown a decline trend in paddy sowing. For instance, the normal paddy sowing in Krishna was 2,45,279 hectares in 2016 kharif. It has slipped to 2,30,375 hectares now (2020). Similarly, it was only 2,23,431 hectares in East Godavari as against 2,29,617 hectares in 2016. Likewise, the normal sowing was 2,38,524 hectares in West Godavari in 2016 and is now 2,27,161 hectares
- **Trade with Bangladesh opens doors for India's non-basmati rice exports:** The resumption of trade with Bangladesh through the West Bengal border has raised hopes among India's non-basmati rice traders of getting fresh orders from the neighbouring country. Trucks carrying rice are currently going through the Petrapole-Benapole border, fulfilling orders which were placed prior to the Covid-19 outbreak. Bangladesh largely buys non-basmati rice. We have come to know that Bangladesh will import rice from India this year. India had exported 7,599,552.15 metric tonnes of non-basmati rice worth Rs 21,184.85 crore in 2018-19.

- **Australian rice planting and output have slumped more than 90% since the 2017-18 season. Its national 2019-20 crop is expected to be 57,000 tons, the second-smallest output on record and the lowest since the 2007-08.**
- **With the support of good monsoon rains, Indian farmers have hastened sowing of kharif crops this time, which has now touched a gross area of over 580 lakh hectares by July 10. Similarly, the area under paddy has increased by 26.16 percent from 95.73 lakh hectare last year to 120.77 lakh hectare. The area of coarse cereals has also increased by 29.55 percent and its area has increased from 71.96 lakh hectare last year to 93.24 lakh hectare at this time.**
- **Under the pandemic situation of COVID-19, Indian government decided to distribute free grains to around 80 crore people till November-2020. Under the scheme of Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Ann Yojana (PMGKAY), 203 lakh tonnes of food grains are to be distributed from April to November, of which 201.1 lakh tonnes will be allocated in July to November, which includes 91.14 lakh tonnes of wheat, 110 lakh tonnes of rice .**
